

# CARI-WAY TRANSPORT RATE CHART

SERVICE	RATE	MINIMUM CHARGE
Hourly Rate (In Town) Within 70km radius of Edmonton, AB	\$80 per hour	\$240 (3 hr minimum)
Out-of-Town Rate	\$3.00 per km	No minimum
2 <sup>nd</sup> Laborer for Unloading	\$50 per hour extra	No minimum
Outside Alberta (Applied permits, taxes, and fees)	Applicable Provincial Rates	No minimum
Off-Road (pavement)	\$100 per hour	No minimum

## How Cari-Way Transport Rates Are Applied

To calculate the total cost of a trip using Cari-Way Transport, the following charges are applied based on the services used. Here's a step-by-step breakdown of how each rate is applied:

---

### Hourly Rate (3-hour minimum)

- **Rate:** \$80 per hour
- **Minimum Charge:** \$240 (equivalent to 3 hours)
- **When it's Applied:** This charge applies for the total time the driver is engaged in the transport job, including driving time within 70 kms radius of Edmonton. If the total time is less than 3 hours, you will still be charged the 3-hour minimum of \$240.
- **Example:**
  - If the transport takes 2.5 hours, you pay \$240 (since it is less than the 3-hour minimum).
  - If the transport takes 4 hours, you pay \$320 (since it exceeds the 3-hour minimum).

---

### Out-of-Town Rate (per km)

- **Rate:** \$3.00 per kilometer

- **Minimum Charge:** No minimum charge (you only pay for the distance covered)
- **When it's Applied:** This charge applies for each kilometer the transport travels outside of the local city/town limits.
- **Example:**
  - If the trip includes 125 km of out-of-town travel, the cost is **125 km × \$3.00 = \$375.**
  - If there is no out-of-town travel, this charge does not apply.

---

## Outside Alberta (permits, taxes, and fees)

- **Rate:** \$100 flat fee
- **Minimum Charge:** No minimum (flat fee is charged regardless of time or distance)
- **When it's Applied:** This charge applies for any trips that cross the Alberta border into another province or territory.
- **Example:**
  - If a trip crosses into British Columbia, you pay a flat \$100 fee.
  - If the trip stays entirely within Alberta, this charge does not apply.

---

## 2nd Laborer for Unloading (per hour)

- **Rate:** \$50 per hour
- **Minimum Charge:** No minimum (only pay for the time the 2nd driver works)
- **When it's Applied:** If a second driver is required to assist with unloading, this hourly rate is charged. The cost is calculated for the time the second driver is required.
- **Example:**
  - If the second driver is required for 2 hours, you pay **2 × \$50 = \$100.**
  - If the second driver is required for 4 hours, you pay **4 × \$50 = \$200.**

---

## Off-Road (Pavement):

- **Rate:** \$100 per hour
- **Minimum Charge:** No minimum time requirement applies to this rate.
- **When it's Applied:** When a delivery is off-road and not on pavement
- **Example:**
  - If the trip is 300 km out of town and 50 km of that trip is off road and takes 1 hour, you pay **300km x \$3.00 per km= \$900**  
**Plus 1 hour off road charge of \$100= \$900+\$100= \$1000**
  - If the trip is not off-road, this charge does not apply
