Application Process

The steps in the Application Process are Inquiry, School Visit, Informational session, Application for Admission, Parent Interview, Acceptance and lastly Student Assessment.

Applications are accepted, and enrollment decisions made, on a rolling basis. A paid enrollment/registration deposit holds a student's spot in their class. All enrollees are considered on a first-come; first-serve basis. All grades are capped at 12 or 14 students; and wait-lists are established for classes that exceed maximum capacity.

We welcome children and families from all backgrounds, whether from different Christian denominational affiliations, other faith confessions, or non-faith, secular backgrounds. We ask that during the enrollment process all parents familiarize themselves with our faith perspective and the role that it plays in student life. HCS students participate daily in Bible reading and hymns at every grade level. All staff members will demonstrate respect toward individual family beliefs and practices.
