EDITORIAL -

Global warming subjects glaciers to melt

Evidence shows that climate change is accelerating and the extreme weather events are increasing both in frequency and intensity. According to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), climate change is a human-induced phenomenon and so are most of the disasters that occur in the hills. In the Himalayas, it is also becoming increasingly clear that haphazard, unplanned and unregulated construction in the name of development and to cater to the needs of tourists is working as a force multiplier in terms of the impact of climate change. Besides melting of glaciers in the Himalayas due to global warming, human activities such as encroachment of riverbeds, building of hotels and houses on the riverside, widening of roads by indiscriminate cutting of slopes beyond what is desirable, tunnelling by blasting of rocks, construction of dams and dumping of resultant muck in rivers and streams are disturbing the fragile ecosystem of the Himalayas, leading to frequent flashfloods and landslides. The push for running hydropower projects beyond their capacity is also not environmentally and socially sustainable, especially in remote, environmentally fragile and climatically vulnerable areas such as Pangi and Lahaul & Spiti. These factors must be taken into consideration in the context of the carrying capacity of various areas. Given this background, it is clear that we must revisit our present development model and come up with an entirely new approach to development in the Himalayan region — one that is climate-resilient and sustainable, and suitable for the well-

being of residents as well as of tourists. The ‘business as usual’ approach will not do. The Supreme Court recently proposed to set up a panel of experts to assess the carrying capacity of the Himalayan region. It asked the Central Government to provide names of three institutions capable of planning and implementing such a study. This came in the backdrop of the recent devastation in Himachal Pradesh due to unprecedented heavy rain accompanied by flashfloods and landslides. This study can provide a basis for future directions to ensure rational and sustainable development in the Himalayan region spread across 13 states and UTs. It will also act as an essential tool for evidence-based policymaking and execution and offer medium/long-term help in strengthening disaster prevention, preparedness and response capacities at the state and local levels. The study will be an opportunity to conduct an analysis based on a critical review of the carrying capacity by a mapping of the tourist places of the entire Himalayan region of India. It could also ascertain, based on real-time data, the factors responsible for the enhanced impact of disasters in various regions. And finally, based on the findings, it can recommend or suggest a way forward in terms of policy and practices to prevent or mitigate the impact of disasters on lives and livelihoods, especially at the community level. The Himalayan region has several popular tourist destinations. The carrying capacity of such places is closely linked to the population residing permanently and the

number of visiting tourists. An assessment should, therefore, take into account factors such as seasonal influx of tourists to the hills and intensive infrastructure development that puts additional burden on the carrying capacity in terms of land use for construction activities, income and quality of services provided. The carrying capacity is associated with sustainable development as well as the potential impact of climate change. It has a lot to do with the level of human activity that an area can withstand without deterioration of its physical, economic and social environment. Exceeding the carrying capacity has impacted both local residents and tourists. The findings of the proposed study on the carrying capacity and its recommendations can pave the way for a development model that is environment-friendly and economically as well as socially viable. Before starting any infrastructure development project, an environmental impact assessment needs to be conducted thoroughly. As such developmental activities have made the Himalayan region extremely unstable, efforts must be made to restore its stability and tread a cautious path in the future. Rules or the standard operating procedures (SOPs) must be followed strictly by contractors engaged in highway construction or building of hotels or houses. They must be held accountable if found flouting rules and regulations. Clearly, the focus of the governments at the state and local levels should be on the environmental aspects of development works, identification of landslide-prone places and increasing the emergency response capacity.

Avoid unregistered app based companies for travel : Admn

**CHANDIGARH :** The Administration had granted aggregator license to two companies, namely OLA and Uber, to provide the cab services in Chandigarh. It may be noted that other app-based aggregator companies such as Bla Bla, Quick ride, in-drive, Redbus, Rapido, etc were not registered with the Administration. For the safety of the residents, the UT Administration has advised the general public to book cabs having yellow

commercial number plates through Ola and Uber companies and not to book cabs through unregistered app-based aggregator companies. The UT also advised not to travel in cab/bike having private number (white plate) which is illegal, failing which strict legal action will be taken against passengers as well as drivers of private vehicles. The panic buttons are also installed in the commercial cabs which can be pressed in emergency.

For early warning disaster portal app launched

The Sachet mobile app would prove useful in reducing disasters, he said, while adding that the app was available in the Android and iOS versions on Google Play and on Apple App Store.

PPCB approval for environmental norms must for dairy farms, gaushalas

**PATIALA :** The PPCB authorities have asked the proprietors of dairy farms and gaushalas that as per National Green Tribunal (NGT) orders, it was mandatory to comply with the revised guidelines for environmental management and to have consent to establish a unit. Directing owners of dairy farms and gaushalas to get its consent for operations, the Punjab Pollution Control Board (PPCB) has asked them to adopt necessary safeguards and ensure compliance of revised environmental guidelines or face penalty. This comes as the majority of gaushalas and dairies continue to discharge dung and wastewater into drains, leading to water pollution. The consent include undertaking that the dairies and farms would treat wastewater before releasing it into sewers and stop dumping bovine dung. The PPCB approval

would be given only if the units would collect dung from the sheds at regular intervals. “At present, the majority of dairies are flouting norms and polluting both air and water. This has to stop or environmental compensation will be levied against defaulters as per NGT orders. At present, most farms are operating without following any norms,” said a top PPCB official. Sources said the recent order came following the problems caused by discharge of dung and wastewater, especially during the floods across Punjab. “Many dairy farms and gaushalas throw dung along with wastewater into drains, leading to clogging. This ultimately reaches rivers and creates water pollution. The dung produces many gases and compounds which are emitted into the atmosphere,” said PPCB Chairman Adarsh Pal Vig.

For detailed project report, Haryana Govt pays its share

**CHANDIGARH :** In an attempt to expedite the process, the Haryana Government paid Rs 1.37 crore as its share for the preparation of the DPR. The Punjab Government’s had paid an identical amount to the UT Administration on August 25. The tricity Metro rail project, passionately awaited by residents, is making progress as both the Haryana and Punjab governments have now contributed their respective share of money for preparing a detailed project report (DPR). According to a senior official of the UT Administration, Rail India Technical and Economic Service Limited (RITES), the agency responsible for formulating the comprehensive mobility plan for the tricity, is set to submit an inception report later this month. The report will undergo a thorough analysis. Any suggestions or



objections that emerge from this review will be incorporated into the Alternative Analysis Report (AAR) before the final drafting of the DPR, he added. The funding structure for the entire Metro project was devised to be shared by states (20%), the Central Government (20%) and a lending agency (remaining 60%). The tentative cost of the comprehensive Metro project stands at approximately Rs 10,570 crore. In July, the UT Administration had taken the step of engaging all stakeholders, including

Haryana and Punjab, in the preparation of the AAR and the DPR for the Metro project, aligning with the guidelines set by the Government of India. The Unified Metro Transportation Authority (UMTA), comprising 23 members, convened on July 18 and approved the Tricity Metro Project, expanding its scope for the first phase from 66 to 77 km. This initial phase will commence from Parol in New Chandigarh (Mohali) and extend to Panchkula extension in Sector 20. In a development set for realisation between 2027 and 2037, three routes are proposed for the first phase. The second phase anticipated after 2037, envisions additional routes connecting various key locations in the tricity. Both phases primarily consist of overground Metro lines, designed to enhance regional connectivity.

Rs 25-cr grant-in-aid for civic body by Chandigarh administration

**CHANDIGARH :** The Municipal Corporation had sought an advance against the third instalment of the grant-in-aid share of Rs 135 crore. Ahead of the scheduled time, the UT administration has announced to release Rs 25 crore grant-in-aid to the cash-strapped MC, which recently stopped floating new tenders for developmental projects due to the shortage of funds, said Mayor Anup Gupta. The Mayor had met UT Administrator Banwarilal Purohit and sought funds so that the ongoing developmental work was not hit. Mr Gupta said the development work in the city would not be stopped at any



cost and that the MC is committed to serving the people of the city. The UT administration had earmarked the grant-in-aid of Rs 555 crore for financial year 2023-24, of which the MC had received Rs 310 crore up to the second quarter of the financial year. MC Commissioner Anindita Mitra had on August 30 ordered, “As per orders of the NGT to ensure the availability of funds to the extent of Rs 282 crore, the MC has ring-fenced this amount from its

funds available under various heads, including funds allocated under capital head. Therefore, in interest of financial prudence, no new tender shall be floated except those of emergent nature, till further orders.” The orders meant that the MC will not initiate even the approved development projects, at least till December, including those related to carpeting roads, paver blocks, back lanes and the renovation or upgrade of community centres and toilets.

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## Naresh Goyal's ED custody extended till September 14 in bank fraud case

**MUMBAI** : The 74-year-old businessman was produced before the special PMLA court at the end of his initial remand on Monday. The special court here on Monday extended till September 14 the ED remand of Jet Airways founder Naresh Goyal, who has been arrested in a money laundering case linked to an alleged fraud of Rs 538 crore at Canara Bank. Goyal was arrested by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) on September 1 under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) following a long session of questioning at the central agency's office here. The central probe agency sought his custody for another four day for



further investigation in the case. The ED told the court that maximum money siphoned off has been stacked in foreign accounts and there is a person in the United Arab Emirates (UAE) to look after it. Special judge for cases under PMLA, MG Deshpande, then extended Goyal's custody till September 14. The money laundering case stems from an FIR of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI)

against Jet Airways, Goyal, his wife Anita and some former executives of the now grounded private airline in connection with an alleged Rs 538-crore fraud case at Canara Bank. The FIR was registered on the government-run lender's complaint which alleged that it sanctioned credit limits and loans to Jet Airways (India) Ltd to the tune of Rs 848.86 crore of which Rs 538.62 crore was outstanding.

## Sukhu appeals to PM for declaration of rain-caused calamity as 'national disaster'

**SHIMLA** : "Had the privilege of addressing the grave aftermath of torrential rains in Himachal Pradesh during my conversation with Prime Minister Shri @narendramodi Ji after our G20 Summit dinner. I also requested a special disaster relief package and emphasised the need to designate this calamity as a 'national disaster', highlighting the urgency of the situation," said Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu. Sukhu has requested Prime Minister Narendra Modi to declare the rain-caused calamity in the hill state as a "national disaster". Sukhu was the only Chief Minister from the Congress-ruled states who attended a dinner hosted by President Droupadi Murmu for G20 leaders on Saturday. Sukhu, who had earlier said Himachal Pradesh had suffered losses to the tune of Rs 12,000 crore due to rain-related incidents this monsoon, has been demanding that the calamity be declared as a national disaster and a special disaster package be announced



on the lines of those provided in the aftermath of the Kedarnath and Bhuj tragedies. On September 4, the Chief Minister had reiterated his demand and said he would meet Prime Minister Modi and Union Home Minister Amit Shah in this regard if the need arises. Earlier, the Congress Government in the hill state had raised claims of losses to the tune of Rs 6,700 crore suffered till August 10 and sent a detailed report of the damage caused during the monsoon to the BJP-led Centre. Himachal Pradesh saw two spells of heavy rain this monsoon. The first on July 9 and 10 led to large-scale destruction in Mandi and Kullu districts. Shimla and Solan districts were hit during the second spell on August 14 and 15, and the capital city of Shimla suffered heavy damage as an aftermath.

## Case registered against PIMS Jalandhar mgmt, as it fails to pay Rs 63-crore fee

**CHANDIGARH** : Sources in the government revealed that the file to lodge an FIR against the PIMS was moved by Special Chief Secretary, Medical Education and Research for approval from the Health and Medical Education Minister. Apart from that, a bank guarantee of the college of Rs 25 crore lying with the government has also been encashed by the government. Punjab Government has given approval for initiating criminal proceedings against the management of the Punjab Institute of Medical Sciences, Jalandhar, for not paying



fee as per the concessionaire agreement. Health and Medical Education Minister Dr Balbir Singh confirmed that he has given approval to lodge FIR against PIMS management. "The matter is being examined by our legal experts. Apart from the FIR, we have encashed their bank guarantee," he said. Last year, the Department of Medical Education and Research had found that the PIMS management

was supposed to pay Rs 63 crore as fee to the government as per the terms and conditions of concessionaire agreement. It was found that the college management had not paid the annual fee as per the concessionaire agreement since 2016. The government had been consistently pursuing the management to pay it but they did not do so despite Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann's orders.

## DCGI asks states to raid sale of falsified versions of 2 drugs

**NEW DELHI** : The Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) on Sept 5 said the WHO has issued a safety alert identified with multiple falsified versions of Adcetris injection 50 mg manufactured by Takeda Pharmaceutical Company Limited, identified in four different countries, including India. DCGI has directed the drugs controllers of all states and Union territories to keep a strict vigil on the sale and distribution of falsified versions of two drugs, liver medication Defitelio and Takeda's cancer drug Adcetris (injection), following alerts issued by the World Health Organisation (WHO). In an advisory on September 5, the DCGI said the WHO has issued a safety alert identified with multiple falsified versions of Adcetris injection 50 mg manufactured by Takeda Pharmaceutical Company Limited, identified in four different countries, including India. On September 6, the DCGI issued another advisory, referring to a safety alert



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issued by the WHO on September 4 for falsified product Defitelio (Defibrotide) 80 mg/ml concentrate for solution for infusion, manufactured by Gentium Srl. "This falsified product has been detected in India (April 2023) and Türkiye (July 2023), and was supplied outside of regulated and authorised channels," the WHO said. It said the genuine manufacturer of Defitelio has confirmed that the product referenced in the alert is falsified. "The use of falsified Defitelio will result in the ineffective treatment of patients and may pose other serious risks to health because of its intravenous administration and could be life-threatening in some circumstances," the health body of the United Nations (UN) said.

## Industrialists meet Haryana CM over ban on diesel generators from Oct 1

## Halwara airport to become operational by September 2023

Chandigarh: "Bids have been allotted and work is progressing well. The airport terminal would give connectivity to the Army area. There was initially some hurdle as the contract for internal roads had to be terminated and reallocated, which led to some delay. The Airport Authority of India (AAI) will take over once the construction is complete," said a PWD official.

The civil aviation department is hoping that the AAI will be able to take over in August. "They also need to float tender and shift some of their infrastructure from Sahnewal. That too will take some time and we have asked them to do it in two

months. The ac tual operations at the airport could, therefore, begin in the beginning of September," said an official with the civil aviation department.

In his Budget speech for 2023-24, finance minister Harpal Singh Cheema had said that for the development of the terminal building at the Halwara Indian Air Force Station, the AAP government had decided to contribute.

After some initial hiccups, the upcoming international airport at Halwara, 40 km away from Ludhiana, is likely to be ready by September as the Punjab public works department (PWD) hopes to get work on the terminal building completed by July end.

## Chahal's pre arrest bail plea in disproportionate assets dismissed

Patiala: Chahal adviser to ex Chief Minister Amarinder Singh was earlier booked by the vigilance bureau in Patiala on August 2 under Section 13(1) (b) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, for failing to submit details of assets and liabilities to the investigation agency.

He worked with Capt Amarinder in 2017-2021 and 2002-2007 during his term as the chief mi nister. The court of additional sessions judge, Patiala, has rejected the anticipatory bail application of the adviser BIS Chahal in a case related to disproportionate assets and ordered for his custodial interrogation for proper investigation.

"When the conduct of applicant BIS Chahal is that he is not cooperating during in quiry and has come with different facts in the bail application, then, applicant is not entitled to concession of antici patory bail. Hence, the present bail application is dismissed," the court said. His counsel had pleaded that Chahal was innocent and



falsely implicated in the case due to "political vendetta" after the change in regime. His counsel said that Chahal's expenditure calculations were exaggerated whereas all income sources of the family were not considered. "Chahal had submitted income tax for the check period (April 1, 2017 to August 31, 2021), and also took loans of Rs 14 crore from various financial institutions," the e counsel told the court.

The public prosecutor, however, submitted that as per the documents made available to the investigation agency the income of Chahal and his family comes out to be about Rs 7.85 crore while they have incurred expenses to the tune of Rs 31.7 crore and he was not cooperating with the probe.

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## Rs 3.760cr support approved for battery storage projects

New Delhi: Grid size battery storage has emerged as a focus area as the govt is looking at supplying 50% power from non-fossil source by 2030 battery stronge are akin to giant power banks that charges using or wind power during the day and supply electricity at night or when there is no wind ensuring continuous availability of green power.

The government on Wednesday approved 3.760 core support for 4,000MWh (megawatt-hour) battery stronger capacity proposed to be built by 2030-31 with a view to making tariffs affordable. Storage tariffs are currently unviable due to

power distribution, the government said. The selection of promoters' for project report will be done a level playing field for both a public and private sector entities. India solar capability has increased from 2.6 gig watt (GW) in 2014 to 71GW at present. Wind energy capacity has increased from 21GW to 40GW during the same period.
