## EO Jagjeet Judge unwilling to implement Vidhan Sabha directives on lodging FIRs against law violators

ducts monthly clinical trials to test genuineness of the undertrial test of the product. Last year , a total of 120 manufactured drugs in HP had failed the CD SCO test.

**EDITORIAL -**

**Avoid world wars through fast globalisation, privatisation**

Every other day the briskly changes in the international business trends are seen taking place. The potential success in the trade of EV's has perceptibly taken Elon Musk's navigation on to China turf. Elon Musk has confirmed his meeting with Chinese Premier Li Qi, on Sunday with a post on social media platform X: "Honoured to meet with Premier Li Qiang. We have known each other now for many years since early Shanghai days," Musk posted, with a picture with the premier. Investment, production entry into a market of crores of consumers, helped by 'duty-concession' import and sale of vehicles seems undoubtedly intriguing for the high-profile tech billionaire. Elon Musk's delayed 'Mission Delhi' holds promise because foreign direct investment, quality production for industrial development are always welcome for India. Yet, there are questions regarding on how strong a wicket he is in his home turf to be ready for his India venture? Musk wrote on X (formerly Twitter) that he was looking forward to coming to India later this year. The New Delhi trip would have been very interesting, considering that India is in the middle of parliamentary elections. ELECTRIC carmaker Tesla's boss Elon Musk put off his visit to India at the eleventh hour due to 'very heavy obligations'. He was expected to be in the country on April 21-22 and scheduled to meet Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The high-tech Tesla electric vehicle (EV) has done well since its entry into the world market. But today, strong

headwinds have already made the Tesla drive extremely tricky. First, hasn't the cheaper Chinese EV (notwithstanding its dubious quality) eclipsed Musk's automobile? Secondly, with the EV demand witnessing a slump in the West, which is Musk's own backyard, can Tesla's downswing this year — after the boom in 2022 and 2023 — be stalled? Virtually overnight, Musk laid off 14,000 staff members, constituting 10 per cent of the global automobile workforce of 140,000, through a laconic message. Even more shocking was the appeal of Musk to seek 'the judge-voided' 2018 pay. He provoked his critics further, justifying the en masse sacking "to prepare the firm for the next phase of growth" "an unfathomable sum" that is unfair to shareholders. That certainly resulted in the tech adventurer losing goodwill even among his shareholding peers. Musk is the epitome of US capitalism and laissez-faire, and the maker of landmark tech companies of the 21st century, unlike the defence and aviation corporations, the offshoots of 20th-century World Wars. With the onset of globalisation and privatisation to create wealth and avoid wars of total destruction by entangling all major economies, the world did change radically. An individual with such 'nuclear-powered' monetary muscle can any day, any time, any place make or break institutions of any Third World nation if he chooses to do so from a remote location and finds his business interests being incompatible with any investment or industry-seeking Global South

capital. Thus, in his own country, Musk has openly spoken against regulators and instantly shifted the site of incorporation of his rocket company SpaceX to Texas and brain-chip start-up Neuralink to Nevada, both from Delaware. The message is loud and clear: any profit-making Western company whose owner's net worth is over \$150 billion, will regard state-made laws as 'irritants' as the world over, multi-billionaires don't like taking 'no' for an answer for 'development and expansion' of their business and profit. Indian history shows how the dogged English traders hung around successive emperors to ultimately have their way on initiating lucrative trade to build the 'Empire of the East' and later of the world. Even today, one sees several Western samples of 'hostile takeover' of small fish by the big ones. In Musk's words: "It's become complex and inefficient." Interestingly, the self-declared 'free speech absolutist' not too long ago had complained that India's EV car import duty was the "highest in the world". Today, that highest rate of 100 per cent is down to 15 per cent. Musk must be missing India now. Returning to the Indian market, the Tesla EV's price is far from competitive. It starts from \$39,000 (around Rs 35 lakh) apiece. In India, any car priced more than Rs 20 lakh has a 5 per cent market. Obviously, Tesla is being overrun by Beijing's \$10,000 BYD (Build Your Dreams) EV. Secondly, the environmental impact of EV battery production and disposal appears to be enormously damaging.

**Punjab to see single-phase polling on June 1**

**Commissioner News Service CHANDIGARH :** With the Election Commission announcing seven-phase Lok Sabha poll schedule today, elections on 13 parliamentary seats in the state will be held on June 1. The General Election will commence on April 19 and the votes will be counted on June 4. As of March 1, the state has 2,12,71,245 voters out of which 1,19,29,959 are men, 1,07,75,543 women and as many as 744 are transgender voters. The state has a total of 24,433 polling stations. The state has nine general constituencies, including Gurdaspur, Amritsar, Khadoor Sahib, Anandpur Sahib, Ludhiana, Ferozpur, Bathinda, Sangrur and Patiala. The four reserved seats (SC) include Jalandhar, Hoshiarpur, Fatehgarh Sahib and Faridkot. In the 2019 Lok Sabha poll, the Congress



recorded victory on eight seats, SAD and the BJP won two seats each and AAP one. So far, only AAP has announced eight candidates—Ministers Gurmeet Singh Meet Hayer (Sangrur), Dr Balbir Singh (Patiala), Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal (Amritsar), Laljit Singh Bhullar (Khadoor Sahib) and Gurmeet Singh Khuddian (Bathinda). The three others include Sushil Rinku (Jalandhar), Karamjit Anmol (Faridkot) and Gurpreet Singh GP (Fatehgarh Sahib). Meanwhile, three prominent Congress leaders—Rinku, GP and Chabbawal—have switched their loyalty

towards AAP. There's a buzz of more leaving shortly incase their "political aspirations were not respected by the party high command". So far, SAD and the BJP have neither released list of their candidates nor have they announced an alliance. During the year-long farm stir in 2020-21, the Akali Dal had pulled out of the pact with the BJP. In February, Home Minister Amit Shah had mentioned about the talks between the two parties. However, the issues related to farmers and 'Bandi Singhs' have kept the tie-up lingering.

**Dry days announced by DEO from May 23 to May 25**

**Rs 43.11 lakh bamboozled from 70-year-old Panchkula man**

**PANCHKULA :** Inder Mohan Sharma, a 70-year-old resident of Sector 12-A was hoodwinked of Rs 43.11 lakh in cyber fraud. In a complaint to the police, who retired as a director of a private Delhi-based company, stated that he had received a WhatsApp message asking him if he wanted to earn money online. The man clicked on the link and followed the given advice. He was given easy tasks of clicking on YouTube links and subscribing to channels upon which he was paid Rs 50 to Rs 100. The complainant was then directed to make a profile on Telegram, a messenger, where another user used to give tips on lucrative investment. He was told that he could earn 30 to 40% profit on his investments.



Sharma said he started investing money and paid Rs 34.28 lakh in 13 different transactions from one of his bank accounts. He further invested Rs 8.83 lakh in eight different transactions from another bank account. The complainant stated that by the time he realised that he had been scammed, he had paid Rs 43.11 lakh to the fraudsters.

A case under Sections 120-B (criminal conspiracy), 419 (cheating by personation) and 420 (cheating and dishonestly inducing delivery of property) of the IPC has been registered at the cyber crime police station. An investigation has been initiated into it.

**PM Modi to address a rally in mid-May**

**CHANDIGARH :** Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi will be addressing a rally at the Sector 34 ground in the middle of May for the third consecutive time in the Lok Sabha elections. Preparations in this regard are already underway as his team from the Centre inspected the Sector 34 ground two days ago and held talks with those concerned, said sources. City BJP president Jatinder Pal Malhotra confirmed that the PM would address a rally here, but the date was yet to be finalised. "The Modi factor will definitely have an impact here. Notably, Chandigarh has always voted for the party that has ruled at the Centre," said a BJP leader. Even in the 2019 Lok Sabha polls, it was felt in the local political circles that Modi's rally had turned the tide in favour of the party candidate MP Kirron Kher at the time when Congress candidate Pawan Kumar Bansal was going strong during the campaigning in Chandigarh.



The sources said as per tentative plans, Modi could be in the city between May 16 and 18. Significantly, Modi's May 14, 2019, election pitch was more for "Phir ek baar, Modi sarkar", rather than the party candidate. During his nearly 40-minute-long address, he had not mentioned Kher's name even once. Modi had not even asked people to vote for the BJP candidate. All he said was, "Your vote on Kamal will go to Modi's account." In the last Lok Sabha elections, sitting MP Kirron Kher had retained the Chandigarh seat by garnering 2,30,967 votes. While Bansal got 1,84,218 votes, AAP candidate Harmohan Dhawan, who passed away recently, polled only 13,781 votes. In the 2014 elections, Kher had secured 1,91,362 votes, while Bansal and AAP's Gul Panag had got 1,21,720 and 1,08,362 votes, respectively.

**Gas protective suits, splash, chemical procured for firefighters by Chandigarh MC**

**CHANDIGARH :** In the first instance the emergency response department of the civic body has procured innovative equipments to safeguard the life of fire personnel. The Municipal Corporation Chandigarh has procured 28 pyrolyne/splash tight suits and 14 chemical/gas tight suits to protect its firefighters from various biochemical threats. The estimated cost for the procurement of these personal protective gear is approximately Rs 51 lakh. The MC has already added 7 Bullet Motor Cycles and 14 Water Mist and CAF High Pressure using special AFFF for



firefighting in narrow lanes, recently. The MC has also purchased inflatable emergency lighting tower. The inflatable emergency lighting tower was used at the time of major disasters like building collapse, fire incident and in rescue operations during night hours. 5 thermal imaging detector have also been purchased for detection in smoke and smog areas having low visibility.

In order to strengthen the department, the MC has appointed 245 firemen and 35 drivers through regular recruitment in 2022. Further, a Fire Safety Audit of all Commercial/Govt establishments of the city has been done and about 6,000 buildings have been issued fire advisories to meet the left out requirements at the earliest. "To create awareness and also to improve fire response among citizens, regular mock drills in hospitals, schools, industries and with RWAs, MWAs etc are being conducted on a regular basis," said an official.

**Varun Chaudhry sitting MLA fielded from Ambala**

**Time period extended for upgradation of Chandigarh railway station until May 31**

**CHANDIGARH :** Initially set for April 10, 2024, the project's timeline has been revised to May 31. The railway officers from the headquarters and Ambala division took stock of works being carried out under the Amrit Bharat Stations scheme. Local railway station's transformative upgrade, designed as a prototype for future stations, has encountered an extension in its completion deadline. The station is being upgraded with innovative modular designs and prefabricated components. The contract has been awarded to M/s Ahluwalia Contracts (India) Limited at a cost of Rs 462 crore. Buildings (G+3) of sizes 60m x 42m each are planned on both sides of the station. The ground floor features essential services such as



ticket counters, book stalls, a souvenir shop, a retail shop, railway offices and an executive lounge. The second floor will house enquiry counters, a food court, retail shops, a cloak room and a paid waiting lounge. The third floor will have an exclusive food court. An air-concourse (72m x 80m) will connect the second floors of the two buildings. The platforms will be accessible through lifts, escalators and stairs from the concourse. Two foot overbridges (each

12 m wide) are strategically positioned on the Kalka and Ambala ends of the station. These will be used by arriving passengers and will also be connected with the station building. A through roof, measuring 180m x 80m, covering the entire area of air-concourse and both the foot overbridges is an important feature. The present parking area on both sides of the station are being developed and is being increased from the existing 13,720 sq m to 24,515 sq m.

**Telangana CM summoned  
Revanth Reddy by Delhi Police**

**NEW DELHI/HYDERABAD** : Delhi Police has summoned Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy on May 1 for questioning in a case of a doctored video of Union Home Minister Amit Shah circulated on social media and police in some BJP-ruled states also swung into action in the matter, with one person being arrested in Assam. Notices have been issued to five members of the Telangana Congress, including its chief Reddy, who posted the video on X, sources said, adding that a team of Delhi Police's Special Cell handed over a notice to the Chief Minister's Office on Monday. They have been asked to appear with their mobile phones, laptops, tablets or any other electronic device through which they have created, uploaded and tweeted the video on their X accounts, the sources said. Addressing a Congress rally at Sedam in Karnataka, Reddy said "no one here is afraid" of such notices and alleged that Prime Minister Narendra Modi is now using Delhi Police to win elections. On Monday, the BJP also lodged a complaint with the

Relations Officer Pranabjyoti Goswami said in a statement that a case was registered at Panbazar police station based on a complaint regarding the circulation of a "distorted and motivated" post on X about Shah. The Special Cell of the Delhi Police had on Sunday registered an FIR after the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C), which is under the Ministry of Home Affairs, filed a complaint about the doctored video of Shah where his statements indicating a commitment to abolish quota for Muslims on religious ground in Telangana were changed to make it seem that he was advocating scrapping of all reservations. The Delhi Police filed the FIR under sections 153 (causing provocation with intention to cause riot), 153A (promoting enmity between different groups on grounds of religion, race, place of birth, residence, language, etc), 465 (forgery), 469 (forgery to harm the reputation of any party), and 171G (publishing false statement with intent to affect the result of an election) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and under the Information Technology Act, the police said.

**75% marks or equivalent grades would enable one to directly enrol for PhD: University Grants Commission**

**NEW DELHI** : In order to pursue a PhD with or without a Junior Research Fellowship (JRF), the candidates will require a minimum of 75 per cent marks or equivalent grades in their four-year undergraduate course. So far, a candidate for the National Eligibility Test (NET) needed a master's degree with a minimum of 55 per cent marks. Students with four-year undergraduate degrees can now directly appear for NET and pursue PhD, according to University Grants Commission (UGC) Chairman Jagadesh Kumar. The exam this year will be conducted in the offline mode instead of a computer-based test. Tests for all subjects will be conducted on June 16. "The candidates with four-year undergraduate degrees

can now directly pursue PhD and appear for NET. Such candidates are allowed to appear (for tests) in a subject in which they want to pursue a PhD irrespective of the discipline in which they have obtained the four-year bachelor's degree," Kumar said. A relaxation of 5 per cent marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC, ST, OBC (non-creamy layer), differently abled, economically weaker sections and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time, he said. The UGC-NET is an exam to determine the eligibility of Indian nationals for the "award of Junior Research Fellowship and appointment as assistant professor" "appointment as assistant professor and admission to PhD" and "admission to PhD only" in Indian universities and colleges.


**New journey into future will certainly commence from June 2024 : Modi**
