

Heard on the Court, "Exactly What is DUPR?"

DUPR stands for Dynamic Universal Pickleball Rating. It's a global rating system designed specifically for pickleball players of all levels. This rating is dynamic, meaning it can change with every game played and reported. By providing an accurate measure of skill, DUPR ensures that players are matched against opponents of comparable ability. There is no cost to participate in DUPR other than your Club membership must be current.

Our Club has three systems of DUPR. Everyone starts by playing in DUPR Qualifying Round Robins. The goal and purpose of this is to get a Reliability Score of 60%. Players do this by playing with other players who already have an RS of 60%. These matches are organized and monitored by one of our DUPR Volunteers. Everyone starts out with a 3.5 skill rating. This rating will go up or down depending on how many games are played, who players play with and against, and the score of each game. The scores of these games are entered into DUPR by one of our Club's DUPR Volunteers.

Once players have obtained a 60% Reliability Score, they are eligible to play in DUPR Skill Rated Round Robins. Invites are sent out weekly through the SWISH App. The games are divided into 4 skill levels: Group A, 3.75+ level; Group B, 3.4-3.74 level; Group C, 3.0-3.39 level; and Group D, 1.5-2.99 level. Players can also organize their own DUPR Skill Rated games.

The third DUPR Club opportunity is MLP, (Minor League Pickleball). This is a round robin team competition with guaranteed matches. Mixed teams of 4 players (2 women and 2 men) are broken into divisions based on their combined DUPR rating to compete against each other in four 25-point games (2 gendered, 2 mixed). Our Club's Fall MLP is winding down. Check out their final matches on Saturday, January 4 @2-4 PM on Courts 1-4 to see what it's all about!
