Scholarship Information & Application 2022



### **Purpose:**

The Georgia Vegetative Management Association (GVMA) financial scholarship is intended to promote education and leadership by awarding a minimum of \$2,000 scholarship to a qualified student with the intent of majoring in a field of study directly related to "Vegetation Management," i.e. forestry, horticulture, environmental science, landscaping and/or natural resources. The scholarship recipient will be selected by the GVMA Board based upon application. The recipient will receive the following: certificate commemorating the award, \$2,000 scholarship check, and an invitation to attend the annual GVMA Conference in which to receive award. Applications may be submitted by Georgia residents who are high school graduating seniors or students who are currently enrolled in a Georgia college or university. The application must be submitted no later than March 31, 2022 to gvmascholarship@gmail.com

## **Eligibility:**

- At the time of application, applicant must be a U.S. Citizen.
- Applicant may be seeking an undergraduate or graduate degree.
- To be considered, the applicant must submit a transcript to confirm their overall GPA for the preceding school year is at least 3.0 (out of 4.0).
- At the time of application, the applicant must already be enrolled in an accredited university or college within the State of Georgia and scheduled to start school within 2022 calendar year. In the event a recipient withdraws from the university/college or changes to a non-eligible field of study, that student will not be eligible for additional support from the GVMA.
- The student must be majoring in a field of study with a demonstrable concentration or emphasis on vegetation or natural resources management.

 College or university acceptance letter or proof of bachelor degree (if entering graduate school)
 Most recent High School or College transcript
 (1) One single-page double spaced, typed essay explaining the applicants views on the importance of vegetation management and your future career plans
 (1) One single-page personal letters of reference
 Most recent high school or college resume, highlighting your personal and academic achievements. Applicants are encouraged to provide detailed information on extracurricular activities, community service projects and honors received.
