# **TUITION POLICY**

Tuition is due on the 1st of each month. A \$25 late fee will be added after the 10th. No exceptions. Tuition can be paid via our website at: Tuition Info/Pay (academyofdancejax.com)

As a reminder, AOD does not send out monthly tuition statements. It is each family's responsibility to pay tuition on time. If you make quarterly payments, IT IS YOUR RESPOSIBILTY TO KNOW WHEN YOUR QUARTERLY PAYMENT IS DUE. We send out a tuition reminder email before the 10th of the month and a tuition due notice is posted on the studio lobby desk. **AOD ONLY SENDS STATEMENTS OUT IF THERE IS A PAST OR OUTSTANDING BLANCE.** Please see the studio policies on our website or stop in the lobby of you have any questions.

# **ILLNESS POLICY**

Many of our families noticed how hard hit the studio was the past few months with illness. We had the flu spread quickly through many of our classes. It is imperative that our families adhere to our illness policy, especially as we move into January. Our classes hit the ground running with end of year recital choreography and our Dance and Thespian teams start their competition season. We want to keep our teachers and students healthu, so class absences are kept to a minimum.

# As a reminder, here is our illness policy

Dancers should not be in class if they are exhibiting ANY TYPE OF SYMPTOM at all. If your dancer has a fever within 24 hours of class, vomiting, diarrhea, cough, malaise, sore throat, etc. PLEASE KEEP THEM HOME. Our teachers will catch them up if they miss anything and we will work with you to find a make-up class. If you have any questions at all about whether your dancer should be in class, please call us.

Ticket Sales: Date and Time TBA SOON! We will send out a detailed email later this Spring. Please do not worry if you cannot make the sale date. There is not a bad seat in the house at Thrasher Hornel

Recital Fee: This is a per family recital fee due at the time of ticket purchase. We will announce that fee at the same time as the ticket sale.

It is imperative that student absences are kept to a minimum through the end of the year. This allows teachers ample time to set choreography and clean it before the Spring Show.

Not all classes will perform in the Spring Show. A list of classes performing in the Spring Show is posted in the lobby. Students in multiple levels of any style, will perform with their highest-level class for the show.

Costumes are being ordered now. Families will be billed costume balances due.

- If you have not paid any costume deposits, you will be billed the full amount.
   If you paid costume deposits, you will be billed the remaining balances due as long as your account is current.
   Costumes will not go home with the student until all balances are paid in full. This includes tuition or other fees due to the studio.
- If you have questions about your costume balance due, please email us or stop by the front desk to request a statement and we will be happy to go over it with you.

Recital costume deposits are a credit that sits in your account Once costumes are ordered you will be billed for the full amount and a statement with your remaining balance will be sent out. It is important to know that your account must remain current to maintain this credit. This means tuition being paid on time each month, no late fees, payments made timely for other items ordered for your student by the studio, other deposits or payments due (i.e. team fees, competition fees, etc.). Any outstanding balances due or past due are paid using any credit on your account.

- Once costumes are sent home, please do not let your student wear the costume(s) until it is time for dress rehearsal. This prevents damage and lost accessories.
- We strongly encourage you to have a dedicated costume bag to hold all costumes and their accessories together and reduce the risk of damage and lost pieces.
- Now is the time to start making a list of items needed for recital. Your student's teacher will let each class know what tupe/color of tights and shoes are needed for the recital dance as well as how hair will be worn.

#### STUDIO REMINDERS FOR STUDENTS & PARENTS

- Parents-PLEASE SPEAK TO YOUR CHILDREN ABOUT
  PARKING LOT SAFETY. Many of our younger students are
  forgetting to watch for cars when leaving class and running out
  into the parking lot There are frequently cars traveling in the
  parking lot at high rates of speed. We want our students safe.
  Please be mindful of your speed as well when pulling up to the
  studio.
- We are having an increasing issue with students eating in the studio lobby and leaving trash behind. ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD should be eaten or thrown away in the studio lobby or bathroom.
   Students, please leave the studio clean when you leave. Thank you for your cooperation.
- Many of our students are of age where personal hygiene is important and a must for the comfort of everyone in the studio. Please ensure dancers bring with them in their dance bags, whatever items they need to freshen up before or between classes. Personal body sprays or spray deodorants should be sprayed OUTSIDE, not in the studio lobby.
- Please adhere to dress code policies for each class. This includes clothing, shoes and hair.
- Students should be respectful while waiting in the lobby for class. If they need to have conversations, they can step outside or keep conversations to a respectful level so as not to disrupt teaching going on.
- As a reminder, students should arrive to class on time, dressed in the appropriate attire for that class and with hair neatly secured off of their face. ABSOLUTLEY NO dance shoes should be worn in the parking lot coming and going from class.
- Please remember to pick up your dancer on time. Especially if your dancer is in the last class of the evening. A late fee will be billed for the last class of the night if your dancer is not picked up on time.
- Please remind your dancers to wait in the lobby if their ride is not there at the end of class. This is especially important for our younger students.
