PERMIT PROVISIONS:

- 1. All work must be paved prior to approval and use. A \$1,500 cash bond must be posted at the time of application. Upon completion of work all funds deposited shall be returned to the applicant.
- 2. The work shall be constructed in a manner that it does not interfere with the existing drainage, the movement of traffic, or removal of snow along subject road.
- 3. The work shall be constructed in such a manner that it does not permit runoff of water from subject location to enter into the property of the owner thereby creating a nuisance to the MIFD-managed property and/or owner.
- 4. Notice must be given at least 48 hours prior to the start of any work and the driveway staked out prior to notice.
- 5. A minimum of 10' from the location the driveway abuts the MIFD-managed road shall be bituminous concrete (asphalt) into the property and a minimum of 12' wide. Pavement shall be a minimum of 2" compacted asphalt over 6" processed gravel base.
- 6. All work required for the driveway construction, including but not limited to tree removal, fill, and repair of disturbed area in the ROW shall be made at the owner's expense.
- 7. Work shall be stabilized for a sufficient distance in from MIFD-managed property (construction apron) to prevent erosion onto the MIFD-managed property and shall be designed in a manner to confine the surface water to the gutter areas and permit free flow of water in the waterways. Pipe, if required, shall be a minimum 15" concrete pipe or approved equal.
