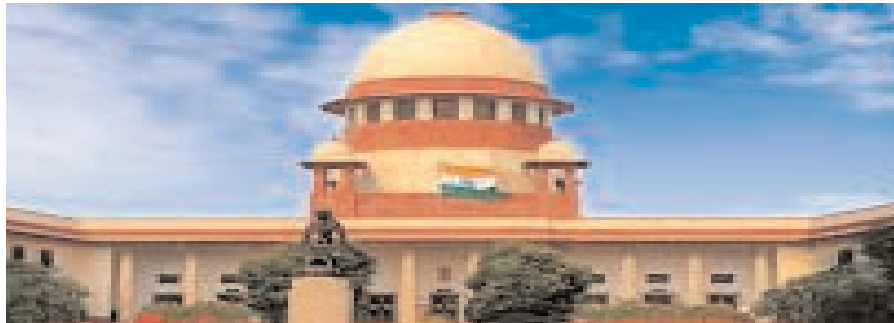
## Demarcation of "Pearl Group" land hangs fire, vigilance on tenterhooks

*The commercial land of 'Green Lotus Utsav' on PR-7 lies undemarcated by the revenue department*

Zirakpur : Last year , on 29 June 2023, Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann had in press, announced that each single penny of invested property property by gullible persons in PACL (Pearl Group) would be compensated by auctioning the amassed ill gotten wealth of the property s h a r k s . Now, how much land

for demarcation vide registered deeds raising the fingers, but had been ordered by Justice RM Lodha (Retd) Committee on 13th Sept 2022. The real estate "Pearl Group" company stands embroiled in a scam and its bail to Gurmeet Singh, Subrata Bhattacharjee , the then directors of the PACL (Pearl Agro Group) on 5 Sept was



rejected by the Honourable Supreme Court, New Delhi. It is nearing about 2

years as the Lodha Committee had on 13 Sept 2022 sent its orders of demarcation

of PACL land to AI GOO --cum-- Chairman SIT of Investigation (Pb) .

In pursuit of the Supreme Court and the district administration orders, the Naib Tehsildar Zirakpur had on 27th June 2023 written a letter to Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate DeraBassi when the land owner Sukhdev Singh and Surjit Singh applied vide their application no. 43 for the de facto demarcation of their land ,as it was earlier

not beneficial and forced upon. On a visit to Chhat village, the CNS has learnt that many other gullible land victims were not consulted, as there were harsh ditches, stony layers, not fertiles and productive. They demanded demarcation of their land along with Surjit p a r t i e s . After the considerable span of period, not

finding an iota of positive development on the orders of the Lodha Committee, the petitioners filed a case of "contempt of court, ' in the honourable Panjab & Haryana High Court. The case was spearheaded by a battery of 5 lawyers being heard by single bench led by Justice Arvind Singh Sangwan.

## Road Mechanical Sweeping to Become Operational by Mid Next Month

Mohali : A total of Rs 10 Crores has been allocated for the procurement of 4 mechanical sweeping machines .These state of the art machines are expected to substantially ameliorate the facade of the dirty streets and convert the sanitary aspect much better than the past ,said Navjot Kaur, the local Municipal Commissioner. The cost of the project has been concluded Rs 41 .53 Cr that underscores the scale and the importance of the mechanical sweeping initiatives. With is budget ,only 6 machines have been purchased . The significant investment would mean substantive results in town 's



waste management infrastructure and would contribute to more hygienic and cleaner urban environment. The company "Global Waste Management Pvt Ltd " had been assigned work orders . Focusing on high traffic areas and main roads and various parts of the city ,the machines would be

deployed . Such machines are already designed to automatically weep and collect debris ,dust and other waste materials from streets leaving the areas clean and brights. Since the manual process is time consuming and labour intensive and results are lackadaisical, speak the volumes of the past sanitation.

"Hillbilly Elegy" also introduced Mr. Vance to the Trump family. Donald Trump Jr. loved the book and knew of Mr. Vance when he went to launch his political career. The two hit it off and have remained friends.

## Captain, 3 Army personnel killed in gunfight with terrorists in J&K's Doda

Doda (J & K) 4 Army personnel including an officer, died in gunfight with terrorists in Doda. The Gunfight lasted for nearly 20 minutes after search operation. More terrorists believed to be hiding in area. In an encounter with heavily armed terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir's Doda district on Monday, the attack was claimed by 'Kashmir Tigers', a shadow group of Pakistan-backed terrorist group .(JeM) jaish-e-Mohammad "General Upendra Dwivedi, COAS, and all ranks of Indian Army convey their



deepest condolences to the bravehearts like Captain Brijesh Thapa, Naik D Rajesh, Sepoy Bijendra and Sepoy Ajay Naruka, who laid down their lives in the line of duty, while undertak-

ing a counter terrorist operation in Doda in order to ensure peace in the region," the Army said in a statement. After a brief exchange of fire, the officials said the terrorists attempted to escape but were chased by the troops led by an officer, despite challenging terrain and thick foliage, leading to another firefight in the woods at nearly 9 pm. In a statement, the terror group 'Kashmir Tigers' said the clash and gunfire erupted while the security forces launched a search operation for the "Mujahideen" .

## Better storm water drainage system to evolve

Chandigarh: During the last rainy season, numerous complaints were received from the public regarding stagnation of storm water at various locations in Sector 43. In the follow up, the area was inspected by the field officers concerned along with the area councillor and discovered that the existing storm water drainage (SWD) system in front of the community centre and near ISBT-43 had been completely choked, filled with silt and debris, thereby blocking the lines completely and causing obstruction in the draining of rain water. It is further said rainwater



stagnation was also witnessed near judicial academy in Sector 43 as there is no SWD system for disposal of rainwater. The current situation leads to accumulation of rainwater on the road, causing inconvenience to motorists and pedestrians alike. Thus, to mitigate the

problem of the residents, it is essential to lay SWD pipelines in the affected areas to mitigate the issue of stagnant water. Therefore, for the affected area, estimate as per requisite field data has been prepared to ensure proper functioning of the SWD system.

## Delhi court extends Kejriwal's judicial custody in CBI's corruption case till July 25

New Delhi : Before Special Judge Kavari Baweja, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal was produced through video conferencing. A court in New Delhi on July 12 extended till July 25 the judicial custody of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal in the corruption case linked to the alleged excise policy scam being probed by the CBI. Mr. Kejriwal was produced through video conferencing before Special Judge Kavari Baweja. He appeared in connection with the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and Enforcement Directorate (ED) cases on the expiry of



his judicial custody. Earlier in the day, the Supreme Court had granted him interim bail in the money laundering case linked to the alleged scam. In May, the ED had filed its seventh supplementary charge sheet in the case, naming Mr. Kejriwal and his Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) as accused.

EDITORIAL -

BRICS muscles up to counter West

As many as 33 countries are waiting to join BRICS. This is a huge number. Since 2010, when South Africa joined BRICS, it remained a club of five countries — Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa. In 2023, during the South African chairmanship, six countries were invited to join the bloc: Argentina, Ethiopia, Egypt, Iran, Saudi Arabia and the UAE. Argentina withdrew, while Saudi Arabia has not ratified its membership. The criteria-based approach was ignored in this rush. Among Ethiopia, Iran, the UAE and Egypt, there is a mix of pro- and anti-Western countries. But the dominant theme is how to join another pole in the emerging international order and seek greater economic opportunities for themselves. Indonesia’s reluctance to join the first expansion has left a gap in BRICS because no Southeast Asian country is a member so far. Indonesia, which was then the chair of ASEAN and had successfully helmed the G20 in 2022, was seen as an ideal partner. But it demurred. One reason was that it did not want to be a party to the international contestation between the US and China, assuming that it saw BRICS as a China-led grouping. Economically, Indonesia placed its bets on its application for the membership of the OECD (Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development). Hence, it did not find BRICS equally attractive. There are three ASEAN countries seeking BRICS membership — Vietnam, Thailand and Malaysia. Public pronouncements by their leadership have varied. Thailand and Malaysia are more public about their efforts, while Vietnam, which recently hosted Russian President Vladimir Putin, has been discreet. Other applicants include Venezuela, Senegal, Cuba, Kazakhstan, Belarus, Bahrain and Pakistan. Why this eagerness of ASEAN countries to join BRICS? They are not taking an ASEAN position on BRICS. Indonesia perhaps thought there should be an ASEAN point of view on BRICS before ASEAN members sought to join. On international issues like the Ukraine war and the Gaza crisis, there is minimal, if any, common ASEAN view. Various ASEAN countries see BRICS as having political and economic influence, which has been significantly higher since the outbreak of the Ukraine crisis. Russia, China and India offer economic opportunities for trade and investment, which in several applicants for BRICS membership think could benefit them. Thailand and Malaysia view their applications as a Global South initiative to seek a more determined international order where they could have a bigger voice. They seek to leverage South-South cooperation, play a more proactive role through BRICS and participate in a more balanced international order. Prioritising multilateralism, strengthening the role

For one person, one prepaid SIM to combat cybercrime : Pb & Hry High Court

**CHANDIGARH :** For an exceptional proposition with a concept transformative in telecommunication policy: one person, one prepaid number would be better mechanism. The innovative initiative aims to disconnect the society from the growing menace of cybercrime. Justice Anoop Chitkara also suggested hanging up on the issue of call routing via international cellular networks and the internet by implementing default blocking of incoming calls with international country calling codes. The subscribers, at the same time, could be given the option to join-in at their discretion. “This strategy guarantees that subscribers exclusively receive calls pertinent to their geographical context. For instance, individuals devoid of overseas acquaintances or relations may question the necessity of receiving calls originating from international codes featuring prefixes such as +91 or +00. Conversely, subscribers who have



traveled internationally or maintain connections abroad retain the flexibility to activate incoming calls from specific countries,” Justice Chitkara asserted. Justice Chitkara also added the Union Ministry of Telecommunication as a respondent before directing the officer concerned to file response on an affidavit. The directions came on a petition by a Madhya Pradesh resident confined in Hisar Central Jail on allegations of facilitating cybercrime by activating and supplying SIM numbers to co-accused. The Bench was told that 35 SIM cards were issued in his name; 12 were still active. “Why does the Ministry of Telecommunication permit individuals, firms, or companies to acquire multiple prepaid SIM cards under their name? Given

of the countries of the South and enhancing economic opportunities are the main reasons cited. That ASEAN countries had with Quad has diminished, but that this would lead to a rush to join BRICS was unanticipated. It is not as if Vietnam, Malaysia and Thailand have had similar voting patterns on the Ukraine crisis in the UN. They voted separately. Now, they are keen on BRICS membership, even though Russia and Iran are under US sanctions and China leads the anti-Western bloc. These countries’ push for membership is challenged domestically on the grounds of strategic autonomy, they revert to citing economic opportunities. However, this does not hold much water because Vietnam, Malaysia and Thailand are closely aligned with China in economic terms. For several years, Beijing has been their largest trading partner, and they are benefiting from the Belt and Road Initiative. The entry of ASEAN nations into BRICS will improve its geographical coverage and bring countries in the ambit of India’s Act East Policy into the grouping. India should have no difficulty in supporting Vietnam, Malaysia and Thailand for their entry into BRICS and Indonesia whenever it seeks to join. India has close ties with these countries. And the economic and political expansion of relations with them remains a keystone of India’s Act East Policy. They are all friends of India and could benefit by balancing the composition of BRICS.

CJM court to work electronically as per new criminal laws

**CHANDIGARH :** From submitting the chargesheet online to recording of the evidences, all have been allowed electronically in the new laws. For example, Section 63 of the BNSS introduces technology compatibility for issuance and service of summons. The court can now issue summons in electronic form authenticated by the image of the seal of the court or digital signature. The court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate (CJM), Chandigarh, has been chosen as the first in the District Courts, Chandigarh, to function as per the provisions of the three new criminal laws — Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam (BSA). The National Informatics Centre (NIC) and other government agencies have been working on the software, which will equip the CJM court to do things electronically as per the provisions of the new laws. The focus in the new criminal laws has been given on paperless work. Further, Section 70 allows for service of summons through electronic means.



For the purpose of making the process effective, transparent and accountable, a provision has been made in Section 64 for maintaining a register in the police station and in the court to keep the address, email address, phone number, etc. of the person to be summoned. The lawyers will be allowed to participate in the proceedings even as they are sitting anywhere. The new laws also allow oral evidence to be given electronically. Witnesses, prosecution and the defence have also been allowed to record the statements electronically. As per the new provision, a magistrate can also supply documents electronically to the accused. Sources in the District Courts say that once the software is installed and other infrastructure is ready, the CJM court will be connected electronically with the model jail and police stations falling under its jurisdiction.

Hike Agniveer quota to 10%, suggests Haryana Cabinet

**CHANDIGARH :** The Haryana government, in its proposal, had suggested five per cent reservation in jobs across Group A, B, C and D. The Cabinet, which deliberated on the reservation of government jobs for those completing the four-year stint as Agniveers, proposed an enhancement over the proposed quota. The ministers, however, at yesterday’s meeting suggested that this be enhanced to 10 per cent in keeping with the reservation policy of the Centre for Agniveers on the completion of their tenure. One of the ministers, during the meeting chaired by Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, said that there should have been prior information of the reservation quota proposal instead of it being tabled at the last minute, sources said. Following this objection, on the instance of the Chief Minister, it was simply opened to deliberations in



which the ministers gave their suggestions. “The underlying idea is that no Agniveer should be unemployed after his four-year stint under the scheme. We are committed to absorbing everyone by bringing this job reservation,” a minister said. Downplaying the minister’s objection to the tabling of the proposal, another minister said, “It was not said as a complaint. However, the minister had said it as a suggestion to allow better preparation on the proposal since it affects a significant number of families.” The proposal for granting horizontal reservation to the Agniveers across

government jobs within the existing quotas but under a new head had been readied for yesterday’s Cabinet meeting. However, it ended up as a discussion with the Cabinet unanimous that the Agniveers be accommodated by increasing their job quota. “The new proposal will incorporate the various suggestions and is likely come as an agenda item at the next meeting provided it has been modified,” a minister said. In June 2022, the then Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar had said that the Agniveers would be granted government jobs after their term ends.

Councillors seeks special powers to spend Rs 1 lakh per project

**PANCHKULA :** The issue of approving cash Rs 1 lakh to councillors has already been discussed in a meeting of MC Councillors and employees and is awaiting approval from the Commissioner. The Municipal Corporation is set to give additional powers to corporation councillors to get small works done in their respective wards. After approval, the councillors would not need to bring matters falling below an expenditure of Rs 1 lakh per project to the MC House, as they would be allowed to approve and get them completed on their own. Officials said, post-approval, the councillors would be able to execute petty and emergency works in their respective wards. They would be able to spend up to Rs 1 lakh per project on 10 different projects in a year. As such, the councillors



would be able to spend Rs 10 lakh per year without approval from the house. The MC would thus spend a maximum of Rs 2 crore on behalf of its 20 councillors in a year. Sources said the matter has been approved by the Mayor and two Councillors Suneet Singla of Ward 13 and Gurmail Kaur of Ward 10. They said it has not been approved by the Commissioner; however, it has been sent to the Urban Local Bodies Department for approval. Ward 13 Councillor Suneet Singla said the decision has been taken to ensure that the small works of residents are completed on time. He said, “At times, people come with

small problems like pits in front of their houses or broken gates in parks, which could lead to mishaps. These works need minimal expenditure; however, they remain pending as all works being carried out by the MC need to go through the officer concerned, a proper process of preparation of the tender, calling the tender, allocation and getting the work done, all of which takes at least 45 days. This new decision will eliminate the needless delay in work and will be carried out through the approval of the councillor.” Mayor Kulbhushan Goyal said the MC is faced with enough issues of broken walls on public properties and non-functional street lights, among others. He said that after approval, these would be done with the approval of the councillors, adding that there would be no delay in the completion of such works.

‘IT to contribute 10% in India’s GDP by 2025’

## Constitution Bench to hear petition on passage of laws as Money Bills

**NEW DELHI** : The procedural formalities regarding filing of documents were complete and the petitions needed to be listed for hearing, pleaded Snr Advocate Kapil Sibal, before the bench of Chief Justice Chandrachud. The Apex Court on Monday admitted to consider setting up a Constitution Bench to hear petitions challenging the validity of passage of laws such as the Aadhaar Act as money Bills, allegedly to bypass the Rajya Sabha. "I will take the call when I form the Constitution Benches," the CJI told Sibal. Earlier, the top court had said it would constitute a seven-judge Constitution Bench to consider the issue of validity of passage of laws as Money Bills. The decision was aimed at addressing the controversy around Money Bills after the government introduced laws like the Aadhaar Act and even amendments to the Prevention of Money



Laundering Act (PMLA) as Money Bills, apparently to circumvent the Rajya Sabha where it did not have a majority then. A Bill is said to be a Money Bill if it only contains provisions on taxation, borrowing of money by the government, expenditure from or receipt to the Consolidated Fund of India. Bills that only contain provisions that are incidental to these matters would also be regarded as Money Bills. They can only be introduced in the Lok Sabha. The Rajya Sabha can only suggest amendments to Money Bills but its suggestions aren't binding on the Lok Sabha. A Money Bill is required to be certified as such by the Speaker before being introduced in the Lok Sabha.

In November 2019, a five-judge Constitution Bench had said the validity of passage of Finance Bill 2017 as Money Bill should be decided by a larger Bench. The 2019 decision had come on petitions on the functioning of tribunals which also challenged the Finance Act 2017 that attempted to revamp the functioning of tribunals. As the suggestions made by the Rajya Sabha on the Bill passed in the Lok Sabha were ignored, the petitioners contended that the passage of the Finance Bill in the form of a Money Bill was entirely inappropriate and amounted to a fraud on the Constitution. The decision regarding the passage of the Aadhaar Act as Money Bill in 2016 had been upheld by a five-judge Bench of the Supreme Court in 2018. Justice Chandrachud had delivered a dissenting verdict and said Aadhaar law could not have been passed as a Money Bill.

## Slot of Congress deputy leader goes to Gaurav Gogoi in Lok Sabha

**NEW DELHI** : Ms Sonia Gandhi Congress Parliamentary Party Chairperson has written to Lok Sabha Speaker Birla, informing him about the appointment of the deputy leader, chief whip and two whips for the Congress in the Lok Sabha, AICC general secretary (organisation) KC Venugopal said on X. The Congress has made significant leadership appointments in the Lok Sabha, with Gaurav Gogoi being named the party's deputy leader in the House.



In addition to Jorhat (Assam) MP Gogoi's appointment, Mavelikara (Kerala) MP Kodikunnal Suresh has been named the chief whip while Virudhunagar (Tamil Nadu) MP Manickam Tagore and Kishanganj (Bihar) MP Mohammad Jawed have been made whips. The appointments are learnt to be aimed at

bolstering the party's leadership and effectiveness in the Lower House of Parliament. A party leader said the changes had come as the Congress and its allies in the INDIA bloc "prepared to advocate for public interests with renewed vigour". "Under the guidance of Leader of the Opposition Rahul Gandhi, the newly appointed leaders are expected to play pivotal role in steering the party's legislative agenda and upholding democratic values in Parliament," he said.

## Bandicoot 'Robots' to clean manholes in Panipat

**PANIPAT** : 'Bandicoot', specifically designed by Genrobotic for sewer tank and manhole cleaning, is equipped with advanced features that enable it to navigate and clean sewer lines efficiently. Manholes in the industrial area will now be cleaned with the help of 'Bandicoot' robots. The Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran (HSVP) made the robot operational in Sector 29 part-1 here. Harpal Dhanda, elder brother of the minister Mahipal Dhanda attended the ceremony. Dhanda also inaugurated two deep tubewells. The introduction of the robot would help end manual scavenging, which poses severe health risks to

sanitation workers. The robot's design encompasses high-definition cameras, robust arms for debris removal and high-tech sensors for navigation, said Gauri Shankar, regional manager, Genrobotic. He said the robot could bear a weight of around 125 kg of garbage and silt. Shree Bhagwan Aggarwal, president, Industrial Estate Association Sector 29 part-1, took up several demands with the minister's brother, including the widening of the main road from NH-44 to Flora Chowk. One side of the road was constructed five years ago but the other side still awaits overhauling. Aggarwal brought up the problem of streetlights, and stormwater drain among others with Dhanda.

## Special verification to be carried out till July 24 : Election Commission

**KARNAL** : On the directions of the Election Commission of India, second special verification of photo electoral rolls would be done by July 24 and the qualifying date was July 1. During this period, all booth-level officers (BLOs) would carry out door-to-door voter verification said Uttam Singh the Deputy Commissioner of Karnal. Mr Uttam Singh is also the District Election Officer, chaired a meeting of officials and representatives of various political parties at the Mini-Secretariat here. "The names of voters, who have passed away, will be removed from the voter lists. Additionally, new voters will be added and photo electoral rolls will be prepared," he added. The draft publication of the voter list will be done on July 25 after the completion of the revision work. "Claims and objections related to the voter lists will



be received from July 25 to August 9 as per the guidelines of the Election Commission," he said, adding that these claims and objections will be addressed by the Electoral Registration Officers concerned by August 19. The final publication of the revised voter lists will be done on August 20. The Deputy Commissioner urged officials to correct inaccuracies and add as many eligible voters as possible to the voter lists. Special camps will be organised at polling stations on July 27, July 28, August 3 and August 4. At the camps,

BLOs will be present at polling stations from 9 am to 5 pm to receive claims and objections. The voter lists will be available for public inspection at each polling station. He also urged representatives of political parties to assist in establishing polling booths in residential societies and areas where the number of voters exceeds 1,500 or the distance is far away. He directed the officials to prepare proposals for such booths promptly. The Deputy Commissioner advised all political parties to appoint their booth-level agents (BLAs) at the earliest and submit the list to the office of the Election Officer, ensuring that each BLA is from the respective booth. Voters who will be 18 years or older on July 1 and whose names are not on the voter list can register by submitting Form Number-6 along with relevant documents and photographs.

## 85% fail to deposit sports funds in Faridabad schools

**FARIDABAD** : The submission of sports fund has been an integral part of the Education Policy of the state government. A majority of the private and government schools here have been served notices to submit sports funds by the end of this month said the sources. The Education Department here, around 85 per cent of schools — both private and government — have failed to deposit the annual sports fund. Thus it had become difficult to meet the expenditure of organising tournaments and games at particular intervals throughout the academic year, sources disclosed. It is learnt that of the 1,700 schools in the district, only around 250 care to deposit sports funds each year. According to a circular issued recently, schools are required to submit an amount ranging from Rs 10 to Rs 90 for each student from Classes I to XII as sports fund. Officials claimed that school



managements were served annual reminders and notices for submitting funds. Yet, every year sports funds to the tune of several lakh rupees remain pending. These funds are used in organising various games and tournaments, and used to cover the participants' expenses, including lodging, boarding, meals, dresses and other facilities, according to the officials of the sports wing of the Education Department. It is revealed that organising a state-level tournament usually costs the department around Rs 30 lakh, while it managed to collect only Rs 26 lakh across the district in

2023-24. Besides, half of the funds collected by the department at the district level are to be deposited with the state directorate. However, many private school administrations have claimed that the policy of collecting sports funds was unjustified as the number of their students participating in the sports events organised by the Education Department remained negligible. "This will be an additional burden that is likely to be passed on to the parents, while we would not be able to justify the demand for collecting this money from students," says spokesperson of the Private Schools Association here. Faridabad Assistant Education Officer (Sports) Harbir Adhana said notices/circulars were being served on schools as annual reminders as part of the state government's education policy. "We have not received any directions in case of non-compliance in this matter," he added.

## Gurugram holistically aims zero emission by 2050

**GURUGRAM** : As Gurugram features among the top polluted cities in the country, the Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) has drawn a holistic plan to reduce emissions in the city. The authority has drafted a 'net zero 2050' document, contouring the goals for urban policy-making to make Gurugram a zero emission city. Net-zero refers to the point at which a specific area or city is able to remove from the atmosphere all green house gases (GHGs) it is emitting. Effectively, it ensures that no additional carbon or other GHGs are being added into the atmosphere.



The document elaborates on the way forward to implement sustainable development strategies like construction of green buildings, setting up of centralised cooling plants in housing societies, adoption of cleaner technologies and increasing the share of electric vehicles over the next 25 years. The plan deals in four major arenas — energy, waste, transport and greenery.

# Murder Theory too Damn Perfect

Pennsylvania : Surface After Trump Rally Shooting. Some of these conspiracy theories centred on the alleged security failings, with social media users questioning how such a thing could happen. Months ahead of the crucial presidential elections in the US, Donald Trump became the target of an apparent assassination attempt at a rally in Pennsylvania. This came days before the former president was scheduled to accept the Republican nomination for a third time.

While law enforcement officials are trying to determine the motive behind the 20-year-old opening fire from a nearby rooftop, the word 'Staged' became a trend on social media in the country within minutes of the attack. This word has become synonymous with extreme conspiracy theories across social media platforms, being frequently used to question the veracity of an attack or shooting. In the last 24 hours, it has overtaken other topics in popular internet discourse, as

millions of views have been received by posts on X that are filled with unsupported rumours, hate speech, and abuse. However, it must be noted that conspiracy theories have historically been drawn to a s s a s s i n a t i o n attempts on US presidents, with the most well-known example being the assassination of John F Kennedy back in November 1963. As it was the first to occur in real-time, it was unsurprising that false reports took off, the report state users' "For You"

## Murder motive of Thomas Matthew was unclear

PennyslwaliaThe FBI has identified the shooter in the assassination attempt on former president Donald Trump as 20-year-old Thomas Matthew Crooks. The US Secret Service said in a statement that the shooter "fired multiple shots toward the stage from an elevated position outside the rally" before being "neutralized" by agents. Donald Trump was rushed off the stage with blood streaked across his face after the shooting in Butler. The shocking incident happened two days before the start of the Republican National Convention in Milwaukee, where Trump will formally become the party's nominee. Thomas Matthew Crooks was named by the FBI "as the subject involved in the assassination attempt of



Donald Trump". A voter-registration record showed that he was registered as a Republican. Thomas Matthew Crooks was the resident of Bethel Park in Pennsylvania. He appears to have graduated in 2022 from Bethel Park High School. He even received a \$500 "star award" that year from the National Math and Science Initiative, according to The Tribune-Review in western Pennsylvania. He was armed with an AR-15 semi-automatic rifle.

Multiple witnesses said they saw him before the shooting and alerted authorities. Crooks was positioned on the roof of a building about 130 yards away from the stage where Donald Trump was addressing the rally. He was shot dead by the Secret Service officials after the attack on the 78-year-old former US President. Police said Crooks' motive behind firing on the presumptive Republican presidential nominee is unclear.

## Athletes to retain dominance for Olympic gold medals: PM

## Home Ministry strengthens J&K Lt Gov



Commissioner News Service New Delhi : In a significant move, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has amended the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganization Act, 2019 enhancing some powers of the Lieutenant Governor of the erstwhile state. President Droupadi Murmu has given her approval to the amendments in the rule exercising the powers conferred by section 55 of the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019, (34 of 2019) read with the Proclamation dated 31st October 2019 issued under section 73 of the Act, a notification issued by the MHA mentions. These rules may be called the Transaction of Business of the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and

Kashmir (Second Amendment) Rules, 2024," reads the notification. The amendments shall come into force on July 12, the date of the publication in the Official Gazette - a move in anticipation of the speculated assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir. As per the inserted sub-rule (2A), "No proposal which requires previous concurrence of the Finance Department with regard to 'Police', 'Public Order', 'All India Service' and 'Anti Corruption Bureau' to exercise the discretion of the Lieutenant Governor under the Act shall be concurred or rejected unless it has been placed before the Lieutenant Governor through the Chief Secretary".

## Local jeweller loses Rs 9.7 cr to Conman

Commissioner News Service Panchkula: Lalit Singla, a resident of Sector 7, Panchkula, who has a jewellery shop in Chandigarh's Mani majra, had in his complaint claimed that he had joined a WhatsApp group named 'EG Primary Group X2', which provided stock market related news. Following the instructions of group admin, he communicated with a person named James on an international number, who assisted him in opening a trading account. With the arrest of Patiala residents, the cyber cell of Panchkula police has solved one of the biggest online frauds of the Tricity where a local jeweller lost Rs 9.68 crore to conmen, who came posing as trading and share market experts. The master mind in the case has a BSc degree in IT, the police said. The security produced the accused, Jatin Jindal and Mushta Mohammad, before the local court and obtained their police remand for further investigation. Panchkula



DCP Himadri Kaushik said Jatin, an IT expert is the mastermind behind the fraud.. The victim was then persuaded to transfer money for trading purposes, initially transferring Rs 38 lakhs, followed by 18 transactions totalling Rs 9.68 crore. The cyber criminals alluring him with an offer of double returns on his investment. They even tempted him with an Apple phone through courier; But upon checking the website www.viyakae.com', it was found to be fake. The complainant filed a complaint at the cyber police station in Panch kula. After verifying

the facts, police registered a case against unidentified persons and started a probe. During the investigation, cops trailed the money transactions and obtained relevant details and information of the accused. Later, a police team arrested Jatin Jindal, the mastermind who holds a BSch degree in IT. Police said the accused had connections with cyber gangs in other states too. Jindal, who was allegedly involved in opening fake accounts, relocated frequently, cops added. Later, police arrested Mustaq Mohammad while attempting to open an office in Zirakpur.

## Trump officially becomes Republican party's nominee

Washington: Former U.S. President Donald Trump's vice presidential pick J.D. Vance has openly praised the work of Federal Trade Commission Chair Lina Khan, a sign that the agency's broad approach to antitrust enforcement could enjoy some level of support from a second Trump administration. Vance is one of several Republican lawmakers, including U.S. Senator Josh Hawley of Missouri and Florida U.S. Representative Matt Gaetz, called "Khanservatives". She recognized there has to be a broader understanding



of how we think about competition in the marketplace," Vance said at an event in Washington in February. The comments reflect a tension in conservative movement, between an impulse to shrink regulatory agencies and a willingness to use antitrust laws to challenge powerful corporations — especially in Big Tech,

where some hope to tackle perceived censorship of conservatives online. "I do think that picking Senator Vance as vice president certainly sends a signal in one direction," said Coniglio. His think tank receives funding from several major technology companies.
