- We need to clarify in the code what the height of 35 feet is, if it is average, we need to also add a maximum height what he would suggest 45 feet, Attorney Smith will look into it

- 2 weeks ago, we have a walk thru with the town officials and they gave the go ahead to start digging the sidewalks on Winterton Rd from Market to Chestnut Ridge!

Mr. Smilowitz asked to put back the sign stop here on red by Winterton corner Main Street, and to add a no standing sign on Winterton along the old houseware shop. Discussion about that, Attorney Mr. Smith will look into it

Mr. Meyerowitz asked to put back the sign stop here on red and to restripe the centerlines and crosswalk on the road and asked to add the yield for pedestrian. Mayor Wood commend that the buss brings it down all the time we tried to put it by the school

Mr. Klein asked to put back the sign stop here on red by Winterton corner Main Street and to restripe the centerlines and crosswalk on the road
