Zirakpur: Persistently published time and again, the woeful story of the sewage overflow over to streets, roads in the town remains condemnable by the resident masses.

The spread of sewage contains harmful micro organisms and protozoa, which may cause serious illnesses like gastroenteritis.

The sewerage system must be neatly maintained by the municipal sanitation and sewer department. The contravention and breach of optimum sewer system may contaminate the treated water supply.



In case of accidental seepage, protective clothing would be required while cleaning the infectious pipeline by wearing rubber gloves, boots. All surfaces will have to be disinfected from hazardous contamination. Media reports can not be

presumed inadequate in apprising the electorate about the action or inaction, yet campaign against the stinking sewage be not ignored at any cost. The interior linking roads, streets are often seen spilling with solid sewage due to pipelines running



full beyond its capacity. Charges are made against the local Civic body for not taking appropriate action against the realtor defaulters in the most populous town transcending now figure of about 5 lakh in short span of gone by period. With small downpour, the

city roads, streets witness the storm water entering the network of sewerage pipelines and make the human breathing uneasy. The municipal authorities are aware of the over flowing the choked pipes with sewage, yet allegedly compromise with the colonial builders who are responsible



for the release of disproportionate volumes into the official pipelines, said an employee of the sewerage board. Of late, farmers of Satabgarh came out on the road, shouting against the sewage flowing all over in their fields. The hard labourad lcrops

were destroyed and the soil too went barren and unproductive due to the assault of stinking sewage. The farmers charged the colonisers against the release of sewerage water into their field which was unethical, and condemnable. The innocent guys should not be deprived

of their farming rights and be salvaged from the defendant discharge into their cultivable soil, agonised Kewal Singh who showed his farm wherefrom foul smell was emanating.

The realtor Harish Gupta of Trishla city said he was the only person who had taken legal sewer connection from the local body department, should not be held accountable for vitiating the purity of soil, many other realtors didn't claim the untouchability of the official sewer lines. Despite many efforts, EO Ashok Pathria could not be contacted as he deliberately didn't add the calls.

300 bank accounts of Khalistan proponents seized

Bhushan steel bank fraud leads to seizure of worth Rs 37 Cr assets

New Delhi : Bhushan Steel Limited and it's Managing Directo Neeraj Singal and associates had formed shell companies, rotated funds through a chain of multiple entities and purchased properties for personal gains., said an official of the Enforcement Directorate. Revelation disclosed that promoters, directors and officials of BSL prepared forged documents and made fraudulent representations before banks. Letter of credits to discount letter of credits and diverted the funds



back into their own companies with mala fide intentions, said an official of the ED. The ample funds were misappropriated against the fabricated LCs created in favour of JSW Steel Ltd and Hindustan Zinc Ltd. About Rs 367 Cr properties of Bhushan Steel Ltd located

in Delhi, Mumbai, Calcutta and Orissa were attached. The attached properties were held in the name of benamidars / shell entities through dummy directors in order to conceal the assets and to ensure that they are out of reach of investigation, said the agency.

Modi Govt Prepares to Pick Election Commissioners Amidst Controversy

New Delhi : The Union government has "informed" Congress leader Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury on Sunday that it will "very soon convene" a meeting of the selection committee to fill the vacancy created in the Election Commission of India by election commissioner Arun Goel's unplanned resignation, revealed, the sources.

The EC at present has only one member – chief election commissioner Rajiv Kumar. The commission is required to have three Election Commissioner. Chowdhury, the leader of the Congress opposition party in the Lok Sabha, is the only member of the selection committee. Its other members are the prime



minister and a second government minister. He has said he will attend the meeting when the date is announced.

The Act is under challenge in the Supreme Court for violating the apex court's ruling last year that ECI members be selected by a panel that is not dominated by the government – so as to ensure the ECI's independence.

Case lodged against 17 firms for not returning repaired transformers

Chandigarh : During the past regimes of two governments, power transformers to certain firms were handed over for urgent repairs. After the 122nd "audit

report it was pointed out that certain lapses had taken place as 635 transformers were not returned even after the due delivery date, as found that Rs 2.27 Cr were costing the repair said the audit report.

No record of 5 transformers was available. The power deptt had no online viable record of the transformers. The case was registered against 17 firms for falling to return the hefty machinery, said the Budh Ram Chairman audit report committee.

Jaipur : For the requisite inspection and recognition of medical seats, the National Medical Commission would launch its portal next week. The affiliated colleges would be required to submit the details of professors, infrastructures, college labs. On the basis of such reports will only enable the applicants to seek recognitions of the National Medical Commission. The colleges would be required to despatch the copies of videography of the



theory as well practical. On the basis of despatched details, the required assessment would be made and human interference would be assured the least, said an official of the National

Medical Commission.

For giving the practical exposure to student examinees, two departments simultaneously, at a time, would be able to appear, and one mentor would be placed over 5 student examinees, Small hospitals having (220 beds) too would be eligible to sustain functioning of medical colleges. The union government intends to open at least one medical college in every district. Hence, that state would get benefit where more districts are working.

EDITORIAL –

No mercenaries live elated life

The first Indian to be killed in combat in Russia was a Gujarati — Ashwinbhai Mangukiya of Surat. Gujaratis are perennial seekers and creators of wealth. Surat is known more for diamond merchants than people who die on the borders donning the uniform. Ashwinbhai could never have travelled in search of a glorious death in the battlefield. He was travelling for prosperity. All migrants would agree with Falstaff that discretion is the better part of valour. The stories of migration to the West are no different. Though they were not temporary people and that they could become citizens and even lawmakers and sit on the benches that once ruled India, the story of their industry, integrity and upward mobility is similar. Migration is one of the easiest and surest ways of uplifting oneself for any Indian — poor or middle class. Why, even scions of wealthy trading and business families set up shop abroad to multiply their riches! Ashwinbhai’s case is ample proof that Indian migrant labour is undoubtedly getting duped into fighting someone else’s war in Russia. All wars are dirty for sure, but someone else’s war becomes dirtier because there is no honour in dying the death of a mercenary. A s h w i n b h a i , Mohammed Afsan of Hyderabad later got killed. Then there were reports of five from Punjab and two from Haryana sending video requests seeking help at the Russia-Ukraine border. And only then did the CBI begin searching the premises of travel agents in seven cities on Thursday — D e l h i , Thiruvananthapuram, Mumbai, Ambala, Chandigarh, Madurai and Chennai; too little, too late. The youngsters from Gurdaspur, Hoshiarpur and Patiala in Punjab and Karnal in Haryana and elsewhere have been clearly tricked by agents who sold them the dream of crossing over to Europe through Russia. Some of them were even told the audacious lie about the requirement of visiting Russia to build a travel history that would help them later get a visa to the West. Such is the ignorance of these youths that they repeat the lies of their travel agents about going to Moscow in the dead of the Russian winter as tourists to celebrate the New Year, while their richer cousins go to Goa or the Maldives. The Indian authorities have to investigate the agents who traffic desperate youngsters out as ‘helpers’ for Russian combat units, and the Russian plan, if any, to entice and force them to fight against their will. Russian President Vladimir Putin is said to be a history buff who takes immense pride in the march of the Red Army into Berlin. He would obviously know the role of the Punjabis, the Sardars, the Jats, the Rajputs, the Gorkhas, the Thambis, the Mahrattas and other Indian units in winning the two World Wars for the British, though almost every Hollywood or British movie conveniently forgets to show the Brown Man. Whether they are ‘helpers’ for the Russian army fighting in Ukraine or poultry farm workers on the Israel-Lebanon border, the Union Government has a responsibility to stop foreign governments from recruiting Indians and pushing them into conflict zones. Time period extended for upgradation of Chandigarh railway station until May 31

CHANDIGARH : Initially set for April 10, 2024, the project’s timeline has been revised to May 31. The railway officers from the headquarters and Ambala division took stock of works being carried out under the Amrit Bharat Stations scheme. Local railway station’s t r a n s f o r m a t i v e upgrade, designed as a prototype for future stations, has encountered an extension in its completion deadline. The station is being upgraded with innovative modular designs and p r e f a b r i c a t e d components. The contract has been awarded to M/s Ahluwalia Contracts (India) Limited at a cost of Rs 462 crore. Buildings (G+3) of sizes 60m x 42m each are planned on both



sides of the station. The ground floor features essential services such as ticket counters, book stalls, a souvenir shop, a retail shop, railway offices and an executive lounge. The second floor will house enquiry counters, a food court, retail shops, a cloak room and a paid waiting lounge. The third floor will have an exclusive food court. An air-concourse (72m x 80m) will connect the second floors of the two buildings. The platforms will be accessible through lifts, escalators and stairs from the concourse. Two foot overbridges

Russian recruitment could be blamed on tricky travel agents and dodgy military contractors, but at least the Israeli recruitment was open and facilitated by the Government of India. The man from Kollam, Kerala, who got killed in Israel in a missile attack was earlier in the UAE and must have thought that he was merely travelling a little further west for a better pay. All this while, the Union Government shut its eyes to illegal migration because it was a private enterprise that benefited the risk-takers, but it’s no longer so. Now, it has turned into a transnational trafficking network feeding warlords. Indian migrant labourers are not and should not be allowed to become mercenaries. Let them build the topless towers of the world, not kill strangers for money. If there is a plan to recruit Indian youngsters to fight Russia’s war, it is inconceivably inhuman and terribly faulty. It is not just about the criminally inadequate 15-day training period, but also about the psyche of a migrant labourer who has been fooled into fighting for a group that has nothing in common with the wide-eyed Indian traveller. The Russians ought to have announced an inquiry. In the absence of an official Russian explanation, the onus of having to prove its innocence lies squarely with the Kremlin. Even if these recruits are being sent as ‘helpers’, it cannot be done without informing the South Block and taking an informed consent from the recruits. Indians cannot be forced to wear a foreign army’s uniform, and that is non-negotiable.

Shaheed Smarak project inspected by Anil Vij Home Minister

AMBALA : The Shaheed Smarak is being built to commemorate the sacrifice of the 1857 revolt heroes at Ambala Cantonment. Haryana Home Minister Anil Vij inspected the under-construction Shaheed Smarak. During the inspection, a presentation was given to the minister on the artwork that would be showcased in the museum. The minister said the museum would be an integral part of the Shaheed Smarak, and it should be developed in a manner that the visitors get all the information about the situations of the first revolt in Ambala and Haryana, among other parts of the country in 1857, adding that the visitors should feel and experience the atmosphere of the 1857 revolt. “A committee of historians was formed for the construction of the Shaheed Smarak, and the agency hired for the artwork should hold discussions with the

committee about the historical facts to be displayed at the museum” said Anil Vij. The officials of the PWD (B&R) and the agency informed the minister that screens, audio and various other forms of media would be used to showcase the history. Vij also inspected the construction work of the 150-foot-high memorial tower, entrance hall, parking area, water bodies, and other areas of the Smarak. He said the memorial would house a museum based on 1857 revolt heroes, a library, an audio-video museum, a food court, a children’s park, a cafeteria and an open-air auditorium, adding that the project was estimated to cost about Rs 500 crore. Ambala Cantonment SDM Satinder Siwach, PWD SE Navneet Nain, XEN Ritesh Aggarwal, and DSP Ashish Chaudhary, among others, were present during the inspection.

Soup served with dead cockroach in Shatabdi, IRCTC fined

CHANDIGARH : Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation Limited (IRCTC) and Northern Railway would pay a compensation of Rs 10,000 to a city resident for causing mental agony and harassment by serving soup with dead cockroach. The District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Chandigarh, has directed the railway authorities to implement the order. The commission also ordered payment of Rs 5,000 as cost of litigation to the complainant. In a complaint filed before the commission, Rahil Mahajan said he and his mother were travelling from New Delhi to Chandigarh in Shatabdi on September 3 last year. They were served hot soup and bread on board by catering staff of the OPs (Railway and IRCTC). After taking some soup, he noticed a dead cockroach in the bowl and immediately called the catering staff and informed them about it. Rahil also brought the fact to the notice of co-passengers. He clicked photographs of the cockroach in bowl and recorded his grievance in the IRCTC complaint booklet. He also informed the train



incharge/TC. The complainant had tweeted about it on the official account of the Railway Ministry and was assured that action would be taken as per procedure. The complainant stated that the bread served to him was expired as the package mentioned ‘best to use before September 2’. The IRCTC denied the charges and claimed that the complainant had filed the false complaint. After hearing the arguments, the commission observed that it was clear from the documentary evidence that the OPs had served unhygienic food to the complainant and his mother as a dead cockroach was found in the soup. The aforesaid act of OPs amounted to deficiency in service and unfair trade practice, the commission stated.

IT professionals complain lower back pain

CHANDIGARH : Lifestyle factors, including prolonged sitting in a poor posture and excessive use of mobile devices, have been identified as major contributors to this rise in back pain cases. In a associating trend observed at the PGI Pain Clinic here, a surge in young patients, particularly those in the IT field, seeking treatment for lower back pain has been reported over the past five years. The clinic recently attended to a 23-year-old IT professional who presented with severe lower back pain. Investigation revealed that his sedentary lifestyle, coupled with prolonged hours of coding work, led to the distressing symptoms. The patient has been prescribed lifestyle modifications, counselling and pain relief medication to address the immediate concerns. However, doctors emphasise if such detrimental habits persist, the intermittent pain may evolve into a chronic condition, potentially causing 24-hour discomfort and mobility challenges. Dr Babita Ghai, in charge of the Pro and Pain Clinic, Anaesthesia Department, highlighted a shift in the age demographic seeking treatment for back pain. Previously associated with older age groups, back pain is now affecting individuals aged between 20 and 30, with over half of them employed in the IT sector.



The Pain Clinic, operating every Wednesday and Saturday, caters to referral cases, with 70 to 75 per cent patients reporting lower back pain persisting for years. The clinic provides various therapies, with a significant focus on yoga, which has shown promising results in alleviating pain associated with prolonged sitting. Dr Ghai emphasised the importance of physical activity and the adverse effects of continuous sitting. Yoga, previously lacking scientific evidence, is now being actively incorporated into patient care. The PGI has undertaken a large-scale study to further explore the benefits of yoga in managing spinal cord patients. Furthermore, the Collaborative Centre for Mind Body Intervention at the PGI, established four years ago, has collaborated with the Research Council on Yoga and Naturopathy in New Delhi. This centre scientifically studies the effects of yoga on the body. Notably, online yoga sessions are being offered to patients, reflecting a proactive approach to address the growing concern of back pain in the younger population.

‘Fight of ‘dharma’ and ‘adharma’, Lord Krishna is with us’, says Kejriwal in Kurukshetra

everything, said the AAP convener who was accompanied by Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann. “What Pandavas had? Lord Shri Krishna was with them,” he said. “What we have with us. We are too small. Lord Shri Krishna is with us,” said Kejriwal. Referring to the BJP-led Centre, Kejriwal said, “They have everything. They have all the powers. They have IB, CBI, ED.” “We have our ‘dharma’

(righteousness) with us. It is a fight of ‘dharma’ and ‘adharma’ (non-righteousness) and you have to decide whether you are with ‘dharma’ or ‘adharma’,” Kejriwal told the gathering. He said the BJP says that it is winning 370 seats in the Lok Sabha polls. “They are openly saying they do not need your votes.” “I came from Delhi to seek your votes with folded hands. “I should have been among you today for this programme, but due to some other



engagements I am in Uttar Pradesh. I am speaking from Kashi, the land of Baba Vishwanath, who is also showering his blessings on you,” he said.
The PM said he offered prayers to Lord Vishwanath on Saturday night and prayed for the wellbeing of the country’s people.
“The efforts of our government have resulted in making more than one crore women ‘lakhpati didis’. We have now resolved that we will fulfil the target of making three crore sisters of the country ‘lakhpati didis,’” he added.
The government is also working on the ‘Namo Drone

Didi Yojna’, under which drone pilot training will be provided, he added.
The scheme by the Centre aims to provide drones to 15,000 select women self-help groups to provide rental services to farmers for agricultural purposes.

TMC supremo Mamata Banerjee on Sunday asserted that her party, a partner of the opposition bloc INDIA on the national stage, will contest the Lok Sabha polls in West Bengal and asserted that her party will confront not only the BJP but also the CPI (M) and Congress in the state.
“We will contest the Lok Sabha polls in Bengal alone and will fight against the Congress, BJP, and the CPI(M). We will also contest elections in Assam and Meghalaya. We are in talks with Akhilesh Yadav (of SP) for contesting one Lok Sabha seat in Uttar Pradesh,” she stated during the ‘Jana Garjan Sabha’. In January, Banerjee had declared that her party would



contest the Lok Sabha elections in Bengal independently, rebuffing efforts by Congress leadership to negotiate a seat-sharing agreement.
The decision by Trinamool Congress to go solo in Bengal has set the stage for a three-way electoral battle, with TMC and BJP poised to vie for voter support.
The Congress-Left alliance, as the third contender, holds the potential to impact the votes of both TMC and BJP, especially in minority-dominated areas and constituencies with narrow margins.
Banerjee interpreted Goel’s sudden resignation as evidence of BJP’s attempt to manipulate the elections.
“I salute Arun Goel for not

succumbing to pressure by Delhi leaders (of BJP) and his top bosses in connection with the West Bengal LS polls and the deployment of forces. It is proven that what they (the BJP-led NDA government) want to do in the name of the election. They want to loot votes,” she remarked.
Election Commissioner Arun Goel resigned on Saturday, days before the expected announcement of the schedule for the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.
His tenure was till December 5, 2027, and he would have become Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) after incumbent Rajiv Kumar retired in February next year.
Hitting out at Prime Minister Narendra Modi over his allegations that central funds are being siphoned off in West Bengal, the TMC supremo said, “The PM must cross-check facts with officials before making baseless allegations against Bengal.”

NEW DELHI : A Bench led by Supreme Court CJI DY Chandrachud -- which had last month pulled up the AAP for encroaching on the land meant for expansion of judicial infrastructure -- however, allowed the AAP to apply to the Land and Development Office (L&DO) of the Centre for alternative land.
“The Supreme Court permits the AAP to move the Centre (L&DO) for allotment of land and LN&DO to process the application in accordance with law in the meantime and communicate its decision within four weeks,” it said.
The top court said the Delhi High Court was in urgent need of the allotment of premises for housing the new recruits, for which courtrooms were not available.
The Supreme Court on Monday directed the Aam Aadmi Party to vacate by June 15 a bungalow on land allotted to the Delhi High Court for expansion of judicial infrastructure in the national capital.
The AAP’s party headquarters is situated on that land.



“In view of impending general election, we grant time till June 15 to vacate the premises so that land allotted to extend district judiciary footprint can be duly utilised on an expeditious basis,” the Bench said.
Noting that the the MTNL building, which was earlier proposed, has been found to be unsuitable, it directed the Chief Secretary of the Delhi government to come up with an alternative proposal in two weeks and communicate it to the Chief Justice of the Delhi High Court.
Anguished to know that the AAP has built its office at Rouse Avenue in the national capital over a piece of land originally allotted to the Delhi High Court for expansion of judicial infrastructure, the Supreme Court had last month

directed the Delhi government and the Delhi High Court Registrar General to hold a meeting for removal of the encroachment.
“How can a political party sit tight on that? Unencumbered possession must be given to the High Court,” the CJI-led Bench had said while hearing a plea related to the condition of district judiciary in India.
“No one can take law into their own hands ... how can a political party sit tight on that? Unencumbered possession must be given to the High Court. What will the High Court use it for -- only for the public and citizens? Why was the land then allotted to the High Court?” the CJI had wondered.
The top court had asked the Delhi Chief Secretary, Secretary, Delhi Public Works Department, and the Finance Secretary of the NCT government to convene a meeting to find a solution to the issue after amicus curiae K Parameswar informed the Bench that a political party has set up its office on the land in question.

On receiving the consignments, retailers, will scam each bottle or case ,and sell scanned bottles to customers

The union health secretary had been asked by Supreme court to ensure notification on standard rate in a month. Under the clinical establishment rule, all hospitals would have to keep in tact their registration, and must display rates charged for each type of service and the nearest referral clinic / hospital for upgraded treatment.
