CHIPS IN THE BUFFALO WALLOW GAME

Supplies:
6-10 small paper plates
Brown spray paint (for adult use only)
Cool glue gun (for adult use only)
White liquid glue or glue stick
Dried straw or grass
Hoola hoop, masking tape, or chalk

Because of the drying time involved, the adult will make the "buffalo chips" at least one day prior to the actual session. The glue needs to dry thoroughly before the chips can be tossed during the game. Send instructions home with the children so that they can play with family and friends.

Make each buffalo chip by gluing two plates together. The inside (eating) surfaces will be glued facing each other. Using a cool glue gun, run a bead of glue around the edge of one plate and place the other plate on top. Press the edges firmly together.

Paint top and bottom. Spread liquid glue on one surface at a time.

Press grass or straw and bits of earth onto the sticky surface. Allow to dry completely before using. Refer to next page for an illustration of the completed buffalo chip.
