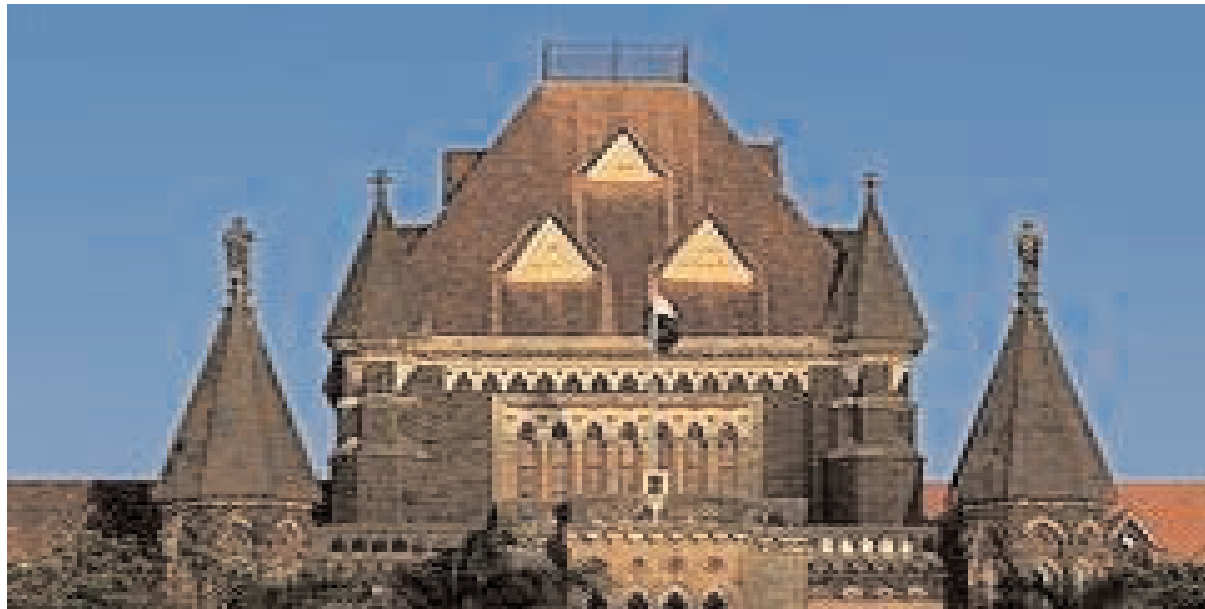

Builders have no right over regularization of illegal structure: HC

Mumbai : Let the builders be not allowed to think that getting regularization of buildings are their birth right. No fundamental right exists for getting the building regularized if norms are not adapted. A stay on the demolition of a commercial shop was lifted away by Bombay High Court in the compound of a housing society in Jawahar Nagar Goregaon (West).

It seems in the usual nature, regularization has almost become fictitiously fundamental right which contravenes the frame work of law. Every person now a day seems to be believing that planning/raising land has become irrelevant and any body, he or she can raise entirely unauthorized construction and there after can seek regularization of the structure, is a matter of just fundamental right, commented

high court to quash BMC's (Nov 2021) demolition order . In an interim relief pending bearing in Dec 2021, the High Court stayed the planned demolition. During January 2023, Mr. Vallabha Krupa told shop was constructed in the passage toward the building entrance since the structure was then in a rickety condition BMC (Bombay Municipal Corporation) had demolished the tottering structure.

Since the shop was left as an hinderance to the redevelopment and assertion of Prakash Aswani are without prolific consequence in law's sight. The bench said under Municipal norms either a structure is authorized or non authorized. It is pointless to accept the structure existed for a long time prior to specific datum line of 1962 and come unto his possession only in June 1995.

Under money laundering act, no proven money reached Manish Sisodia : SC

New Delhi :The bail proceedings of Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader and former Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia in the cases registered by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and the Directorate of Enforcement (ED) over the alleged Delhi liquor policy scam are. In marathon session, spanning usually four and a half hours The Supreme Court put forth a barrage of questions towards the investigative agencies. This unfolded during the hearing presided over by a bench comprising Justices Sanjiv Khanna and SVN Bhatti. The bench was considering two petitions filed by Sisodia, challenging the decisions of the Delhi High Court, which had previously denied him bail in connection with the investigations being conducted by the CBI and the ED. Setting the stage for this extensive inquiry directed towards Additional Solicitor General SV Raju, who was appearing for the ED and CBI, Justice Khanna commented, "Normally, in a bail matter, we don't take so long." Seeking clarification regarding the nature of submissions of the investigative agencies, Justice Khanna asked if the Delhi government's Excise Policy for 2021-22



was under challenge. To this, ASG SV Raju submitted that the agencies were not challenging the policy decision. Justice Khanna then asked But you say that policy decision was motivated for personal benefits. So will it not mean that you're challenging the policy decision?"The ASG responded in a negative and reiterated that the submission forwarded by the agencies was that the policy in question was framed in a manner which benefitted certain wholesalers and Sisodia had a role to play in the same. He added that the policy was framed as a "facade" to replace the old excise policy which was not favoured by the Delhi government. In order to change the same, a report was

sought from the Ravi Dhawan expert committee. However, when the said report came out as unfavourable, causing Sisodia to be unhappy with the same, objections and suggestions were invited against it. The old policy was not what they wanted. To change the policy they got Dhawan committee report but it wasn't what they wanted. So then they invited objections and suggestions. In those objections we see the role of the petitioner."ASG Raju, furthering his submissions, stated that the public opinion of stakeholders was concealed and manipulated to frame the new excise policy. In this context, he stated that various parties were asked to draft emails raising objections against the Ravi Dhawan report. He added that these emails were copied from a handwritten note which was handed over by Sisodia to Zakir Khan "with the direction to get multiple emails on the said lines sent to the dedicated email address". These emails on issues such as allotment of retail licences through auction of zones, reduction of excise and VAT, as well as enhancement of licence fee, and increase in the number of liquor vends were eventually sent to manipulate public opinion, as per the ASG.

He deplored that the charges against India

over the killing of terrorist Hardeep Singh Nijjar lacked adequate evidence, and he described it an "unfortunate" development. Mr. Aghi said, "An important issue [of Nijjar's killing, its allegations were brought without any solid evidence into the Parliament of Canada]. It is unfortunate that the Prime Minister of a country goes into a Parliament and makes allegations and not being able to come out with evidence to show that these allegations are credible.

NLFT, ATTF ban continues by WAPA

The central government said ATTF and NLFT have a professed aim of establishing an independent nation with the secessions of Tripura from India through armed struggle, in alliance organisation in the state, and to incite the in digenous people of the state for such objective.

Both NLFT and ATTF are already designated as 'terrorist organizations' under UAPA, which lists 42 terrorist outfits operating across different theatres. While a ban under the anti-terror law remains in force inti-terror law remains in force in defi-



nately unless revoked, an organization may be declared an 'unlawful association' for a definite period, usually five years. The 'unlawful' tag automatically expires unless its validity is extended through a fresh notification. 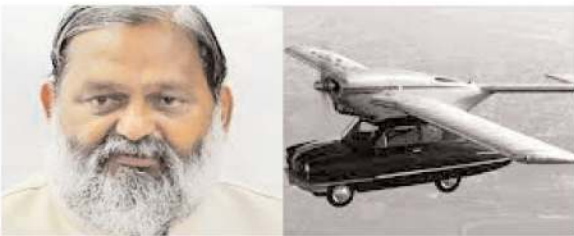
Gender empowerment through amended act

The Women Reservation Act is riddled with complexities, not the least being its linkage to the delimitation exercise, whose fate itself is unknown. The coupling of the Act with delimitation raises the question — when can women expect to get the political representation they have been seeking for decades? The Constitution (108th Amendment) Bill, 2008 — popularly known as the Women’s Reservation Bill or the Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam, as christened by the Narendra Modi government to emphasise the underlying message of gender empowerment — sailed through both Houses in the just-concluded special session of Parliament. While seeking to set aside one-third of all seats for women in the Lok Sabha and legislative Assemblies. The other issue is the demand for a separate sub-quota for women from the Other Backward Classes (OBCs) and minorities, both of which were raised mutedly, the latter more so in the pervading socio-political milieu. The Bill set aside the statutorily mandated quota for SC and ST women from the overall 33 per cent. The call for an OBC sub-quota had scuppered attempts to pass the Bill in the past. It was a hangover of the Mandal era, which ushered in a new phase of OBC empowerment — or re-empowerment of the economically empowered — in the Hindi heartland. The southern states, pushed by social reformers and

political radicals such as Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar and D Devaraj Urs in Karnataka, Narayana Guru in Kerala and EV Ramasamy Naicker (Periyar) and CN Annadurai in Tamil Nadu — accepted the sub-quota demand as an inevitability, but joined their colleagues from the north as and when it figured in Parliament. The leading lights of post-Mandal politics, championed the ‘cause’ of the OBC sub-quota for women. The Congress distanced itself since its then president Sonia Gandhi resolutely pushed for the Bill’s passage in its existing form, but the BJP was in a pickle and conflicted over its stand. In principle, BJP leaders stressed that they wanted the Bill, but in reality, the bloc of powerful OBC leaders it nurtured to catch up with the Mandalised socialists was second to none in supporting the sub-quota demand. Those were the days when the writ of the BJP’s top brass didn’t necessarily prevail over its rank and file. Uma Bharti, backed by the male OBCs in her party, led the clamour for an OBC sub-quota, Lalu Prasad Yadav, Mulayam Singh Yadav and Sharad Yadav. Remarkably, when the Bill was finally passed, the sub-quota bugbear was submerged in the all-party enthusiasm over its passage and the celebrations which ensued once it was done. The Mandalites, especially those from the Samajwadi Party and the Rashtriya Janata Dal, were muted in their response. The only note of dissent was struck by the All India Majlis-e-

Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM), but nobody associated with its two MPs who voted against the Bill. The polemical battle between Hindutva and Mandal — Mandal-Kamandal, as it was termed — which dominated the north’s political landscape in the 1990s looks settled in favour of Hindutva. Many believed that caste identity would trump religious polarisation, but faith has taken precedence, at least in the present phase. The Congress doubled down on the demand for an OBC sub-quota after a long and uneasy relationship with the OBCs and Mandal. It appeared as though the party hoped that its carefully nurtured social equation of Brahmins-Muslims-Dalits in the heartland would endure even when politics entered a new chapter. As the BJP expediently shoved the sub-quota issue to a later date, will the celebrated Bill impact women voters in the impending state elections as well as the 2024 battle? The Congress and the BJP have worked hard to cultivate a gender vote bank through targeted programmes in the states they rule. However, the atrocities against women and the manifest failure of the administration and the police to nail the criminals often detracted from the cutting-edge benefits of publicised schemes such as MP’s Ladli Laxmi and Ladli Behana Yojana, Rajasthan’s Udan scheme, Swavalamban Yojana and Mahila Nidhi and Chhattisgarh’s Saraswati Bicycle Scheme and Godhan Nyay Yojana.

Flying car unit in Ambala to be established : Vij to firm

For construction of MBBS center, PGI finance panel to take place on October 27

CHANDIGARH : The PGIMER had proposed setting up of a state-of-the-art medical college with intake of 100 students for MBBS course at its Sarangpur centre. The proposal envisioned a college campus along with an attached hospital fully equipped for quality education, research and patient care. A meeting of the standing finance committee of the PGIMER will take place on October 27. Items on the agenda include construction of a centre at Sarangpur for MBBS course and implementation of Hospital Information System-2 (HIS-2). Among the important items on the agenda is the proposal for hiring 50 phlebotomists to be



deployed across various departments at the PGIMER on outsourcing basis. The panel will deliberate on the proposal to increase the stipend paid to BSc (Nursing) students during their six-month internship period. In accordance with the Government of India guidelines, the stipend for these students may see a substantial increase from Rs 500 per month to Rs 13,150 per month. Another significant agenda item is the proposal for the additional requirement of

17 laboratory attendants on outsourcing basis, along with the ex post facto sanction for 18 laboratory attendants who have already been hired. A significant workforce-related issue to be addressed is the regularisation of 124 relief-cum-housekeeping workers and 25 supervisors on a post facto basis. These workers are part of the 969-strong outsourced workforce deployed through a service provider at the institute.

Helpline for stubble management launched by District Administration

MOHALI : The farmers and panchayats of about 10 surrounding villages on hazards of fire firms were cautioned by Deputy Commissioner (DC) Aashika Jain. In a bid to nudge farmers to shun the practice of stubble burning, the district administration reached out to the growers in Tewar village. She enlightened them about the availability of machinery for stubble management on a subsidy of 80 per cent (for cooperative societies) and 50 per cent (for individual



farmers), respectively. She noted that hundreds of societies, panchayats and farmers have been given sanction for machinery to manage crop residue. Some of the machines are balers, rakes and surface seeders. Moreover, a dedicated helpline has been launched for making

machinery for crop residue management available to the tillers. The farmers can reach out for help on the numbers (0 1 7 2 - 2 2 1 9 5 0 5 , 2219506). The administration has also arranged balers from other areas where the harvesting season was delayed.

Now, 20% quota for SCs in Group A & B promotions

CHANDIGARH : Reservation in promotion to employees belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC) in all cadres of Group A and Group B posts has been decided by the Haryana government. Earlier, the quota was limited to Group C and D positions. A detailed instruction, issued by Chief Secretary Sanjeev Kaushal, states that under the new policy, the state government will reserve 20 per cent of the sanctioned posts for promotional quota for SC employees. The reservation will be admissible to all Group A and Group B posts, except for the highest promotional post in a cadre. However, the inter-se seniority as per the applicable service rules will be taken into account for the highest promotional post. The benefit will be admissible only when two or more promotional posts are available. The reservation will be implemented cadre-wise, taking into account the total number of promotional posts sanctioned. The Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) or competent authority for Group A or Group B promotions will determine the adequacy of the current



representation of SC employees on promotional posts. If the representation is below 20 per cent, the deficiency will be addressed when a promotional quota post becomes available. All SC employees on Group A or Group B posts filled through promotion will be considered for representation regardless of the mode of appointment. However, non-SC employees, who have already been promoted to Group A or Group B posts, will not be reverted to fulfill the 20 per cent reservation, but the deficiency will be addressed when promotional quota posts become available. The SC employees will not be deprived of promotion even if the 20 per cent reservation limit has been met or will be met upon their promotion based on seniority and merit. The roster points for direct recruitment of SC candidates, as per government instructions,

will apply. The instructions for Group C and D employees for the application of roster points or replacement theory will also be strictly followed. If an eligible SC employee is not available for promotion as per the roster, an eligible employee from another category may be promoted. The SC employee will be adjusted against a supernumerary post when they become eligible. The reservation in promotion will not affect seniority in the promotional post. Also, the reservation in promotion will not be considered for granting ACP Pay Level where percentage-based criteria exist in a cadre. Since the Jamail Singh batch of cases is pending in the Supreme Court, all promotion orders issued in line with these instructions will be subject to any further orders passed by the court in these cases. This instruction will take effect immediately and is applicable to all departments, boards, corporations, universities, and statutory bodies under the Haryana Government, says the government spokesperson.

In pursuit of greater process the Delhi High Court on Monday announced that it will start today live streaming of proceedings in the court presided by its Chief Justice. A communication issued by the high court said that the streaming link will be available on its official website and for now, live streaming will be done



on a case-to-case basis. "For now, the live streaming of court proceedings will be conducted on case to case basis, as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court," it added. Court no. 1 of the high court generally deals with public interest litigations. The live streaming of court proceedings will soon also start in high court's court no. 39 where another division bench conducts its proceedings, the note said. The communication clarified that the live

streamed content is for information purpose only and shall not constitute the official record of the court proceedings. It also said that no person/entity, including print and electronic media, and social media platforms, other than those authorised, shall record, share and/or disseminate the content. In January, the high court had notified the rules for live streaming and recording of proceedings.

4 more NDPS fast-track courts to be setup by Haryana Govt

CHANDIGARH : The NDPS courts will expedite the resolution of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act cases, according to an official statement, Haryana Chief Secretary Sanjeev Kaushal said. The Haryana government has recently initiated the setting up of four additional NDPS fast-track courts, in addition to the six already notified and one already operational, a senior bureaucrat said on Monday. He said that the Haryana State Narcotics Control Bureau has been compiling a comprehensive database of drug traffickers in every village in the state. After attending the sixth apex committee meeting of the Narco Coordination Centre, or NCCORD, through a video link, Kaushal said that the state government has established an advisory board to strengthen the ecosystem for combating drug abuse. The meeting was held under the chairmanship of the Union Home Secretary. Kaushal said the government has been taking measures to upgrade the Haryana Forensic Sciences Laboratory. He said steps have been taken to enhance forensic capabilities to meet emerging challenges. These measures include the upgrade of the Forensic Sciences Laboratory in



Haryana, and the establishment of NDPS divisions at the four Regional Forensic Labs in Rohtak, Gurugram, Hisar, and Panchkula. Three of these RFLs already have functional NDPS divisions, and the fourth division will be operational at the newly sanctioned station in Panchkula, he said. According to the statement, the Haryana State Narcotics Control Bureau has prepared and circulated a detailed SOP regarding financial investigations involving drug crimes. The Bureau has also prepared a database of property seized and forfeited under the provisions of the NDPS Act, starting from 2000, for monitoring and analysis. Kaushal said the government has also set up an 'Inter-state Drug Secretariat' for coordination among Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, Delhi, and Chandigarh. The Haryana State Narcotics Control Bureau has developed its own software, HAWK, for profiling drug traffickers and people accused of crimes under the NDPS Act in Haryana.

Tel Aviv flights cancelled by Air India until October 14

NEW DELHI : Air India will extend all possible support to passengers who have confirmed bookings on any flight during this period, the spokesperson added. The Airlines said it has cancelled its flights to and from Tel Aviv till Oct 14. Israel came under attack by Hamas militants on Saturday and since then, both sides are engaged in fighting in which scores of people have died. "Our flights to and from Tel Aviv will remain suspended till 14th October, 2023, for the safety of our passengers and crew," an airline spokesperson said in a statement. The full-service carrier operates five weekly flights to Tel Aviv from the



National Capital. The service is on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. On Saturday also, the carrier cancelled its flights to and from Tel Aviv. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, on Saturday, expressed solidarity with Israel after Hamas militants launched an attack on the country. Modi condemned it as "terrorist attacks" in Israel as its leader Benjamin Netanyahu said the country is at war.

15% illegal colonies found eligible for regularisation

FARIDABAD : The announcement regarding the regularisation of 30 unauthorised colonies located outside the Municipal Corporation limits of Faridabad is likely to benefit less than 15 per cent, as the total number of such colonies identified in the official survey is over 200, according to sources. The parameters taken into consideration for the regularisation include the total area of the colony, width of internal and main approach road, available vacant land and the density of population, according to officials of the department concerned. The list announced by the state government includes as many as 12 colonies of Ballabgarh subdivision and 9 each in the revenue area of Faridabad and Badkhal subdivisions. These are spread on around 320 acres. While a detailed survey carried out had found around 210 such colonies situated outside the MC limits, the office of the



DTP (Enforcement) found only 76 fulfilling the parameters, of which the authorities cleared the names of 30. However, sources claim that the number of colonies selected or meeting the criteria has been only about 15 per cent of the total number of such colonies in the district. The number of colonies recommended for regularisation within the MC limits has been 59 so far against a total of 105 recommended by the DTP office, according to sources. The number of colonies in the MC limits not fulfilling the conditions is over 150, it is reported. Though a total of about 553 colonies had been

detected in the initial survey, the number was scaled down to 418, considering the conditions attached. Though a notification has been issued, the officials on the other hand have no clue about the agency which will carry out development works as these are located outside the jurisdiction of the Municipal Corporation. Faridabad (MCF), said a senior official on the condition of anonymity. He said the basic infrastructural development work in the 59 colonies announced to be regularised about two months ago was yet to take off. Majority of the unauthorised colonies are located in the adjoining areas of about 62 villages falling in the civic limits. Rajender Sharma, DTP (Enforcement) said that as the list of a total of 89 colonies stands approved for regularisation, various departments, including the MCF, will be able to get the development works initiated as per the policy of the state government.

browbeat journalists" A joint statement by INDIA partners said the government was trying to convert the media into a "mouthpiece for its partisan and ideological interests "by facilitating the takeover of media organisation by "crony capitalists". "Both the government and its ideologically aligned organisation have resorted to reprisals against individual journalists who spoke truth to power. Furthermore, the

BJP government has also spearheaded regressive policies like the I T Rules 2021 that constrict the media from reporting objectively BJP is not only hiding its sins of omission and commission from the people of India, it is also compromising India's global standing as a mature democracy, " the INDIA partners said. While Congress said the early morning raids on journalists came as a "fresh distraction from the explosive findings of caste census in Bihar and the growing demand for caste census across the country." AAP said BJP was "scared" of journalists. TMC's Mahua Moltra mocked the government, saying, "New India takes the press seriously".

In this light, the press bodies said . "It is imperative that the judiciary confronts power with a fundamental truth that there is a Constitution to which we are all answerable." As journalists and news professionals, we are always ready and willing to cooperate with any bona fide investigation. However, ad

hoc, sweeping seizures and interrogations surely in any democratic country, let alone one that has begun advertising itself as the 'mother of democracy.' "the letter said. Original QR codes made use of, on fake documents : DC

MOHALI : In the No Objection Certificate (NOC) scam, the preliminary investigations conducted by deputy commissioner Aashika Jain has found Quick Response (QR) Code used on the fake documents, when scanned , directs to the official portal of the Punjab Government, pointing at the suspected involvement of officials of revenue department . The QR code is only generated by the Punjab government through its IT department and primafacie, a deep- rooted conspiracy having alleged involvement of the government officials is being suspected . Said Aashika Jain, District Magistrate got a couple of fake NOC's and scanned the QR code worked properly and was diverted to the official portal, but the document was fake. This draws suspicion on how the original QR code was fixed on the document when the NOC was found to be fake, she said. DC Aashika Jain said, "Directions issued to all sub

registrars and Tehsildars to ensure in built safeguards while registering documents a with NOC, FCR office has issued instructions from time to time for verification of NOC's issued by development authorities as well as urban local bodies, CROs were directed to exercise extra caution in the wake of recent reports, "Recently the Mohali police have registered FIR against unknown persons for issuing fake No Objection Certificates (NOC's) for registration of property . The FIR has been registered following the complaint of Derabassi MC Executive Officer (EO).

Tendering process for new waste mgmt plant

Chandigarh: In a high level technical committee meeting chaired by Dharam Pal UT adviser, the queries raised during the pre-bid meeting were taken up and decided upon. Representatives of the National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (NEERI) also participated in the meeting . It was decided to go ahead with the tendering process after incorporating agreed upon changes. More than 90 queries were raised in the pre-bid meeting held in July Eight companies had participated . In August , the high - level technical committee took up the quries, but the NEERI couldn't participate in it. "Representatives of



NEERI submitted their view on the technical aspects of the queries and the tender document . Resolution of around 50 queries are to be included," said an official. "By Monday the MC is expected to issue the corrigendum in the tender stating the altered conditions. The tendering process is likely to take another month or so, It involves opening of

technical and financial bids," said the official. The MC has already started the process of getting the green clearance for the brown field project. In a step toward getting the requisite environmental clearances for plant NEERI has approached the ministry of environment for its nod for the project. Earlier, the MC had written to NEERI for initiating the process of getting the requisite environmental clearance for the setting up the plant. IIT, Roper, was asked to prepare a detailed project report for upgrading the existing plant. Later, NEERI was taken as consultant.

Near Airport demolition stayed by SC

Mohali: The division bench comprising Justice A S Bopanna and Justice M M Sundresh , while granting permission for the SLP and issuing notices to the respondents, also ordered that neither the existing construction will be demolished nor shall the petitioners put up any further construction, will be demolished nor shall the meantime, status quo, existing as on today, would continue . The recent orders of the Supreme Court to stay demolition of structures falling within in the 100- meter radius of the Chandigarh airport boundary were based on two grounds - (The) Works of Defence Act , 1903, which is already under challenge at the apex court and the defence's failure to implement the notification within stipulated time -frame.

A Supreme Court division bench while allowing the specific leave petition (SLP) filed by Pabhat residents seeking stay on the demolition of the structures near the defence installation ,



accepted the ground taken by the petitioners that the apex court's decision regarding the validity of (The) Works of Defence Act, 1903 (Act No.7 of 1903) - as to whether the said enactment can be sustained or has to be declared unconstitutional being inconsistent with Part III of the Constitution of India- is still pending and the defence failed to implement the notification within stipulated time frame.

Advocate Ankit Grewal , counsel for the petitioners, had challenged the order of the Punjab and Haryana high court denying a stay on the demolition of the

structures. Following the orders of the high court, a panel led by the Punjab chief secretary was formed to look into the legality of the structures . A comprehensive report was submitted to him, which had recommended that structures raised after 2010 were illegal and must be compensated as per the law before being razed. In February 2007, it was published in the gazette that "restriction was imposed on construction up to 100 meters from the outer parapet, and up to 900 meters from bomb dump of the IAF station, Chandigarh.

Assembly session amid SYL row on Oct 20, 21

CHANDIGARH : Supreme Court on October 4 had asked the Centre to survey the portion of land in Punjab which was allocated for the construction of part of the SYL canal and make an estimate of the extent of construction carried out there. The Punjab government has called a two-day session of the state assembly on October 20 and 21, amid a political row over a Supreme Court directive on the Sutlej Yamuna Link canal. The decision comes days after the state Cabinet had said that there was no question of building the SYL canal in Punjab as the state has no water to spare for Haryana.

“Under second proviso to Rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Punjab Vidhan Sabha (Legislative Assembly), the speaker has been pleased to call the Punjab Vidhan Sabha, which was adjourned sine die on 20th June, 2023 to meet at 11 am on Friday, 20th October, 2023 in the Punjab Vidhan Sabha,” said a notice of the Punjab Vidhan Sabha secretariat.

Officials argue that the October 20-21 session will be an extension of the fourth session -- the budget session in March -- of the assembly, and there is no need to take an approval of the governor to call a sitting of the assembly.

Communist shielded News Click, declined to reveal their China link -- Kavita Krishnan
