

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
DURHAM PARK SOCIAL & RECREATIONAL ASSOCIATION

We the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty one years or more, acting as organizers of a non-profit organization under Section 501 (c) (7) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (Code), adopt the following Articles for such organization.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the organization is DURHAM PARK SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II.

The organization is a non-profit organization.

ARTICLE III.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The organization is organized exclusively for the purpose of promoting, organizing and operating a club for the pleasure, social activities and recreation of its members.

ARTICLE V.

The organization shall have one or more classes of members. The designation of such class or classes, the manner of election or appointment of such members, and the qualifications of the members of each class shall be exclusively within the discretion of the Board of Officers, as such Board in the By-Laws may from time to time provide. No member of any class shall have any rights in the property of the organization; and no member of any class shall be personally liable for the debts, liabilities or obligations of the organization. The Board may however, in its discretion, require a fee to be made to the organization as a prerequisite to membership; and the Board shall have the power to fix or levy fees and special assessments upon the members in the manner and within the limitations that may be specified in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VI.

The following additional provisions are inserted for regulation of the internal affairs of the organization:

Section A: No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its Officers, members, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.

Section B: No part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of any regular trade or business of a kind ordinarily engaged in for profit.

Section C: Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, the organization shall not engage in any activities not permitted to be carried on by a organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (7) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Section D: Upon the dissolution of the organization, the Board shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the organization, dispose of all of the assets of the organization exclusively for the purposes of the organization in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for the pleasure, recreation or other non-profitable purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, as the Board shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the registered office of the organization is then located.

ARTICLE VII.

The number of officers constituting the initial Board of Officers of the organization is four (4), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial officers, each of whom shall hold office until the first annual meeting of the Board of Officers and until his successor is elected and qualified, are:
