Eliminating Violence Against Women

The International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women is observed on November 25th annually. Globally, **1 in 3 women** have experienced physical or sexual violence, often within intimate relationships. "I conducted an online survey using PREP to recruit undergraduate psychology students with varying levels of decreased **sound tolerance (DST)** to investigate whether DST severity relates to social competence development. DST is a sensory processing condition where individuals experience extreme emotional distress from trigger sounds, often bodily noises (e.g., chewing, drinking) but potentially any sound (e.g., fan humming). Due to the distress, individuals with DST often show avoidance behaviors, which we predicted may impact social competence. We also aimed to use cluster analysis to identify unique social competence profiles, expecting that DST severity would vary across profiles, with the lowest social competence scores linked to the highest DST severity."

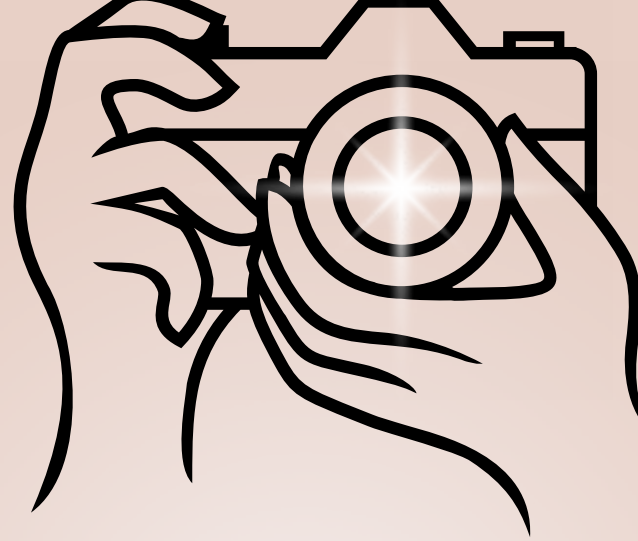

Remembrance Day marks the end of World War I hostilities. It is a day to commemorate and remember those who have served and protected our nation and continue to do so.

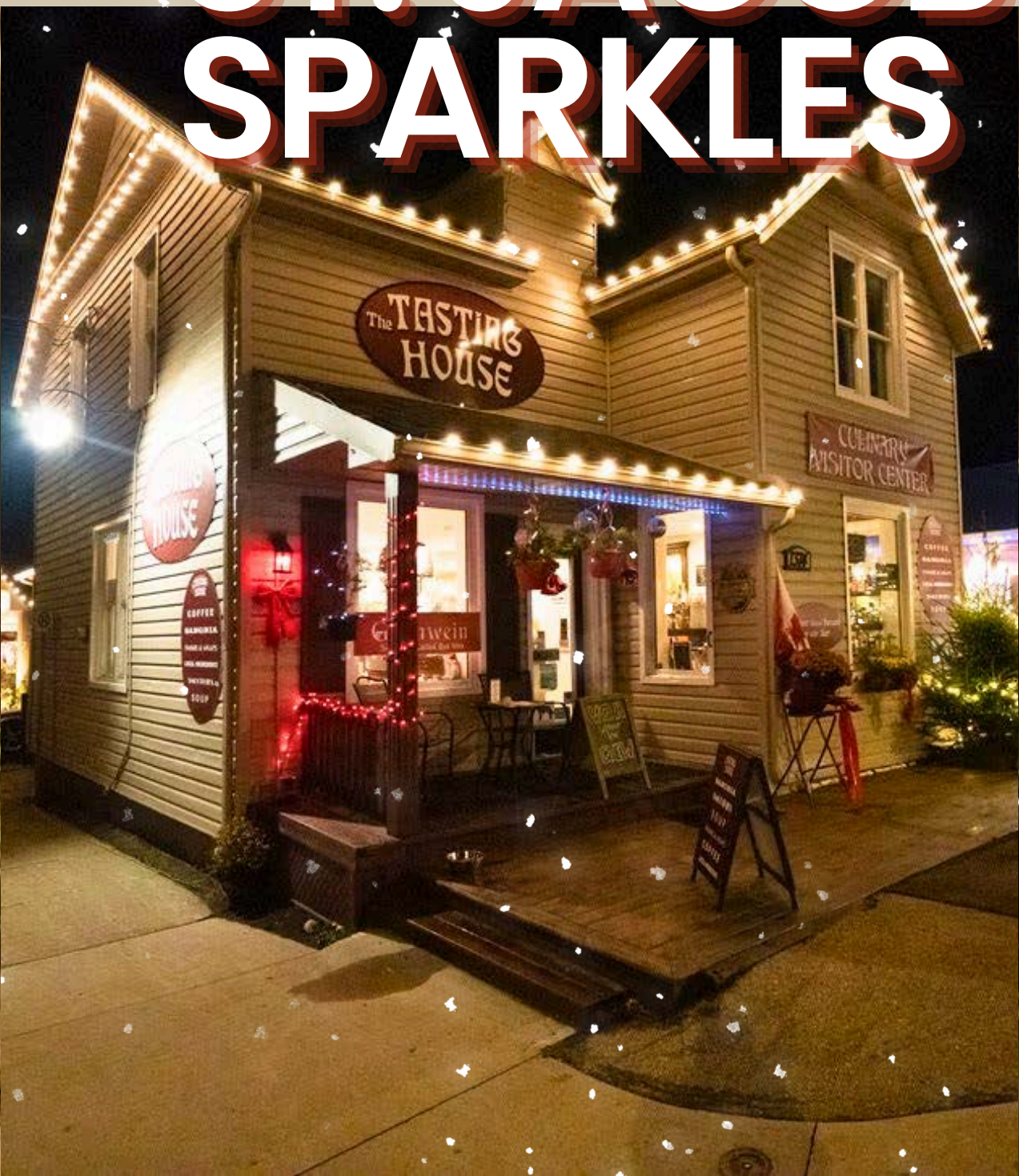
THE RED POPPY
