7 STPs, 2 water projects for Mohali in pipeline

Mohali: Seven sewage treatment plant (STP) and two surface water project at various places in Mohali district would be built. The construction of the identified projects will not only lead to proper management of sewage water but also help in dealing with situations like floods. The treated water will be used for irrigation purposes and various other activities," said a source. Divulging the details, additional deputy commissioner Damanjit Singh Mann said that the projects would be given practical shape shortly. Minstruted the executive officer of municipal council Kharar to complete all pending works related to the provision of land on priority basis to pave the way for construction of 10 MLD STP at a cost of Rs 11.34 crore at Hospital Road, Kharar. Apart from this, instructions were given to

complete the sewerage works on Kharar-Ludhiana Road at worth Rs 1.84 crores. ADC Mann also reviewed a the Landran road STP Project worth Rs 47.40 crore and passed on instructions to speed up the process of laying sewage lines. He asked for immediate removal of all the obstacles related to the surface water (canal water) project costing Rs 117.04 crores in 17.45 acres. He said that another surface water project will come up at Kurali at a cost of Rs 30.51 crores. It is pertinent to mention that canal water would be provided to the people for drinking through surface water projects. The ADC also informed that a 17 MLD STP would soon come up at Naya Gaon at a cost of Rs 34.4 crore. Similarly, Sanoli area of Zirakpur would get an STP of capacity 22.5 MLD.

EDITORIAL –

Missing socialism fabric from political communication

A political narrative becomes successful only when it is accepted by the entire political class as an essential and unavoidable reference point for political communication. For instance, socialism was the dominant narrative in the first few decades after Independence. It was gradually replaced by the narrative of secularism in the mid-1980s when even BJP started celebrating its philosophy of cultural nationalism as 'real secularism'. In the 2000s a new narrative of inclusion became the buzz word for political transactions. However, it faded away by early 2010s, especially after the India Against Corruption movement which led to the formation of AA. Consequently, nationalism emerged as the decisive narrative of politics. The electoral success of BJP in the post-2014 period played a significant role in providing Hindutva flavor to nationalism. In fact, it is reasonable to describe Hindutva driven nationalism as the principal narrative of contemporary Indian politics. No political party is in a position to ignore Hindu issues Hindu sentiments and Hindu interests BJP has emerged as the hegemonic political entity in two related senses as a strong electoral competitor as well as the anchor of political discourse. The claims made by the Samuhik Sankalp, hence, should not merely be seen as symbolic responses to challenge of Hindutva-driven the narrative nationalism. This document is also meant to provide a workable justification for political realignments and internal compromises to deal with the compulsions of electoral politics. The over enthusiasm of a few key constituents of INDIA for prioritizing the seat-sharing discussions underlines this paradoxical equation: they want to win the battle of ideas without changing their style and strategies of electioneering. It is too early to make any

conclusive statement about the future orientation of INDIA at this stage. Yet, it is certainly clear that this political entity has to work hard to elucidate the ideas and ideals listed in the Samuhik Sankalp in a thoughtful and realistic manner. Otherwise, it will be difficult (if not impossible) for it to move beyond the contours of the dominant narrative of Hindutva nationalism. The formation of INDIA (Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance) is a significant political development. The statement issued by Opposition parties, the Samuhik Sankalp (Collective Resolve), shows that a serious attempt has been made to produce a convincing alternative platform. First, INDIA is committed to safeguarding the constitutional 'idea of India', which is based on 'secular democracy economic sovereignty social justice and federalism'. This political formulation is not entirely new. Opposition parties have been invoking constitutional principles, especially the text of the Preamble, to highlight the political limitations of BJP's Hindutva narrative. The Samuhik Sankalp, it seems, does not rely entirely on this prevalent form of criticism. Instead, it offers a new and interesting term 'economic Sovereignty' - a foundational value, which is underlined by the governing party. The Samuhik Sankalp clarifies that this alliance is keen to create 'a fair economy with a strong and strategic public sector as well as a competitive and flourishing private sector'. This is a significant intellectual-political move. It establishes a direct link between economic sovereignty and secular notion of social justice. The second claim is about the style of governance. It is argued that INDIA promises to transform both the substance and style of governance that will be more consultative, and

participative'. This claim is also based on Opposition's criticism of the use of government agencies. This is a tricky promise. The centralised, non-democratic form of governance, in a way, has emerged as an unwritten norm of Indian politics. Even non-BJP state governments follow this norm as a practical requirement. There is another, internal implication of it. The corroding of consultative mechanisms inside the party, the emergence of a few key leaders/families as primary stakeholders of party heritage, and deliberate undermining of the internal party structures are some of the serious challenges faced by all political groups. The promise to make governance much more decentralised and democratic, in this sense, would become meaningful if it is presented as a resolve to tackle the emerging autocratic character of our political class. This brings us to the question of alternative narrative - a phrase that is often used by a section of political observers freely to offer different and even contradictory meanings. Is it possible to treat this Samuhik Sankalp as a move to create an Opposition-driven narrative of Politics, at least in the electoral sense? In my view, a political narrative could be described as a form of communication between political parties and the citizens. It aims to provide an explanation of political realities by arranging a set of identified issues, events and key figures in a particular sequence. Three essential elements of our public life are relevant in this regard: the legal-constitutional structures, changing policy framework and electoral mobilization. These elements are used as resources by political parties to create favourable electoral packages to attract voters in the electoral arena.

Sparing smack holder, 3 cops suspended for dereliction on duty

AMBALA : The Housing Board police post in-charge Sub-Inspector Chander Bhan, Investigating Officer SI Amar Singh and Munshi of the police post Head Constable Vikram Singh have been suspended for their negligence in duty. Jashandeep Singh Randhawa, Ambala Superintendent of Police has suspended three policemen, including the in-charge of a police post in Ambala Cantonment, for releasing a person who was rounded up with



contraband recently. "The suspension comes following an input that nearly 10 days ago, a man was held with a small quantity of smack at a naka, but he was released. Even if the quantity was small, the suspect shouldn't have been let off in any circumstances.

The possibility of taking money in lieu of releasing the person can't be ruled out. The matter was in the notice of the police post in-charge. They have been suspended. A probe is being conducted against them" said Jashandeep Police Superintendent.

Ashok Singla wins by one vote for chairmanship of Pb & Hry Bar Council

CHANDIGARH : The Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana has 25 members who are elected by way of preferential voting system by advocates from the states of Punjab, Haryana and UT Chandigarh. A statutory body established under the Advocates Act, 1961, Advocate Generals of both Punjab and Haryana are ex-officio members of the council. In the runoff, Ashok Singla has been elected chairman of the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana. He defeated his rival candidate Karanjit Singh by one vote. At least 14 votes were polled in favour of Singla, while Karanjit secured 13.

Similarly, Ranvir Singh Dhaka was elected vice-chairman by securing 14 votes. His contender Hargobinder Singh Gill (Bagga) got 13 votes. The elections for the office-bearers of the council were held. Raj Kumar Chauhaan has already been chosen as the honorary secretary. Singla and Dhaka thanked the outgoing chairman, Suvir Sidhu, and honorary secretary Gurtej Singh Grewal for their exemplary service for the institution. Singla, who belongs to Sangrur, earlier served as honorary secretary in 2005-06, and vice-chairman in 2022-23. His father too was a renowned lawyer in Sangrur.

Preserve, protect areas notified as reserved forest : High Court

CHANDIGARH : On a petition filed by Vijay Bansal, claimed that the residents of the Morni block came within the definition of traditional forest dwellers "from all angles and for all intents and purposes". But efforts had not been made either at the political or at administrative level to secure justice — social, economic and political — to the people of the Morni block. The Punjab and Haryana High Court has directed the State of Haryana to preserve and protect the areas notified as reserved forest and not to permit any kind of illegal activity there. The Bench of Chief Justice Ravi Shanker Jha and Justice Arun Palli also set August 22 as deadline for the State to take necessary steps for complying with the provisions of law in this regard. The direction came after the Bench asserted that the steps taken by the respondent-authorities were inadequate and are "not as desired by law". The assertion came after the Bench went through a status report filed by the State indicating the steps taken. Bansal was seeking the settlement of the land in Morni Hills in Panchkula in a time-bound manner. The



PIL also sought the implementation of the recommendations by a committee in 1987 so that the rights of villagers cultivating the land could be decided. It was submitted that the Morni Hills area was included in Haryana in 1966 from Himachal Pradesh, but the State of Haryana failed to recognise and record their ownership rights over "Nau-taur Land" (new broken land for cultivation) despite lapse of more than 50 years after Haryana came into being and public declaration dated October 15, 1980, made by the then Chief Minister. It was added that Himachal Pradesh long ago solved the problem of "Nau-Taur" land. In 1987, the then Commissioner of the Ambala division TD Jogpal submitted a detailed report regarding the land rights of the Morni area people and recommended immediate fresh settlement.

PGI to provide superspeciality services over phone

CHANDIGARH : The aim of the PGI institution would be to facilitate patient follow-ups and streamline disease prevalence identification, benefiting individuals who have to travel long distances for routine checkups. The Telemedicine Department of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh, is planning to set up tele-clinics in collaboration with various medical colleges and hospitals, including Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), Sector 32, and Government Multi-Specialty Hospital (GMSH), Sector 16. The specialties that will be covered under the tele-clinic initiative include radiology, cardiology, ICU, stroke clinics and emergency services. Tele-clinics will allow patients to connect with different departments and superspeciality clinics remotely. The stored data will be securely maintained on a server or cloud storage, ensuring the privacy and confidentiality of patient information. The tele-clinic project will



commence with the active involvement of the departments concerned at the PGIMER and the pilot phase will initiate services for a designated hour or two, with consultants offering their expertise remotely. Upon successful testing, the initiative will be expanded to provide round-the-clock services by recruiting consultants dedicated to their respective departments. The Department of Telemedicine will oversee the implementation and management of this service. In addition to expanding services within Chandigarh, the PGIMER aims at collaborating with medical colleges, hospitals, primary health centres (PHCs) and community health centres (CHCs) in Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, and Jammu & Kashmir. The primary objective is to enhance medical facilities and provide quality healthcare in these states.

60 tablets proposed for councillors by MC to make paperless

CHANDIGARH : The cost of making the municipal house paperless would include tablets, software and electrical material. The project has been estimated at about Rs 72 lakh. The agenda in this respect will be presented at the House meeting scheduled for Tuesday. Mayor Anup Gupta's concept of making the Municipal Corporation House paperless has started taking shape with the civic body proposing to install 60 tablets for councillors as well as officers. During House meetings, inaccordance with the agenda,a large quantity of paper is used, which includes copies of agenda to be distributed to councillors. Further, manpower is required to circulate the agenda copies



to all councillors and officials. It is submitted that to bring more efficiency and enhance digitalisation for a smooth working of House, there should be paperless meetings that are easier than ever nowadays. "Many Houses such as the Himachal Vidhan Sabha and the Haryana Vidhan Sabha have started paperless meetings to streamline various processes," says the agenda. Officials feel paperless meetings will ensure that there is no confusion or delay if a

person fails to find a specific copy. It takes a lot of money to print a large number of copies of lengthy agendas. A digital solution will not only save time but also be a cost-friendly option. Besides, a huge amount of paper will be saved, which will prove to be a milestone in the direction of going eco-friendly. All online papers can be accessed using the tabs, which will help carry out House proceedings in an effective manner, says the agenda.

3 Haryana districts face Gram panchayat polls on August 13

CHANDIGARH : As per the election schedule, nomination papers shall be presented from July 28 to August 3. The polling for these elections shall be held on August 13. The election schedule for the conduct of the general elections of panches and sarpanches of Gram Panchayat Ajampur, Block Naraingarh, Ambala district; Gram Panchayat Chabri, Block Jind, Jind district; Gram Panchayat Bhartana, Block Pillukhera and Gram Panchayat



Rojkhera, Block Uchana, Jind district; and Gram Panchayat Juan-1, Block Sonepat, Sonepat district, has been issued said Haryana State Election Commissioner Dhanpat Singh. He stated that the Model Code of Conduct came into force from July 20 in respect of the

Panchayati Raj Institutions where the polling was to be held on August 13. No officer/official connected with the election work in these institutions would be transferred from his/her present place of posting till the completion of the election process, he added.

Govt not to extend 31 July deadline, masses advised to file income tax return

CHANDIGARH : "We expect that the filing of return would be higher than the last year...we are hopeful that it should be more than the last year," Revenue Secretary Sanjay Malhotra said. He has asked income tax payers to file their return at the earliest as the finance ministry is not contemplating extension of the July 31 deadline. We expect that the filing would be higher than the last year...we are hopeful that it should be more than the last year," he said. About 5.83 crore income tax returns were filed as on July 31 last year, the last day for filing returns for assessment year 2022-23. "We would like to thank income tax return filers as ITR filing has been at a much faster pace than last year and we would advise them not to wait to the last moment and also not to hope for any extensions. "So, I would advise them to



file their tax return at the earliest because the deadline of July 31 is approaching fast," he said. With regard to the tax mobilisation target, Malhotra said, it is more or less in line with the target growth rate, which is 10.5 per cent. The growth rate as far as Goods and Services Tax (GST) is concerned, it is 12 per cent so far, he said. However, the growth rate is lower than 12 per cent on the excise duties front due to rate reduction. "It is rather negative as of now. Hopefully going forward, once the impact of the decrease in the tax rates is over, we will see some increase in collection of excise duties. So, overall we

feel it's still early days...we feel that we should be able to achieve the target," he said. As per the Budget 2023-24, the government expects gross tax receipts of Rs 33.61 lakh crore in the current fiscal. Of this, the government aims to mobilise Rs 18.23 lakh crore, 10.5 per cent higher than collected from corporate and individual income tax, as per the Budget papers. Collections from customs duty are expected to rise by 11 per cent to Rs 2.33 lakh crore from Rs 2.10 lakh crore in the revised estimates for FY23. GST collections are projected to grow by 12 per cent in the next fiscal to Rs 9.56 lakh crore. Taking both direct and indirect taxes, the gross tax collection is expected to grow by 10.45 per cent to Rs 33.61 lakh crore in 2023-24 as compared to Rs 30.43 lakh crore mobilised in the last financial year.

Supertech took a loan worth crores in the name of flat buyers under an agreement that until possession Supertech will pay the loan instalments, but neither has the possession been given nor is Supertech paying the instalments. Banks are issuing warrants to buyers through outstation courts," SK Sachdeva, an investor, added.

Swati Maliwal chief Delhi Commission to visit Manipur

NEW DELHI : The Delhi Commission for Women (DCW) chief would visit the strife-torn Manipur despite the state government allegedly denying her permission for the visit said DCW chief Swati Maliwal. TMhe Manipur Government has refused to let her visit the state to interact with survivors of sexual violence. In a tweet on Sunday, Maliwal said she has written to Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh seeking an urgent meeting with him during her visit. She is expected to reach Imphal by 12 noon. "Manipur Govt recommended I consider postponing my visit due to law and order situation. After deliberation on their suggestion, have decided to fly to Imphal as planned. Sought time from Manipur CM. Will meet him & request him to come along to visit the sexual assault survivors," Maliwal tweeted. Maliwal also shared a copy of a letter written to the Manipur Chief Minister on Sunday in which she urged him to facilitate her visit while ensuring that she will not do anything to create problems for the state government. "I seek an urgent meeting with your hon'ble self to discuss the extremely pertinent issue of the human rights violations and sexual assault cases occurring in Manipur... Several Manipuri women have



come to Delhi in order to escape the ongoing violence in the state. I wish to discuss issues regarding their welfare as well with your hon'ble self," she said in the letter. She also sought the CM's support in visiting the violence affected relief camps where the victims of sexual assault are presently staying. "I request you to kindly issue directions to the officers to facilitate my visit. As a fellow citizen of this country and the head of a statutory body protecting women and girls, I appeal to your hon'ble self to aid me in providing help and support to the sisters of Manipur. I assure you that I shall not be doing anything that creates a problem for your government during my visit to the state," she added. "I assure you that I shall leave no stone unturned to support the Manipur Government in its mandate to protect the rights and dignity of the women and girls of the state," she said. Maliwal said the video of inhuman atrocities against women and girls in Manipur has shocked the nation and she

wished to ascertain their wellbeing and provide support to them. The DCW chief said she had written to Singh on July 20 and then to the chief of Manipur Police on July 21 regarding her visit to the state to interact with survivors of sexual violence. "A letter dated 21.07.2023 was sent to DM Imphal who forwarded the same to Joint Secretary (Home) with the request to provide necessary support to the undersigned (Maliwal) and her team. The DM also gave us the contact numbers of the Joint Secretary (Home) who confirmed to us that we can travel to Manipur and he shall provide the necessary support to us in visiting the relief camps. Subsequently, we planned our travel to Imphal," Maliwal said in the letter. "However, suddenly we received an email from the Joint Secretary (Home) requesting us to consider postponing our visit in view of the current law and order situation in Manipur," she said.

Govt officers entitled to mobile, laptop costing up to Rs 1.3 lakh; can retain after 4 years

NEW DELHI : Guidelines for the issuance of mobile, laptop, tablet, phablet, notebook, notepad, ultra-book, net-book or devices of similar categories to eligible officers for official work would be listed out in the office memorandum issued by the Finance Ministry's Expenditure Department. Central government officers will be entitled to mobile, laptop or similar devices costing up to Rs 1.3 lakh, which can be retained by them for personal use after 4 years. As per the guidelines, all central government officers of the rank of deputy secretary and above will be entitled to such electronic devices. In the case of Section Officers and Under Secretaries, 50 per cent of the sanctioned strength can



be issued such devices. Regarding the cost of the device, the office memorandum said it could be Rs 1 lakh plus taxes. However, for devices with a Make-in-India component of more than 40 per cent, the price ceiling will be Rs 1.30 lakh plus taxes. "No new device may be sanctioned to an officer who has already been allotted a device, in a ministry/department, up to 4 years except in case of repair, which is declared as 'beyond economical repairs'," the memorandum said.

It further said post completion of four years of usage, the officer shall retain the device. "Concerned Ministry/Department shall ensure that the data in the device is completely wiped out (data sanitised) before the device is handed over to the officer for retention," the memorandum said. The memorandum dated July 21, 2023, supersedes the earlier one, which was issued on March 27, 2020, as per which the cost of such devices was capped at Rs 80,000 and there was no provision for retention of devices for personal use.

With 30% rebate one can deposit property tax till July 31

Beneficiary annual income should not exceed Rs 60000 : Minister

As many as 2,184 beneficiaries under a social welfare scheme in Muktsar district have been found getting Rs 1,500 monthly pension from the state government, but their annual income is more than Rs 60,000. They have been served notices to produce their income certificates within 15 days. The district has 1,18,327 beneficiaries, including old-age people, widows, destitute children

and disabled persons. An officer in the Social Security, Woman and Child Development Department said, "We are told to serve notices on the beneficiaries having annual income more than Rs 60,000. We have no information how it will be recovered." In 2017, the department through a verification drive, had identified 7,441 "ingenuine" beneficiaries in Muktsar, who withdrew Rs 15.7 crore pension illegally.

New Delhi : A bench of Justice BR Gaval & Justice Prashant Mishra issued notice to the complainant BJP MLA Purnesh Ishwarbhai Modi who was represented by senior Advocate Mahesh Jethamalani and gave him 10 days to file his response after Rahul counsel snr Advocate AM Singhvi said SC could consider either granting interim stay on conviction which would have enabled Rahul to be reinstated as an MP or fix final hearing with in the shortest possible period. The bench chose Singhvi' s latter option ,said " the limited



question arising in this petition is whether the conviction deserved to be suspended or not. Singhvi said a stay on the trial court' verdict was essential and legitimate as the frivolous conviction had already ousted Rahul from Parliament for 111 days shutting down the voice of Wayanad' s in Parliament people.

Following his conviction and 2 years sentence by a Surat court, in the Modi' s surname defamation case , and SC has scheduled a detailed hearing on his petition, seeking a stay for August 4, discounted Rahul' plea for interim suspension of conviction.

Cracks develop in Russian military -- General

Moscow: At least 13 senior Russian officers had been detained for questioning. Another 15 has been suspended by the top military authorities.

In addition to losing Popov, Lt Gen Oleg, deputy Commander of Russian Southern II, of military district died in an air strike, in the occupied city of Berdiansk, marking one of the highest level losses Russia has suffered on the battlefield since the start of the war.

The latest sign of disarray emerged with the release of a four-minute video on which a top



Russian general, fired from his post commanding troops on the critical Zaporozhzhia front accused the military leadership of inflicting a blow on his forces at a challenging time. Major General Ivan Popov

had been commanding Russia's 58 combined Arms Army until he was removed in what he described as retribution for voicing the truth about the battlefield to senior leadership behind closed doors.
