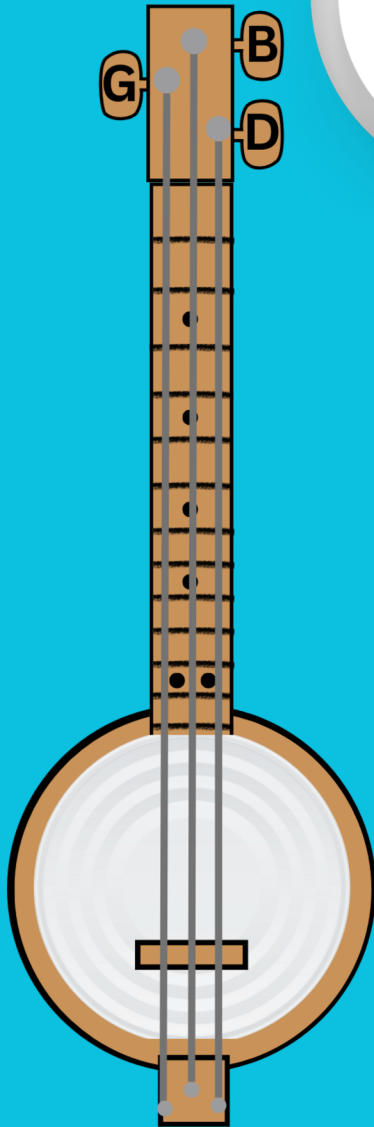

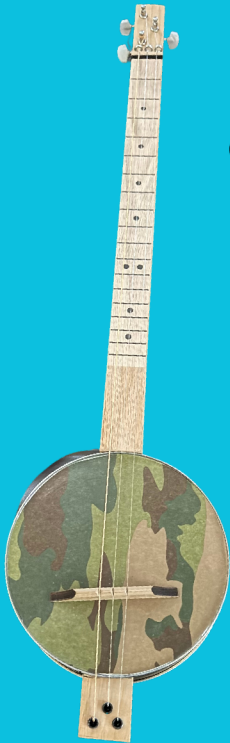

Slides and Barres

Play the guitar in a traditional position or in a horizontal position like a steel guitar.
in either position, barring across all 3 strings creates a chord.



Slides can be made from metal, glass, wood, or bone. Slides that fit onto the finger.



This type of slide is made to work with a horizontal positioned slide guitar.

**A tuner is a must have item.
Clip on tuners work well.
Tuner apps are also available
for smartphones.**

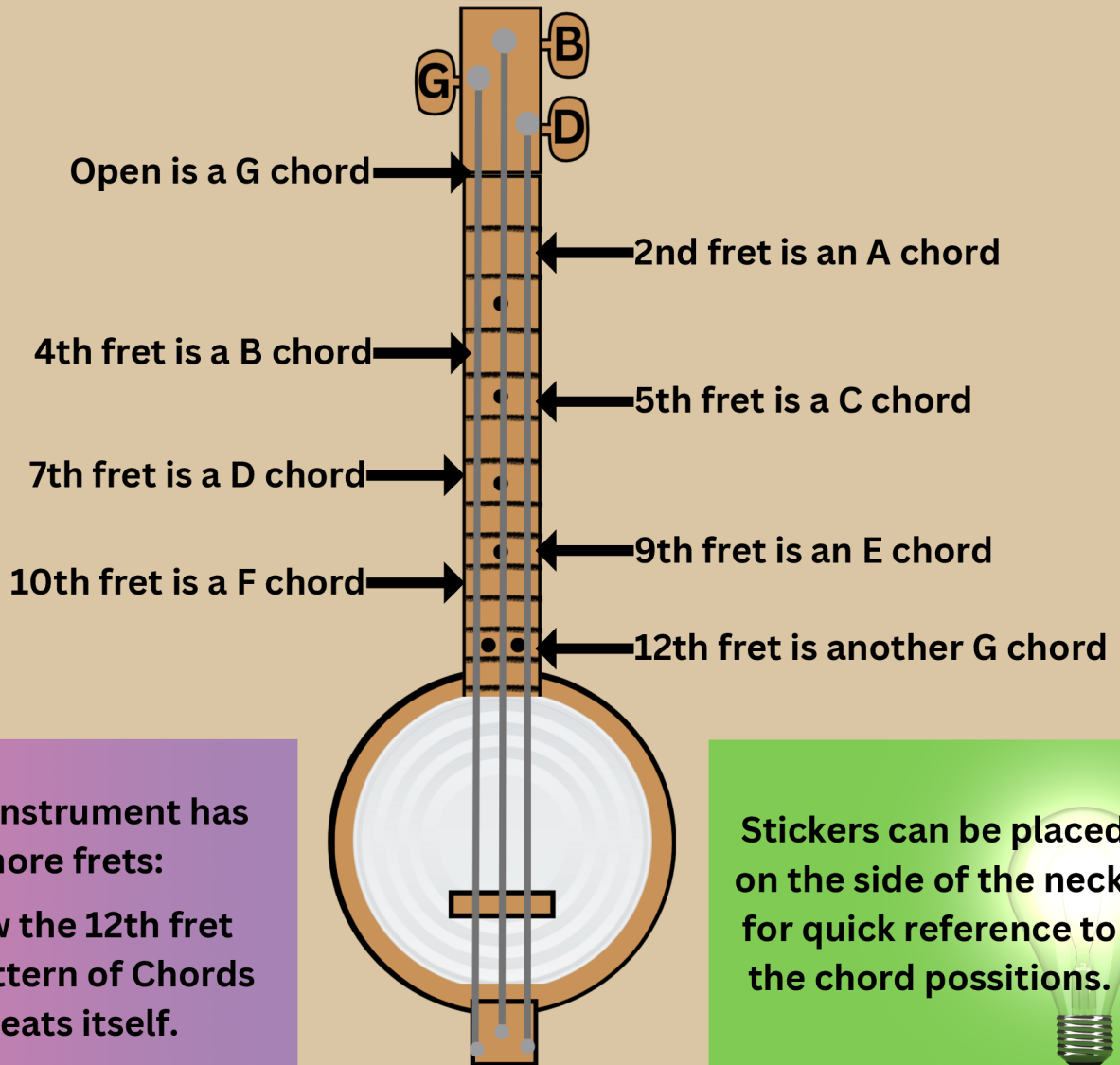
**Many different guitar picks are

Slide Map

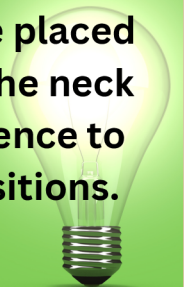
G B D Major Triad

Open Tunings



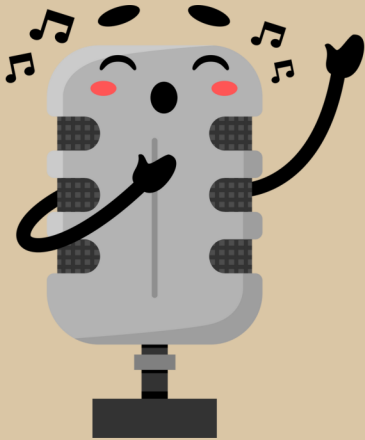
If the instrument has

repeats itself.

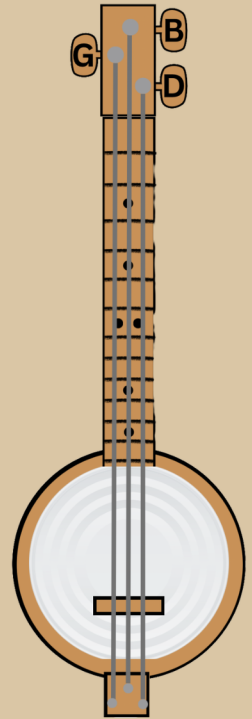
Stickers can be placed

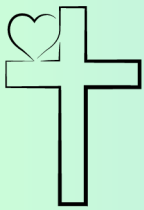
