TRADESWOMEN OWNING THEIR POWER SPONSORSHIP 2024

Women make up **less than 2%** of all tradespeople and of those women who do begin in a trade role, **74% leave** their apprenticeship, compared to 44% for men. Once the 26% of women who do complete there apprenticeship complete, the issues don't stop.

A large number of women leave there industry after completion due to burnout, lack of confidence, anxiety and harassment.

This is a problem due to the skill shortage. With not enough skilled workers we need to not only get women into trades but keep them there. It is no secrete that there are social issues that are a barrier which then leads to women having to overcome a large number of obstacles before they enter the trade and once they are in the trades.

Sponsoring a tradeswomen to complete the Tradeswomen Owning Their Power Coaching program will allow women to have access to the tools they need to not only survive but thrive in the trades.

According to the 2020 Productivity Commission, National Agreement for Skills and Workforce Development Review -

Targeted support services are generally very effective at increasing completion rates with some programs as high as **15% improvement**. A 15% increase of retention of tradeswomen will have a massive impact on closing the skills gap.
