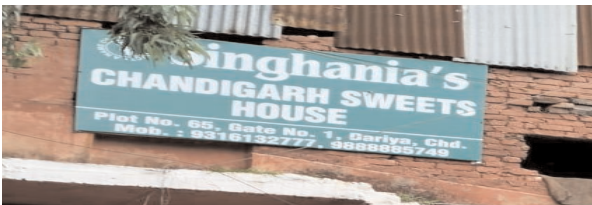

## Sweets makers capitalise Chandigarh name to make a buck

*FSSAI fails to regulate purity standards of sweets, edible oil*

Dariya (Chandigarh) : An isolated town "Dariya" of Union Territory administration has been encashing metropolitan title name "Chandigarh", as its most of the sweets makers have chosen tempting name and intended for making fast bucks.

Best quality of edible oil like mustard oil, often used for frying, cooking Mathis, Mattar has vanished as it is adulterated with cheap palm oil, even soyabean oil but chiefly is mixed with Argemone oils. The Chandigarh Sweets' Singhania brand is not worth its recogni-



tion, as despite recent orders by the Health authorities for renewal of registration were issued by the Director Health 2700255 but the owner had not complied with nor has manifested the manufacturing and the expiry date of sweets as per the directive of Food Safety law stipulated by FSSAI- 2006. It seems that the proprietor has been selling stale food items as not displaying its

manufacturing dates. The Food Safety and Standards Authority, of India, 2006 Act came into being to consolidate and regulate food related norms and establish science based food standards. The enshrined law assures standard food for human consumption but usually unsafe, unwholesome is seen in the today's markets. With regard to this,



assent of the President of India was published on 23 August 2006 in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary) Part 1, dated 24 Aug 2006, for compliance in our country. In market, real, original milk is nowhere available, the adulterated sweets are in plenty readily available from anywhere or neighbouring Zirakpur godowns which are often seen supplying

to closer tricity. The Food Safety And Standards Authorities of India remains the supreme power responsible for regulating and supervising the food safety. It is mandatory for food establishments to procure food safety license, registration as per the prevalent law. Food safety registration, and renewal is required even for small business or startups like petty,



medium food manufacturers, storage units, transporters, retailers, marketers and distributors. One would be needed to fill in form 'A' for registration and upload form "B" for issuance of license renewal with all documents for the requisite license. The stipulated documents would include signed form 'B', photograph of the owner, incorporation certificate or the partnership deed,

list of the saleable food products and other utility b i l l s .

In order to test the purity of the sweets, one could break a piece and add a few drops of iodine into the sweets mixture to see the result of adulterated sweets as its new color has surfaced blue/purple.

Not far behind, even detergents are used to make its looks crystal

white and vigorously brightened.

Another bamboozling addition remains "Urea" quantity that supplements protein contents and silver foils are substituted by aluminium fibre. It may be borne in mind that sweets in the markets are one of the most unchecked, contaminated food items with pandemic suppliers, sellers, said Mohan Rai, a dietician employed in a govt boys hostel. He remorsefully uttered even chalk powder and juwar flour were being added for a starch.

## Unmanufactured spurious mustard oil being sold by Shankrah oil mills

Mohali : The title name of the oil mills may crack big sound but virtually, the mustard oil mills to the spectators' wonders are located in a small shed of another industrial unit. No industrial, pollution control consent has been procured by the unscrupulous owner of the tactfully managed Shankrah Oil Mills, at 86 phase V, Industrial. The frivolous entrepreneur of the outlet if asked about the rate of mustard oil, starts scolding, threatening, on knowing that the interrogator is not his real customer.



His outlet is located in densely populated area opposite to Garvit Karyana Store, located in multi-storied building near Swaraj Tractors in Phase V, Industrial area. The liberty to sell illegitimate edible oil without any check by the health, pollution control, smacks high-handedness of the so called

entrepreneur at Mohali industrial area in the times of adulteration of food quality and standards. How would the standard food for human consumption would prevail upon where unsafe, unchecked parameters are operating, raised finger on the enforcement of Food Safety and Standard of India Act 2006.

## Re 1.71 Cr fine levied on Omaxe group against breaching environmental norms

Dera Bassi : Against Omaxe Group, the National Highways Authority of India had lodged a complaint with PPCB in 2021 about the illegal sewage connections with highways drains. The National Green Tribunal under the provision of water act 1974 issued a notice for causing deliberately and intentionally water pollution. The construction work of a housing project launched by Omaxe gp at Jharmari village had been suspended due to potential environmental hazards. As a part of the green housing project a total of 650 flats have been constructed and 550 sold flats had already been occupied. About 100 left over flats are yet to be allotted. Many other anomalies pertaining to pollution control norms are yet to be rectified by the housing group. The housing unit didn't have functional treatment plant

(STP), and sewage and effluents were being discharged into nearby fields and drains along the National Highway. No site of solid waste management plant has been specified by the company nor the stoppage of wild growth been pointed and checked effectively. Welfare Association of the project had given so many avenues in 2021 to the Omaxe Gp to solve the evolving malaise but did nothing. The adviser to Omaxe Group Dalip Moudgil said they had received a consent under the Water (Prevention & Control of pollution act and also Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act to continue to operate. Mr Dalip Moudgil however said when the group receives a copy of order they would appeal to the authorities to reconsider the amount of fine, as we have now complied with the all environmental norms.

## Astounding rape-murder by Kolkata doctor

Kolkata : The rape murder accused doctor had slept at home, washed clothes after the heinous crime as the police found blood stain on his shoe.

The doctor was accused of raping and murdering inside the Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital went back to his home after allegedly committing the crime and slept for a few hours, the police said on Sunday. He later washed his clothes to destroy evidence. The police, however, said the accused is not linked to the hospital professionally



but he used to frequent the premises. The body of the woman, a post-graduate trainee doctor, was found inside a seminar hall of the hospital on Friday morning. According to her colleagues, she had gone to the hall to rest after taking her meal. The rape and mur-

der took place between 3 am and 6 am. As per the initial autopsy report, the victim's body was bleeding from her eyes, mouth and private parts. There were injuries to other parts of her body, including her leg, neck, hand and lips

## Illegal poultry farm operates sans any registration

Visiting from Zirakpur, after about 1 km from toll plaza, the illegitimate poultry farm has become a substantial nuisance due to stench generated from this farm, said Tarlok Singh resident of Karala village.

Under air (prevention and control of pollution) act 1981, no action is being initiated for the reasons unknown to the inhabitants of the village. Several times the residents found dead poultry birds behind the poultry farms, bemoaned Tarlok Singh.

## Another 1Re store inaugurated by Mayor in Maloya

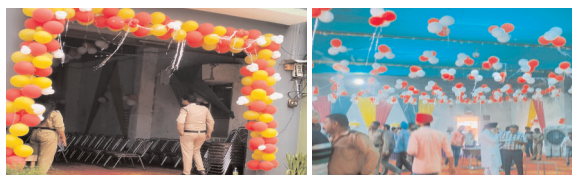

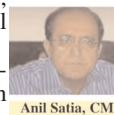

## MC looks for AI to plug leakages

Chandigarh: "We are working hard to stabilize the 24x7 water supply project in mission mode. Our first target would be to provide 24x7 water in all the areas of Manimajra by the end of this month. AI tools will help detect leakages. The average billing system will also come to an end. MC will earn more revenue via this project," said Anindita Mitra Municipal Commissioner. Manimajra doesn't need more than 6.5 MGD potable water for around 1.8 lakh people. So, saving water is another goal of this project.



By plugging all these leakages and thefts, 1.5 MGD water will be saved in Manimajra, disclosed the officials. Three teams have been constituted for round-the-clock handling of complaints and attend to the grievances of the people for on-the-spot solutions. Two of these

teams will work during the day period, and other will be available in night hours to address the complaints of the dissidents. A permanent grievance cell will be operational from 9 am to 5 pm to redress the complaints, said the sources.

EDITORIAL –

Creed ought to be preserved as a solemn faith

Religious and caste identities are not going to disappear in the foreseeable future. It is a fact of life in India, has been there for centuries. In rural India, where more than half of our people live, caste is a factor of daily existence. In urban India, where interaction is perforce impersonal, caste and even religious identity was slowly losing its relevance.

Since, endemic corruption weakens the moral fibre, communalism and casteism militate against unity that is essential to make India stand up as one against poverty, illiteracy and the feudal mentality that presently pervades the national psyche. Rahul Gandhi has decided now to become a full-time politician, he can pose a challenge to Narendra Modi's leadership. His choice of caste politics to combat the communal politics of Modi and the Sangh Parivar seems to be a dangerous one. To add casteism to the two main evils that the country faces — communalism and corruption — will prevent our country from progressing, and is certainly a dangerous move. That feeling of being Indian, first and foremost, is sadly being eroded. First, it was the Hindu-Muslim divide accentuated at the time of elections and now, this attempt by

Opposition parties to further divide the majority Hindus on the basis of caste for electoral gain. That is going to end in disaster, like the division on religious grounds is leading us to.

If dividing and weakening India on religious and caste lines was not enough, the Supreme Court, in a six-to-one decision of a seven-judge Constitution Bench, overturned its own 2004 ruling that had pronounced that all SCs constitute one homogenous body. By that ruling, the more educated units of SCs, like the Mahars in Maharashtra or the Chamars in Punjab, cornered most of the reserved seats allotted to the Scheduled Castes, leaving the less educated bereft of the benefits that reservation promised.

The 2024 Supreme Court majority verdict, of which the CJI was a part, argued that the categories of SCs who had not benefited from reservation should now be treated separately so that the principle on which reservation was conceived was upheld. This judgment will further divide Indian citizens and produce demands for inclusion from sub-castes whose existence itself was not known to most citizens. Be that as it may, the presence of these dispossessed sub-castes of SCs, obviously quite

numerous in the north of the country, has been noted by the Supreme Court. The court has rightly deigned that they, too, should be given a part of the reservation pie. The enforcement of the court's order is not going to be easy. More difficult will be to calculate the political fallout of this further divide in the polity.

Both factors need to be kept in mind by the decision-makers while formulating a "via media". Political parties, starting with the Congress under Jawaharlal Nehru right up to the BJP under Narendra Modi, have neglected education and health, the bedrocks of a successful society. China has stolen a 50-year march over us in ensuring 100 per cent literacy, as now exists in the advanced countries of the West. If we had achieved total literacy, we could have selected the really bright boys and girls from the neglected castes and enrolled them at the State's expense in the best schools to ensure that they could compete with their sisters and brothers of the advanced castes on an even plane. The problem of admitting a candidate who achieved rank 821 in the civil services exam into the IAS would not have arisen, as it did in the recent case of Puja Khedkar.

Manish Tewari’s election challenged by Sanjay Tandon in High Court

**CHANDIGARH** : Sanjay Tandon has asked the court to declare the election void and announce him as the duly elected Member of Parliament from the constituency. The BJP’s candidate for the city LS seat, Sanjay Tandon, has moved the Punjab and Haryana High Court seeking the cancellation of his opponent Manish Tewari’s election. Among other things, Tandon has submitted that Tewari, along with the Indian National Congress, the Aam Aadmi Party and their supporters, had engaged in various corrupt practices to secure his victory in the election. Had



these practices not occurred, he would have been rightfully elected as the Member of Parliament in the Lok Sabha. Tandon contended their actions of filling out guarantee cards and posting videos to lure innocent voters into believing that they would be compensated with Rs 8,500 per month if they voted for Tewari, provided Rs 1 lakh salary “for every first job of every educated youth” and would get

legal guarantee of MSP based on Swaminathan formula besides loan waiver. He used the national emblem in his endorsements and these all were grounds for disqualification under the Representation of People's Act, said Tandon. The petition filed through senior advocate Chetan Mittal was placed before Registrar Judicial Rajan Nanda who directed the issuance of notice to Tewari and other respondents. The matter was directed to be placed before the “designated judge” for scrutiny on September 9.

Migrant labourers being subjected to discrimination in Jandpur village

**MOHALI** : Under the name of law and order, a handful of social activists here have issued an 11-point diktat to the migrant labourers and ‘outsiders’, including a prohibition of staying outdoors after 9pm. Continuing with the disturbing trend of vigilantism in rural areas, Jandpur has become the third village in the area where migrant labourers and ‘outsiders’ are being subjected to discrimination. Naib Tehsildar



Vikasdeep and police officials visited Jandpur village and held talks with the activists there who had put the boards. They dissuaded them from framing rules for the society and advised the migrant workers to register a complaint with the police if anyone harasses them.

The Naujawan Sabha, Jandpur, said if the guidelines are not followed within 15 days or violated repeatedly, they will be asked to leave the village. Locals said the group is planning a door-to-door awareness campaign in the coming days. One councillor is also reported to be backing the move. The diktats include wearing proper length clothes, ban on smoking, only two persons per room on rent and not parking vehicles in streets and roads.

Panchkula mayoral polls to fall on September 25 -- Haryana government

Strength of stray cattle in Panchkula city to be surveyed by MC

**PANCHKULA** : The issue of conducting survey of stray cattle was discussed during a meeting of Panchkula development advisory committee. The Municipal Corporation has been sending stray cows to shelters. These shelters have already exhausted their capacity and are not in position to accommodate more animals. MC officials pointed out that they had till date sent 2,721 cows to different cow shelters in and around the city. He said, “But the cow shelters have now stopped accepting more animals citing shortage of space.” The local Municipal Corporation will now carry out a survey to count the number of stray cattle head in the city as well as those being kept at various cow shelters to take a decision regarding the setting up of new cattle pounds and



transportation of strays. Haryana Assembly Speaker Gian Chand Gupta said they should carry out a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters. He said, “Conduct a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters and those roaming around in the city. We will see if we have any space to keep the animals in the existing shelters else requisite land can be provided to interested NGOs to open and run cow shelters.” Officials present at the meeting also discussed the dog bite incidents and sought stringent action in this regard. They said the district had recorded

registration of as many as 5,699 dog bite cases at health institutions in merely six months this year. Gupta pointed out that the district administration had spent Rs 4 crore on the development of a pound at Sukhdarshanpur village for keeping stray dogs, but remained unsuccessful in its initiative. MC Commissioner Sachin Gupta said, “The law provides provisions for sterilisation of dogs. The canines also have to be dropped back to the place from where they were picked for sterilisation.”

Dental services at Aam Aadmi Clinics to be available across Punjab : Health minister

**PATIALA** : Soon oral health services will be offered at Aam Aadmi Clinics (AACs) across the state said Dr Balbir Singh, Health Minister while flagging off a modern mobile dental clinic van, prepared at a cost of Rs 67 lakh, from Government Dental College here. "There is a huge lack of awareness among people about dental diseases, especially among the marginal section of society. It is also leading to situations like oral cancer. Dental doctors will play an important role in preventing the increasing disease of oral cancer. We are planning to offer such facilities at our AACs so that the marginal section of the society could benefit from it," said Dr Balbir. There are a total of 842 Aam Aadmi Clinics across the state, providing at least 80 diagnostic tests free of cost. Sharing details about the mobile dental clinic van, Dr Balbir Singh said that this state-of-the-art van has two fixed dental chairs and one mobile dental chair for the complete examination of the patient's teeth. Besides, the bus is equipped with air-conditioner, autoclave, generator, power backup, etc,



which will help in emergency dental treatment. Through this van, awareness about dental diseases will also be spread, particularly in rural areas. Besides, dentists will organise dental camps, and the van will be beneficial for the training and further studies of dental college students. Dr Balbir Singh said that dental students' study will examine the teeth of people in villages, cities, colonies, school students, and common people. This will benefit research and offer affordable oral healthcare to the marginal section of society. On this occasion, director Research and Medical Education Dr Avnish Kumar, joint director Dr Puneet Girhadar and Dr Akash, Colonel JV Singh, college principal Dr JS Mann, Dr Harnesh Sharma, Dr Gagandeep Kaur, and medical students were present. The minister added that the process has been completed and 39 vacant posts of dental doctors will be filled soon.

Urgent release of over Rs 1,000 crore RDF, market fees from Centre, case deferred to Sept 2 by Supreme Court

**NEW DELHI** : The Supreme Court Bench, has agreed to hear the Punjab Government's plea on September 2 after Attorney General R Venkataramani and Punjab Advocate General Gurminder Singh jointly made a request in this regard. The case deferred to September 2 the hearing on the Punjab Government's plea seeking an urgent release of over Rs 1,000 crore from the Centre on account of alleged dues of Market Fees and Rural Development Fees (RDF). A Bench led by CJI DY Chandrachud could not take up the matter due to paucity of time on Monday. The Punjab Government had last year filed a suit before



the Supreme Court against the Centre over the non-reimbursement of statutory fees allegedly running into thousands of crores of rupees that the state government had levied on behalf of the Central Government during the procurement of food grains. In its original suit filed under Article 131 of the Constitution, the State of Punjab complained against the Centre for refusing to transfer back the statutory Market Fees and Rural

Development Fees levied by the state on behalf of the Centre. Article 131 of the Constitution deals with original jurisdiction of the top court in a dispute between the Centre and one or more states or a dispute between two or more states. The levies are key to bearing the expenses of acquiring food grains with minimum transition losses, the State government explained. The dues on account of RDF were said to be to the tune of Rs 3637 crore from 2021 and market fees to the tune of Rs 2400 crore from 2022. The Centre's actions went against the Modified Fixation Principles in place since February 24, 2020, the Punjab Government submitted.

58 hi-tech ambulances flagged off by CM Bhagwant Mann

**CHANDIGARH** : Flanked by Health Minister Dr Balbir Singh, CM Bhagwant Mann dedicated 58 new hi-tech ambulances to the people of the state. With this addition to the fleet of ambulances, 325 ambulances have been pressed into the service of people to ensure that they get health services in time. These ultra-modern ambulances have been mandated to reach to the needy within 15 minutes in urban areas and 20 minutes in rural areas. Reiterating his government's commitment to providing quality health services to the people, Mr Mann on Sunday flagged off 58 new hi-tech ambulances to serve the people of the state. These ambulances will work in tandem with the Sadak Surkha Force to ensure that precious lives of people are saved in cases of emergency. The 58 hi-tech ambulances have been purchased at a cost of Rs 14 crore and are equipped with life-saving drugs and ultra-modern



equipment. Talking to mediapersons, Mann later said the Union Government had stalled state's Rs 1,000 crore funds under the National Health Mission. "It is not my problem that Punjabis have rejected the BJP. Maybe they are giving vent to their frustration of losing all Lok Sabha seats in Punjab by denying us our dues," he said. He said though they were committed to imparting quality health services in the state, the Union Government was hatching conspiracies to deny these to Punjabis. "They have stalled the release of grant under the NHM just to

torpedo pro-people initiatives being taken by the state government, as Punjab has a non-BJP government," he said. The CM said it was strange that despite immense contribution in the freedom struggle, making the country self-reliant in food production and safeguarding the unity, integrity and sovereignty of the country, Punjab has been completely ignored in the Union Budget. He said the Niti Aayog meetings were a futile exercise as states did not even get proper time to flag issues of their concern.

Rs 1L cr in Odisha to be invested by Railway in next 5 yrs

This roadmap shall help authority in deciding, approving and executing its projects and planning budgets. "The authority's sole purpose is the transformation of Gurugram into millennium city and achieve the target in next two decades. This can be called the blue print of the vision, which will systematically direct the development of the city," said CEO PC Meena. The plan focuses on a roadmap for authorities to follow in five areas education, healthcare, public safety,



recreation and socio-cultural facilities. The plan underlines the need for more schools, daycare centres in residential clusters, multi-purpose campuses of institutes, government healthcare facilities within three kilometres, parks in colonies, police posts and old-age homes. In the education sector, the assessment concluded that the five existing universities and another eight nursing and paramedical training institutes would meet the needs of the residents at the district level by 2041. But the city would need another 750 nursery schools, 430 more primary schools, and 686 secondary and senior secondary schools over the next two decades. Currently, there are 545 nursery schools, 279 primary schools, and 412 secondary and senior secondary schools in the city. On the health front, the city would need two more general hospitals, a civil hospital and

six veterinary hospitals. It currently has two government-run civil hospitals and five veterinary hospitals. About 210 speciality hospitals, diagnostic centres would be needed by 2041, 250 dispensaries and clinics, 25 nursing homes and maternity centres too. On public safety, the plan noted that there are 25 police posts in sectors, which need at least nine more, especially in Old Gurgaon and the new sectors that are now lined with housing societies. For recreation the plan seeks four district parks, 26 community parks and 747 neighbourhood parks in addition to sports complexes and a stadium. On socio-cultural activities, the key takeaway was the need for cultural centres, old-age homes (22), orphanages (16), night shelters (5), hostels for working people (3), and cremation and burial grounds (24) over the next 18 years.

## 'Single Judge's order gets stayed by High Court

Chandigarh: In July 17s order released two days ago, Justice Sehrawat had expressed deep displeasure against the Supreme Court (SC) for staying the orders passed in contempt of court petitions for non compliance of high court orders.

A division bench, comprising Chief Justice Sheel Nagu and Justice Anil Kshetarpal, passed these orders while taking suomotu cognizance of the order passed by Justice Sehrawat. Referring to a 2006 judgment, titled Midnapore Peoples' Coop. Bank Ltd. and others versus Chunilal Nanda and others, passed by the Supreme Court, the Chief Justice led division bench observed, "Where the single judge passes an



order, which is though not appealable before the division bench, but while doing so exceeds the power and jurisdiction which the single judge exercises, an appeal can very well be entertained." The Punjab and Haryana high court on Wednesday stayed the order passed by single bench of Justice Rajbir Singh Sehrawat in which certain comments were made "lowering the majesty and dignity of the

apex court". "To prevent any further damage etoge to the reputation and majesty of the rule of law and the Supreme Court and also of this court, the impugned order dated July 17, 2024, passed by the single judge shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing," the HC ordered - while adjourning the case for August 22.

## 'Media Club' formed with registered constitutional guidelines

Chandigarh :A case has been registered at vigilance bureau police station, Jalandhar range, and both the arrested accused will now be produced in court of law. The PNRC (Punjab Nursing Registration Council) was responsible for overseeing nursing colleges in Punjab, including granting recognition, allocating seats, and conducting ANM and GNM courses and examinations. During a probe into a complaint about fraudulent admissions and examinations, it was discovered that KD College of Nursing at Ma hilpur in Hoshiarpur district received recognition from the Indian Nursing Council in New Delhi on

Sept 25, 2019 and from the PNRC on Nov 29, 2012. However, the PNRC in Mohali had issued admission forms and receipt numbers to the college before its official recognition reached. The PNRC received admission forms for five roll numbers from KD College of Nursing, but these forms and roll numbers were actually issued to Princeton Institute of Nursing in Gurdaspur, said a spokesperson. Charanjit Kaur Cheema, former registrar of the Punjab Nursing Registration Council (PNRC), and Dr Arvinder veer Singh Gill for irregularities in nursing admissions and examinations have been arrested against their misconduct.

## Jagdeep Dhankhar hits back at Jaya Bachchan for 'tone is not right'

Kharge had demanded that Tiwari's remarks be expunged from the records.

Dhankhar kept reiterating that Tiwari was only "praising" Kharge in Sanskrit and meant no disrespect. To this, the Opposition MPs erupted in disagreement, alleging that the Chair was siding with Tiwari.

## Court raps Bibhav Kumar in Swati Maliwal case

Maliwal. Aa three-judge bench of Justices Surya Kant, Dipankar Datta and Ujjal Bhuyan was hearing the bail plea filed by Kumar challenging the Delhi High Court's recent order that denied him bail in the case. In May, a magisterial court in Delhi dismissed his bail plea.
