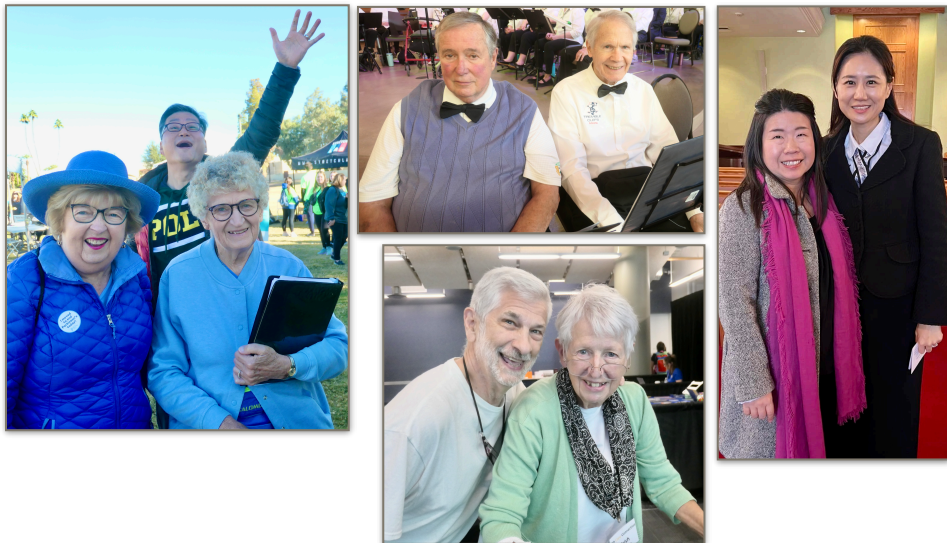


We Welcome People with Parkinson's disease

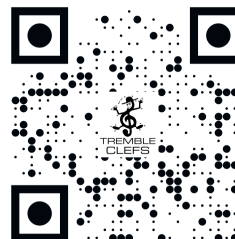
