Unapproved Colony “Central Town” on Shamlat land springs fast, MC ignores deliberately

Interanal roads, Sewerage system, crying on death bed for survival

Zirakpur : The illegitimate massive demolition of unapproved constructions of 'Central Town' would, one day, become monstrous task, if the timely action is not initiated against the on going construction beside the Nagla road. It is pertinent to highlight here that no structure can be raised/built on the shamlat land of the government / panchayat, nevertheless on the Nagla road, 'Sanat Realtors' owned by Sunny Garg has purportedly engaged in constructing the colony sans any valid architectural plan. The Commissioner News Service endeavoured its best to contact the



owner of the ongoing project but the owner had reportedly tried to evade the scribe and had instructed his sensitise staff about his mobile number or whereabouts to any visitor or client. The clandestine dealing itself speaks volumes on the legality of the proposed Central Town. The Punjab

Apartment Ownership Act, no. 13 in 1995 enshrined to provide ownership of an individual apartment in all respects of a building with full architectural amenities. The sale manager of the 'Sanat Realtors' however said the land was ancestral and no customer was required to



worry as they were safe in the hands of the said realtors. No one, at this juncture, should forget the deeds of the former Executive Officer Girish Verma who amassed several crores of rupees by passing wrong architectural layouts and neverchecked the practically built up houses or the commercial buildings.

The issues were transcending its barriers and he was caught red handed, had to face the jail imprisonment during 2022. The alleged fake architectural plan on Shamlat land is bamboozling the homeseekers and the RERA has silently beenwatching the phenomenon on the earth, where as it is

has not manifested the names of the official signatories which are not clear with bold letters name, mobile numbers incase any client wish to meet or clarify one's doubts, he finds no way to claim his capital amount, said a home seeker on the basis of anonymity. In the ongoing fraudulent cases, now the time bound replies are being sought by the higher authorities and another Vidhan Sabha Committee comprising 13 MLAs has come into being for containing the mushrooming of illegitimate constructions, said an official of the Vidhan Sabha Committee.

EDITORIAL –

Politics, crimes how would we salvage ?

Law and order is a state subject, in what amounts to a no-confidence signal against the local police, Mamata has backed the transfer of the case probe to the CBI and demanded that the perpetrators be apprehended and tried expeditiously. Preliminary reports about how the case was handled by the local police in the early stages of the investigation have raised many troubling questions, including allegations of a botched cover-up attempt to shield the perpetrators. A rebuke by the Calcutta High Court has embarrassed the police. To compound the alleged perfidy by the state government, the principal of the medical college concerned was allowed to ‘resign’ but was immediately appointed at another local hospital, thereby exonerating him of the lapses resulting in the Abhaya tragedy. Even wellwishers of the TMC are dismayed. The horrific gangrape and murder of a junior doctor at a medical college and hospital in Kolkata has triggered national outrage. This was reflected in Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s Independence Day address. “I would like to express my pain once again, from the Red Fort today. As a society, we will have to think seriously about the atrocities against women that are happening — there is outrage against this in

the country. I can feel this outrage. The country, society and state governments will have to take this seriously.” Such cases of crime against women should be investigated speedily “and those responsible should be punished without delay” to bemoaned Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The victim in the Kolkata case is being referred to as Abhaya by her shell-shocked colleagues, recalling the horrific 2012 Delhi gangrape-murder that was termed the ‘Nirbhaya’ case; it took eight years before the perpetrators were finally brought to justice in March 2020. The sexual violence unleashed on the doctor is gut-wrenching. Hopefully, the CBI will be able to move swiftly, even as the Abhaya case is the tip of a murky iceberg. In the same fortnight, a nurse returning home after night duty at an Uttarakhand hospital was sexually assaulted and murdered (July 30); the accused was arrested a week later from Bareilly. India’s rape statistics indicate that 90 such dastardly incidents are reported daily. The callous justification for the deplorable trends related to the security and safety of women and the girl child over the past two decades. A large number of rape and molestation cases do not get reported by the

families of the victims. Alas, in many instances, close family members are the culprits. Despite Nirbhaya-2012 and the outrage it generated at that time, the response of both the state and society has not changed for the better in any visible manner. Immediate uproar after every ghastly incident is followed by political platitudes. The ‘Beti Bachao’ (save the girl child) pledge, made with fanfare by Modi 1.0 in January 2015, remains a mere slogan. The law is enforced in a selective manner. Once assured of state patronage, the ubiquitous male predator remains on the prowl and vulnerable women are exploited, whether at the workplace (as in the Abhaya case) or on the streets (Nirbhaya case). The plight of victims in high-profile rape cases and the relief accorded by the state to the accused are stark in cases such as that of Bilkis Bano (2002 Gujarat riots); clearly, political considerations trump the sanctity of the law. Electoral compulsions have made a mockery of justice; the perpetrators, instead of being brought to book, are feted and treated with kid gloves. The sordid Gurmeet Ram Rahim saga and the latitude given by the Modi government to ex-MP and former wrestling federation chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh are illustrative.

Fill in correct information for new Aadhar card : Chandigarh DC

CHANDIGARH : Out of the 1,190 applications received for aadhar card in the past one year, 627 have been rejected, mostly because the applicants were not found residing at the mentioned address during field verification. Chairing the district-level Aadhaar monitoring committee, Deputy Commissioner Vinay Pratap Singh urged people to submit complete applications with correct details for new enrolment as the Administration conducts physical verification of each and every application. Jagdish Kumar, Director, UIDAI, Chandigarh, said residents must keep their Aadhaar updated and ‘upload

document’ feature was available on mAadhaar app and on ‘my Aadhaar portal’ where one could upload latest proof of identity (POI) and proof of address (POA) in cases where no updation was done in the past 10 years. The feature is accessible free of cost till September 14 online or at all Aadhaar enrolment centres for a fee of Rs 50. The DC also appealed to parents to get their children enrolled for Aadhaar and further get the biometrics updated of children aged 5 and 15 years at

nearby Aadhaar enrolment centres. The facility is free of cost and provided in select government schools in Chandigarh as well as at Sampark centres, select post offices, bank branches, aanganwadis centres and Aadhaar Seva Kendra. Sachin, project manager, UIDAI, suggested to update email ID in Aadhaar so that residents could get updates. At present, only 17% of Aadhaar cards from UT Chandigarh are seeded with email ID.



Mandip Brar becomes new Chandigarh Home Secretary

CHANDIGARH : The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved inter-cadre deputation of Mandip Singh Brar from the Haryana cadre to the AGMUT cadre (Chandigarh segment) for three years or until further orders, whichever is earlier. Mr Brar had earlier served as city DC from 2018 to 2021. Mandip Brar, a 2005-batch IAS officer of the Haryana cadre, will become the new Home Secretary of Chandigarh. He had



done his graduation from the Government College, Sector 11. The Haryana Government had sent a panel of three IAS officers to the UT Administration for the post, including Amit Kumar Aggarwal (batch 2003), Mandeep Singh Brar (2005) and J Ganeshan (2006).

600 new houses planned for construction by govt

CHANDIGARH : For the new housing project, the UT was considering using 33 acres in Sector 43, where “Apni Mandi” is held for the residents of Chandigarh town. At present, there are nearly 13,500 government houses for employees from Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and the Centre. The existing Type-2 houses, with two rooms, one toilet and one separate bathroom, are in poor shape. In an effort to alleviate the shortage of government housing for employees from Punjab, Haryana and Chandigarh, the UT Administration has planned to construct nearly 600 new government houses. Officials of the UT Engineering Department had recently discussed the project with UT Adviser Rajeev Verma.

UT Chief Engineer CB Ojha said the administration was in the process of identifying a suitable site for the new housing plan, with potential locations being Sector 43, 46 or 50. A final decision was expected within a month. The major demand was for Type-2 (two-bedroom) and Type-3 (three-bedroom) houses, he added. Ojha also stated that 124 government houses, which are in poor shape, would be demolished. Preliminary estimates suggest around 600 houses would be constructed. The new two-bedroom houses will feature one drawing room, attached toilet, bathroom and dining hall each and two galleries. The three-bedroom houses will include one drawing room, one dining hall and attached bathrooms for each room.

Migrant labourers being subjected to discrimination in Jandpur village

MOHALI : Under the name of law and order, a handful of social activists here have issued an 11-point diktat to the migrant labourers and ‘outsiders’, including a prohibition of staying outdoors after 9pm. Continuing with the disturbing trend of vigilantism in rural areas, Jandpur has become the third village in the area where migrant labourers and ‘outsiders’ are being subjected to discrimination. Naib Tehsildar Vikasdeep and police officials visited Jandpur village and held talks with the activists there who had put the boards. They dissuaded them from framing rules for the society and advised the migrant



workers to register a complaint with the police if anyone harasses them. The Naujawan Sabha, Jandpur, said if the guidelines are not followed within 15 days or violated repeatedly, they will be asked to leave the village. Locals said the group is planning a door-to-door awareness campaign in the coming days. One councillor is also reported to be backing the move. The diktats include wearing proper length clothes, ban on smoking, only two persons per room on rent and not parking vehicles in streets and roads.

Worth Rs 20 crore fuel saved by e-buses within 2 years

CHANDIGARH : About 25.28 lakh litres of diesel worth Rs 20.80 crore has been saved within two and a half years by plying electric buses on local routes. Procured in November 2021, 80 electric buses are in service in the tricity at present, said a spokesman of the UT Transport Department. The electric buses had covered 1.26 crore km till August 16 on intra-city routes, thus saving over 25.28 lakh litres of diesel besides preserving environment. These buses have helped prevent 6674.91 tonne of CO2 emission. The e-bus fleet of the department included vehicles of Ashok Leyland and Eicher. In order to provide eco-friendly transportation in the city, the department plans to procure 100 more e-buses this year. The administration has plans to replace the entire fleet of 350 diesel buses



of the Chandigarh Transport Undertaking (CTU), running both on local as well as suburban routes, with electric ones by 2027-28. Each bus covers a distance of nearly 130 km on a single charge. It takes nearly two hours to fully charge a vehicle. With a seating capacity of 36, a bus can carry a maximum of 54 people at a time. On an average, each bus covers 200-300 km a day. The State-Level Steering Committee (SLSC) has decided to replace 100 diesel buses with e-vehicles sanctioned by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs to Chandigarh under the

Centre-sponsored PM e-Bus Sewa Scheme. The ministry will be requested to allocate 80 more buses to the city under this scheme. Apart from public transport, the share of private electric vehicles (EVs) is also increasing. Since the implementation of the EV Policy in September 2022, as many as 3,281 electric two-wheelers and 1,785 four-wheelers have been registered in the city till July 15. According to the data provided by the Registration and Licensing Authority (RLA), 352 electric two-wheelers and 114 four-wheelers were registered from September to December in 2022. The highest number of 2,103 electric two-wheelers and 1,013 four-wheelers had been registered in 2023 and 826 two-wheelers and 658 four-wheelers till July 15 this year in the city.

Victorious hockey team with Olympic bronze felicitated with cash prize by Bhagwant Mann

Tanmaya Lal, Secretary (West) in the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), eulogised the move at a media



briefing. Days ahead of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Kyiv, India on Monday said it is willing to contribute in finding a peaceful solution to the conflict in Ukraine. The ongoing conflict in Ukraine will form



a part of discussions, he said. India has independent ties with both Russia and Ukraine, Lal said replying to a question. Modi will travel to Poland before visiting Ukraine.

Security deployment to shoot up by 25% at Central hospitals - Ministry of Health

NEW DELHI : The Health Ministry has allowed enhancement of security deployment by 25 per cent at all Union Government hospitals, official said, amid protests by resident doctors demanding a Central law following the alleged rape and murder of a trainee doctor at a Kolkata hospital. Apart from the standard security protocol, the deployment of marshals would also be approved based on individual demands by government hospitals after they conduct their security assessment. Bringing a Central law based on the RG Kar case "will not make any huge difference" as the alleged rape and murder of the junior doctor at the Kolkata facility was not a case of patient-doctor violence. Crimes and rapes are already covered under existing laws, they said. They further said that 26 states and Union Territories, including West Bengal,



Uttarakhand, Delhi, Haryana, Maharashtra, Assam, Karnataka and Kerala, have passed legislations to protect healthcare personnel. In all these states these offences are cognisable and non-bailable. "So, bringing in an ordinance or even a Central law, that too based on the RG Kar case which was not a patient-doctor violence incident, will not make any huge difference," an official source said. They said they have held meetings with some Residents Doctors' Associations and have explained these aspects to them too. More so, a committee will be constituted under the chairmanship of Directorate

General of Health Services (DGHS) to look into various aspects of security and facilities at hospitals for residents like duty room, working hours and conditions, and canteen services. "Hospitals being public facilities cannot be turned into a fortress. We have urged the doctors to call off their strike because patient care is getting affected," an official source said. The ongoing doctors' strike in the national capital over the Kolkata incident completed a week on Sunday, causing difficulties for patients. The Indian Medical Association (IMA) has also sought Prime Minister Narendra Modi's "benign" intervention in realising their demands that includes a central law to check violence against healthcare personnel and declaring hospitals safe zones, like airports, with mandatory security entitlements.

3 months extension granted to Jaspal Singh Sandhu GNDU Vice-Chancellor

AMRITSAR : Appointed V-C in August 2017, Jaspal Singh Sandhu's tenure is set to stretch over seven years. Before joining as the V-C in 2017, he was the secretary of University Grants Commission (UGC). Mr Sandhu, the present incumbent Vice-Chancellor (VC) of Guru Nanak Dev University (GNDU), received an extension in his term for another three months. Acting on the recommendation of the government, Punjab Governor Gulab Chand Kataria gave his assent to the decision.



Sandhu also served as a professor and headed the Department of Sports Medicine and Physiotherapy at GNDU. It was also learnt that the Bhagwant Mann-led government has already commenced screening applicants for the coveted post. Around 50 applications, many of which were from the senior faculty of the GNDU, have already been received.

Dental services at Aam Aadmi Clinics to be available across Punjab : Health minister

PATIALA : Soon oral health services will be offered at Aam Aadmi Clinics (AACs) across the state said Dr Balbir Singh, Health Minister while flagging off a modern mobile dental clinic van, prepared at a cost of Rs 67 lakh, from Government Dental College here. "There is a huge lack of awareness among people about dental diseases, especially among the marginal section of society. It is also leading to situations like oral cancer. Dental doctors will play an important role in preventing the increasing disease of oral cancer. We are planning to offer such facilities at our AACs so that the marginal section of the society could benefit from it," said Dr Balbir. There are a total of 842 Aam Aadmi Clinics across the state, providing at least 80 diagnostic tests free of cost. Sharing details about the mobile dental clinic van, Dr Balbir Singh said that this state-of-the-art van has two fixed dental chairs and one mobile dental chair for the complete examination of the patient's teeth. Besides, the bus is equipped with air-conditioner, autoclave, generator, power backup, etc,



which will help in emergency dental treatment. Through this van, awareness about dental diseases will also be spread, particularly in rural areas. Besides, dentists will organise dental camps, and the van will be beneficial for the training and further studies of dental college students. Dr Balbir Singh said that dental students' study will examine the teeth of people in villages, cities, colonies, school students, and common people. This will benefit research and offer affordable oral healthcare to the marginal section of society. On this occasion, director Research and Medical Education Dr Avnish Kumar, joint director Dr Puneet Girhadar and Dr Akash, Colonel JV Singh, college principal Dr JS Mann, Dr Harmesh Sharma, Dr Gagandeep Kaur, and medical students were present. The minister added that the process has been completed and 39 vacant posts of dental doctors will be filled soon.

Karnataka High Court defers special court proceedings for Siddaramaiah till August 29

BENGALURU : In the petition, the Chief Minister submitted that the sanction order by the governor, Thawar Chand Gehlot was issued without due application of mind, in violation of statutory mandates, and contrary to constitutional principles, including the advice of the Council of Ministers, which is binding under Article 163 of the Constitution of India. The Karnataka High Court on Monday directed the special court for people's representatives, slated to hear complaints against Chief Minister Siddaramaiah in the alleged Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) site allotment 'scam', to defer its proceedings till the next date of hearing on August 29. "No injunction has been granted," said Justice M Nagaprasanna, who heard a writ petition filed by the



Chief Minister challenging the legality of the August 16 order of the Governor, who accorded sanction against him under Section 17A of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and Section 218 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. Siddaramaiah contended that the Governor's decision is legally unsustainable, procedurally flawed, and motivated by extraneous considerations, and thus, he has preferred the writ petition seeking to quash the impugned order amongst

other reliefs. The Governor had issued the order after Pradeepkumar S P, T J Abraham and Snehamayi Krishna had submitted to him petitions requesting sanction for prosecution of the Chief Minister in connection with the alleged irregularities in the allotment of alternative sites to his wife Parvathi by MUDA. Abraham and Krishna have moved the special court for public representatives, and the case was slated to come up on Tuesday and Wednesday. "Since the matter is being heard by this court and the pleadings are yet to get complete, till the next date of hearing, the concerned court shall defer its proceedings," Justice Nagaprasanna said. Senior advocate and Congress spokesperson Abhishek Manu Singhvi and the Solicitor General of India Tushar Mehta appeared on behalf of the Chief Minister

Urgent release of over Rs 1,000 crore RDF, market fees from Centre, case deferred to Sept 2 by Supreme Court

NEW DELHI : The Supreme Court Bench, has agreed to hear the Punjab Government's plea on September 2 after Attorney General R Venkataramani and Punjab Advocate General Gurinder Singh jointly made a request in this regard. The case deferred to September 2 the hearing on the Punjab Government's plea seeking an urgent release of over Rs 1,000 crore from the Centre on account of alleged dues of Market Fees and Rural Development Fees (RDF). A Bench led by CJI DY Chandrachud could not take up the matter due to paucity of time on Monday. The Punjab Government had last year filed a suit before



the Supreme Court against the Centre over the non-reimbursement of statutory fees allegedly running into thousands of crores of rupees that the state government had levied on behalf of the Central Government during the procurement of food grains. In its original suit filed under Article 131 of the Constitution, the State of Punjab complained against the Centre for refusing to transfer back the statutory Market Fees and Rural

Development Fees levied by the state on behalf of the Centre. Article 131 of the Constitution deals with original jurisdiction of the top court in a dispute between the Centre and one or more states or a dispute between two or more states. The levies are key to bearing the expenses of acquiring food grains with minimum transition losses, the State government explained. The dues on account of RDF were said to be to the tune of Rs 3637 crore from 2021 and market fees to the tune of Rs 2400 crore from 2022. The Centre's actions went against the Modified Fixation Principles in place since February 24, 2020, the Punjab Government submitted.

Kolkata Police said 40 people, allegedly disguised



as protestors, entered the hospital premises, vandalised property and cars, and pelted stones at the police. Suwendu Adhikari BJP leader alleged that the vandalism was carried out by "TMC goons" sent by chief minister Mamata Banerjee. The protests were a reaction to the rape and murder of a postgraduate trainee doctor

at the RG Kar Medical College and Hospital in Kolkata while on duty. The body of the 31-year-old woman was found on August 9 in the seminar hall of the hospital. The Kolkata police commissioner Vineet Goyal blamed the media for the mob attack on August 15, alleging that what happened was the result of 'wrong and malicious media campaign'.

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Wednesday warned the Maharashtra government that it would suspend its freebie schemes unless it pays compensation to a private party whose land was "illegally" occupied by it more than six decades ago. Coming down heavily on the Maharashtra government, the court said it had a huge amount to "waste on freebies" but does not have money to compensate a private party which lost land to it "illegally". Observing that Maharashtra's conduct in the matter was not that of a "model state", the court warned it may direct that all the freebie schemes will be suspended until the compensation amount was paid. A bench of Justices BR Gavai and K V



Viswanathan noted while the state has offered to pay ? 37.42 crore as compensation, the applicant's counsel has contended that it comes to around ? 317 crore. Advocate Nishant R Katneshwarkar, appearing for Maharashtra, urged the bench to grant three weeks, saying the matter was being considered at the highest level and certain principle was required to be followed for calculating compensation according to the ready reckoner. We will grant you three weeks time and

pass an interim order that until we permit, no freebies schemes should be implemented in the state of Maharashtra. We will stop 'Ladki Bahin', 'Ladka Bhau'," the bench said. Under the 'Mukhyamantri Majhi Ladki Bahin Yojana' announced by the state government earlier this year, ? 1,500 is slated to be transferred into the bank accounts of eligible women in the age group of 21 to 65 years whose family income was less than ? 2.5 lakh.

Pvt schools have to accommodate economically low wards: SC

New Delhi: "I am the first generation from my family who went to an English medium school. My parents studied in a Marathi-medium school. When I came to Delhi, it gave me a holistic understanding of what life in India is... When I went to Delhi University, I interacted with students from Northeast state. Only after interacting, we realised what North East is. Otherwise who knew what North East was", said CJI Chandrachud. The Apex Court upheld a Bombay HC order quashing Maharashtra govt's Feb 9 notification that had exempted private schools, within one kilometre radius of a govt or govt-aided school, from keeping aside 25% of seats in pre-primary classes for admitting poor students under Right to Education Act. Appearing for petitioner, Association of Indian

Schools', senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi said there are conflicting judgments from various HCs on this issue, with one from Allahabad HC where CJI Chandrachud was chief justice delivering that was in line with the ruling of the July 19 Bombay HC judgment. "It requires consideration and an authoritative declaration from SC," he said.

A bench of CJI D Y Chandrachud, and Justices J B Pardihrad, and Justices J B Pardiwala and Manoj Misra said a poor child statutorily have a right to admission in good private schools. "Why should we relegate them to govt schools and deny them admissions to good private schools. The poor students do not get a chance to get facilities for studies, sports and other activities available in a private school"

Rajnath to head for United States
