Monthly Association Meetings	
1-20 people	Volunteer as a group or individual to help with setup, service, & child care
\$500	Provide a meal to feed the families during a monthly meeting (130-160 people, 60% children)
\$150	Provide dessert for a meeting
1-8 people	Share your knowledge or talent with the teens and elementary children
Join the Nanny/Manny Brigade or Babysitting Club	
Adults ages 18+	Can't foster or adopt but still want to make a personal difference in the life of a child in care? Become a member of the Nanny/Manny Brigade or Babysitting Club - an adult who is approved to spend time with the children in meaningful ways while at the DFCS Office or giving foster parents a much needed break for a couple of hours!
Foster/Adoptive Child Needs (Quarterly Drive)	
February 2019	Shoe Drive—all sizes, open and closed toed, male/female - 100+ pairs
May 2019	Socks & underwear drive – all sizes, male/female
September 2019	Fall/Winter Wear drive – all sizes, male/female – approximately 100 needed (coats, hats, gloves)
November 2019	Christmas Angels – adopt a family to provide a happy holiday for children in their homes
Quarterly 2019	Provide items to give away during the (3-4) yearly Raffles
Extracurricular Activity Funds – Restoring Normalcy for School-Aged Children	
\$500-1500	Provide funds for an Association educational trips to museums, gardens, or other places
\$100	Allow a child to participate in an after-school sport, program, activity or club
\$200	Support a child in pursuing an interest like music lessons, art lessons, martial arts, or other activity
Summer Camp Sponsorships	
\$300 per child	Sponsor a child for a week of summer camp (day camp only)
\$750 per child	Sponsor a child for a week of summer camp (away)
College Scholarship Program – Positive Future Scholars – Academic Merit & Community Service Based	
\$1,000	Provide 1 child with a \$1,000 college scholarship
