Shade Gardens

Tips:

- ✓ Many plants thrive in the shade.
- ✓ Be Water Wise; use mulch, and decrease the amount of water you put on your plants.
- ✓ Always remember to check soil frequently, shady areas tend to get too much water which will cause the roots to rot and plants to die.
- ✓ Most broad-leafed evergreens flourish in shade because they are protected from the winter wind and sun.
- ✓ If you want a shade loving plant in a sunny spot just plant a sun/heat tolerant plant next to it creating shade for your shade lover.

Listed below are plants that do well in the shade. Many of them can grow in the sun as well.
