Politics, crimes how would we salvage?

Law and order is a state subject, in what amounts to a no-confidence signal against the local police, Mamata has backed the transfer of the case probe to the CBI and demanded that the perpetrators be apprehended and tried expeditiously. Preliminary reports about how the case was handled by the local police in the early stages of the investigation have raised many troubling questions, including allegations of a botched cover-up attempt to shield the perpetrators.

A rebuke by the Calcutta Court High embarrassed the police. To compound alleged perfidy by the state government, the principal of the medical college concerned was allowed to 'resign' but immediately appointed at another local hospital, thereby exonerating him of the lapses resulting in the Abhaya tragedy. Even wellwishers of the TMC are dismayed.

The horrific gangrape and murder of a junior doctor at a medical college and hospital in Kolkata has triggered national outrage. This was reflected in Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Independence Day address.

"I would like to express my pain once again, from the Red Fort today. As a society, we will have to think seriously against women that are happening — there is outrage against this in

Security deployment to shoot up by 25% at Central hospitals -**Ministry of Health**

NEW DELHI: The Health Ministry has allowed enhancement of security deployment by 25 per cent at Union Government hospitals, official said, amid protests by resident doctors demanding a Central law following the alleged rape and murder of a trainee doctor at a Kolkata hospital. Apart from the standard security protocol, deployment of marshals

would also be approved based on individual demands by government hospitals after they conduct their security assessment. Bringing a Central law based

on the RG Kar case "will not make any huge difference" as the alleged rape and murder of the junior doctor at the Kolkata facility was not a of patient-doctor violence.

Crimes and rapes are already covered under existing laws, they said.

They further said that 26 states and Union Territories, including West Bengal,



Uttarakhand, Delhi, Haryana, Maharashtra, Karnataka and Kerala, have passed legislations to protect healthcare personnel. In all these states these offences are cognisable and non-bailable. 'So, bringing in an ordinance or even a Central law, that too based on the RG Kar case which was not a patientdoctor violence incident, will make any huge difference," an official source

They said they have held meetings with some Doctors' Residents Associations and have explained these aspects to them too. More so, a committee will be

constituted under the chairmanship of Directorate

General of Health Services (DGHS) to look into various aspects of security and facilities at hospitals for residents like duty room, working hours conditions, and canteen services.

"Hospitals being public facilities cannot be turned into a fortress. We have urged the doctors to call off their strike because patient care is getting affected," an official source said.

The ongoing doctors' strike in the national capital over the Kolkata incident completed a week on Sunday, causing difficulties for patients. Medical

Indian Association (IMA) has also sought Prime Minister Narendra Modi's "benign" intervention in realising their demands that includes a central law to check violence against healthcare personnel and declaring hospitals safe zones, like airports, with mandatory security entitlements.

Besides, the bus is equipped with air-conditioner, autoclave, generator, power backup, etc,



which will help in emergency dental treatment. Through this van, awareness about dental diseases will also be spread, particularly in rural areas. Besides, dentists will organise dental camps, and the van will be beneficial for the training and further studies of dental college

Chandrachud could not take up the matter due to paucity of time on Monday. The Punjab Government had

last year filed a suit before



the Supreme Court against the Centre over the nonreimbursement of statutory fees allegedly running into thousands of crores of rupees that the state government had levied on behalf of the Central Government during the procurement of food grains. In its original suit filed under Article 131 of the Constitution, the State of Punjab complained against the Centre for refusing to transfer back the statutory Market Fees and Rural

Development Fees levied by the state on behalf of the Centre. 131 of the

Constitution deals with original jurisdiction of the top court in a dispute between the Centre and one or more states or a dispute between two or more states. The levies are key to bearing the expenses of acquiring food grains with minimum transition losses, the State government explained.

The dues on account of RDF were said to be to the tune of Rs 3637 crore from 2021 and market fees to the tune of Rs 2400 crore from 2022. The Centre's actions went against the Modified Fixation Principles in place since February 24, 2020, the Government Punjab submitted.

'We had high hopes of women safety' but **Swati**

Kolkata / New Delhi: The mob violence took place while midnight protests 'Reclaim the Night' were being held by women.

A large group of unidentified men stormed into Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital around 12.40am on Thursday and destroyed hospital property at rampant in the middle of the junior doctors' ongoing agitation doctors' ongoing agitation against the August 9 rape and murder of a post-



Supreme Court Will Suspend All Freebies by Maharashtra

New Delhi Maharashtra government had a huge amount to "waste on freebies" but does not have money to comhave money to compensate a private party which lost land to it "illegally".said the Supreme Court.

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Wednesday warned the Maharashtra government that it would suspend its freehie suspend its freebie schemes unless it pays compensation to a private party whose land was "illegally" occupied by it more than six decades ago. Coming down heavi-ly on the Maharashtra

government, the court said it had a huge amount to "waste on freebies" but does not have money to compensate a private party which lost land to it

"illegally". Observing that Maharashtra's conduct in the matter was not that of a "model state", the court warned it may direct that all the freebie schemes will be suspended until compensation amount was paid.
