Zrk sewerage struggles with poor capacity 17.3 mld STP, against demand of 100 million litre daily

Civic body ignores misuse of official sewerlines, Pvt STPs are lying shut

Zirakpur : The town facing slum facade is undergoing lethargic or no development as the internal roads, overflowing sewerage system speak volumes.

The town finds itself on crossroads, since the ongoing construction process of innovative STP at Sanouli village had to be stalled due to the court case filed by the scrupulous persons.

The incapacious, small treatment plant has been experiencing bottlenecks in handling the treatment operations and owing to unbearable, excessive load, enroute itself sewage spill out, over to



upper ground level. Such type of bursting of sewer pipes often metamorphoses the landscape into hellish environs where no human can even stand and breathe, said Suresh Pal, a ret'd Engineer. The sewer work can't be undertaken and sustained unless there is availability of appropriate, sufficient land, till then choked,

overflowing lines would continue disrupting the smooth sewerage system, bemoaned Dinesh Kumar Jr Engineer of the Water and Sewerage Board, Zirakpur.

Severe impact of overloaded sewer lines is being experienced by the legal as well illegal habitations/ colonies which are made ultimately sub-



ject to pay undue charges of property taxes also by the municipal authorities. Surreptitiously, carved out lines, at times crawl to shoulder sewage load and burst out, over to colonial territories. Other merciful plight of the developing town has erupted, where all plans of raising Sewerage Treatment Plant have

crumbled as till this stage no appropriate land has been made available for the expected facility. Already having sewerage lines overflows, burden is seen choking the official lines due to unjustified load in the official lines, say several residents on the VIP road. Over 99% builders are reportedly annexing their



pipelines with the government laid down sewerage system. On the condition of anonymity one builder disclosed that it was not easy to convert sewage material into manure which certainly helps farmers to find their crops very greeny and nutritious. The process needs plenty of

manpower and certain chemicals to create oxidation. The solution of overloading sewerage pipes is to remove the illegal sewerage connection or build other sewerage plants for most populous town by providing facilities of 100 MLD (Million Litre Per day), adds

Dinesh Kumar. Before this abandoned site efforts were once made at Gajipur there also dispute arose and no head could ever be made. Excessive load on sewer lines must be removed due to illegal interception by the builders. The stinking of the area in habitation was really a scourge for all of us as the people might get succumbed to various diseases. On speaking to EO Ashok Pathriya, he said the municipal team has undertaken a digital survey to record the sites of water flooding which will be channelised into seasonal choes.

Rahul tarnishing India's image in United States--BJP

NEW DELHI :The Rahul's remarks, part of a discussion at University of Texas, elicited a strong reaction from BJP which called the leader of opposition in Lok Sabha a "black spot" on Indian democracy "who sullies the image of India on foreign soil".

Speaking to students in the US, Rahul, asked about the employment problem, said the US used to be the production hub till the 1960s after which jobs moved to Korea, Japan and China, and China today dominated global production.

Yo on to India, you look at the phones, you look at the furniture, you look at the clothes... you will see 'Made in China', that's a fact," he said, adding that America, Europe and India had given



up on the idea of production that creates jobs and had handed it to China.

Rahul Gandhi said Bangladesh too had wiped India clean in textile production. Rahul warned that continued slide in production would create massive social problems and "polarisation of our politics is because of this".

Giving his ideas about increasing the labour partici-

pation of women, Rahul said, "Also, this is part of the ideological fight between BJP and us. BJP and RSS believe that women should be restricted to a particular role. They should stay at home, they should cook food, they should not talk too much, and we believe that women should be allowed to aspire to whatever they want to do."

Jaishankar to address United Nations whereas Modi would address Nassau Veterans in New York

New Delhi: Modi will be in New York on Sept 22 at the 16,000-seater Nassau Veterans Memorial Coliseum in Long Island. He will also address UN's land-mark 'Summit of the Future' that is being convened at the global body's headquarters on Sept 22 and 23. The PM is also expected to have several bilateral meetings at the UN including one possibly with Bangladesh chief advisor Muhammad Yunus, who has sought a meeting with Prime Minister Modi.

US Biden, however, was keen on having the summit in Delaware. Biden represented Delaware in the Senate for 36 years



before becoming President. This will be the last Quad summit for both Biden and Kishida as they prepare to demit office. India had also considered having the summit on the margins of the G7 summit in Italy this year but Australia wasn't invited for the meeting. Indian govt had first proposed hosting the summit on the margins of the Republic Day celebrations in January but changed.

Rajnath Asks Pakistan To Stop Terrorism in J&K

Ramban (J&K) : Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said Article 370 of the Constitution that granted special status to J-K was revoked to end the misery of the people and make the region prosperous. Rajnath Singh on Sunday said India is ready to start dialogue with Pakistan if it stops terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir.

Addressing a rally in poll bound Jammu and Kashmir's Ramban district, he said that India remains ready to start dialogue with Pakistan if it stops sponsoring terror in the Valley. Pakistan should do one thing that is stop taking the



support of terrorism. Who would not like to improve relations with neighbouring countries? Because I know the reality that you can change a friend but not your neighbour. We want improved relations with Pakistan but first of all they should stop terrorism," Singh told a well-attended gathering here.

Emergency film cleared subject to cut, fast check

New Delhi: The cuts in emergency film included removal or modification of visuals depicting Pakistani soldiers attacking Bangladeshi refugees, scenes involving infants and women casualties. The committee also sought replacement of an expletive and change in a family's surname mentioned in the film.

Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC) has granted 'U/A' certificate to Kargana Ranaut's film, 'Emergency' but asked it for three specific cuts and verification of certain historical claims. The claims included quotes attributed to former US President Richard Nixon and former British PM Winston Churchill, which were dis-



paraging towards Indian women and population growth, respectively. A 'U/A' rating means the film is appropriate for all ages with parental guidance. Manikarnika Films Pvt Ltd submitted the film for certification on July 8 and on Aug 8, CBFC communicated 10 changes for 'U/A' certification.

Now, no NOC for plot registration upto 500 sq/yds

Chandigarh : The state govt in Punjab passed the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulations (Amendment) Bill 2024 on Wednesday to waive the NOC conditions for plot registration, who purchased their plots before 31 July, 2024.

To check the mushrooming of such illegal colonies, the amendment stipulates higher fine and punishment against the offenders of the law. As a deterrent to illegal colonies in future, the amendment hikes the amount of fine from Rs 25 lakh to Rs 5 crore, besides imprisonment of a minimum of five years.

Winding up the discussion on the bill, chief minister



Bhagwant Mann said, "NOC is the keyword for the bill. That is how people will understand it. There are families which realised that the colony developed by a political leader or under his patronage, where they bought a plot with their life savings, was illegal. They could not get sewerage or power connections for their

house." Mann said unscrupulous colonisers asked plot owners to pressurise politicians to get the colonies regularised ahead of elections. He said the state had regularised illegal colonies thrice in the past under previous govts. He said: "Each time, there was a rider: 'It won't happen again.'"

Kiran Kher allowed to work as non official member of STA

Chandigarh : The State Transport Authority (STA) is the supreme authority to regulate the transport sector in the city. In the latest deviation from the old precedents of incumbents continuing as non official member of STA, ex parliamentarian Ms Kher has been picked up against the conventional occupancy of the chair. The order reads, "Kiron Kher, ex member of parlia-



ment (lok sabha) UT Chandigarh is allowed to continue as non official member of the State

Transport Authority, UT, Chandigarh. The administration has not come to terms, with the new twisted reality. Literally, opposition MP afront is being treated as adversary, said a congress activist.

A notification regarding composition of STA has been done as per rules with approval of the competent authority, said Viney Partap Singh Secretary, UT Transport.

2 IPS officers (Retd) to continue serving, yet as troubleshooters

Bathinda: Jaskaran Singh, 1998 batch IPS officer, retired on April 30, while 2008 batch, IPS officer Narinder Bhargav retired on June 30, would extend their service in the capacity of trouble shooters.

Before his superannuation, Jaskaran Singh was posted as ADGP, intelligence, while Bhargav as DIG, vigilance bureau. Both belonged to Punjab Police Services and were promoted to IPS. When farmer organisation BKU (Ekta-Ugrahan), one of the biggest outfits in Punjab, and labourer organisation Punjab Khet Mazdoor Union announced to hold protests in Chandigarh, the state govt roped in Jaskaran

site in Sector 34. Jaskaran Singh and Bhargav were also seated near chief minister Bhagwant Mann when he met the farmers and labourers for over two hours on Thursday. Another retired police officer DSP Gurjit Singh Romana was also involved in the parleys.

AAP hikes power rate by Re 3 per unit in Punjab

Mohali : The petrol in Mohali will now cost Re 97.62/ litre in comparison to neighbouring state charging petrol rate in Pkula is Rs 95.83/ litre and 94.29/ litre in Chandigarh. "AAM party's exploitative conduct has been unmasked," said Kuljit Singh Bedi, Deputy Mayor Municipal Corporation, Mohali. The further hike by Rs 3 per unit for power bills upto 8 killo watt was another step in taking up anti -people measure, bemoaned Mr Bedi.

"We request the state government to take immediate action to address our concerns and bring VAT rates in



line with neighboring states. It will help arrest the decline in sales, prevent further loss of revenue, and protect the interests of petroleum dealers and the state government," said Mr Kuljit Bedi. The deputy mayor denounced the government's decision to hike VAT on diesel and petrol and steep rise in electricity tariffs by Rs 3 per unit for bills

Sportspersons may not make good politicians !!

Why Indian sports is entrenched in politics the first is the more obviously clamouring one. From cricket to boxing, via football, archery, swimming, gymnastics, equestrian, or table tennis, not only are the governing bodies of almost all sports in the country led by politicians or their cronies, but also used as a fiefdom in which to play political games.

To rise in this system, every athlete and their families know, one must be dogged, determined, resourceful, and able to keep the right people happy. Each of these are qualities essential for politics. As are the purely sporting virtues that determine athletic success-focus, discipline and rigour.

Virat Kohli once told me that when he was about 13, he had a moment of despair when he realised the level of politics and influence that drive team selection even at the junior level in Delhi cricket. He made a choice: "To be so good, that I can rise above that, that my skills become impossible to ignore." But that's the preserve of the top 1% of athletes in any sport-the best of the best. For the thousands of others, there's often a different incentives at play-govt jobs.

It looks like Vinesh Phogat, India's most decorated female wrestler, and Bajrang Punia, the 2020 Olympic medallist, will be contesting the Haryana assembly elections on a Congress ticket. It seems like the perfect fit. Phogat and

Punia, along with Sakshi Malik, India's only female wrestler with an Olympic medal, led the movement that resulted in the powerful BJP politician and former Wrestling Federation of India chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh being charged with sexual abuse and harassment. If anyone needed an intensive, hands-on crash course in politics, that movement was it.

The wrestlers took on a domineering political figure, tackled a sensitive topic where victims are often socially ostracised and humiliated (as they were here too) head-on, mobilised massive support, led public rallies, gave hundreds of stamina and toughness to endure a months-long sit-in protest, courted police action, and did not back down despite every hurdle that was thrown their way.

Indian sportspersons, in fact, have been training for politics all their life. If they are any good, Indian athletes enter a deeply politicised system by the time they are 10 or 12 year old, and spend the next couple of decades or so learning the ways of that system.

This is the second way in which Indian sports inculcate the political life in athletes, by dangling that highly coveted and extremely resource-scarce prize. It becomes the sole life goal of many athletes who comes far-flung villages or congested Tier II and III towns, often in a bid to escape or overcome their family history of poverty.

Do sportspersons make a good politicians then? Yes, though the current crop of athletes turned politicians presents a different picture. There is a reason for that - BJP, as it settled into becoming a political party with unchallenged power between 2014 and 2024, drew a lot of athletes in their fold simply for their popular appeal to distinct demographics and not because they showed any inclination for politics. Examples include PT Usha for nostalgia, Mary Kom for the Northeast, Saina Nehwal for instant, pan-India recognition and social media reach.

All of these athletes have middling to poor oratory skills, and none of them have any clear stand or passion for any issue or a problem that they have made their own.

On the other side of the politician divide, the boxer Vijender Singh, who won India's first boxing medal at the Olympics (bronze in 2008), was equally a damp squib for Congress.

Gautam Gambhir, the battling fractious batter who always presented his emotions unflinched on the field used his personality to good effect for BJP in Delhi-out spoken and happy to get into fights, and pushing for issues he actually cared for, the former India opener worried East Delhi in the 2019 general elections. Happily, he has found a job even better suited to his temperament this year-the coach of the Indian cricket team.

Vice Chiefs of 3 services fly together in Tejas fighter !!

Their joint participation in the exercise demonstrates the growing focus on cross-domain cooperation, with land, sea and air forces working together to face contemporary challenges, revealed the sources.

This landmark joint flight marking the first time when the three service Vice Chiefs have flown together as part of a single formation is a powerful testament to India's advancing integrated defence capabilities, commitment to self-reliance and showcases the seamless integration of the armed forces, an officer remarked.

The flight took place over Jodhpur, where the Indian Air force is conducting



Exercise Tarang Shakti - 2024, India's first multinational exercise aimed at enhancing interoperability and operational coordination among friendly foreign countries. This opportunity was also utilised by three Vice Chiefs for interacting with the participating crew both from India and abroad.

About 30 countries including India, with 150 aircraft, are participating in the IAF-led drill aimed at fostering closer ties that strengthen cooperation with a myriad of capacities. The inclusion of the Tejas in this mission underscores the critical role indigenous platforms are playing in modernising India's defence infrastructure.

Designed by the Aeronautical Design Agency (ADA) and developed and produced by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL), the Tejas is a state-of-the-art multi-role fighter, designed to meet the needs of India's armed forces while reducing reliance on foreign imports.

Road sinking, defunct Mohali bus stand, notice of motion served to Punjab Chief Secretary

MOHALI : A case in the public interest has been filed by the Deputy Mayor of Mohali Municipal Corporation, Kuljit Singh Bedi. Officials who have been issued the notice of motion include Chief Secretary, Punjab; Principal Secretary, Housing and Urban Development Department; Principal Secretary, Transport Department; Deputy Commissioner-cum-Chairman District Road Safety Committee, SAS Nagar, Mohali; and Chief Administrator, GMADA.

The High Court has issued a notice of motion to Punjab Chief Secretary and other officials for October 23, regarding a case in connection with the functioning of the Mohali bus stand and opening of the adjacent GMADA (Greater Mohali Area Development Authority) road. In a public interest petition, the court was requested to direct respondents to repair and



restore the closed 'one-way' of the main road adjacent to the Baba Banda Singh Bahadur Inter-State Bus Terminal, Mohali, and make the bus stand operational.

People have to face a lot of difficulties as the bus stand is lying non-functional. Besides, the closure of the 'one-way' road can pose risk to human lives because the part of this road occupied by the bus stand is sinking in. The road next to this bus stand has been closed since 2009, while this bus stand is also defunct since 2016.

Bedi claims to have written letters to the Deputy Commissioner, Chief Administrator of GMADA, and even the Chief Minister, but no action was taken.

Strength of stray cattle in Panchkula city to be surveyed by MC

PANCHKULA : The issue of conducting survey of stray cattle was discussed during a meeting of Panchkula development advisory committee.

The Municipal Corporation has been sending stray cows to shelters. These shelters have already exhausted their capacity and are not in position to accommodate more animals.

MC officials pointed out that they had till date sent 2,721 cows to different cow shelters in and around the city. He said, "But the cow shelters have now stopped accepting more animals citing shortage of space."

The local Municipal Corporation will now carry out a survey to count the number of stray cattle head in the city as well as those being kept at various cow shelters to take a decision regarding the setting up of new cattle pounds and



transportation of strays. Haryana Assembly Speaker Gian Chand Gupta said they should carry out a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters. He said, "Conduct a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters and those roaming around in the city. We will see if we have any space to keep the animals in the existing shelters else requisite land can be provided to interested NGOs to open and run cow shelters."

Officials present at the meeting also discussed the dog bite incidents and sought stringent action in this regard. They said the district had recorded

registration of as many as 5,699 dog bite cases at health institutions in merely six months this year. Gupta pointed out that the district administration had spent Rs 4 crore on the development of a pound at Sukhdarshanpur village for keeping stray dogs, but remained unsuccessful in its initiative.

MC Commissioner Sachin Gupta said, "The law provides provisions for sterilisation of dogs. The canines also have to be dropped back to the place from where they were picked for sterilisation."

‘Rahul Gandhi is now strategist’,

AAP-Cong alliance in hazy
weather against assembly
poll in Haryana: Sources

NEW DELHI : As the last date to file nominations for Haryana poll is September 12, no final decision has yet been taken on the alliance with the Congress for the October 5 Haryana Assembly polls, sources in AAP said on Sunday. “The talks are under way but there is no final decision yet,” said an AAP source. Earlier in the day, AAP Rajya Sabha MP Raghav Chadha said both Congress and his party are trying to forge an alliance for the Haryana elections by keeping aside their individual aspirations. Chadha said while the parties are yet to reach a consensus on the alliance,



the talks are progressing in a “positive” direction and they are hopeful of a good outcome. He, however, added that the AAP will not proceed with the alliance “if there is no win-win situation”. “The talks are happening in a positive atmosphere. Both parties are working towards contesting the elections together, prioritising unity and the demands of the people of Haryana, while setting aside individual party and candidate aspirations,”

“Ball by ball commentary cannot be done on the seat-sharing arrangement. Both the parties have desire and hope to form an alliance,” he added. According to sources, while the AAP is demanding 10 seats, the Congress is ready to give them only seven. However, Chadha refused to divulge any details about the seat-sharing talks held so far. “We will take a decision well before (September) 12, the last day of filing nomination. If there is no win-win situation, we will leave it. The talks are going on, good discussions are happening. I hope a good conclusion will come out of it,” he added.

India reports Mpox case,
no risk to people: Health
ministry

NEW DELHI : ‘The case of Mpox in a young male who tested positive for a strain from western Africa, has testified true’, confirmed the Union Health Ministry on Monday. The ministry said the patient remains clinically stable and is without any systemic illness or comorbidities. There is no indication of any widespread risk to the public at this time, the ministry said. The government said the testing had confirmed the presence of ‘clade 2’ of the virus, and that the particular strain is not a part of the current public health emergency, reported by World Health Organisation (WHO) which is regarding



clade 1 of Mpox. “The previously suspected case of Mpox (monkeypox) has been verified as a travel-related infection. Laboratory testing has confirmed the presence of Mpox virus of the West African clade 2 in the patient. This case is an isolated case, similar to the earlier 30 cases reported in India from July 2022 onwards, and is not a part of the current public health emergency (reported by

WHO) which is regarding clade 1 of Mpox,” the health ministry said in a statement. A ‘clade’ refers to a biological grouping that refers to all evolutionary descendants of a particular strain of virus. “The individual, a young male who recently travelled from a country experiencing ongoing Mpox transmission, is currently isolated at a designated tertiary care isolation facility. The case aligns with earlier risk assessments and continues to be managed according to established protocols.” The ministry said that contact tracing and monitoring are actively in place to ensure the situation is contained.
