G-7 resolves not to pay earned interest to beneficiary Russia , instead oblige 'Ukraine'

Inevitability of world war might break out

As 'Moscow' 2 years ago invaded its neighbour country 'Ukraine' for not towing its dictates, yet the targetted Ukraine has not yet bowed down its sovereign stand. The G7, committed to salvage would provide \$50 billion of loan, using earned interest on capital reserve by Russia. No body helps no body in the advancing world of commerce and business. It seems explicit that free brownies are missing from the plate but on the capital asset, of Russia would not find itself

West reacts unconstructively to Russian proposal -- Kremlin

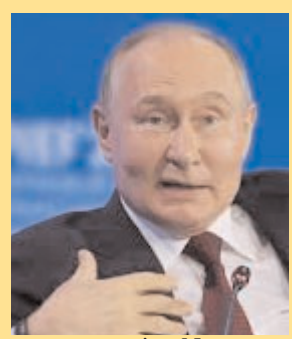

Fight between Pak judiciary and military power intensifies

Islamabad: Several high court and lower court judges have complained that since May 9, 2023, Pakistan's "powerful" authorities as army, ISI have tried to pressure them using intimidatory tactics such as secret surveillance, and even abduction and torture of their family members, to secure favourable adjudication in political cases related to Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party and its founder, Imran Khan.

The clash between Pakistan's judiciary and the military establishment has been escalating as judges have started questioning the conduct of army and Inter Services Intelligence (ISI) officers over blatant interference in judicial matters. At an event in Rawalpindi on Sunday, Lahore High Court chief justice Malik Shahzad Ahmad claimed he has got many complaints



verbally and letters regarding interference, in judicial matters by "institutions" a reference to the army and ISI. "To get rid of the military establishment's interference, we've to face it with bravery, courage, and with out any fear, and with the belief that this interference will end soon. Temporary worries do come but you have to face them eye to eye and not be a target of any of their blackmailing. Don't be hesitant to make any kind of sacrifice." Earlier, in March, six of the eight Islamabad HC judges

had penned a startling letter to Supreme Court judges about attempts by the ISI to pressure them through the abduction and torture of their relatives as well as secret surveillance inside their homes.

Following the letter, judges for other HCs also acknowledged interference by spy agencies in judicial functions. It led the apex court to take suo motu notice of the matter, with high courts submitting their responses and recommendations as proceedings continued.

The curriculum does not mention the Babri

EDITORIAL -

Political expletive by
uniformed soldier ?

Violence justified by someone in uniform — who is sworn to protect the Constitution of India and all Indians alike — is not acceptable. Neither one’s political beliefs and biases nor the actions of the recipient of violence should dictate how do we feel about violence. There is no space for support to what Kulwinder did. There can be no justification for it and no ifs and buts or nuances associated with this position. We cannot justify someone in uniform making a political statement on duty — whatever the provocation. This is a slippery slope, and what the meme makers, stand-up comics, artistes and others fail to realise is that they could also be on the receiving end of violence one day. We must not forget that it was only last year that a constable of the Railway Protection Force killed four persons aboard the Jaipur-Mumbai Superfast Express, and at least three of the victims were allegedly targeted by him on account of their religion. A CISF constable, Kulwinder Kaur, slapped actor and MP-elect from Mandi, Kangana Ranaut, at the Chandigarh airport on June 6. While the CISF promptly (and rightly so) suspended Kulwinder and handed over the matter to the local police, polarised narratives almost instantly overtook the events. There were those who expressed support for Kulwinder, celebrating the act, offering her a job and suggesting that Kangana deserved violence because of the abhorrent statements that she had made about Sikhs, Punjab and the farmers’ protest. On the

other hand, there were the moderates, who rightly castigated what Kulwinder did as being contrary to the ethos of the uniform. And then, there were the not-so-moderate ones, who concluded that this was an act of terror and that Punjab was on the brink of secessionism by lazily correlating this incident with the election of Amritpal Singh and Sarabjeet Singh Khalsa. In short, the usual trope, devoid of reality, that has been peddled since the farmers’ protest. Kangana, as if on cue, added her two bits of ‘concern’ and equated the incident with the ‘rise of terrorism’ in Punjab. Kangana’s abhorrent remarks on Sikhs and Punjab during and after the farmers’ protest do not justify an act of violence against her, and I say this as someone who has sparred with her and attracted the vitriol and abuse of her supporters. We cannot justify someone in uniform making a political statement on duty — whatever the provocation. This is a slippery slope, and what the meme makers, stand-up comics, artistes and others fail to realise is that they could also be on the receiving end of violence one day. We must not forget that it was only last year that a constable of the Railway Protection Force killed four persons aboard the Jaipur-Mumbai Superfast Express, and at least three of the victims were allegedly targeted by him on account of their religion. The uniform cannot be politicised, and if it is, it will lead to disastrous consequences. It would be incorrect to label the CISF an unprofessional force — which it is not — based on Kulwinder’s

unbecoming conduct, but it would be pertinent to also address the ‘yeoman service’ that some officers in the military and paramilitary forces have rendered to the politicisation of their offices. The rank and file observe their leaders. If the leaders depart from their constitutional duties, join political events, make political statements in service and run as candidates of the ruling party immediately after demitting office, then politicisation will occur and manifest itself in different forms. The right to protest in a democracy is fundamental and absolute, as is the right to oppose those who protest. Therefore, it was entirely within the growers’ right to hold a stir against what they believed were unjust laws, and others are entitled to disagree with their cause. That the Government of India saw merit in their demands and ultimately repealed the laws is lost on various IT cells of political parties and trolls. Unfortunately, the discourse at the time reached the lowest of lows, and whoever protested or disagreed with the government was labelled an anti-national, a terrorist, an urban Naxal or a member of some fabled ‘Tukde Tukde’ gang and was subjected to hate and bigotry and faced calls for violence. There is no terrorism in Punjab, and the state rejected the idea of Khalistan long ago. Does Punjab have deeper social, economic and political challenges? Absolutely. And do these challenges create fissures and give rise to a fringe? Yes, they do. But has Punjab adopted the fringe en masse?

Kids flooding swimming pools, huge
rush witnessed

CHANDIGARH : While privately-run summer-coaching camps offering various activities, including dancing, painting, singing among others, are getting huge response from kids’ parents, the Charisma of summer turns unique. With the local educational institutions closed amid the severe heatwave, summer-coaching camps and indoor sports complexes across the city have started receiving an overwhelming response. While enrolment for swimming classes has increased at the local sports complexes. In order to protect the school students from the intense heat, the UT Administration had rescheduled the summer holidays. In efforts of trying to make most of these extended holidays, majority of the kids are attending these camps for recreation. “We have already registered more members than the actual capacity. The kiddies pool (having a depth of approximate 4 ft) have started witnessing a huge rush. Luckily, the pools having depth of over 6 ft are still



untouched by amateurs. Not only kids, but their parents are also approaching the department to get a slot,” said a swimming expert in the sports department here. The city has nearly 12 pools run by the local sports department and three are privately run in different sectors. “We have registered more than 15 schoolchildren in the last three days. During summer camps, the students indulge in various activities and interact with fellow kids. Usually, we organise such camps in June, but this year, we started early,” said Shelly Gupta, a private organiser. “Keeping in view the ongoing heatwave, we call kids in the morning and evening shifts. We have made elaborate arrangements to avoid any inconvenience to them,” said Sudarhsna,

who runs a summer camp in the city. “Soaring temperatures can lead to dehydration, exhaustion and even stroke. Kids should be encouraged to wear loose-fitting, light-coloured clothes that cover their arms and legs. During the peak hot hours, strenuous outdoor activities should be limited or even rescheduled for cooler mornings or evenings. When it comes to hydration, water is the king, but incorporating fruits like watermelon, coconut, oranges and berries can also be a delicious way to increase fluid intake. These fruits are packed with water and electrolytes, offering a natural way to replenish fluids lost through sweat,” said Dr Arpna Bansal, consultant, paediatrics department at a Panchkula hospital.

Drive against violations of
packaged material under rules,
2011 by Chandigarh Admn

CHANDIGARH : The weight and measurement department has recently conducted checking in commercial establishments across Chandigarh to regulate use of correct weighing and measuring instruments in trade and commerce. It was found that some firms are covering the declarations provided on the pre-packed commodities by their own MRP stickers, which is a violation of Packaged Commodities Rules, 2011. As per Rule 6 of The Packaged Commodities Rules, 2011, every pre-packed commodity should have mandatory declarations such as complete name and address of the manufacturer/packer/importer, month and year of packing/import, common or



generic name of the commodity, net contents, unit sale price and the sale price of the package (maximum retail price, incl. of all taxes), customer care number with name, address, telephone No. of the person/office which can be contacted in case of consumer complaints and size, if applicable printed on the such packages and declaration printed on them conform to the contents of the package. Legal Metrology Wing of the UT Department Food

and Supplies and Consumer Affairs and Legal Metrology is going to start an extensive checking drive in the coming days against violations of The Packaged Commodities Rules, 2011. The department requested the business establishments to ensure that the provisions of the rules are followed in letter and in spirit. The department has been engaged in regulating use of correct weighing and measuring instruments in trade and commerce, to ensure that exact weight, measure and number of any commodity is provided to any customer as contracted for, or paid for by him. It also safeguards consumers’ interest by ensuring mandatory declarations on packaged commodities.

Panchkula civic body to allot
project to new company

PANCHKULA : For the construction of new office building, the MC aims at floating tenders and completing the construction by March 2025. After years of delay due to a fundamental breach of contract and its cancellation, followed by a court case, the Panchkula Municipal Corporation’s project of construction of a new office building in Sector 3 is now finally set to be allocated to a new company. Earlier, the Municipal Corporation had allocated the construction of the new building in December 2019 for Rs 29.49 crore. The work was supposed to come to completion in April 2021. However, well before the project could come to completion, it was marred by a fundamental breach of tender conditions due to subletting of part of the work and a delay in execution, after which the company expressed its inability to complete the task. The contract between the MC and the company was



terminated, and the firm was held liable to pay liquidated damages of Rs 2.94 crore along with a 20 per cent penalty for the incomplete work. It was debarred from the tendering process, and its bank guarantee of Rs 1.47 crore was ordered to be forfeited. The court directed the MC to get the work done at the risk and cost of the company. The MC then invited fresh e-tenders for completion of the pending work; however, as the court had restricted it to finalising the bids only, the company again went to court over the same. As a result, the tender process remained inconclusive. In a recent oral order issued by a single Bench of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, it said the contract between the MC and the

firm envisaged an arbitration agreement and redirected the pending disputes, including the issue of debarment and the risk and cost of the company for completion of the pending work, to the arbitration court. It also allowed the MC to raise construction for the new building either through the existing tender, by issuing a corrigendum, or by inviting fresh tenders. Gian Chand Gupta, Panchkula MLA Speaker of the Haryana Legislative Assembly said the blockages in the way of construction of the new building were removed with the disposal of the court case. Mr Gupta said, “The MC will issue a new tender for the pending work soon, and it will be completed at the earliest.”

NSA Doval, US engage
counterpart talk in critical tech
cooperation

NEW DELHI : The peace meeting took place against the backdrop of political discord between the two sides after India stayed away from a West-quarterbacked communique on Ukraine at a peace summit in Italy. National Security Adviser Ajit Doval met his US counterpart Jake Sullivan to hold the first-ever review of the progress in joint work on critical technologies. A couple of days earlier, an Indian was extradited from Czech Republic to a Brooklyn jail for his alleged involvement in a plan to kill Sikh separatist Gurpatwant Singh Pannun on American soil. This was Doval's first engagement with the Americans after taking over as the NSA for the third time and demonstrates his utility for Modi 3.0 despite an



assassination in Canada that is unravelling with the arrest of four Indians and the extradition to US of Nikhil Gupta, allegedly the linkman between RAW officials and assassins hired to kill Pannun in New York. "The current visit continues their high-level engagement on the robust and multi-faceted agenda of the India-US global strategic partnership," said the MEA that did not mention any specific issue in this regard. The Foreign Ministry said the NSAs discussed bilateral issues and reviewed the

India-US partnership on regional and global issues of mutual interest. They also chaired the first annual review of the Initiative on Critical and Emerging Technologies (iCET) with an inter-departmental delegation from both countries. On Tuesday, the NSAs will address an iCET roundtable with industry CEOs. In the latter half of Modi 2.0, India had focussed substantially on the acquisition of critical technologies that will drive the economies of tomorrow. The issue was at the top of the agenda in PM Modi's meetings with leaders of France, the UK and Germany during his first visit overseas to Italy last week after taking over as PM for the third time. The iCET was launched just over two years ago by PM Modi and US President Joe Biden.

The decision was taken on Monday after Congress's top leadership held discussions on the issue at Kharge's residence. "The last five years as a member of Parliament from Wayanad have been a very fantastic and enjoyable experience. The people of Wayanad gave me support, energy to fight in a very difficult time. I will never forget that..."



"I will continue to visit Wayanad and the promises we made to Wayanad will be fulfilled," he said. Congress Parliamentary Party chairperson Sonia Gandhi, Rahul Gandhi and party general secretaries K C Venugopal and Priyanka Gandhi Vadra were among those present during the discussions. "Rahul Gandhi won from two Lok Saba seats but as per the law, he has to vacate one. Rahul Gandhi will retain Rae Bareli and we have decided that Priyanka ji will fight from Wayanad," Kharge said after the meeting. Rahul Gandhi said both Rae Bareli and Wayanad "will

get two MPs". "I have an old relation with Rae Bareli and I am very happy that I will be representing it. This was not an easy decision, because affection is with both (Wayanad and Rae Bareli)," he said. Rahul Gandhi has to vacate one of the seats within 14 days of the Lok Sabha results, which came out on June 4. "I won't let the people of Wayanad feel Rahul's absence," Priyanka Gandhi said. The Congress Working Committee has also urged Rahul Gandhi to take up the position of the Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha and a resolution to this effect was passed by the CWC in its last meeting held on June 8. Venugopal had said that the CWC urged Rahul Gandhi to take up the position as "he is the best person" for the post.

PATIALA : The All India Power Engineers Federation (AIPEF) has warned of power snags as demand increases all times high. The extreme summer conditions accompanied by the ongoing paddy transplantation have pushed the power demand to an all-time high, breaking last year's record of 15,325 MW from past three days. "The office timings should be changed from 7am to 2 pm and all commercial establishments, including malls, shops, should be closed by 7pm," says the AIPEF letter. The power engineers' body has asked to impose peak load restrictions. "This triggered a hike in power demand which is now constantly touching 15,500 MW and anymore increase by another 1,200 MW could lead to grid failure," said a PSPCL official.



"Paddy sowing in the remaining areas of Punjab should be shifted to June 25, and no one should be allowed to violate the date. The water guzzling varieties like PUSA 44 should be banned and encourage varieties like PRI26, basmati, etc., which mature in 90 days," said AIPEF. "Power theft should be covered as an offence under NSA. Free power as a state policy should be reviewed forthwith," it said. "A major power crisis looms large over Punjab with peak

demand constantly touching 15,500 MW in past three days, an all-time high in Punjab's history," said a senior Punjab State Power Corporation Limited. Last year on June 23, the PSPCL met a record maximum demand of 15,325 MW and supplied 3,435 lakh units. "The maximum demand of over 16,500 MW can be expected in the last week of June when the paddy season will be at peak," said a senior PSPCL official. As per Punjab Agriculture Department, the state had witnessed a staggering 31.93 lakh hectares under rice cultivation, including 5.87 lakh hectares of basmati, in 2023. The AIPEF also wants the state government to write to The Minister of Power "to allocate at least 1,000 MW additional power extra from central pool on Top Priority".

"PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in
Haryana" launched by CM

AMBALA : "It is a matter of pride for us to launch the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in Haryana in which rooftop solar plants will be installed. The benefit will be given on 'first come first served' basis. It will benefit the families having annual income of less than Rs 1.80 lakh. This scheme will help those who used to face difficulty in paying bills. People should get their registration done on the portal. The solar plant will be installed at a cost of Rs 1.10 lakh. While Rs 60,000 will be contributed by the Central government, the remaining Rs 50,000 will be given by the state government," pronounced Nayab Singh Saini, the Chief Minister of Haryana. Similarly, families with an income between Rs 1.80 lakh and Rs 3 lakh will receive a subsidy of Rs 60,000 from the Central government and Rs 20,000 from the state government," he added. Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini launched PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in the

state. He also announced an ultra super critical thermal power unit of 800 MW at Rajiv Gandhi Thermal Plant, Khedar, Hisar. The power unit will come at a cost of Rs 7,250 crore. The Chief Minister also announced that the government has abolished the monthly minimum charges (MMC) for the consumers having domestic connected load up to 2 KW. Earlier, the MMC was Rs 115 per KW. The consumers will have to pay their bills as per their consumption of units only. It will benefit 9.50 lakh families and will save them Rs 274 crore annually. Taking a dig at opposition parties, the CM said, "Electricity used to be a political

issue in the state. People used to seek votes in the name of 24-hour power supply. But the double-engine BJP government worked in a systematic manner — former Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar launched 'Hamara Gaon Jagmag Gaon' in Haryana, and as a result, all villages are getting 24-hour power supply today." The CM said, "To make Haryana self-reliant in the field of power generation, it has been decided to set up an 800 MW ultra super critical power unit at the Rajiv Gandhi Thermal Plant in Hisar to meet the future power demand at a cost of Rs 7,250 crore." Earlier, the CM also flagged off a bus under Mukhyamantri Tirtha Yatra Yojana ferrying devotees to Ayodhya and said, "I congratulate all those who are travelling to Ayodhya." As many as 38 devotees left for Ayodhya in the bus today. Power Minister Ranjit Singh Minister of State for Transport Aseem Goel, and several senior officials were present on the occasion.

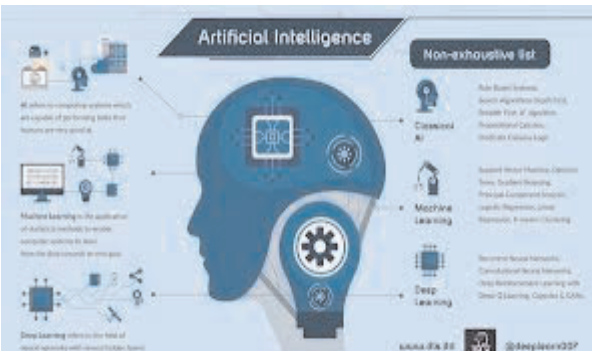

Elections to the post of the Speaker of the Central Legislative Assembly, the lower house of the Imperial Legislative Council - the legislature of British India, were held for the first time on August 24, 1925 when Swaraj Party nominee Vitthal bhai J Patel won the coveted post against T Rangachari. First non-official member Speaker Patel, the first non-official member to be elected as the Speaker,



won the maiden election with a narrow margin of two votes. Patel had polled 58 votes against 56 garnered by Rangachari. Buoyed by its increased strength in the Lok Sabha, the opposition INDIA bloc is now aggressively demanding the post of the Deputy Speaker, which by convention is held by a member of an opposition party.

A special Indian Air Force aircraft, C-130J, carrying mortal remains of 45 Indian victims in the fire incident in Kuwait's Mangaf, landed in Kochi on Friday morning and coordinated with Kuwaiti authorities to ensure swift repatriation, was also onboard the aircraft, the Indian embassy said.
