- **Q.** What are my voting rights in the Condominium Association?
- **A.** One (1) vote per unit
- **Q.** What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?
- **A**. Maximum occupancy of this unit type is **5**. Also See Rules and Regulations, in Condo Docs
- **Q.** If my unit is occupied by a renter or others; do I still have use of the common elements during that occupancy?
- **A.** No. When your unit is rented or otherwise occupied by others you transfer your rights to use the common elements to them for the duration of their occupancy.
- **Q.** What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on leasing my unit?
- **A.** No pets allowed
- Q. What are my assessments to the condominium association for unit type and when are they due?
- **A.** Current monthly fee for this unit type is \$ . All fee
  - . All fees due on the first day of each month.
- **Q.** What expenses are paid through the maintenance fees?
- **A.** The maintenance fees pay for only common expenses, including but not limited to: Building insurance, management fees, water/sewer, common electricity, cable t.v., internet service, building maintenance, reserves for replacements etc.
- **Q.** Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the Association, what are my voting rights and how much are my assessments in this association?
- A. No
- **Q.** Am I required to pay land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A. No
- **Q.** Is the Condominium Association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court case in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000.00? If so, identify each such case.
