Pak goes for general elections in November 23 - PM

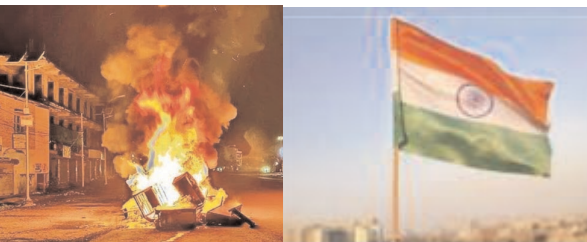

Islamabad : "My government would transfer power to an interim setup before the current National Assembly tenure concludes next month" said Mr Shehbaz Sharif. Mr Sharif disclosed that the parliamentary election might be held during the month of November. On August 12, five year term of the National Assembly would end up with the present

coalition govt led by Shehbaz Sharif . Left with only 4 weeks in office, Mr Sharif has intensified his present political engagements, holding meetings with his coalition partners to determine the timings for the upcoming elections and finalise the format of interim govt team which would assume full powers to organise the modus operandi for general election in Pakistan.

Govt rejects European Parliament directing steps over Manipur strife



New Delhi: Where as violence in India's Manipur state has erupted along ethnic and religious lines between the mainly Hindu Meitei community and the Christian Kuki tribe, leading to a cycle of violence with over 100 people killed, over 40,000 displaced and the destruction of property and places of worship. Whereas Manipur has previously faced secessionist insurgencies in which serious human rights abuses were committed. Whereas, in the latest round of violence human rights groups have accused the BJP led government in Manipur and rationally of implementing divisive ethno nationalist policies which press in particular religious minorities," the resolution said. With the European Parliament adopting a resolution on Manipur that called upon the Indian government to take all necessary measures to stop the

violence there, government slammed the interference" in India's internal affairs calling it unacceptable and reflecting a colonial mindset. The resolution had also called up on India to protect all religious minorities, especially the Christians, and denounced the allegedly nationalistic rhetoric deployed by BJP leaders. "We have seen that the European Parliament held a discussion on developments in Manipur and adopted a so-called Urgency Resolution. Such interference in India's internal affairs is unacceptable, and reflects a colonial mindset," lamented Arindam Bagchi., spokesperson of Ministry of External Affairs. "Indian authorities at all levels, including the judiciary, are seized of the situation in Manipur and are taking steps to maintain peace and harmony and law and order," he added.

Metro mobility to move ahead with Rs 7.72 Cr expenses, meeting today

Chandigarh : The United Metropolitan Transportation Authority. (UMTA) would engage the Rail India Technical Economic Service (RITES) for preparatory report of Rs 8.50 lakh per kilo metre and subsequently might approve consultancy proposal, scope of work , submission timelines and consultancy fee as suggested . The Chandigarh administration would introduce an agenda on 18 July in first



meet of UMTA to share cost of preparation of detailed project report (DPR) and alternative analysis report for the Metro mobility in the tricity amongst 3 stake holders.

The utility of RITES would be hired in preparing of 2 reports and it's approval would be discussed in the meeting to be chaired by the Administrator UT. The expenditure share of as per the plan , Rs 3.51 Cr would have to be borne by Chandigarh, Rs 3 .10 Cr by Punjab and Rs 1.10 Cr by Haryana .The track coverage would be 35 km for Chandigarh, 31 km for Mohali and 11 km for Pkula.

New Delhi: "The Indian Muslim population is almost equal to the combined population of around 33-member states of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation", said Ajit Doval, national security Advisor .

Al-Issa, an important voice for moderation and a key figure for reforms of family laws and relaxation of curbs on women in Saudi Arabia-from compulsory veiling to ban on driving-emphasised the need for "communication between cultures in order to address the negative trends in the world" and called for strengthening of common values. "Diversity promotes good



relationship between cultures.", he said ,while addressing the meet of religious leaders, Islamic scholars and academics. Doval said Al-Issa's message is loud and clear. "We have to live in harmony if we want to protect the future of humanity" Doval described the reformist scholar as an authentic global voice of moderate Islam, adored and acclaimed by millions

around the world. "When we are far apart from each other... there is room for fear to seep between us... *we* must work to wards bridging these gaps. At the Muslim World League, it is our principle of working on rectifying and presenting the true image of the faith so that we can strengthen relationships with the different faiths of the world."

Panchkula: Most of the owners are running their dairies in an unregulated manner. "They dispose of cattle dung by throwing it in open places/roads or in sewer lines/drains and due to which cow dung reduces the cleaning capacity of the sewer line and blocks the sewerage system, which not only drains the sewerage water on the ro ads but also spreads foul smell," said Sachin Gupta MC Commissioner. As a result, this causes the spread of diseases and creates public pollution," he added.Cattle dung also generates methane gas in sewer lines, which poses a real life threat to the workers maintaining them. He informed that the Urban Local Bodies



(ULB) department has prepared cattle dung management policy for its scientific disposal. "Scientific disposal of cattle dung as per the provisions of this policy is the prime responsibility of the generator and they will have to register them selves with the concerned MC within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of public notice. The registration form for the process is available on the

website of the Municipal Corporation. Dairies are responsible for disposal of cow dung in a environment friendly manner,"the order stated. These wer lines etc, and in case of non-payment of muni cipal dues as per usage basis of the premises/properties, the MC is going to confiscate the cattle will hand them over to the registered Gaushala, in addition to the penal provisions.

EDITORIAL -

Evolving UCC
a tough exercise

The Constitution is a secular document that forbids religious discrimination. It calls for enacting a UCC , giving such a code impeccable secular credentials. The BJP is on the secular side in this dispute, regardless of its motives. Congress says a UCC will hurt Muslims by forcing them to abandon their traditions.

Female infanticide was a traditional Hindu practice in Punjab and Tamil Nadu but is that any reason to support the traditionalists? Sati was an ancient Hindu tradition, but should we permit it? Ironically, most secular parties have historically dragged their feet on a UCC, whereas the BJP, a Hindu nationalist party has lobbied for it. The Congress and Communist parties want to woo the Muslim vote bank. This represents opportunistic politics. They have avoided reforms because they think traditionalist mullahs will get them more Muslim votes than progressive Muslims who seek reform.

The BJP aims to strengthen its Hindu vote bank by tracking down on a supposed Muslim privilege though it is no privilege at all for Muslim women. It will mean reforming Hindu law too, not just Muslim and Christian personal law .For instance, Hindus current ly have the right to form Hindu

Undivided Families as a separate legal and tax entity something without parallel Christianity This right has been used historically to evade thousands of crores of taxes and deny wom en equal property rights, and must be reformed by a UCC. We as a secular fundamentalist should welcome Prime Minister Modi's call for a Uniform Civil Code (UCC) to govern the personal law of all religious groups, Including Muslims and Christians. When reforming Hindu personal law in the 1950s, Jawaharlal Nehru should have removed the personal laws of all religious groups to give India a UCC. Sadly he finked the taak. It is high time India abolished religious differences in personal law But this should be a secular exercise, not a majoritarian one. Millions of Muslims have migrated to the US, UK, and other western countries with uniform civil laws. There, Muslims do not agitate for a separate personal law. If they can live happily with modern civil laws in the US and Europe, why not in India too? After Goa ceased to be a Portuguese colony and became part of India, the secular Portuguese codes covering inheritance and property rights continued in force. Some mullahs claimed that since

Goa was now part of India, Muslim personal law should apply in Goa too. But liberals, including a section of Muslim women, opposed any change, and the traditionalist demand for Sharia died down. If secular codes can apply to Muslims (and Hindus and Christians) in Goa, why not everywhere else?

India's Constitution forbids discrimination on the basis of caste, gender, religion, or place of birth. Alas, traditions of all religious groups- Hindus, Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, P a r s i s - h a v e historically included discriminatory practices. This constitutional approach needs to be given full force . No UCC should be drafted until we have the court's verdict. But preparatory work should start. The court is dealing with three specific disputes, but there are many more. We need an expert committee with the representa- tion of all faiths to lay the ground for a UCC. The committee should identify the disputed are- as, and try to narrow the field. Next, it can classify the disputes into different categories that can be tackled through category-specific remedies. Finally, after the court delivers its verdict, the committee can help weave the verdict into category-wise clauses.

PGI to provide superspeciality services over phone

CHANDIGARH : The aim of the PGI institution would be to facilitate patient follow-ups and streamline disease prevalence identification, benefiting individuals who have to travel long distances for routine checkups.

The Telemedicine Department of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh, is planning to set up tele-clinics in collaboration with various medical colleges and hospitals, including Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), Sector 32, and Government Multi-Specialty Hospital (GMSH), Sector 16. The specialties that will be covered under the tele-clinic initiative include radiology, cardiology, ICU, stroke clinics and emergency services. Tele-clinics will allow patients to connect with different departments and superspeciality clinics remotely. The stored data will be securely maintained on a server or cloud storage, ensuring the privacy and confidentiality of patient information. The tele-clinic project will commence with the



active involvement of the departments concerned at the PGIMER and the pilot phase will initiate services for a designated hour or two, with consultants offering their expertise remotely. Upon successful testing, the initiative will be expanded to provide round-the-clock services by recruiting consultants dedicated to their respective departments. The Department of Telemedicine will oversee the implementation and management of this service. In addition to expanding services within Chandigarh, the PGIMER aims at collaborating with medical colleges, hospitals, primary health centres (PHCs) and community health centres (CHCs) in Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, and Jammu & Kashmir. The primary objective is to enhance medical facilities and provide quality healthcare in these states.

Insurance company ordered to pay Rs 2.94 lakh to complainant

YAMUNANAGAR : Anoop Aggarwal a complainant of Industrial area, Yamunanagar, claimed that he purchased a medical claim insurance policy providing health coverage to his wife and two sons having a sum assured of Rs 10 lakh. The policy was valid from May 28, 2017 to May 27, 2018 and prior to it, the complainant was a regular customer of the insurance company since 2014. During the validity period of the policy, the wife of the complainant was hospitalised in a cancer institute of Delhi on July 27, 2017.

Her uterus was removed by surgery in the institute and she incurred a medical expenditure in the sum of Rs 3,28,079. The complainant deposited the medical bills along with other requisite documents with the insurance company for reimbursement of

medical expenditure. The order was passed by DCDRC president Gulab Singh, members Geeta Parkash and Asvinder Singh. The District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (DCDRC), Yamunanagar, has ordered an insurance company to pay Rs 2,94,874 as insurance claim and punitive damages to a Yamunanagar resident. As per the order of the DCDRC, Rs 1,94,874 shall be paid as insurance claim and Rs 1 lakh as punitive damages to complainant in all heads within two months from the date of this order. In default of it, the insurance company shall be liable to make the payment along with eight per cent interest per annum from the date of the order. The insurance company paid Rs 1,33,205 against the total bill of Rs 3,28,079. The complainant sent a legal notice to the company, but the firm failed to redress his grievance.

370 posts to be filled by September : PGI

CHANDIGARH : The Secretary Health, Government of India, the PGIMER committed to filling 370 posts by September 30 in a recent review meeting. Experiencing the staff crunch, the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER) here will fill 370 vacant posts of nursing, technician, clerk and sanitary attendant. Kumar Gaurav Dhawan, Deputy Director, PGIMER, said, "The institute will be able to fill 370 posts by September-end. It will relieve the burden on the existing staff, who are already stretched to their limits due to the staff crunch. With more staff, the institute can provide better quality patient care and reduce wait time. With the number of patients increasing daily, the institute needs more staff to

ensure that patients receive timely and adequate medical attention." The institute has around 7,300 sanctioned posts, including those of teaching and non-teaching doctor, nurse, paramedic, lab technician and security. However, the institute is unable to fill the vacancies due to various reasons, including court cases, which have resulted in a backlog of over 1,700 vacancies. The hospital provides treatment to an average of 9,000 patients daily, including 8,000 in the Out-Patient Department (OPD) and 300 in the Emergency wing. As many as 155 out of 2,572 nursing positions remain unfilled at the PGI. The situation is no better for teaching staff with 36 posts of professor and 91 of assistant professor remaining vacant against the sanctioned strength of 70 and 652, respectively.

Water supply team collects samples from villages of Mohali

MOHALI : A team of the Water Supply and S a n i t a t i o n Department, under the supervision of Executive Engineer Ramanpreet Singh, collected from the villages of Rurka, Bakarpur, Kurari, Kambala, Sohana, Balongi and Badh Majra in the wake of diarrhoea cases reported from some areas. The department also has a mobile water-testing lab to analyse the samples on the spot. The number of patients under treatment for diarrhoea in the district is 65. Cases with mild symptoms of diarrhoea have been reported from Jujhar Nagar, but no patient was hospitalised. Fifteen patients have



been undergoing treatment at the Dera Bassi Subdivisional Hospital, 45 at the District Hospital, Mohali, and four at CHC, Kurali. Meanwhile, the water supply has been restored in the area and regular chlorination is being carried out. However, the water supply to Balongi continues to be disconnected in view of the recent diarrhoea outbreak. Teams of the Mohali M u n i c i p a l Corporation and the Greater Mohali Area

D e v e l o p m e n t Authority (GMADA) carried out fogging in its affected areas. Besides, the other municipal councils of the district have also been doing regular fogging besides spraying chemicals on stagnant water to kill mosquito larvae in their respective areas. Health teams have been conducting medical camps in the district, particularly in the flood-affected areas, to examine for seasonal diseases.

MC Commissioner asks officials to ensure no water accumulation, raise drainage

SCADA to facilitate unified control over basic amenities

CHANDIGARH : The state-of-the-art centre planned to come up, will control essential services, including SCADA systems for water supply, public bike-sharing, streetlights, parking, solid waste management, street sweeping and sewage treatment. Chandigarh will procure its Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) centre next month. At present, SCADA operations for water, streetlight and street sweeping are running from the MC building and that for solid waste management from the Rose Club in Sector 16. The system for public bike sharing (PBS) and parking is operating from a temporary setup in Sector 17. The SCADA systems for STPs are working locally at the plants. "The co-location of these systems into one SCADA centre enables the city operators and administrators to have a comprehensive real-time view, detailed situational



awareness and better control of the city's infrastructure," said Municipal Commissioner Anindita Mitra. This holistic approach is aimed at facilitating unified control and supervision of essential services, effective i n t e r - d e p a r t m e n t a l coordination, improved maintenance, cost-saving and resource utilisation. All SCADA systems installed at the centre will be integrated with the Integrated Command and Control Centre (ICCC). By sharing expertise, location, resources and technical capabilities, the ICCC and the SCADA centre shall establish a robust framework for decision-making and

coordinated response. Anindita, who is also Chief Executive Officer, Chandigarh Smart City Limited, said, "We are about to achieve a significant milestone in our journey towards building a smarter and more sustainable Chandigarh. The SCADA centre will empower us with effective control and better utilisation of resources allowing us to respond swiftly to challenges and optimise services for the benefit of our citizens." It allows a platform for new applications, sensors or smart devices, facilitating the implementation of future smart city initiatives.

GMDA mobility plan aims to provide last-mile connectivity

GURUGRAM : The upcoming Metro in the town will boost connectivity and the GMDA will work to provide supporting infrastructure development to optimise the benefits of the Metro services.
The Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) is rolling out a comprehensive micro-mobility plan to improve last-mile connectivity for commuters in the city.
With the Metro set for a major expansion in the city, the authority is planning to augment the mobility aspect by working on motorised and non-motorised transport.
Following a meeting with officials of the Haryana Mass Rapid Transport Corporation (HMRTC) and the World Bank, GMDA CEO PC Meena discussed the Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) Policy of Haryana and other key aspects of the Comprehensive Mobility Management Development Plan.
"TOD is an important aspect in ensuring financial sustainability and stability of the project and the GMDA, being the nodal



department for mobility development in Gurugram, will coordinate with all departments concerned in taking the metro project forward successfully," said Meena. The Gurugram Metro project, recently approved by the Union Cabinet, will connect Old and New Gurugram and the Metro route will include Sector 45, Cyber Park, Sector 46, Sector 47, Sector 48, Technology Park, Udyog Vihar Phase 6, Sector 10, Sector 37, Basai, Sector 9, Sector 7, Sector 4, Sector 5, Ashok Vihar, Sector 3, Krishna Chowk, Palam Vihar Extension, Palam Vihar, Sector 23 A, Sector 22, Udyog Vihar Phase 4, and CyberHub.
The team from the World Bank delivered a presentation on how TOD can be applicable to the Metro project. The meeting also discussed last-mile connectivity

within the city and the engagement of city buses to plug the gap, along with other initiatives.
The TOD policy integrates land use and transport planning and focuses on the creation of high-density mixed land use development in the influence zone of transit stations, which is within walking distance of the transit station or along the vicinity of the Metro corridor. CEO Meena said as per the Comprehensive Mobility Management Development Plan prepared for Gurgaon and Manesar to facilitate long and short-term interventions to improve mobility between 2021 and 2041, special focus on developing pedestrian pathways and cycle tracks has already been taken up by the authority to strengthen non-motorised transport in the city.

Govt not to extend 31 July deadline, masses advised to file income tax return

CHANDIGARH : "We expect that the filing of return would be higher than the last year...we are hopeful that it should be more than the last year," Revenue Secretary Sanjay Malhotra said.
He has asked income tax payers to file their return at the earliest as the finance ministry is not contemplating extension of the July 31 deadline.
We expect that the filing would be higher than the last year...we are hopeful that it should be more than the last year," he said.
About 5.83 crore income tax returns were filed as on July 31 last year, the last day for filing returns for assessment year 2022-23.
"We would like to thank income tax return filers as ITR filing has been at a much faster pace than last year and we would advise them not to wait to the last moment and also not to hope for any extensions.
"So, I would advise them to



file their tax return at the earliest because the deadline of July 31 is approaching fast," he said.
With regard to the tax mobilisation target, Malhotra said, it is more or less in line with the target growth rate, which is 10.5 per cent.
The growth rate as far as Goods and Services Tax (GST) is concerned, it is 12 per cent so far, he said.
However, the growth rate is lower than 12 per cent on the excise duties front due to rate reduction.
"It is rather negative as of now. Hopefully going forward, once the impact of the decrease in the tax rates is over, we will see some increase in collection of excise duties. So, overall we

feel it's still early days...we feel that we should be able to achieve the target," he said.
As per the Budget 2023-24, the government expects gross tax receipts of Rs 33.61 lakh crore in the current fiscal.
Of this, the government aims to mobilise Rs 18.23 lakh crore, 10.5 per cent higher than collected from corporate and individual income tax, as per the Budget papers.
Collections from customs duty are expected to rise by 11 per cent to Rs 2.33 lakh crore from Rs 2.10 lakh crore in the revised estimates for FY23.
GST collections are projected to grow by 12 per cent in the next fiscal to Rs 9.56 lakh crore.
Taking both direct and indirect taxes, the gross tax collection is expected to grow by 10.45 per cent to Rs 33.61 lakh crore in 2023-24 as compared to Rs 30.43 lakh crore mobilised in the last financial year.

Anti graft body arrests cabinet minister in corruption

Singapore : S Iswaran, cabinet transport minister has been arrested in connection with a rare top-level corruption investigation .

The probe has also ensnared a billionaire hotel tycoon,said the country's anti-graft body.
The minister, was arrested and "subsequently released on bail", the Corrupt Practices Investigation Bureau (CPIB) said in an emailed statement , confirming the arrest for the first time.

Hotel tycoon Ong Beng Seng, one of Singapore's richest people, was also arrested on the same day and released on bail in connection with the probe, the bureau said.

The investigation bureau has not disclosed details of the probe that has gripped the city-state, a global financial hub reputed to be among the least corrupt countries in the world.
Cabinet ministers are paid salaries comparable to the



top earners in the private sector to deter corruption.
The investigation of the transport chief by the powerful anti-graft bureau widened after it was disclosed that Ong was included in the probe.
Ong is the managing director of Hotel Properties Limited (HPL), which owns a string of high-end hotels and resorts in locations around Asia and the Pacific.
In a filing with the Singapore exchange the company said Ong was given a "notice of arrest" by the CPIB and had posted bail.

While the passports of those under arrest are generally impounded, Ong was granted permission to leave Singapore on Friday, with the CPIB noting it considers requests for travel overseas "on a case-by-case basis".

Sitharaman also met her Canadian counterpart Chrystia Freeland and discussed the progress being made on ongoing trade negotiations. The meetings were held on the sidelines of the 3rd Finance Ministers and central bank governors meeting in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
"They also discussed the progress on the ongoing various trade-related negotiations between India and Canada," tweeted the ministry.

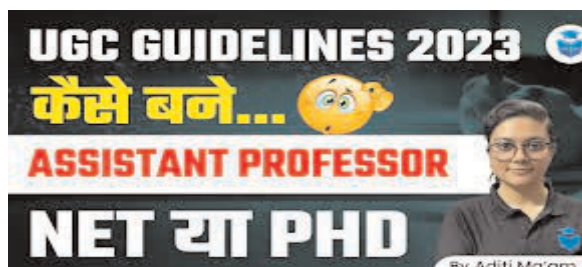

Chandigarh: Panjab University is all set to adopt revised UGC guidelines on minimum qualifications for appointing teachers and academic staff. The University Grants Commission (UGC) has announced that national eligibility test (NET), State eligibility test (SET) and state level eligibility test (SLET) will be the minimum requirement for direct recruitment to the post of assistant professor in all universities and colleges, in stead of PhD. According to the revised guidelines, UGC-NET/SLET/ SET is the minimum requirement for direct recruitment as assistant professor for those with a master's degree, while PhD degree holders are eligible

for direct recruitment to the post of assistant professor and are exempted from UGC-NET/SLET/SET. Rajat Sandhir PU Professor said, "During our time, qualifying NET was mandatory. It served as a screening process on a national level and that was good for us." Priyatosh Sharma Chairperson, history department, also hailed the decision. "This is advantageous for young talent as people who used to spend six to seven years pursuing a PhD will now be eligible to be assistant professors at the university,"he said. With limited mentors, it becomes difficult for people, especially the economically disadvantaged to pursue a PHD.

Send entries for Asiad wrestling by July 23

New Delhi: The trials to select the wrestling teams have to be conducted latest by July 22 and the final entries have to be sent the next day. The Olympic Council of Asia (OCA), led by its new president Sheikh

Al-Issa said that "there was also agreement on the importance of working

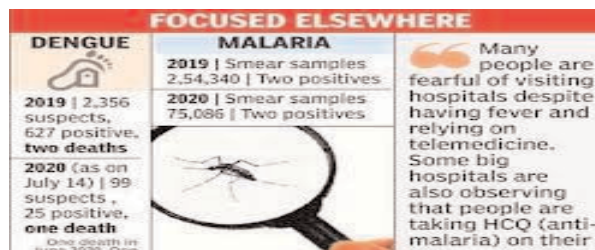
