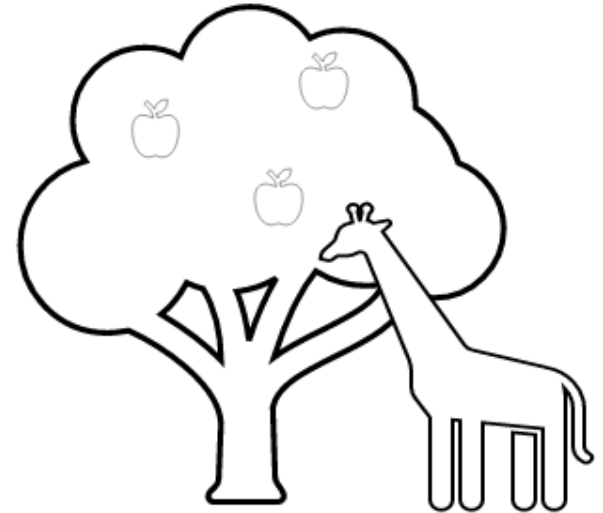


The Creation Story

Genesis 1:1-2:3



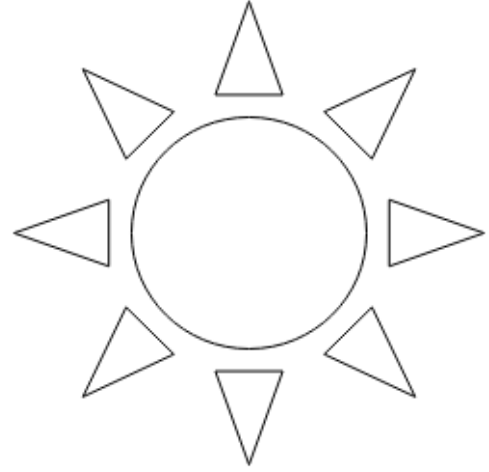
1st Day

Discuss:

Do:

1. Color the sun **yellow** and the water **blue**!



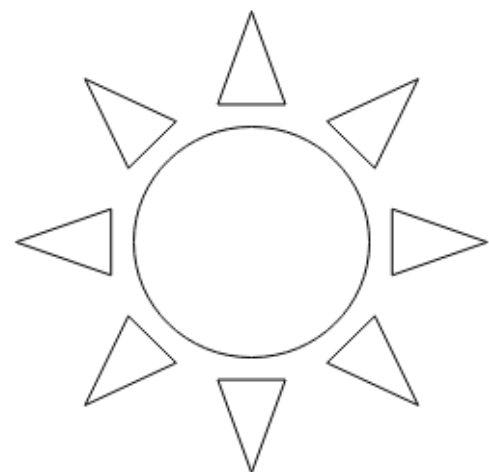
2nd Day

Discuss:

Do:

2. Draw another cloud in the sky!



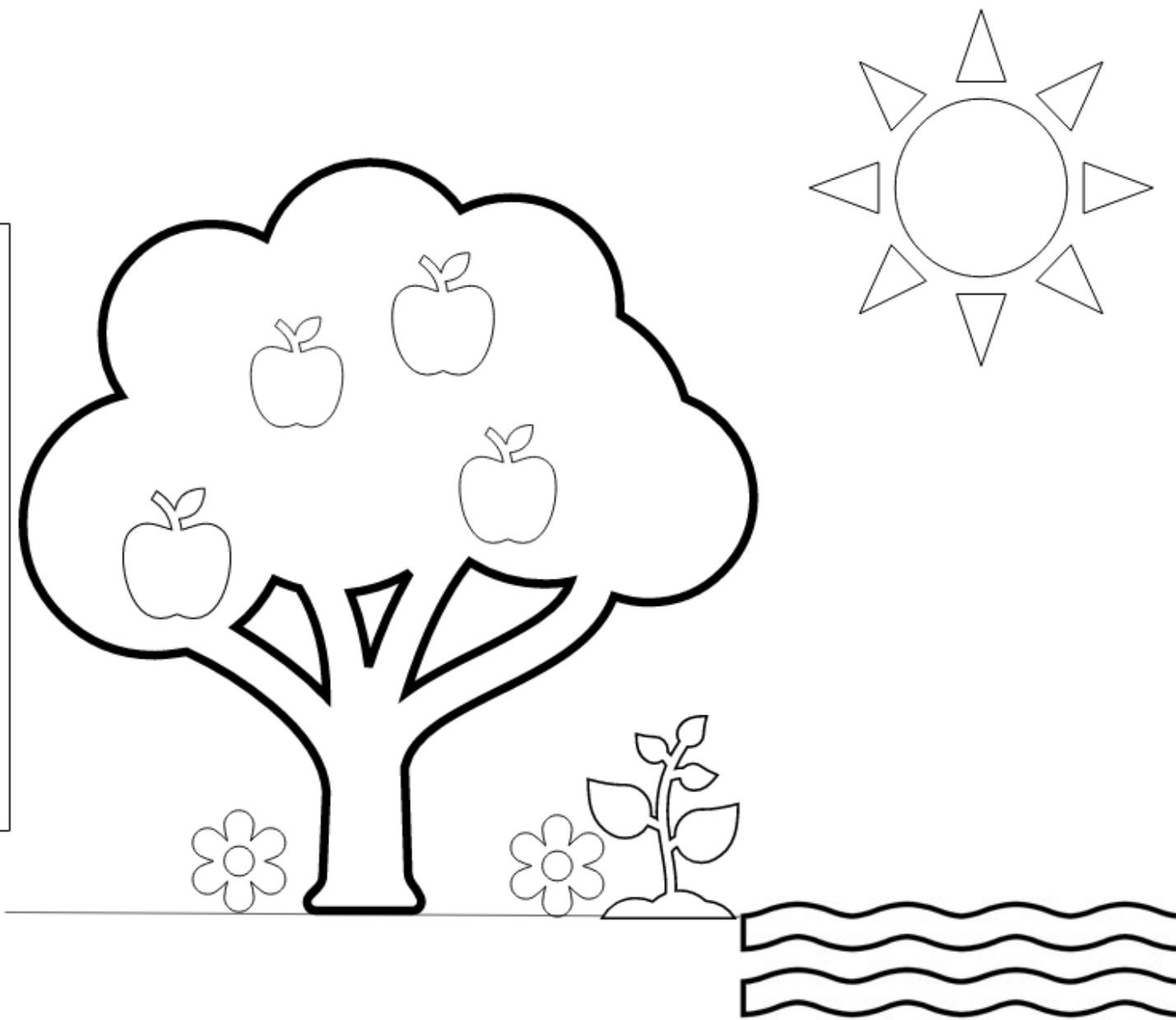
3rd Day

Discuss:

- God commanded "the water... to be in one place, so that land will appear."
- Land was seperated from the water.
- God created fruits and plants!

Do:

1. Color the sun **yellow** and the water **blue**!
2. Color the land, plants and tree!



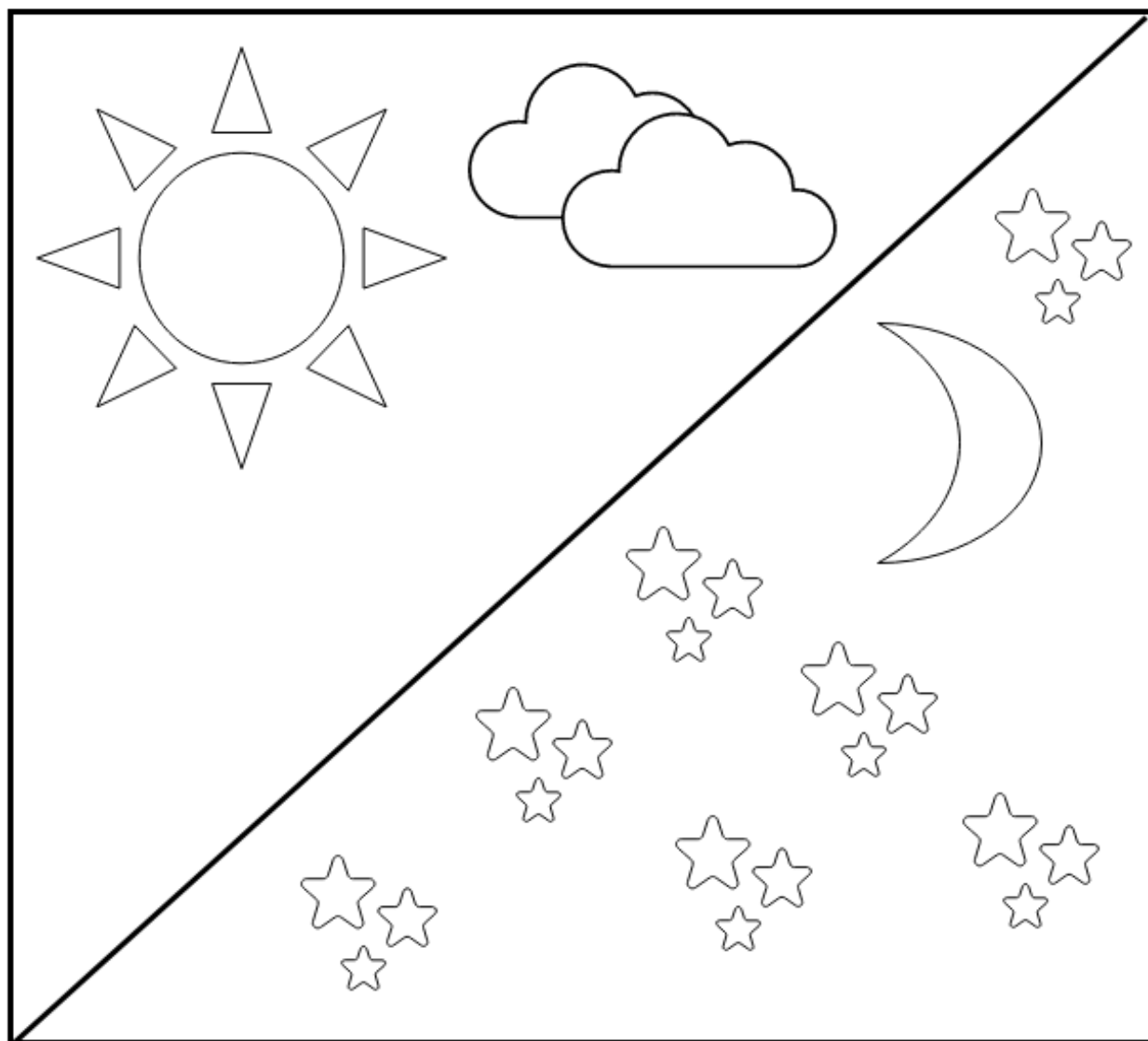
4th Day

Discuss:

- God separated day from night.
- God made the sun for the day, and the moon for the night.
- God made lights in the sky called stars.

Do:

1. Color the sun, moon and stars.
2. Count how many stars are in the sky at night.



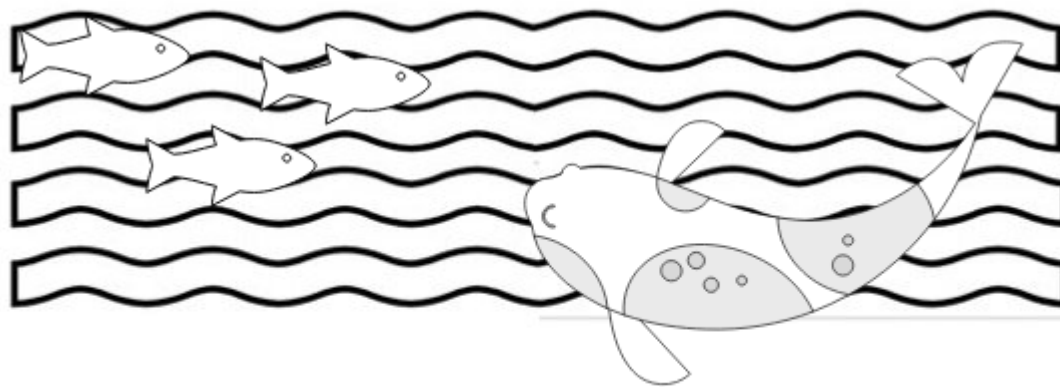
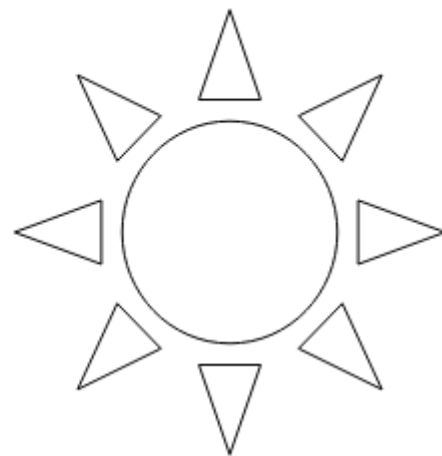
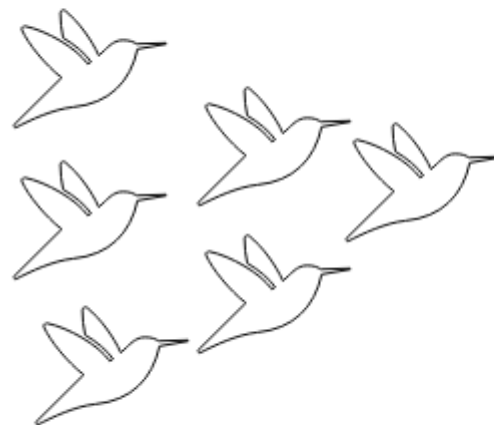
5th Day

Discuss:

- God created birds and sea animals.
- Birds filled the sky.
- Sea animals filled the water.

Do:

1. Color the sun, water, birds and fish.
2. Count how many birds are in the sky and fish in the water.



6th Day

Discuss:

- God created man and woman.
- God gave man the power over the fish, birds and animals.
- God gave grains and fruit for man to eat.
- Gave grain the birds animals grass and plants to eat.
- God was well pleased with what He had made.

Do:

1. Color the people animals, trees and plants.
2. Count how many animals you see.



7th Day

Discuss:

- On the seventh day, the work was complete and God rested from all of His work which he made.
- God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it.
- The seventh day remains a day of rest and reflection on God's work and all He has done for us.

Do:

- 1. Color the earth.
- What has God made that you are thankful for today?
