300 persons given citizenship under new Amendment Act

New Delhi: With the Centre handing over documents to over 300 people, is an emphatic signal of its intent to go ahead with the law. It was enacted in the face of heavy resistance, which opened an accelerated path for Indian citizenship to other members of religious minorities from Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan who arrived in India by 2014 to escape religious persecution. Mr A.K Bhalla Home Secretary handed over citizenship certificates to 14 applicants in New Delhi, others got the much - awaited document digitally. Mr Amit Shah Home Minister

lauded the development and termed it "historic " , an assertion which was seen also as a political statement in the context of continuing resistance to CAA from opposition parties like CPM, Trinamool Congress

and DMK which have vowed not to implement the law for not keeping Muslims within its purview.

EDITORIAL –

Liberal democracy a choicest way of life

A country falls into the category of liberal democracy when it institutionalises free and fair elections, ensures judicial independence, establishes robust constraints on executive overreach, rigorously safeguards civil liberties and upholds equality before the law. The government in India has occasionally used laws on sedition, defamation and counterterrorism to silence critics. A third electoral term for the BJP government “could lead to further autocratisation, given the already substantial democratic decline under Modi’s leadership and the enduring crackdown on minority rights and civil society,” says the V-Dem report. Autocratisation is diametrically opposite to democratisation or the process of deepening democracy. It signifies that today, democracy does not die in military coups, as in Chile in 1973, or through election malpractices. Autocrats now consider sudden takeovers of power politically imprudent. The use of violence to take over the government and the consequent loss of lives provoke outbreaks of outrage and resistance, or, at the least, simmering discontent. Democracy dies when governments slowly but surely subvert institutions that realise and protect democracy to a point where only elections remain. Multi-party elections are held, but under conditions that are palpably unfair. Above all, autocratisation implies a massive concentration of power in the chief executive. Elected executives weaken checks and balances and implement measures to prevent the Opposition from challenging power. Crucially, the substantial decline of core institutions and practices of democracy takes place under the guise of legal proprieties. The process is prolonged, measured and opaque. Contemporary autocrats have perfected the art of eroding democratic institutions while maintaining democratic façades. Piecemeal changes are cloaked in appeals to hyper-nationalism and majoritarianism and through anti-minority and anti-immigrant rhetoric. Autocratisation is a process, not a predestined end to full-blown authoritarianism. The outcome of the process cannot be predicted. We cannot assume whether there will be a complete democratic breakdown or a return to democracy. Politics is chancy, contingent and unpredictable. Miracles can happen, perhaps. Elections, even if held under unfair conditions, can either kindle the democratic spirit, or spur the stabilisation of authoritarian regimes. What is crucial is the ability of citizens to comprehend the gradual withering away of democracy to the point where the vote is the only weapon available to them. Nevertheless, the power of the vote gives us hope. Perhaps competition between different agendas might enable us, once again, to become what we are meant to be — Aristotle’s Zoon Politikon (political animal). Perhaps the autocrat will be deterred by the fact that the idea and ideals of democracy have become the standard for judging existing regimes. After all, after the end of the Cold War, democracy, as a global norm, has been increasingly shaping expectations. The theory of autocratisation alerts us to the fact that political practices and policies cannot be divided into neat compartments: democracy vs authoritarianism or dictatorship or fascism. There are elements of authoritarian rule in a democratic government. And autocrats or aspiring autocrats hesitate to adopt policies that draw international condemnation or lead to an uprising within the country. Despite the whittling away of democratic norms and institutions, India has seen at least two major social movements in recent times that have challenged political power. There were massive protests led by university students against the Citizenship Amendment Act in December 2019. In the year that followed, farmers assembled at the borders of the national capital to protest against laws that allegedly favoured the corporate sector.

Punjab to see single-phase polling on June 1



Commissioner News Service CHANDIGARH : With the Election Commission announcing seven-phase Lok Sabha poll schedule today, elections on 13 parliamentary seats in the state will be held on June 1. The General Election will commence on April 19 and the votes will be counted on June 4. As of March 1, the state has 2,12,71,245 voters out of which 1,19,29,959 are men, 1,07,75,543 women and as many as 744 are transgender voters. The state has a total of 24,433 polling stations. The state has nine general constituencies, including Gurdaspur, Amritsar, Khadoor Sahib, Anandpur Sahib, Ludhiana, Ferozepur, Bathinda, Sangrur and Patiala. The four reserved seats (SC) include Jalandhar, Hoshiarpur, Fatehgarh Sahib and Faridkot. In the 2019 Lok Sabha poll, the Congress recorded victory on eight seats, SAD and the BJP won two seats each and AAP one. So far, only AAP has announced

eight candidates—Ministers Gurmeet Singh Meht Hayer (Sangrur), Dr Balbir Singh (Patiala), Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal (Amritsar), Laljit Singh Bhullar (Khadoor Sahib) and Gurmeet Singh Khuddian (Bathinda). The three others include Sushil Rinku (Jalandhar), Karamjit Anmol (Faridkot) and Gurpreet Singh GP (Fatehgarh Sahib). Meanwhile, three prominent Congress leaders—Rinku, GP and Chabbewal—have switched their loyalty towards AAP. There’s a buzz of more leaving shortly incase their “political aspirations were not respected by the party high command”. So far, SAD and the BJP have neither released list of their candidates nor have they announced an alliance. During the year-long farm stir in 2020-21, the Akali Dal had pulled out of the pact with the BJP. In February, Home Minister Amit Shah had mentioned about the talks between the two parties. However, the issues related to farmers and ‘Bandi Singhs’ have kept the tie-up lingering.

78 MW hike in power demand witnessed by electricity department in past one week

Commissioner News Service CHANDIGARH : With over 2.40 lakh power consumers, the city receives 345 MW of power from April to September. To address the rising demand, the Union Power Ministry has already approved a 5% increase in supply. The 5% hike in power approval translates to an additional 200 MW, bringing the total available power to 545 MW for the UT. With temperatures soaring to 44°C, the power demand in the city has surged from 280 MW to 358 MW over the past week. This spike in electricity usage was due to excess use of cooling appliances such as ACs and desert coolers. In a bid to ensure a smooth power supply during the summer, the UT Electricity Department had requested the Union Ministry of Power



to augment the unallocated power quota for the city from the current 9% to 14%, from April to September this year. Chandigarh receives 345 MW of power to meet the needs of its approximately 2.40 lakh consumers. The study revealed a peak demand of 280 MW around 10 am during summer, escalating to 410 MW between 2 pm and 5 pm. A senior officer said last year also they had received an additional 200 MW. The department has also secured a regular supply of 30 MW from a Gujarat-based government agency from non-renewable energy

sources. Power consumption is likely to go up by nearly 93,458 kilowatt (kW) this year as power consumers are expected to increase by nearly 10,000. As per the connected load growth projections approved by the Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission (JERC), all categories of consumers will be requiring 17,48,987 kW by 2024-25, whereas the power consumption in 2021-22 was 16,55,529 kW. The UT Electricity Department had filed a petition before the JERC for the approval of the projections for the multi-year control period from 2022-25. By keeping 2020-21 as the base year, the commission had approved a load of 16,86,035 kW for 2022-23, 17,17,183 kW for 2023-24 and 17,48,987 kW for 2024-25.

Multiple cybercrime cases transcending in Mohali, victims lose Rs 9 crore in a month

Commissioner News Service MOHALI : The police in the district has been receiving cybercrime complaints involving Rs 9 crore in the past one month. In one such case, a Sector 71 resident was reportedly duped of Rs 4.27 crore on May 9. Cybercrime cases related to stocks and investments through unverified applications are on the rise in Mohali. In another case, a resident of Sector 68, who is a retired Colonel, lodged a complaint against unidentified fraudsters who cheated him out of Rs 3.60 crore on April 30. A 43-year-old woman of Mandi Gobindgarh was duped of Rs 50 lakh in a case related to IPOs on May 8. A Sector 66 resident, who is a doctor, was duped of Rs 28.5 lakh on April 30,” the police said.



The Punjab State Cyber Crime police station has registered four cheating cases under the IT Act. “The majority of the complaints are related to stocks, investments and cryptocurrency offers for which were made through unverified applications or social media,” said SP (Cybercrime) Harinder Singh Mann. Fraudsters approach their victims promising high returns on investments, sometimes as high as 600 per cent. To begin with, fraudsters convince their victims to invest a small

amount and pay returns on their investments platforms as promised. Once the investment amount gets very big, they default, leaving no trace of their unverified investment platform. The bank account, in which the money is siphoned off, is found empty. The bank account was opened with forged or fake documents. The police said they had reported several bank accounts and phone numbers to the national cyber cell and many of those had been blocked. “To be sure, one must do a thorough verification of the platforms and the bank accounts in which the investor is transferring money. It is always advised to subscribe to verified platforms,” said Mann.

Home buyer to get 10.85% interest for delayed house allotment, RERA directs Omaxe

Commissioner News Service MOHALI : The Real Estate Regulatory Authority, Punjab in its order dated April 16 this year, has directed the respondent that the payment of interest should be made within the time stipulated under Rule 17 of the Punjab State Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Rules, 2017, from the date of the issuance of the order. The authority, has directed Omaxe New Chandigarh Developers Private Limited, New Chandigarh, to pay interest to a home buyer on an amount of Rs 79.36 lakhs at the rate of 10.85% per annum from August 1, 2021, for a delay in handing over possession till a valid offer of possession is made after obtaining the Occupancy Certificate. Complainant Neha of Pathankot had booked a residential unit having super area measuring nearly 2,300 sq ft in the project named “The Lake”,



which was developed by the respondent at New Chandigarh. A buyers agreement was executed between the parties on March 11, 2020, and the total sale price of the unit was Rs 1.02 crore. The complainant stated that she paid Rs 79,36,408 of the total sale price and only Rs 15,70,141 was pending at the time of offer of possession. As per the Clause 7.1 of the buyer’s agreement, the possession of the unit was to be delivered on July 31, 2021. “However, the respondent has not offered possession till date,” stated the complainant’s counsel, Shah Nawaz. The respondent’s counsel

pleaded that lockdown was imposed in the entire country on March 22, 2020, due to the Covid pandemic and as such, the work on the said project was completely stopped. The respondent referred to an advisory of the Union Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs and an order dated October 28, 2020, passed by the RERA whereby all statutory compliances in relation to real estate projects, which had become due between March 15, 2020, and September 15, 2020, had been extended by six months from the original date, which was May 31, 2022.

Time period extended for upgradation of Chandigarh railway station until May 31

Commissioner News Service CHANDIGARH : Initially set for April 10, 2024, the project’s timeline has been revised to May 31.



The railway officers from the headquarters and Ambala division took stock of works being carried out under the Amrit Bharat Stations scheme. Local railway station’s transformative upgrade, designed as a prototype for future stations, has encountered an extension in its completion deadline. The station is being upgraded with innovative modular designs and prefabricated components. The contract has been awarded to M/s Ahluwalia Contracts (India) Limited at a cost of Rs 462 crore. Buildings (G+3) of sizes 60m x 42m each are planned on both sides of the

station. The ground floor features essential services such as ticket counters, book stalls, a souvenir shop, a retail shop, railway offices and an executive lounge. The second floor will house enquiry counters, a food court, retail shops, a cloak room and a paid waiting lounge. The third floor will have an exclusive food court. An air-concourse (72m x 80m) will connect the second floors of the two buildings. The platforms will be accessible through lifts, escalators and stairs from the

concourse. Two foot overbridges (each 12 m wide) are strategically positioned on the Kalka and Ambala ends of the station. These will be used by arriving passengers and will also be connected with the station building. A through roof, measuring 180m x 80m, covering the entire area of air-concourse and both the foot overbridges is an important feature. The present parking area on both sides of the station are being developed and is being increased from the existing 13,720 sq m to 24,515 sq m.

In a letter written to the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Punjab, the Government Medical College and Hospital Nursing Association has stated that a large number



of medical employees including doctors, nurses and ANMs have been assigned election related duties in violation of the Election Commission of India (ECI) guidelines. Ramanjit Singh said with hundreds of employees from the medical college assigned these duties, the medical services are getting affected for the patients. "The employees would not only be required on the election day but are also required to attend many rehearsals and meetings as part of the preparations for elections," said Palwinder Kaur, a senior

leader of the association. She said that due to violation of the set norms by the local administration, many employees, especially nurses, who are assigned night duty at the hospital, are forced to attend election rehearsals during the day. "This is not only affecting medical services but also the mental and physical health of the employees," she said.

Among those who have been assigned election duties are the faculty members of the college who also attend to the patients in their assigned wards on a regular basis. They stated that being busy in election duty means that they would not be available for patients coming to the hospital OPD.

Omaxe builder penalized with 10% interest on capital amount against 5-year flat dispossession

Chandigarh:One ambitious home seeker couple Ms Kavita Gupta and Manohar Lal Gupta residents of Shimla had paid Rs 64 lakh for the flat in 2015, after getting assurance of possession by 2018; but it was factually not handed over even after 5 years. The couple submitted that on March 17, 2015, they were allotted a residential unit, measuring 1,885 square feet, at "The Lake" project developed at Omaxe, New Chandigarh. The complainants had filed a case against Omaxe New Chandigarh Developers Private Limited, Mohali.The Real Estate Regulatory Authority, Punjab, has directed the builder to pay interest to the Shimla-based family for an over five-year



delay in handing over possession of the flat in New Chandigarh. The basic sale price was around Rs 68 lakh of which they had paid around Rs 64 lakh.The possession was to be delivered on September 17, 2018. Even after five years, the possession ,however has not been handed over to them.Alleging that the

developer has violated various provisions of the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Act, 2016, seeking payment of interest against the delay in handing over possession. In their defensive response, the developer alleged that the Act was not violated.
