



Participant Information

Thank you for entering the Headscarf Hustle 2026. Please find below all the information you will need to help prepare you for this fabulous event on **Sunday 8th March at 10am**.

New Venue

Due to works on the Humber Bridge we have had to relocate the event for this year. With thanks to Hull City Council and The Deep we have managed to create a route along the river path. However instead of the usual 4-mile distance, this year the route is around 3 miles. As before this is NOT a timed event but you are welcome to time yourself. The start of the event is just outside The Deep HU1 4DP.

Getting to the event

There is **absolutely no parking** in the car parks of The Deep or the Business Centre for participants of the Headscarf Hustle. It is very important to adhere to this since we are being wonderfully supported by these organisations and do not want to affect business for them on the day. There are however a great number of nearby parking options within easy reach of the start of the event. You can see transport/parking options below – please make sure you use these options instead.

Registration

You must collect your event number from Registration which is based in The Deep Business Centre (Not The Deep).

There are **absolutely NO ENTRIES on the day**. So if you know anyone thinking of doing it they must sign up in advance – **closing date is this Thursday 10am**.

It is really important you arrive in good time so you can register and get to the start in time. Number collection opens at 9.15am. Your event number **MUST** be clearly displayed on your front to enable you to take part. You will also receive a headscarf for you to wear on the day! You can wear this however you like...how will you wear yours?!

Toilets

Toilets have been hired for the event and will be available in the White Gates Car Park. This is the area on the right as you approach The Deep. Make sure you allow enough time to use the facilities and get to the start area. **No** Toilets are available for use in either The Deep or The Deep Business Centre.



Start

This year we welcome Traitors “Faithful” Jessie to open the event and recognise the important connection with International Women’s Day. There will be an event briefing and a group warm up from 9.50am. Then the official start will be led by Peter Levy promptly at 10am. Runners will be set off first followed by walkers. Remember **NO** scooters and bikes are allowed – and assistance dogs only.

Safety

The course is an out and back route so please be aware at all times of participants on the path, especially when the front runners start heading back to the finish. Members of the public will also be out on the path and so be courteous to other users not involved in this event.

The route

The route is an out and back as far as Siemens. There will be volunteer marshals on route to support and cheer you on! Children (under 15s) must be accompanied at all times and remain the responsibility of the adult taking part with them. Please always keep to the left to allow people to pass you, and the safe passage of oncoming runners/walkers.

Facilities

- Public Toilets are located in the White Gates car park (none are available in The Deep/Business Centre).
- Water will be available on your return.
- There will be no mobile refreshment vendors located at this event but there are a number of local lovely cafes nearby.

Medical cover

We will have the support of Vie Medic Services Ltd on the day. Please remember to fill in the back of the event number with any relevant medical information that may be required.

Transport/Parking Options


From the west of Hull by far the easiest travel is to use Hull Park and Ride from Priory Park, Hull (Near Sainsburys) which runs direct to The Deep. Buses run every 20 minutes throughout the day from 7am and the last departure from The Deep is 19.07. Parking is free and buses run throughout the day. Buses are wheelchair accessible and there are public toilets at Priory Park [HERE](#)

From East Hull and Bransholme using buses, alight on Alfred Gelder St (Near Drypool Bridge) and walk down High St towards Myton Bridge.

There is cycle parking outside The Deep.

The nearest multi-storey car park is the Fruit Market and a separate surface car park on High St (Both next to Myton Bridge) - a short walk over the Millenium footbridge (Next to Tidal Barrier) that brings you straight to The Deep. Here are more details [HERE](#)
