


# COVID-19 and your Course

## COVID-19 and your course

We are committed to providing our learners with the qualifications they require for work and their personal development.

Many of the qualifications we offer are for the purpose of ensuring workplaces remain complaint and staff are occupationally competent. Following the government advice, we are operating a policy of "business as usual" but with a few minor adaptations.

### Your course with us:

Learners who have recently returned from countries specified by the UK government, should not attend the course.

Anyone who is showing the signs of a cough, cold or flu will also be asked not to attend.

### During the course

We will ensure:

- Tissues are available
- Alcohol wipes and/or hand sanitiser are available
- Learners are able to wash their hands at regular intervals

The health and well-being of our learners is our highest priority. We are committed to ensuring learners can continue to access their chosen qualification with minimal disruption. We will continue to review our hygiene policies in line with Public Health England and will ensure these are followed by all learners.
