BUNNY LUV HOW-TO'S...

SEAMS: Use 4" seam allowance unless otherwise With right sides together, indicated.


CUTTING: See pattern pieces for cutting information & fabric suggestions.

GIRL OR BOY BUNNY(17")

Use pattern pieces #1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10 & 11

HEAD: With right sides together, stitch center head seam.





EARS: With right sides together, pin one pink & one white ear to thermolam. Stitch ear seam. Trim. Turn right side out.

Fold ears as shown. Stitch fold in place.



With pink side of ears down, baste ears to head front.
See pattern for placement.

With right sides together, stitch front head to back head. Trim seams. Turn right side out. Set aside.






LEGS: With right sides together, stitch front & back leg seams, leaving open between dots for stuffing.

With right sides together, stitch foot bottom to leg, matching dots to leg seams. Trim seam. Turn right side out.



Match leg seams & zig zag top of leg closed.

With right sides together, place leg between dots on bottom of body front. Zig zag leg top to bottom of body. Pin feet to body front so they won't get caught in seams.



With right sides together, stitch back body seam, leaving open between * for stuffing.



With right sides together, stitch body front to body back at side/arm seams. Clip inward points.

BODY BOTTOM: With right sides together, stitch body bottom to body, matching dots to side seams.





with right sides together, place head inside of body. Stitch neck seam, using ½" seam allowance..be careful not to catch ears in seam. Turn right side out thru back opening.

HINTS ON STUFFING...

For best results, always use good quality, light, fluffy fiberfill. Round out edges with stuffing stick (sharpened wood dowel or end of paint brush). Stuff to outer edges firmly. Bunny should be stuffed firmly, but do not pack fiberfill.




Stuff arms almost to stitching line. Machine stitch arms on stitching line.


Stuff head, body & legs. Slipstitch back openings closed. Now, let's make that adorable bunny face...


EYES: Double thread long doll needle with black buttonhole twist. Measure 1" out & 3/8" up from nose point on each side. Put straight pin in for eye markings. Needle goes in at one eye marking and comes out at other eye marking. Go in & out 2-3 times, pulling slightly to indent. Tie off.



MOUTH: Measurements for points B,C,D & E... Measure down from nose point A $1\frac{1}{4}$ " & mark with pin for point B. From point B, measure $\frac{1}{2}$ " over & $\frac{1}{4}$ " down & mark with pin for point C. From point C, measure over 1" & 3/4" up & mark with pin for point D. From point C, measure over $\frac{1}{2}$ " & 1/8" up & mark with pin for point E. Repeat measurements on other side for points F, G & H.



Poke needle into point A & out at B...back in at A & out at C, in at B, out at D, in at C & out at E. Take needle over thread, pulling thread down, bowing mouth...poke needle back in at E & out at B. Repeat for other side of mouth. Poke needle out at D



Take ¼" stitch across D for smile line as shown. Poke needle back over to G. Repeat, making smile line. Go in & out between D & G, pulling slightly to indent. Poke needle back thru to A and tie off.

EYES: Stitch eyes in place. Glue 3/8" piece of eyelash under buttons. <



False eyelashes or craft eyelash strips can be used. You can order the craft eyelash strips from Luv 'n Stuff.


TONGUE: Glue tongue in place.



NOSE: Run hand gathering stitch around outer edge of nose. Place small amount of stuffing on nose & pull up to make a ball measuring 5/8". Stitch to face at point A.

WHISKERS: Double thread needle with buttonhole twist. Take tiny stitch in face, leaving $1\frac{1}{2}$ " end hanging. Take another stitch over 1st


stitch, leaving another $1\frac{1}{2}$ " end hanging. Trim. Repeat for other side.





ROSEY-UP: Put small amount of paint on medium-size damp brush. Blot on paper towel. Using a very light touch, rosey-up cheeks.



GIRL BUNNY'S CLOTHES


DRESS: Cut (2) $22\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $8\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces of print fabric.


with right sides
together, stitch 13/4"
side seams, leaving openings as
shown. Press
seams open.



Topstitch close to folded edge on armhole opening.

Press under 4" twice on bottom edge. Topstitch with decorative stitch & contrasting thread.






For top casing: Press under $\frac{1}{4}$ ", then press under $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Stitch casing as shown, leaving $\frac{1}{2}$ " opening.


Place raw edge of lace under top edge of dress. Topstitch lace to dress <u>close</u> to folded edge of dress.





Pull elastic thru casing, adjust to fit bunny's neck. Stitch ends of elastic together. Stitch casing opening closed.


BLOOMERS: Use pattern piece #13. With right sides together, stitch center front seam. Press under ¼" on legs. Place lace under folded edge & decorative top-stitch.



MARCHINE

Press under 3/8" twice on top of bloomers. Zig zag stitch elastic to waist...stretching as you sew.

Zig-zag stitch elastic to wrong side of bloomer legs (see pattern for placement)..stretching as you sew.



With right sides together, stitch center back seam. Stitch inner leg seam.

Slipstitch satin bow to center dress. Tie craft ribbon bows around ears.



All Done...now, dress that cutie!

BOY BUNNY'S CLOTHES

Use pattern piece #13. Bow: Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Bow Center: Cut (1) 2"x2". Straps: Cut (2) 9"x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Hat: Cut (1) 12" diameter circle.

SHORTS: With right sides together, stitch center front seam. Press under 3/8" twice on legs. Topstitch.



Press under 3/8" twice on top edge. Zig-zag stitch elastic to waist...stretching as you sew.


With right sides together, stitch center back seam. Stitch inner leg seam.

STRAPS: Press under $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both long edges, then press straps in half. Topstitch.




Slipstitch one end of straps to inside back casing 1" from center back seam.

Crisscross straps in back & slipstitch other end to inside front casing 1½" from center front. Stitch buttons to front as shown. Glue pom-pon to back of shorts for tail.



Pq 4

HAT BRIM: Place brim right sides together on interfacing Stitch brim seam. Trim seam. Turn right side out. Press. Topstitch edge.



Run gathering stitch ¼"
from outer edge of hat.
Open one edge of 14"
piece of single fold
bias tape. With right
sides together, stitch
short ends...forming
circle.


Pull up gathers on hat to fit bias tape. With right sides together, pin tape to hat, distributing gathers evenly. Stitch.






Turn tape to inside & zig-zag topstitch.
Place brim under tape & topstitch.

BOW TIE: With right sides together, stitch bow leaving 2" opening. Clip corners. Turn right side out. Press.







Press under ½" on both long edges of bow center. Wrap bow center around bow & slipstitch raw edges together.

Slipstitch bow to bunny's neck.

All Done...Isn't he a Handsome Fella!?!



BABY DOLL BUNNY


Use pattern pieces #14 & 15. Bunting: Cut (1) $9"x4\frac{1}{2}"$.

EARS: Place pink & white ears right sides together. Stitch. Turn right side out.



Fold ears to meet in center. Stitch in place. Stitch pink side of ears to right side of head (see pattern for placement).

Cut 1½" slit at neck on body back. With right sides together, stitch body seam. Turn right side out thru slit. Stuff.




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Slipstitch neck slit closed & wrap thread around neck, pulling to indent. Tie off.

Slipstitch small buttons to face for eyes. Glue pink pom-pon to face for nose. See pattern for placements. Rosey-up cheeks like big



bunny's. Make whiskers the same as big bunny's except use single strand of buttonhole twist. Tie $\frac{1}{4}$ " satin ribbon around both ears in front.





BUNTING: Press under 4" on bunting top. Place 3/8" flat lace under folded edge & top-stitch. Zig-zag stitch elastic 3/4" down from lace edge, stretching as you stitch.


With right sides together, fold bunting in half. Stitch seam. Clip corners. Turn right side out. Slipstitch bow to bunting front. Place bunny in bunting. Glue pom-pon tail to bunting back. All Done...Such a Sweet Doll Bunny!



GIRL OR BOY BUNNY:

½ yd 60" White Velour

12"x10" Pink Velour

Notions: Fiberfill, 9"x10" Thermolam, (2) 5/8" Black Buttons, White & Black Buttonhole Twist, Craft Eyelash Strip, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Doll Sculpting Needle, White Craft Glue, 2" White Pompon, Red Acrylic Paint & Medium-size Paint Brush

GIRL BUNNY'S CLOTHES:

½ yd Small Print Fabric

Notions: 1½" Flat Lace..2 yds, ¼" Elastic, 5/8" Satin Ribbon..1/3 yd, Craft Ribbon..1 yd

BOY BUNNY'S CLOTHES:

1/3 yd Dotted Fabric

1/8 yd Small Print Fabric

Notions: (2) 3/4" Buttons, Small Piece Interfacing, $\frac{1}{4}$ " Elastic, Single Fold Bias Tape.. $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

BABY DOLL BUNNY:

12"x8" White Velour

Small Piece Pink Velour

10"x4" Piece Dotted Fabric

Notions: Fiberfill, 3/8" Flat Lace..1/3 yd, $\frac{1}{4}$ " Satin Ribbon..5/8 yd, Tail: 3/4" White Pom-pon, Eyes: (2) 7-9mm Black Beads or Buttons, Nose: 5mm Pink Pom-pon or Bead, $\frac{1}{4}$ " Elastic, White Buttonhole Twist, White Craft Glue, Red Acrylic Paint & Medium-size Paint Brush

BASKET:

6"-8" Round or Oval Basket

1/8 yd Dotted Fabric

Notions: $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Ruffled Lace..1 yd, Ribbon Beading Lace..1 yd, $\frac{1}{4}$ " Satin Ribbon..1 yd, $\frac{1}{4}$ " Contrasting Satin Ribbon..1/3 yd, Hot Glue Gun

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
