CAMP IS BACK! After missing the past two camp seasons, preparations are well underway for the 2022 POWEROF2YOUTHCAMPS. Two exciting weeks are planned for this summer: Junior Camp (ages 7-12) July 4-6 and Teen Camp (ages 12 and up) July 11-15. We want to extend a special invitation to those seniors who were unable to attend their 'last camp year' due to the camp's closure. We welcome you back as a camper this year. Your advance registration is critical this year as so many demographics have changed since our last camp. Please <u>REGISTER EARLY</u> (no later than June 14th) so we have good census numbers for the final logistical planning.

The Camp will be co-moderated by Bro. Mark and Bro. Duane. Bro. Dean McNeese and Bro. Justin Cooper will be heading the preaching team for Teen Week. Missionary Keith Shumaker, Bro. Chris Cornett and Bro. David Martin will be preaching in our Junior Week. The focus of the camp will be on Old-Fashioned Preaching and Singing as always – we are UNAPOLOGETICALLY OLD FASHION. Bro. Mark will be heading up the big Camp Choir each night. The super-sized auditorium will be opened to the community each night for our services.

We are still finalizing activities, but we anticipate returning to the Trampoline Park, Funopolis, sports and more. These activities have been included in your fee and are covered in your consent and release. In addition to the services and planned excursions, the camp days also include group and individual devotional times, competitions, food, fellowship and so much more.

Wahoo Baptist Church will be hosting the PTM God and Country Service on Sunday afternoon, July 3rd at the Union Grove Campground – 3:30 PM. These special Sunday Afternoon activities allow our volunteer staff to arrive and settle in as we spend time in prayer for the upcoming camps. Speaking of Camp Volunteers, the camp relies on quality youth volunteers for the operation of our Junior Week specifically. The pattern of recruitment has always been tapping into the young people that have been a part of the camp experience and enlisting them for volunteer responsibilities. With the gap in the camp timeline over the past couple of years, we know that a different group of young people are emerging. They may not have heard from their older counterparts about the volunteer program. The Camp utilizes young people ages 13 and up during Junior Week. These volunteer staff members assist in the oversight of the campers. participate in their games and services, help out in the kitchen and canteen and many other functions. There is no cost to volunteer at Junior Camp. In addition, the camp is working on our annual appreciation weekend between Junior and Teen Weeks (July 6-8). We are planning a fun filled get-away to Pigeon Forge, Tn with lots of activities. The camp covers half of the cost of the weekend for those volunteers. All of the details are available on the camp website along with the appropriate volunteer sign-up documents and details. We need Pastors and Youth Leaders to speak to young people in their church that would be quality volunteers and encourage them to participate. This is a wonderful ministry experience that produces a lifetime of relationships and memories along with eternal fruit in the work of the Lord.

<u>Camp Fees</u>: Teen camp is \$245 and Junior camp is \$135 if you register by June 14. The cost will increase to \$285 and \$160 if you register late or at camp. With commodity prices escalating

with inflation and complicated by the increase in fuel/transportation cost, we found it necessary to implement an increase in our camp fees. Even with the increase, the camp will require individual and church donations to break even. Thank you for your understanding as we attempt to put together a quality camp experience.

Registration: We have licensed a new on-line registration system as we continually try to improve the registration process. All applications should be completed on-line by visiting our website at www.powerof2youthcamp.com. When you submit your application, your electronic data will be added to our database and a paper version can be printed for the appropriate signatures. We must have original signed consent and release forms. You will have an opportunity to upload supporting documents such as insurance cards and more during registration. You will have the option of paying your fees on-line (or bringing payment to camp) and bringing your signed forms with you to camp. with you to camp. Your advance payment helps us with campexpenses that must be paid before camp begins. If needed, we will be able to accept your credit or debit card at camp allowing payment of fees, prepayment for canteen, extra shirts, donations and other items that are available.
