# **November Program:**

# Race and Racism on the Death Penalty

Professor James D. Unnever will share with us his research that explores the role that race and racism has on support for the death penalty in the United States and cross-culturally.

# <u>About Our Speaker – James D. Unne</u>ver

James D. Unnever is a Senior Research Fellow, University of Cincinnati, Center for Communities & Justice and a retired Professor of Criminology from the University of South Florida. He received his doctorate in sociology from Duke University (1980). He has over 60 peer reviewed articles and has books including A multiple Theory of African American published Offending Race, Racism, and Crime (2011). Most of his research has focused on how race and racism influence the likelihood of African American offending and how they are related to crime control policies such as support for the death penalty. He has been hired by the Hague International Court, the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), and has testified for the defense in a death penalty case. His testimony focused on whether death qualified juries are systemically racially biased. He was the recipient of the Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences' Donal A. J. MacNamara Award.
