## GENERAL INFORMATION

DENALI-EA™ is designed to improve the efficiency of agricultural chemicals by acidifying and buffering the spray solution to an acidic pH, increasing spreading action and promoting more uniform coverage.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DENALI-EA should be the first ingredient added to the spray tank for acidifying and buffering. Add DENALI-EA last if the primary purpose is spreading.

**ACIDIFYING AGENT:** Use 1/4-2 pints per 100 gallons of water. For best results add to water first.

**INSECTICIDES, MITICIDES:** Use 1/4-1 pint per 100 gallons of spray solution.

**HERBICIDES, DEFOLIANTS:** Use 1-4 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution.

**FUNGICIDES:** Use 1/4-1 pint per 100 gallons of spray solution.

**AQUATIC:** For applications to control surface pests, algae and noxious weeds, use DENALI-EA at a rate of 1-4 pints per 100 gallons spray solution. Follow the rates and application recommendations shown for nonionic surfactants on the pesticide label.

## USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not use DENALI-EA with copper fungicides.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in original container only and keep tightly sealed. Store in closed storage area.
