In approving this plat by the Commissioner's Court of Williamson County, Texas, it is understood that the building of all streets, roads or other public throughfares or any bridges or culverts necessary to be placed on such roads, streets, dr other public throughfares shall be the responsibility of the owner and/or developer of the tract of land covered by this plat and in accordance with the plans and specifications prescribed by the Commissioner's Court of Williamson County, Texas, and said Court assumes no obligation to build any of the streets, roads, or other public throughfares or any bridges or culverts in connection therewith, and assumes no obligation for maintenance thereon until such time that 80% occupancy of the lots along the roadways in this subdivision has been achieved and only after such roads and streets have been paved by the subdivider—to meet the specifications set forth by the Williamson County Commissioner's Court for paving and grading, and all driveway drain pipes have been installed on written permission from the County Commissioners and have a minimum drain size of 18 thiches in diameter or equal and a minimum length of 22 feet.

All dwellings built on these lots must be served by a septic tand meeting the requirements of the State and County Health Department
