




Garrett Campbell RA

A biotechnology and molecular biologist, Garrett Campbell is employed by Primus Pharmaceuticals, a novel specialty prescription products company focused on unmet needs in dermatology and rheumatology, as a research and development analysist. His work on the Rx-tri lipid emollient is the #1 most prescribed in dermatology and has just been published in the Journal of Skin and will be presented at the fall Clinical Dermatology Conference. In these experiments, he has demonstrated how a prescription emollient cream used for atopic dermatitis, eczema and contact dermatitis repairs the stratum corneum dysfunction against microbial contamination.

Among his prior work, Mr. Campbell has co-led the research and development of multiple dermatology products using an in-silico modeling, differential gene expression analyses on orphan diseases and skin barrier disorders such as congenital ichthyosis, plaque psoriasis, and atopic dermatitis to identify specific pathways in which to target molecular deficiencies which can be exploited to manage / teat the underlying disease. His work is the subject of serval patents, and his current focus is characterizing severe unmet therapeutic needs affecting quality of life, how to enhance topical formulations to deliver next generations performance as life-cycle management, developing new standards of care by combining Rx medical devices with Rx drugs in chronic skin diseases. He furthers his work by looking to create innovative scientific and clinical study designs to demonstrate the comparative vs. effectiveness of breakthrough new skin therapies vs. existing drugs. His passion in translating science into real life QOL benefits in compromised and underserved patient populations.

Morag Currin LE






Horses are steadfast dance partners; what they have to say has the power to spur change.




