POOL RULES

GENERAL RULES

- 1- All association Rules & Regulations must be followed while at the pool facility in addition to the Rules and Regulations contained in this article.
- 2- Open swimming in the pool facility is limited to the hours of 8:00 AM and 10:00 PM. Daily, between the hours of 6:00 and 8:00 AM the pool is designated for lap swimming only.
- 3- Facility gates are to remain closed at all times.
- 4- All swimmers should shower prior to entering the water.
- 5- No person(s) having skin lesions, sores, inflamed eyes, mouth, nose or ear discharges, or who is a carrier of any communicable disease, shall use the pool.
- 6- Urinating, blowing the nose or depositing foreign matter in the water is prohibited.
- 7- No running, pushing, horseplay or mischievous behavior is allowed within the pool enclosure. Dunking, swearing, spitting, etc., are prohibited.
- 8- No cut-offs or clothing other than normal swimming attire is allowed to be worn while in the pool.
- 9- Incontinent persons must wear waterproof rubber pants with diapers at all times when in the pool. Children who are not toilet trained must wear diapers with rubber pants.
- 10- No glass containers are allowed in the pool enclosure.
- 11- Any person violating these Rules and Regulations who is asked to leave the pool enclosure by a member of the Board of Directors or their authorized representative, must do so immediately.
- 12- Any person who is found to be in violation of these Rules and Regulations are subject to fining by the Board of Directors or loss of pool privileges.
- 13- Conduct in the pool enclosure must not jeopardize the safety of self or others.
- 14- Abusive or foul language is prohibited.
- 15- No animals are allowed in the pool enclosure.
- 16- Running, excessive splashing and boisterous conduct are prohibited.
- 17- For safety reasons all persons must leave the pool enclosure when there is a threat of an electrical storm.
- 18- No bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or roller blades are allowed in the pool enclosure.
- 19- Playing with the pool equipment is prohibited.
- 20- Climbing or swinging on the walls, fences or gates is prohibited.
- 21- Dispose of cigarette butts in appropriate containers.
- 22- A fee of \$10.00 is charged for key replacement.

23- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool enclosure.

24- The pool facility may not be reserved for the exclusive use of any homeowner.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

1- An adult must accompany children under the age of fourteen (14) while in the pool enclosure.

DIVING

1- Diving is not permitted.

FLOTATION DEVICES

1- Flotation devices are not permitted in the pool unless the person using the device is under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian.

Direct supervision is defined as being in the water and within arms-length of the person using the flotation device.
