Commissioner News Service Mohali: Former Punjab Congress President Navjot Singh Sidhu alongwith social activists has filed a petition in the (NGT) National Green Tribunal New Delhi to interfere and the Punjab Government as it was going lethargic in the cases of illegal mining perhaps due to collusion of local police with the officials of mining department.

The congress leader has highlighted that an extensive mechanised mining and crushing of gravel has

damaged the local environment of Ropar town. The plea sought direction to identify erring officials who have allowed alleged illegal mining in Rupnagar and initiate action against such officials after a detailed investigation. The bench headed by Prakash Justice

Shrivastava on Monday after hearing the submissions of Advocates KC Mittal and Abhimanyu Walia, sought the response of all respondents and fixed the matter for March

Indore ranks "cleanest city" of India

Commissioner News Service New Delhi: The emergence of Indore as the cleanest city shows how it has come a long way from being one of the dirtiest cities that saw the epidemic of plague nearly three decades back. Indore's leapfrogging to cleanest city in 2017 from 25th rank in 2016 and maintaining that position for seven years is an indication that once people embrace cleanliness, it can become a part of their lives. The results of. " Swachh Suvekshan " 2023 were released by President Droupadi Murmu. She said about one-third of India's population lives in urban areas and cleanliness of cities and towns is essential for their health and develop-

ment. She lauded the efforts of all states, ULBs and citizens for taking steps for moving ahead on the path of prosperthrough cleanliness. 'articipation of citizens and all stakeholders is essential to maintain the achievements of cleanliness mission," she said.

In this survey, the cities, towns and ULBs were put under two categories based on population more than one भारत का सबसे स्वछ शहर

lakh and less than one lakh. In the more than one lakh category, 446 cities and municipal areas were ranked, while 3,970 towns and municipal areas were covered under the less than one lakh category. Ths survey covered 4,477 cities and ULBs the highest ever.

Indore made it, to the top of the list for the seventh time in a row, Surat emerged as the joint winner with the same score for the first time since the ranking at national level started in 2016.

Under the first category, Navi Mumbai emerged as the third cleanest city followed by Visakhapatnam, Bhopal, Vijayawada and the NDMC area of Delhi. In less than one lakh population cat-Sasvad in Maharashtra got the top rank, followed by Patan in Chhattisgarh and Lonavala in Maharashtra. Four out of the top five cities in this catwere Maharashtra. The bottom fivetowns in this ranking were from Nagaland.

Among the Ganga towns, Varanasi and Prayagraj won the top two awards and the cleanest cantonments award went to Mhow and Deolali. Chandigarh walked away with the award for "Best Surakshit Safaimitra Sheher" for putting in place the best ecosystem to protect the manpower engaged in cleanliness tasks. Among states, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh emerged as the cleanest. Arunachal Pradesh Mizoram, Rajasthan and Nagaland were the least clean.

No more online admission for EWS in minority schools



Chandigarh: The RTE can not be applied to minority schools. Such schools have been exempted from the online portal but all recognised unaided private minority and non minority schools would be required to meet their obligation to provide 15% reservation seats for EWS under the Allotment of Land to Educational Institutions (Schools) etc on leasehold basis in Chandigarh 1996, scheme Harsuhinder Brar, School Director Education, UT.

The minority schools in the city have been accorded exemption from the participation in the online i centralised economically weaker section and disadvantaged admission groups' process of the UT education department. There are 275 entry level EWS seats in the city ' 20 minority schools for the academic year 2023 - 24. In these schools off line admissions for EWS kids would be made and .will not be on the department portal. Admission forms could be filled in upto 10 Feb from 9 am to 1;pm said Ms Brar.

Maldives President Mohamed Muizzu sets March 15 deadline for Indian troops withdrawal

MALE: There are 88 Indian military personnel in the Maldives. Abdulla Nazim Ibrahim disclosed the public policy secretary at the President's Office President Muizzu has formally asked India to withdraw its military personnel by March 15.

President Maldivian Mohamed Muizzu has asked India to withdraw its military personnel from his country by March 15, a senior official here said on Sunday, nearly two months after Male sought their removal.

"Indian military personnel cannot stay in the Maldives. This is the policy of President Dr Mohamed Muizzu and that of this administration," he said. Maldives and India have set up a high-level core group to

negotiate the withdrawal of



troops. The group held its first meeting at the Foreign Ministry Headquarters in Male' on Sunday morning.

The meeting was also attended by Indian High Commissioner Mahawar, the report said.

Nazim confirmed the meeting and said the agenda for the meeting was the request to withdraw troops by March 15.

The Indian government did not immediately confirm the media report or comment on

Soon after taking oath as the President of Maldives on November 17 last year, Muizzu, who is regarded as a pro-China leader, formally requested India to withdraw

its military personnel from his country, saying the Maldivian people have given him a "strong mandate" to make this request to New Delhi.

The request for the withdrawal of Indian military personnel comes amid a row between the two nations in the backdrop of derogatory comments posted by three deputy ministers of the Muizzu government against Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Muizzu suspended the three ministers after their social media postings, which stirred concern in India and calls for a boycott by Indian tourists who ranked highest in numbers followed by Russia. Chinese tourists figured third.

During his just-concluded state visit to China, Muizzu sought to align Maldives closer to Beijing.

'We understand the pain that the people of Manipur have been through, we understand the hurt,

the sadness. We will bring back

harmony, peace and affection for which this state was known," he

The yatra will cover a distance of 6,713 km, straddling 100 Lok Sabha constituencies and 337 assembly segments and covering 110 districts. It will conclude in Mumbai on March 20 after 67

"Modi has time to drive by the sea, take a dip in the sea but has not come to Manipur. Modi keeps chanting 'Ram, Ram', but he should not do it to seek votes. The BJP mixes religion and politics, and incites people," he said at the launch of the yatra.

'The BJP has 'Ram' on its lips but carries a knife by their side. They should not have such an approach towards people," the Congress president said.




