The Snowbox is a hazardous area. Snow is a slippery substance and the sports that you partake in are extreme sports. We have a minimum of 2 slope patrollers on the snow at any one time to oversee and minimise risk where possible. Netting and padding is on the slope to assist in protecting our guests and team whilst partaking in the activities. All equipment is maintained by our facilities team and cold side team, and is inspected annually by an external engineering company. All guests partake in activities at their own risk. Non-skilled activities are separated by barriers/ areas from the lessons and lift passes to reduce the risk. Our slopes are kept separate to also allow for beginners to be on a smaller slope and away from those who are of a higher level or ability. The risk of slips trips or falls within the snowbox is high due to the nature of the extreme sports being partaken on a slippery surface. All participants on snow activities will will be given their footwear (ski/snowboard or snowplay boots) as well as any equipment needed.

All lessons that have been booked will have a qualified instructor for the discipline booked.

Helmets and gloves are compulsory for everyone taking part in a lesson, non-skilled activity or on a recreational lift pass.

All lessons are taken by BASI (or equivalent) qualified instructors.

All guests in a group on lift passes will be asked to provide details of shoe sizes, height and weight in advance to The Snow Centre to allow skis/ DIN settings to be set up. This speeds up the process for when you arrive on site and keeps skiers safe. They will be made aware of our recreational standard prior to purchasing lift passes.

Our recreational lift pass standard is you must be able to control their speed and direction, link turns and stop when necessary, use a button lift competently without assistance.
