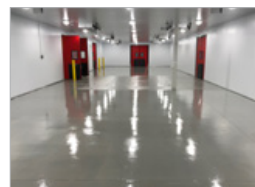

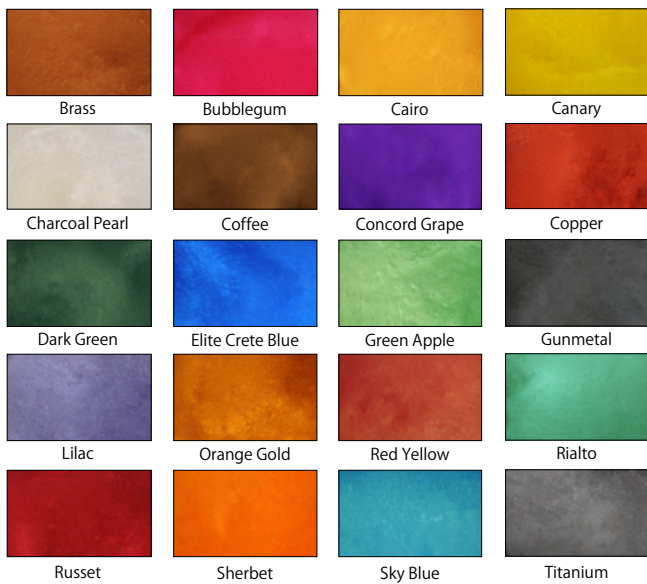

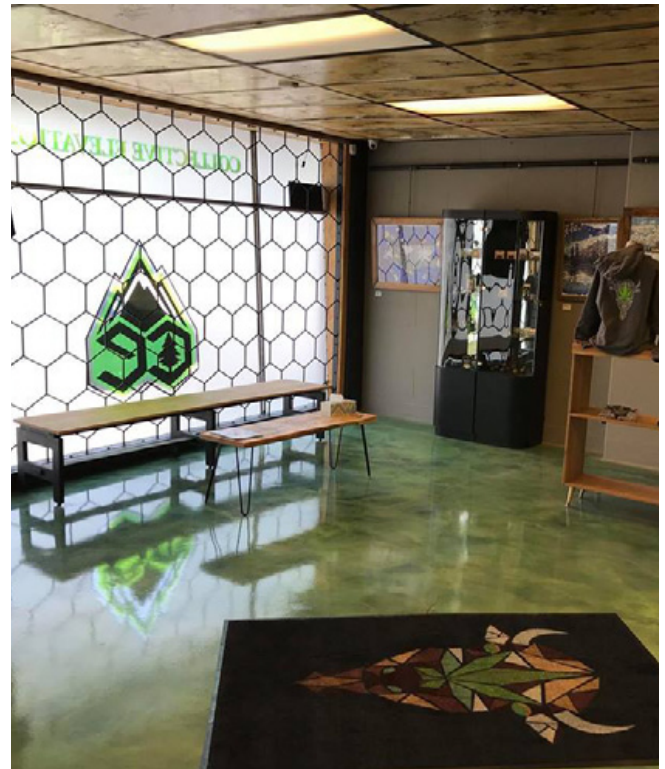
SAMPLE REFLECTOR™ ENHANCER COLOR CHART
