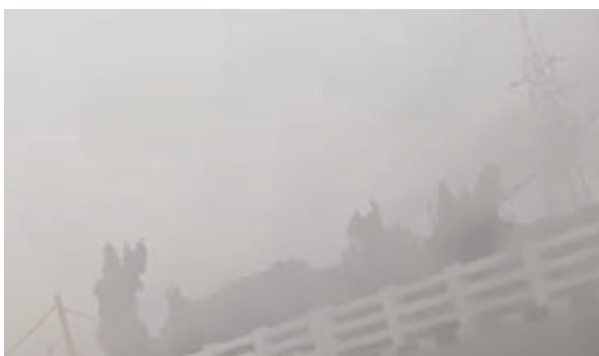

## India supports UN resolution against Israeli settlements in Palestine : United Nations

United Nations : India was one of the 145 nations voting in favor of a UN resolution against Israel's settlement activities in "the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, and in the occupied Syrian Golan" on Saturday. As many as seven countries, including Canada, Israel and US, voted against the resolution, while 18 abstained. The UN resolution was passed two days after its draft resolution was approved the other day. "By a recorded vote of 145 in favour to 7 against (Canada,



Hungary, Israel, Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Nauru, United States) with 18 abstentions, the Committee approved the draft resolution titled "Israeli settlements in the Occupied Palestinian Territory,

including East Jerusalem, and the occupied Syrian Golan," UN said in a statement. "By its terms, the Assembly would condemn settlement activities in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, and in the occupied Syrian Golan and any activities involving the confiscation of land, the disruption of the livelihood of protected persons, and the forced transfer of civilians and the annexation of land, whether de facto or through national legislation," it added

## Harassment of Outsourced employees to cease, no sacking by contractor : UT Administration

Chandigarh: The UT administration has directed no outsourced employee can be removed from service by a private job contractor without its approval. "Now contractor cannot at his whims and fancies sack an outsourced employee. The directions came after a slew of complaints against contractors were received," said an official. Outsourced employees have repeatedly brought to the knowledge of the administration that contractor demand a part of the employee's salary for ensuring his continuation on payroll. "If the employees refuses to pay the demanded amount or complained about it, contrac-



tors threaten to fire such employees.. This has been happening for several years now. Even otherwise there is a no job security for outsourced employees as they work at the mercy for the contractor, " said an outsourced employee working in the UT engineering department . The administration has failed to stop the fleeing and exploitation, according to sources. On the other hand UT officials have maintained that they have little or no control over

the contractors hired through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM), a national procurement portal . "We are mandated to hire contractors from the GeM. The lowest bidder gets the contract. Also, the administration has little control over the contractor employee relationship. Through the administration had instructed that contractors deposit the salary directly into the employs' accounts, it has failed to curb the harassment. As the UT cannot control two after the salary is deposited, it was decided that instructions should be issued that a contractor cannot remove the employee without the nod from the department officials concerned," said the official.

## BJP challenges Municipal voter list

PATIALA : Against alleged gross errors in the voter's lists for the municipal corporation elections Punjab BJP Mahila Morcha president Jai Inder Kaur on Thursday lodged a protest with Patiala deputy commissioner Sakshi Sawhney. Said, "The new lists have many errors such as missing area names and illegal inclusion of remote areas by crossing ward limits. When there is no increase in the ward count resetting their limits is illegal. For the municipal polls, votes are always counted door to door, but this time it was done after tearing up papers from the lists that were prepared for the assembly elections" "If the civic elections are



based on these lists, no candidate from any party will be able to locate its voters, and even the voters will fall to find their nominees. The BJP demands a door-to-door survey for listing the voters again. By these 60 lists, some wards have only 2,200 to 2,500 to 10,000 or 12,000." Said Jai Inder Kaur.

## CBI registers 2 cases over Rs 100 Cr land grab deal

Chandigarh/Zirakpur : Observing that the abuse of process of law called for a detailed investigation in the present case so that the trust of the litigants in the system doesn't get eroded, the high court had ordered a CBI probe in the matter. Consequently, CBI booked Sanjiv Kumar Gaba and Rajesh Kumar Gaba of Zirakpur, besides Rajinder Kumar and Sarabjit Singh of Delhi, under Sections 420 (cheating), 465 (forgery), 467 (forgery of valuable security), 468 (forgery for purpose of cheating) and 471 (using forged document as genuine) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) in the first FIR. It was alleged that the accused used goons and muscle-men armed with deadly weapons to illegally take possession of the property. The accused also misused judicial process with the help of an



advocate by attempting to shift the entire forum of litigation from Mohali, and putting pressure on the complainant by filing multiple frivolous civil and criminal suits in the courts, the petitioner had further alleged. As per the plea, the trust, which is over 100 years old, had purchased various properties from time to time. Among these was a chunk of 8 acres along the Zirakpur-Patiala highway, which was purchased in 1986 fake trust was created by forging documents by the accused to forcibly take possession of the land.

## Over deepening climate crisis, US, China compromise under G20 pact

New Delhi: Two largest emitters of greenhouse gases (GHG) - have decided to jointly back the New Delhi G20 Leader's Declaration on tripling renewable energy capacity globally by 2030. Seeking to find a common ground ahead of the UN climate conference (COP26) in Dubai later this month both the countries also decided to work together to deal with methane emission and plastic pollution and tackle all GHG through 2035 climate action targets. The decisions taken in a meeting



held between the US special presidential envoy for climate John Kerry and China's special envoy for climate change Xie Zhenhua at Sunnylands, California last week. The joint statement remained silent through on the need to rapidly transition away from fossil fuels this

decade - a key point which will be one of the central issues for discussion at COP28. "This agreement sends a clear signal that, in an increasingly turbulent world, climate change challenge provides unique opportunity to strengthen global solidarity" said COP28 president - designate, Sultan Al Jaber. The talks between the two countries over the climate issues were stalled in 2022 due to unease in China in the wake of the visit of former House of Representatives Speaker Nancy Pelosi to Taiwan.

China to supplement  
 Hamas and Arab Nations

China wants the US to back off on Taiwan, as it perceives that the US is mobilising Japan, the Philippines and Australia to robustly challenge it. Beijing also wants that the issues of democracy and human rights should not be raised by the US. China is keen that its path to development within its economic and political order should not be unduly criticised or impeded by America and its allies. It decries sanctions on hi-tech exports by the US, and the encouragement to decoupling and ‘China plus one’ policies. China also wants to avoid the ‘autocracy vs democracy’ debate. The Chinese aim is to exploit the situation to side with Hamas and Arab nations. It hopes to find a role as a mediator in West Asia, which is actually an arena of US policy preferences. The China-Russia-Iran axis will work towards this end. Zhai Jun, China’s special envoy to West Asia, met Mikhail Bogdanov, the Russian President’s special representative for West Asia and Africa, in Qatar last week and enunciated this strategy. China offers the possibility of a G2 management of the world since it has Russia firmly behind it. If it gets that G2 opportunity, it promises to offer a constructive and cooperative

relationship with the US. Meanwhile, it has imposed curbs on graphite exports to counter the US move to inhibit technology exports to China. China, it seems, is seeking a panda moment again in its ties with the US. Some of the pandas gifted to the US around 1972 are scheduled to return to China in December this year, but if a Xi-Biden summit is held in November, new pandas may actually come to the US and bring new green shoots. China hosted the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) summit on October 17-18, while holding out the promise of a Xi-Biden meeting on the sidelines of the APEC summit, but putting forth its conditions quite clearly. China acknowledges that there are many differences with the US, but these can be bridged if a commonality is worked out. As always, the Chinese are looking for ‘mutual respect’ among their core interests. This is where China’s West Asia interests come into play. China has been creating an alternative alliance with Russia and Iran, whose main aim is to destabilise American policies. Since Iran isn’t in the US-brokered Accords, this could mean adopting an anti-Israel attitude and provoking an Arab

reaction against Israel where feasible. The quick pace of the Accords and the speed with which Saudi Arabia was moving towards a rapprochement with Israel was unsettling for the perceived loss of influence for China. China invested considerably in the S a u d i - I r a n rapprochement in March this year. Saudi Arabian embrace of Israel is impacting Chinese interests. Therefore, the Hamas attack against Israel, whether provoked by Iran, China or others, is manna from heaven for the Chinese policy in West Asia. Neither China nor Russia has condemned Hamas, but they continue to criticise Israel for its Palestinian policy. Given China’s influence with Iran, it is noticeable that the US has not directly blamed Iran for the Hamas strikes. This is to keep the pot boiling and allowing China leeway in the region. Condemning Israel, not criticising Hamas, fostering Arab unity and resumption of peace talks between Palestine and Israel for a two-state solution, preferably facilitated by China, are the objectives. A bigger Chinese role will be a reduction of the US influence, and hence Washington may seek a cooperative complementary effort with China to address the Israeli quagmire.

MC to raise temporary night  
shelters for 3 months at  
7 places

**CHANDIGARH** : Amongst 7 places where the waterproof shelters will come up, would include near the GMCH-32, the GMSH-16, the PGI, the ISBT-17 and the ISBT-43. The city Municipal Corporation (MC) has prepared to set up temporary night shelters at seven locations for three months (from December 1 to February 28). The facility will cost the civic body about Rs 1.33 crore. These shelters are set up every winter for the homeless and needy people. According to information, fire safety equipment, lighting facility,



electricity connections, drinking water and toilet facilities will be provided at these shelters. Besides, cushioned carpet, quilts, mattresses, pillows and blankets will be available. CCTVs will be installed inside and outside the shelters. Meanwhile, residents said the MC should have its own temporary night shelter arrangements rather than every floating tender every year and

hiring a private agency for the job. “They should make city’s existing permanent Raen Baseras functional and run them in good condition. Spending such a huge amount on temporary night shelters makes no sense. Their utility should also be observed. Despite these shelters, people are seen spending night in market corridors,” said RK Garg, president of a city-based senior citizens’ body.

Work on Phase-II of IAF  
Heritage Centre yet stalks

**CHANDIGARH** : The “Indian Air Force Aerospace and Technical Centre”, was delayed over the maintenance of the artefacts at the heritage centre. The UT Administration wanted the IAF to take over the upkeep of the centre, as it lacked expertise. Later, the Air Force authorities in principle agreed to take over maintenance of artefacts at the centre, but are yet to submit a communication in writing to the UT Administration. Two months after the IAF authorities submitted their proposal for the expansion of the centre at the Government Press Building, Sector 18, its maintenance responsibilities become a point of contention between the UT Administration and the IAF. Expansion of the Indian Air Force (IAF) Heritage Centre under Phase II has been stuck up as the Air force authorities are yet to give a reply in writing to the UT Administration for its maintenance. Officially named as “Indian Air Force Aerospace and Technical Centre”, the proposal of expansion of the heritage centre under Phase II was submitted in July. At present, Phase I of the centre is being handled by the UT Tourism Department. However, in July this year, the IAF had submitted an expansion plan to the UT Administration. The UT Administration sent a letter to



the IAF authorities, expressing their lack of expertise in artefact maintenance and suggesting that the IAF should take this responsibility. A senior UT officer stated that they had communicated to the IAF authorities that they did not possess the necessary expertise for artefact maintenance, and it should, therefore, be carried out by the IAF. When the proposal was submitted, IAF officers had stated that once a memorandum of understanding (MoU) was finalised, work would begin within a month and completed within six months. Under Phase II, the centre will have advanced technology-driven features aimed at inspiring youngsters to join the Air Force. The new wing will be constructed in an adjoining hall covering an area of nearly 13,000 sq ft. It will have a display of technology-based and electronic systems, simulators and aero engines. The project has been cleared by the IAF authorities.

Free 2-wheeler parking to  
begin from Dec 1

**CHANDIGARH** : “This is a Diwali gift to the residents of the city as well as visitors to market places. We had intended to provide a relief to two-wheeler riders for a long time. Though the tendering process for the same will take time, today being Diwali’s eve, I have decided to announce free parking facility from December 1” said Gupta. Mayor Anup Gupta announced free parking for two-wheelers in all paid-parking sites that fall within the jurisdiction of the civic body from December 1. The General House of the MC had approved the agenda regarding free parking of two-wheelers in all parking sites in July. According to the agenda, all two-wheelers will be exempt from the parking fee. The Mayor said there were 89 parking sites in Chandigarh that were managed by the Municipal Corporation



and all had an equal parking space for two-wheelers as well as four-wheelers. At present, the corporation charges Rs 7 for two-wheeler parking. Car parking charges is Rs 14. However, in the last House meeting, it was approved that car parking charges would be Rs 15 for four hours. For parking up to 8 hours, Rs 20 will be charged. After that, Rs 10 will be charged per hour. However, there will be double the charges for cars registered outside the tricity. All rates will be applicable once FASTag-based smart parking system is introduced following tendering process.

Apply for the post of  
RERA chief, interviews fall  
on November 18

**CHANDIGARH** : Eyeing post-retirement rehabilitation, atleast 16 Haryana bureaucrats are in race for the posts of chairpersons and the member. A total of 34 candidates are vying for each post of chairperson while 63 are in fray for member’s post. Now Decks have finally been cleared for the appointment of chairpersons for Panchkula and Gurugram Benches of the Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA) and a member of the Panchkula Bench. The Haryana government has invited the candidates for interview for the post of chairperson on November 18. and for the member’s post on November 17 and 18. Among the former IAS officers, who are eyeing both the posts are Varinder Singh Kundu, Sunil Kumar Gulati,

Arun Kumar, Alok Nigam, Mahavir Singh, Rajeev Arora and Dheera Khandelwal, all former IAS officers, and Yogender Chaudhary, former IRS. The Haryana Government constituted two benches of RERA—Gurugram (with jurisdiction in Gurugram) and Panchkula (with jurisdiction in rest of Haryana) in 2017—to provide an institutional grievance redressal mechanism to property buyers and regulate the largely-unregulated real estate sector across the state. KK Khandewal and Rajan Gupta, chairpersons of the Gurugram and Panchkula Benches, respectively, retired earlier this year. A substantial number of bureaucrats and other professionals apply for these lucrative posts which carry handsome salaries and other perks, including palatial bungalow and official car.

Rs 60 lakh approved for repair  
of RUB at Mubarkpur

**MOHALI** : The approaches had been damaged during the floods. The railway under the bridge was handed over to the PWD by the Railway Department for maintenance. An estimate of Rs 1.20 crore has been prepared by the Public Works Department for this purpose. Out of the total amount, PWD will have to bear half of the expenses, while the District Administration will bear the other half. The District Administration has approved its part, and an intimation in this regard will be sent to the PWD head office to issue the rest of the amount, said Deputy Commissioner (DC) Aashika Jain. In a meeting held at the



District Administrative Complex today, the District Mineral Foundation (DMF) approved Rs 60 lakh apart from the already demanded Rs 60 lakh from the PWD for the repair of the approaches to the railway underbridge at Mubarkpur in Dera Bassi. The DMF has also approved in principle to plant 12,000 bamboo trees along the banks of Ghaggar and Tangri to strengthen the soil across both rivers. The foundation also gave the nod to provide

gym equipment to the 11 villages in Dera Bassi Block. The DC said that the villages that have been declared drug-free have been selected for this program. She added that this would inspire neighbouring villages to get included in this list. She further said that each village would be given gym equipment worth Rs 2.5 lakh. Jain said that the three public sand-mines that had stopped work during floods have resumed functioning, and the cheaper sand at the rate of Rs 5.50 per cubic foot has been made available at the pit heads. She added that the purchaser would be bored with the transportation and loading costs.

Dog bite victim to get Rs 10,000 per  
tooth mark compensation, rules  
Punjab and Haryana High Court

**CHANDIGARH** : The state government shall be primarily responsible for paying compensation to victims of dog bites, adding that the minimum financial assistance would be Rs 10,000 per tooth mark, ruled the Punjab and Haryana High Court on Tuesday. “When the flesh is removed from the skin, the compensation will be at least Rs 20,000 per 0.2 cm wound,” the court ruled. The ruling came during a hearing on a batch of petitions pertaining to dog bite incidents. Disposing of a batch of 193 petitions, the high court also mandated the



governments of Punjab and Haryana and the Union Territory of Chandigarh to set up committees headed by the deputy commissioners of the respective districts to determine such compensation. “The award should be issued by the Committees within four months of the filing of the claims along with the necessary documents. The State shall be primarily

responsible for paying the compensation, to the defaulting agencies of the state, from the resources of the state, with the right to recover, or a private person,” a single bench of Justice Vinod S Bharadwaj ruled. The ruling assumes significance at a time when dog bite cases have been on the rise across the country.

Voters of Kalka, Panchkula  
to file objections till  
December 9 : ECI

**PANCHKULA** : Voters can get the entries recorded in the voters’ list corrected and name transferred from one polling station to another under the Assembly constituency during this time, for which eligible persons must enter the new name in the voter list, said Deputy Commissioner and District Election Officer Sushil Sarwan. As per the instructions of the Election Commission of India (ECI), claims and objections regarding the voters’ list will be taken up by December 9. Persons who will be aged 18 or more on January 1, 2024, can get their names registered in the electoral rolls ahead the upcoming elections. Form number 7 will have to be filled to remove the name of an ineligible voter while form number 8 will have to be submitted for corrections, changing location (outside the Assembly constituency) and remove duplicate cards.



Sarwan said, photocopies of necessary documents such as proof of age, residence, ration card, etc would have to be attached with each claim. All these forms would be available free of cost at polling stations and respective offices. He said as per the instructions of the ECI, the booth-level officers would be present at all polling stations to address claims and objections in regards the revision of the electoral rolls during the special campaign on November 25 and 26. He urged all the voters of both Assembly constituencies in the district — Kalka and Panchkula — to check their names in the voters’ list on the official

website of the Chief Electoral Officer: www.ceoharyaryana.nic.in. Voters can also check their details at the district election office, Panchkula, during any working day. “If the name of a voter has been removed from the list for any reason and the voter is present at his place, he/she can get his name included in the electoral rolls by filling form number 6 by December 9,” said the district election officer. He added that voters can also fill these forms online through the National Voters’ Service Portal (NVSP) app or the Voter Helpline App (VHA) issued by the Election Commission of India.

## Purohit accords assent to FRBM Bill, shelves Budget Session of Punjab Vidhan Sabha

**CHANDIGARH** : It may be mentioned here that the Punjab Government had approached the Supreme Court last month against the decision of the Governor declaring the October 20 special sitting as invalid and his refusal to give consent to the Money Bills. The Governor had been objecting to the extension of the session after its adjournment and convening special sittings of the House without getting it prorogued. After the tussle between Punjab Governor Banwarilal Purohit and Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann reached the Supreme Court, the former on Thursday prorogued the Budget Session of the Punjab Vidhan Sabha. Governor Purohit has also



given his consent to the Punjab Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management (Amendment) Bill (FRBM), 2023. The Bill is to be presented in the Winter Session of the Vidhan Sabha, which is proposed to be held in the last week of November. With this, all three money Bills that the government wanted to be tabled in the Vidhan Sabha have been given the nod by the Governor. The other two money Bills — The Punjab Goods and Services Tax

(Amendment) Bill, 2023, and the Indian Stamp (Punjab Amendment) Bill, 2023 — were given the nod on October 31. However, no decision has been taken on the four Bills passed by the Punjab Vidhan Sabha in its two-day special sitting held on June 19-20. These Bills include the Sikh Gurdwaras (Amendment) Bill, 2023; the Punjab Universities Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2023; the Punjab Police (Amendment) Bill, 2023; and the Punjab Affiliated Colleges Amendment Bill, 2023. Though the Governor had termed the special sitting of the Vidhan Sabha in June invalid, the apex court, on November 10, had declared the sitting as valid and asked the Governor to decide on the fate of these Bills.

## Mumbai to get special train for Ayodhya from next year: BJP President

**MUMBAI** : A "special" train to Ayodhya will run after January 24 next year for Mumbaiers to visit the newly constructed Ram temple, said BJP president Ashish Shelar. Consecration ceremony will be

held at the Ram temple in Ayodhya on January 22, 2024. Speaking at a function on Tuesday, Shelar said Mumbaiers will be able to take the special train from Dadar to Ayodhya for "darshan" of Lord Ram.

## Voter enrolment period extended to next year Feb 29

**AMRITSAR** : A fresh notification was issued by the Gurdwara Election Commission with a revised schedule in this regard. The last date for receipt of claims and objections will be April 11, 2024. The final publication of the voters' list will be May 3, 2024. The voters' enrolment process for the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC) general poll has been pushed to February 29, 2024. Earlier, the voters' registration was between October 21 and November 15. Many Sikh organisations, including the SGPC, had approached Justice SS Saron (retd), Commissioner, Gurdwara Election Commission, apprising him



about the problems being faced by members in registering their votes. In the 2011 elections, a total of 52.69 lakh voters were registered in Punjab, followed by 3.37 lakh in Haryana, 23,011 in Himachal and 11,932 in Chandigarh. As Haryana may be out of the picture this time as it has already constituted a separate ad-hoc Haryana Sikh Gurdwara Management

Committee, the voters from Himachal and Chandigarh would participate in the SGPC poll. While Chandigarh has started the enrolment procedure from today, Himachal has yet to start this exercise. Thus, taking cognisance of flaws in the registration process, the Gurdwara Election Commission has extended the window.

## Environmentalists raise concern over amended Forest Act from Dec 1

**CHANDIGARH** : Environmentalists have expressed concern over potential forest exploitation by private companies as the amendments consolidate more power in the hands of the Central government. From December 1, amendments to the Forest (Conservation and Augmentation) Act, 1980, encompass permission for infrastructure development within 100 km of the International Border (IB). With this, construction along the roads, railway tracks and eco-tourism projects like



safaris and zoos in the forest areas can be developed. Punjab shares 550-km IB with Pakistan, spread across Pathankot, Gurdaspur, Amritsar, Tarn Taran, Ferozepur and Fazilka districts. Senior Forest Department functionary said the amendments might escalate the pace of forest degradation and ecology.

The official said, "The exemptions are not only for defence projects, but for public utility services as specified by the Centre." "Safaris and eco-parks in the forest areas will put a huge pressure on the ecosystem," said environmentalists, adding that eco-tourism projects require massive infrastructure development.

## 65k applicants for 487 teaching posts

Chandigarh: The Department of education has once again extended the application deadline, particularly for the post of JBT now accepting applications until November 30 for a total of 293 vacancies. The application process, initiated three month ago in July has faced several extensions due to pending court matters. "Now that these clarifications issue are resolved, we are hopeful to conclude this recruitment by year end" started the director of education, Harsuinder Brar. During this period, approximately 53, 119 applications were submitted, and the corresponding fees were paid. The ongoing recruitment



drive for teaching cadres in the UT education department has witnessed over 65,000 applications received for 487 posts distributed across three cadres : JBT PGT and special educators. For the 98 vacant positions for POTs, 6,439 applicants completing the fee payment

process. In the case of 96 posts of special educators (JBTs and TGTs), the department has received around 5,662 applications and payments. Notably, this includes 96 JBT PwD candidates and 179 TGT PwD candidates . The education department initiated the recruitment details for various teaching cadres in July. The application windows opened on July 20 for JBT, September 20 for special education and the most recent one on October 25for PGTs. The recruitment for JBTs is taking place after eight years, and for PGTs, it marks a significant event after 20 year. Applications for JBTs and PGTs are still being accepted.

## Landslide, technicalities in drilling machine, obstruct Uttarkashi operations

Dehradun: Operations to rescue 40 labourers trapped under a collapsed tunnel's debris here for the last three days have been hampered after a landslide at the site and technical issues in a drilling machine being used to create an escape passage, officials said.

The labourers are safe, and oxygen, electricity, medicines, food items and water are being constantly supplied to them, they said.

Rubble from the landslide fell on the collapsed part of the under-construction Silkyara tunnel on Tuesday night, hampering operations as well as injuring two rescue workers. They are being treated at a makeshift hospital, the officials said. Operations to rescue 40 labourers trapped under a collapsed tunnel's debris here for the last three days have been hampered after a landslide at the

A new platform is being built inside the tunnel for another drilling machine, which is on the way, said an official at the police control room near the site. Some more equipment is being brought from Delhi by air to aid rescue efforts, according to officials of the State and National Disaster Response Forces. They added that the drilling machine at the site is facing some technical problems.

What we're trying to is to change the relationship for the better."Asked what he hoped to achieve at the meeting, he said he wanted "to get back on a normal course of corresponding; being able to pick up the phone and talk to one another if there's a crisis; being able to make sure our (militaries) still have contact with one another."

## 1926 stall permits generated Rs 44 Lakh revenue for MC

Chandigarh: The local civic body has harvested Rs 44 lakh from 1,926 people who took permits to set up stalls across the city. Though permission was given only through online mode, now in specting teams will also issue manual slips till Sunday, but on double charges.

"Since some people in stall temporary stalls in the market areas during Diwali festival to sell their articles , we give them permission on the spot, but the authority charges double amount for the same. Moreover, only authorized place are permitted for installing stalls in the market or the commercial arears," an official said.

Since many markets are witnessing huge footfalls, multiple parameters like area, locations and shops are kept in mind while giving booking space for installing temporary



stalls, "The key issue is that there should not be any hindrance to movement," sources said .

Earlier, the civic body authority had earmarked "I m Chandigarh" mobile app , though which all the bookings were done. Like the previous year, no permission will be given in any part of the Plaza area of Sector 17, which is prohibited for vendors. Moreover, no stalls will be allowed in any areas of Sectors 1 to 6 of C h a n d i g a r h "Moreover, all parking areas, pedestrian paths, footpaths and cycle tracks of the ambit, and nobody will be allowed to open stalls in such points" said a source.

## Haryana appoints retired officers as CVOs

Chandigarh: A circular issued with regard to the appointments by chief secretary Sanjeev Kaushal started that a CVO would head vigilance division of an organisation and act as a special assistant/ adviser to the administrative secretary / head of department on all vigilance matters. The multifaceted role involves preventive vigilance functions, aiming to thwart corrupt practices by identifying potential corruption spots and sources. Mandated with ensuring integrity of ongoing projects, the CVOs have been directed to conduct thorough scrutiny inspections and surprise checks within the department / board/ corporation concerned. Special attention is to given towards areas prone to discretion or favoritism, such as the awarding of tenders, the progression of civil works, and Instances of potential abuse of discretionary powers

in decision- making processes. Following these assessments CVOs are required to submit detailed findings, accompanied by recommendations for rectifying irregularities, to the administrative secretary/head of the department. Further more , copies of these recommendations are to be endorsed and forwarded to chief secretary and special secretary vigilance department.

The Haryana government has appointed serving and retired officers to the post of chief vigilance department on deputation and contract basic, respectively. Serving officers appointed to the position of CVO include Deepak Bura, district attorney (DA), HRD, Haryana civil secretariat ; Dinesh Rathee, SE, irrigation &water resources department, and Krishan Kumar, joint director, technical education. ## Bureaucracy Vs elected government in Delhi flare up

New Delhi: The clash between the elected government and bureaucracy came out in Delhi's divisional commissioner, Ashwani Kumar, in an unusual move, addressed his second press conference in about five months. ect. While the original award for the 19 acre land was Rs 41.5 crore, it was raised to almost Rs 353, 8 crore in may this year by then district magistrate (southwest) Hemant Kumar. Atishi had sought all files related to the land acquisition from the divisional commissioner and the vigilance director. The divisional commissioner, who is the reporting manager of the district magistrates, claimed the CS had no role to play in awarding the compensation to the land downers or enhancing it and that he had rather proactively ensured that necessary action was taken against the district magistrate. The DM was first transferred and later suspended by the ministry of home affairs.

## Commuters get direct shuttle for IGI Airport from today

Chandigarh: The CTU is set to start a shuttle bus service (HVAC) from the Inter State Bus Terminal, Sector 17 to IGI Airport Delhi, from November 14. "Presently, CTU has been providing its bus service for various desti-

Now, to facilitated the general public of Chandigarh and to promote simple, efficacious and reliable public transportation services CTU is going to start its IGI Airport, New Delhi with effect from November 14, disclosed an official.

## MC to authorise free parking for 2 wheelers from Dec 1
