BULLETIN 1

- 1. The races are for school teams invited by their National Schools' Ski Association and will be run on full poles. Teams should comprise four skiers, all of whom must be full time pupils on the Autumn Term Roll of the school they are representing and in Years 7 and above. Scottish high schools start at Year 6 and so it has been agreed by all 3 nations that pupils in Year 6 from Scotland will be accepted. The team score will be the aggregate of the best three times from team members on the first run and the best three times from team members on the second run. The combined total of times from both runs will be used to calculate an individual's time.
- 2. Racers must have 3rd party liability insurance. (English teams supplied by Snowsport England)
- All racers are expected to wear properly fitted helmets without cameras, mountings, or stickers.
- **4.** Ski poles should be fitted with bungs or the racer will not be allowed to start.

Bib issue 8.15 tbc and there will be a short practice session for team members only. The race will consist of two runs over the same slalom course. Full details will be in bulletin 2.

NOMINATED OFFICIAL

Each team is required to nominate a named official to assist the organisation. It is recognised that teams with long journeys may only be able to bring one adult per team — in this case that person must act as Team Manager and Race Official, as every team is required to provide a named official as a condition of entry. Please give details of experience and any requests for positions.

ENTRY FEES of £80 per team must be paid before the closing date

The entry fee is £105 but subsidised by ESSKIA so you only pay £80 per team. This does not include the practice session on Saturday. It is expected that competitors will provide their own equipment. Standard rental equipment is available at the slope, but please check in advance that they are able to supply correct items and sizes.
