EDITORIAL -

Existing conflict between Tibet vs China

It's the existence of the ancient sovereign Tibet which became an eyesore to the newly-born Han state in October 1949. This political Tibet was perceptively defined by Hugh Richardson, the last British and first Indian Head of Mission in Lhasa, as a territory of half a million square miles, wherein ruled the "Tibetan Government continuously from earliest times down to 1951." This indisputable fact and reality of history is one that Indians usually didn't bother to stress upon, or forgot while taking on the 1949-born CPC dictatorship and its private militia-type People's Liberation Army (PLA). What stands as geopolitical Tibet today was actually broader, longer and larger, encompassing both the Qinghai and Sichuan provinces of Beijing's empire, which ethnographically were Tibetan from antiquity; but diabolical and destructive ethnic cleansing drastically changed them into a Han habitat centre. Tibet had always been an independent theocracy till 1950-1951, notwithstanding the sporadic Han invasion to forcibly capture this Himalayan land. Indeed, the history of Lhasa's political geography is well known and well documented. And factually, the Tibet-China border fluctuation and territorial dispute constitute the core issue around the Himalayas, which wasn't the making of either the British or the post-1947 Bharat. Hindustan's Himalayan frontier has never had any problem whatsoever. If anything, Delhi was

forcibly dragged into the Lhasa-Beijing dispute in the early 20th century, as a peripheral and secondary factor; it had never had any issue with its shared Himalayan border with the sovereign Tibet. The fact is, long before the advent of the Europeans in South Asia, it was the imperial rulers of the Middle Kingdom who were in a state of ceaseless conflict in the land between Beijing, Gansu and Tibet, which ultimately surged with the unprovoked invasion of the Lama land by the decaying Manchu ruler's ruthless General Chao Er-feng in 1910. This effectively gave the Chinese the first-ever entry to the Tibet capital against the Buddhist rulers' wishes. That's the beginning of the Himalayan odyssey, which subsequently hit Delhi hard by the Dragon from across the highland, which thus far constituted the natural and benign border-cum-barrier for thousands of years. In the early 20th century's India got entangled with the tussle of the two independent nations of Tibet and China indirectly as it was the diplomatic venue of her British rulers in 1913-1914 at the Simla Conference. Interestingly, the British here weren't the aggressor or combatant, but appeared as the mediator between the Lhasa-Beijing fight with a distinct Beijing tilt, as found in the original Simla plan, wherein "Thibet" was referred to as forming a "part of Chinese territory." Both London and Beijing were agreeable to Tibet being a part of China, but retaining her suzerainty under

Chinese sovereignty. Nevertheless, since the Chinese refused to sign the 1914 Simla Accord, they lost the opportunity of an international law document stipulating Tibet as a part of, and under, Chinese sovereignty. The end result was a reversion to status quo. The 1912 declaration of Tibet's sovereignty by the 13th Dalai Lama got fresh validity, which subsequently was never repudiated or rejected by any international diplomatic document. By not signing the Simla Conference documents, the dragon became the end loser as sovereign Tibet emerged unchallenged. In retrospect, when the CPC-PLA duo realised the monumental blunder of its 1914 predecessors, it came back with a vengeance to forcibly capture and crush independent Tibet in October 1950, exactly a year after gaining independence in the aftermath of a two-decades-long civil war. In one stroke, the huge Tibet became occupied land under the CPC-PLA dictatorship in 1950-1951. And, unlike today's diplomatic cacophony on Russia's Crimea annexation, there was no West or EU, NATO, USA or UN to sanction the Chinese aggressor or to supply tanks, missiles, bombs, guns and HIMARS rocket launchers to Tibet for fighting or taking action against the CPC-PLA's naked aggression and occupation of a sovereign landlocked state on the world's roof. Much has been made out post the 1950 CPC-PLA's Tibet conquest. Beijing went ballistic in its India-China border dispute as a "legacy of British imperialism" and

attributing its origin to the Simla Convention which made the McMahon Line as the Himalayan boundary. However, close scrutiny reveals that the "sole original ground of Beijing objections, so far as frontiers were concerned, was the line proposed for boundaries between" (sovereign) Tibet and (remote) China, not for India. In the eyes of the CPC-PLA, how could a sovereign Tibet border, claimed by sovereign China, be allowed to be passed on, or handed over, to India peacefully? Sixty years after the Chinese invasion of India, the stage is set to install Xi Jinping as China's lifetime ruler, even as the CPC-PLA's hardline approach to New Delhi is more than visible. And any Indian thinking otherwise, ie a change of heart of 21st-century China's leader, the "Second Mao", will be under the delusion that India won't lose any more land or will regain her lost sovereignty or that the Himalayan border will shortly be back to being a pristine and benign abode of peace and tranquillity as it existed during the days of sovereign Tibet as the neighbour of sovereign India from 1947 to 1950. True to the CPC-PLA design, which couldn't be deciphered by Delhi for seven decades, things haven't changed one bit. Transformation and transfer of the Himalayan border sharing from Lhasa to Delhi in "superior" Han rulers' eyes is as reprehensible and odious as it was before. If anything, the insatiable CPC-PLA appetite for Indian land doesn't show any sign of abatement even today.

Residents suffer multiple diseases owing to contaminated water supply by MC

Commissioner News Service
MOHALI : Environment activist and advocate Ms Sunaina filed the petition / application against the polluted water supply, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents for ensuring potable and clean water supply to residents of Zirakpur - Banur - Rajpura belt.

The civic bodies are to draw up a comprehensive plan to ascertain root causes of water contamination and suggest remedial measures.

The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has asked director, Punjab Water Supply and Sewerage Board (PWSSB) and member secretary, State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) to appear before the tribunal via video conferencing on 10 Oct . 2023, taking serious note of supply of contaminated drinking water to residents of the Zirakpur - Banur - Rajpura belt.

The applicant stated that due to supply of contaminated water, residents of Zirakpur - Banur - Rajpura belt were



suffering from various diseases like cholera, jaundice, typhoid, vomiting, abdominal pain, diarrhoea, dehydration and skin - borne diseases.

The Tribunal constituted a joint committee comprising state PCB ; principal secretary, department of health, Government of Punjab, Punjab water supply and sewerage board and deputy commissioners of Patiala and Mohali and directed them to submit an action taken report within two months.

"The statements made in the petition raise substantial questions relating to environment arising out of the implementation of the enactments specified in

Schedule - I to the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010. In view of the serious allegations made in the present application, it would be appropriate to have a factual and action taken report in the matter." The NGT said that personal appearance of the director, Punjab Water Supply and Sewerage Board and member secretary, State PCB was essential for producing relevant documents regarding requisite compliance with the enactments specified in Schedule - I to the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 and also in assisting the Tribunal in just and proper adjudication of the questions involved in the case.

Deliver fast justice in sacrilege case - Vijay Pratap

BEHBAL KALAN (FARIDKOT): Justice is not far away now and soon those who are protesting will assemble for shukrana divas (thanksgiving day) soon, he said. "If justice is not done now, we will lose faith in this government as well. We have already taken up the matter with the government," he said. As a host of speakers took on the previous SAD - BJP and Congress regimes and the present AAP government for playing with the Sikh sentiments and not doing anything to deliver justice, Punjab assembly speaker Kultar Singh Sandhwan tried to pacify the crowd. Punjab minister Inderbir Singh Nijjar reaffirmed Sandhwan's statement. Earlier, speakers also demanded filing of a challan against former CM Parkash Singh Badal and his son and then home minister Sukhbir



Badal. They even demanded death penalty for sacrilege.

Making a veiled attack on the Badals, Vijay Pratap said they had witnessed bloodshed ordered by general Dyer whom Michael O'Dwyer had sent. "It wasn't the army from Lahore but from Punjab," said Vijay Pratap as he dismissed the statements made by the then government that there was an ISI hand in the incident.

Showing copies of his investigation on the matter, Vijay Pratap said when I resigned from police services, the Badal family was very happy. They were behind the cancellation of cases against

Dera Sacha Sauda head Gurmeet Ram Rahim and the sacrilege, he alleged.

Waris Punjab De head Amritpal Singh said the community could wait for some more time if the government assures them of providing justice. However, he cautioned the state on an inordinate delay in delivering justice.

Deceased Krishan Bhagwan Singh's son Sukhraj Singh, who is managing the Insaaf Morcha, said the government must stop testing the patience of Sikh community. "We have been waiting for justice for seven long years and the state must keep it in mind that any further delay can be harmful for it," he said. Sukhraj also told the government not to make efforts to save a political family as was suggested by Kunwar Vijay Pratap.

Shifting of fuel base need of time

CHANDIGARH : Since the CAQM (Commission for Air Quality Management) has provided a window till December 31 for the errant industrial units, we are hopeful that all such units will shift to cleaner fuel by then," said HSPCB chairman P Raghuvendra Rao.

As per information, of the 381 industries in Panipat, 202 have either shifted to biomass, while 32 have shifted to PNG. Similarly in Gurugram, 183 units have shifted to PNG, 24 to biomass and 39 to electricity.

In Faridabad, 37 industrial units have shifted to PNG, 40 to biomass, 22 to electricity and 14 to low sulfur heavy stock fuel. "Since shifting to biomass was the easiest one, most of our industries have shifted to biomass. While those units which are in the process of shifting to a cleaner fuel base are currently getting their job work done from those industries that have already switched to cleaner energy, said Pritam Singh Sachdeva president of the Panipat



Industries Association. Forced by the directives of the Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM), industries in the national capital region, barring Panipat, have started shifting to cleaner fuel, revealed the data released by the Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB). Earlier, restrictions imposed by the CAQM had sent the 20,000 odd industrial units across the NCR in the state into a tizzy. Besides impacting the working of Panipat - based dyeing units, the CAQM orders also raised questions at the restrictive use of generators by non - fuel based industries, especially when it came

to use of captive power. As per the HSPCB data, a total of 3,135 units were identified for causing air pollution and were on the radar of the administration following the CAQM guide lines. As of Thursday, 1,165 units have shifted to bio mass, 776 to PNG, 367 to electricity and 213 industrial units have moved to low sulfur heavy stock fuel, revealed the data. All these industries use furnaces and boilers for their operations and require fuel for production. "Haryana has shown an improvement when it comes to shifting of fuel base by the polluting units.

50 samples of food items sent for laboratory test

The seized items include milk, paneer, khoya, sweets and bakery products, amid other items. The test report of all the samples is awaited. Following strict guidelines of the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) commissioner Abhinav Trikha, the team of the district health department have raided many sweet shops to discourage selling of spurious material. The team also conducted four

early - morning sampling drives to check adulteration in the food products being sold by the neighbouring states. Dr Kumar said the food safety team is visiting all the sweet manufacturing factories and checking the hygiene, there. Shops and factory owners are issued challans if conditions are not found satisfactory, he added. Food safety team is also conducting raids with the help of local administration involving

SDM Mohali and SDM Derabassi. The DHO further said that the message by the health department is clear and loud that every food business operator needs to follow all the guidelines that are laid in the Food Safety Act. He appealed to all the hotel, dhaba and dairy owners, and caterers of the district to buy cheese, milk, curd and all other food items with proper bills, and not to buy anything, especially from other districts and states, without a bill. He said the sale of adulterated and substandard food products will not be tolerated at all, as under the Food Safety, Standards and Regulation Act, adulterated and substandard milk and milk products cannot be sold under any circumstances.

15 ft wide eco friendly food street for Chandigarh

G20 Summit in September 2023 to be host by India

Commissioner News Service NEW DELHI : India is set to take over the presidency of G20 for a year from Indonesia, which is set to host the leaders' summit in November. The country will hold the presidency from December 1, 2022 to November 30, 2023. Our country will take over the presidency of the G20 from December and host the summit of leaders of the world's twenty largest economies in New Delhi during September 9-10, 2023. Under its Presidency, India is expected to host more than 200 preparatory and other meetings across the country, beginning in December this year. An exercise is already underway to identify suitable venues in places ranging from Tamil Nadu to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir for hosting these meetings. India will take over after twice swapping the presidency of the G20, first with Italy in 2021 and then with Indonesia in 2022. "The G20 Leaders' Summit at the level of Heads of State [or] Government is scheduled to be held on 09 and 10 September, 2023, in New Delhi," the external affairs ministry said in a statement on Tuesday. Indonesia has invited both the Russian and Ukrainian presidents to the G20 Summit to



be held in Bali during November 15-16. Russia's presence in preparatory meetings this year has already led to some tensions with other member states. The Group of Twenty is an intergovernmental forum of the world's major developed and developing economies. It comprises 19 countries - Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, South Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, the UK and the US - and the European Union (EU). Collectively, the G20 accounts for 85% of the global GDP, 75% of international trade and two-thirds of the world population, making it the premier forum for international economic

cooperation. India is currently part of the G20 Troika, which comprises the current, previous and incoming G20 presidencies and includes Indonesia, Italy and India. During its presidency, the troika will include India, Indonesia and Brazil. This will be the first time that the troika will consist of three developing countries and emerging economies, "providing them a greater voice", the statement said. Mohali SSP served contempt notice over RTI issue
