Monsoon overhead, overloaded sewer lines fail to bear brunt of spilling sewages

17.3 mld plant capacity becomes too little to shoulder sustaining of sludge of 6 lakh populous town

Zirakpur : Heavily overloaded sewerlines have signalled exhaustion and paralysis with old installation of 17.3 mld capacity when the town was in its teething trouble. Flooding of rain water have always struck the sewerage system, causing overflow of sludge and made the life of inhabitants a hell where nothing but stinking smell enveloped the landscape of the affected colonies. Burdening the official sewerage pipes, builders have unearthed and laid their sewer pipes thrusting the voluminous, massive sewage into official network of sewerage flow system. Consequently, every other 3rd day, complaints of over flowing stinking sewerage are pouring in. Residents have got tired raising their clamorous voice for getting the solution of their persistent problems. Already having sewerage lines overflows, burden is seen choking the official lines due to unjustified load in the official lines, say several residents on the VIP road. Over 99% builders are reportedly annexing their pipelines with the government laid down network of sewerage system. On the condition of anonymity one builder disclosed that it was not easy to convert sewage material into manure which certainly helps farmers to find their crops very greeny and nutritious. The process needs plenty of manpower and certain chemicals to create oxidation. The solution of over loading sewerage pipes is to remove the illegal sewerage connection or build other sewerage plants for most populous town by providing facilities of 100 MLD (Million Litre Per day), said JE Dinesh Kumar. Although district administration has been making all out efforts to construct sewer plant at Sanauli but could not succeed due to no procurement of land. Before this site efforts were made at Gajipur there also dispute arose and no head was ever made. Excessive load on sewer lines must be removed due to illegal interception by the builders advised SDO Bharat Bhusan on duty who was looking more perplexed due to the challenge of over flowing of sewage. The stinking of the area in habitation was really a scourge for all of us as the people might get succumbed to various disease. Despite many efforts to contact Ashok Pathria Executive officer no success was made.

TGT recruitment for 303 posts to continue until June 23

Chandigarh: With the drive beginning on Saturday, the department envisages to fill 303 vacancies spread across 12 disciplines. These posts include 136 positions for general category, 55 for SC, 82 for OBC, and 30 for EWS candidates. Applications for the TGT posts were accepted from February 26 to March 18, this year setting the stage for a rigorous selection process. The initial phase of examinations kicked off on Saturday, June 22, at 10 am across 85 centres, mainly at govt schools throughout the city. 3. Out of an expected 45,347 applicants, 27,442 attended the exams on time. The candidates claimed that strict adherence to rules resulted in denying exam opportunities to many of those arriving just two minutes late.. Around 20 students faced this issue at the examination centre in Sector 28 B with some initially allowed entry, but were later expelled, impacting their future adversely. It is not their fault that due to traffic and other issues, they were late by 5-10 minutes," said Rajat,whose brother was one of such candidates. The officials from the department of school education said, "To avoid any ambiguity, entry time at the examination centre is explicitly mentioned on the admit card of each candidate. No matter how genuine the cause of the delay is, we have issued clear instructions that no late entry is to be allowed.

Chandigarh: The charged parking fees are not sufficient to manage the parking in the city very effectively. The parking situation at Govt Medical College & Hospital has become chaotic with passage of time as new centres and buildings have come up, consuming remaining spaces that could have been utilized for parking. The influx of vehicles and the limited availability of parking spots have created a challenging scenario for both patients and staff members, admitted Dr Aktri Director Principal, GMCH sec 32. The GMCH authorities are exploring the possibility of introducing an e-rickshaw service within the campus, similar to the system at the PGI. "This initiative aims to provide a convenient mode of transportation for patients and visitors, reducing the need for private vehicles within the campus," said Prof Attri. To fund this small project, officials are actively seeking corporate social responsibility funds and partnerships to provide a free shuttle service for patients on campus. This move shall add reasses the parking challenges and promote an eco-friendly approach to transportation within the hospital complex.

Arvind Kejriwal Approaches Supreme Court Against Stay On Bail

New Delhi: Arvind Kejriwal Delhi Chief Minister has approached the Supreme Court, challenging the Delhi High Court's pause on his bail in a corruption case related to the liquor policy case till a petition by the Enforcement Directorate is heard. The Central agency had challenged the bail granted to Mr Kejriwal hours before he was to leave Tihar jail. On Friday, the high court said till it heard the agency's petition, the trial court order for bail will not take effect. Mr Kejriwal was arrested by the ED on charges of money laundering. The agency has alleged that the Chief Minister got money from the liquor lobby for framing the excise policy and it was used to fund his Aam Aadmi Party's election campaign in Goa. He has been in jail since March 21 except for a brief interim bail granted by the Supreme Court ahead of the general election. In its latest petition, the ED argued that the trial court's order granting bail to Mr Kejriwal was "perverse" and had serious procedural irregularities. The court's order was flawed, it said, since it was based on wrong information, on wrong facts, wrong dates, you come to a conclusion that was mala fide," Additional Solicitor General (ASG) SV Raju, representing the ED, had said.

Billionaire "Hinduja" sentenced to 4 ,1/2 yrs jail, later releaed by higher Court

Geneva(Switzerland) : The abuse by Indian born tycoon Prakash Hinduja and his wife son with daughter - in-law seized passports of their Indian illiterate servants employed at their luxurious village in Geneva. These workers were always paid in Rupees,not in Swiss francs The fifth one,their business manager Najib Ziati was available in the Geneva court.Mr Ziati too received 18 months suspended sentence. The court said four Hinduja were guilty of exploiting their workers and providing illegal unauthorised employment.The court dismissed the trafficking charges on the ground that the staff understood what they were getting into, times atleast in part. Meanwhile, their plea in higher court have worked, and all in Hinduja family members have been released.

In the fast changing world order, PM Modi to visit Moscow on July 8

New Delhi : Not being clubbed with the planned BRICS summit, expected to take place in Kazan during October —also because it comes soon after the Prime Minister took charge of the government for the third term and after Russian President Vladimir Putin was re-elected for the fifth time in March. Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to launch very urgent a day-long trip to Moscow on July 8, which would be expected to underline the engagement between India and Russia, these distinguished partners would also renew afresh partnerships in the fast-changing world order. Modi's trip would be magnificent, not just because it is a standalone visit — but unparalleled due to swift scenario taking place over the world. Much has also changed in the bilateral relationship since Modi last came to Russia was in Vladivostok in 2019, but last visited Moscow in 2015. For starters, the Russian invasion of Ukraine is more than two years old. But following that invasion, the sale of Russian discounted crude oil to price-sensitive India has been so significant that Russia has replaced Saudi Arabia as the largest source of imported crude all in the world.

EDITORIAL -

No space for PPP in provincial govt, in Pakistan

Ever since six judges of the Islamabad High Court wrote a letter to the Supreme Judicial Council (SJC) in March this year, alleging interference and intimidation by Pakistan's omnipotent Intelligence (ISI), the judiciary has been up in arms to rid itself of the age-old taint of being a handmaiden of the military establishment. Partly, this bravado stems from support among the younger judges for deposed PTI (Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf) leader Imran's populist narrative. The Army leadership has been disapproving of these moves. Addressing a passing-out parade at Pakistan Air Force's Risalpur Academy on May 2, Army Chief Gen Syed Asim Munir observed that the army was "well aware of its constitutional limits" and "expected others to prioritise the Constitution as well". On May 7, as the anniversary of last year's 'Black Day' violence (May 9) approached, the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) clarified that any dialogue with the PTI could happen only if it "earnestly apologises publicly in front of the nation", promises to adopt "constructive politics" and forgoes "politics of anarchy". After the Supreme Court advised incarcerated former Prime Minister Imran Khan to seek avenues for political negotiations, he has resorted to the devious stratagem of pushing in Pashtunkhwa Milli Awami Party veteran Mahmood Khan Achakzai to be his frontman for any possible contact with either President Asif Ali Zardari or the Sharif brothers. The negotiations are going nowhere as Imran has told the sizeable contingent of Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) legislators to continue

agitating for the restoration of the February 8 electoral mandate. They are threatening street protests, with possible roping in of disgruntled Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam (Jul-F) cadres of Maulana Fazl-ur-Rehman. After the May 29 Formation Commanders' Conference, the ISPR reiterated that without bringing the planners, perpetrators, abettors and facilitators of the May 9, 2023, violence to justice, there would be no stability in the country. It noted with concern that politically motivated and vested digital terrorism unleashed by 'conspirators' (read Imran's troll bands) was inducing despondency and discord among national institutions, especially the armed forces, which would not be tolerated. Despite these warnings, the courts have been ruling in favour of Imran, holding the procedures and haste employed to imprison him before the February 8 elections violative of natural justice. His indictment in the cipher leaks case was struck down. All these cases have been appealed against. A seven-member larger Bench of the Supreme Court led by CJ Qazi Faez Isa is hearing a suo motu case regarding agency interference in judicial functions. No hearings have been scheduled in the past couple of months. Another CJ Isal Division Bench is set to hear the Election Commission of Pakistan's (ECP) petition challenging the Lahore High Court's decision to appoint six more tribunals to settle election disputes in Punjab. Sargodha Anti-Terrorism Court judge Muhammad Abbas has complained to the Lahore High Court Chief Justice, Malik Shahzad Ahmed Khan,

about the alleged role of the ISI in damaging water and electricity meters outside his house. CJ Ahmed Khan, whose elevation to the Supreme Court was announced only recently, has issued showcause notices to police officials concerned. The Election Commission's decision not to assign reserved seats of the National Assembly to the Sunni Ittehad Council, to which elected PTI legislators now adhere, was upheld by the Peshawar High Court, but it has been challenged by the PTI in the Supreme Court. Deliberations by a full court Bench there have remained inconclusive. If the SC upholds the ECP's decision, reserved seats in Parliament and provincial legislatures will be allocated to the ruling parties and the Jul-F, enabling the government to pursue constitutional amendments. Reports are rife about the government planning to extend the tenure of the Supreme Court CJ and other judges by two years. Ascending to this post has not been without travails for him as he had to face references against his integrity before the SJC, brought at the behest of Imran, prodded perhaps by military leaders of the day (Gen Qamar Javed Bajwa and then Director General, ISI, Lt Gen Faiz Hameed). His January 13 ruling, depriving the PTI of its election symbol (cricket bat), has also been under adverse public scrutiny. He has been responding in a restrained manner to all this venting of ire against the agencies by judges from lower courts. After the Eid vacation, all eyes will be on how the Supreme Court deals with these cases, which could have significant implications for Pakistan politics.

By harnessing the power of women's participation, we are not only

addressing water scarcity but also empowering local communities to be active stewards of their natural resources." Mitra highlighted the multi-faceted approach adopted by various departments. Key interventions include rain-water harvesting structures in private houses, 116 schools and 38 anganwadis and other government buildings. The Adviser directed the departments to prepare an action plan.

Network of immigration fraud continues in Chandigarh

CHANDIGARH : The UT police have registered seven cases in connection with immigration frauds to the tune of Rs 67 lakh. Cracking down on immigration consultants duping people under this pretext of sending them abroad, the fraud persons have now landed in police net. One of the complainants, Darshan Singh of Malerkotla, alleged that Jaskaran Randhawa and others operating from Sector 7 cheated him out of Rs 5.75 lakh under the guise of immigration services. Another case was registered on the basis of a complaint by Lovepreet



Singh of Fatehgarh Sahib, who claimed that Manpreet Singh of Sure Abroad Immigration, Phase I, Industrial Area, defrauded him of Rs 2.50 lakh. The police also booked Ravi Kumar following a complaint by Komal Kumar, who alleged being duped of Rs 10.65 lakhs. In a complaint, Puran Chand, a resident of

Amritsar, alleged that Gurinder Singh Guri and others defrauded him of Rs 15.78 lakh paid to send his son abroad. In another incident, Varinder Kumar of Jind was allegedly duped by Jagjit Singh and Navjit Singh of Rs 31 lakh for sending his brother abroad. Similarly, Sandeep Kumar of Kaithal was allegedly defrauded of Rs 85,000 by the owner of Manchester Consultant and Harman. Meanwhile, Abhishek Kumar of Hisar was allegedly duped of Rs 33,000 by Jagbir Singh, owner of Excellent Visa Solution, Sector 40.

Drive against violations of packaged material under rules, 2011 by Chandigarh Admn

CHANDIGARH : The weight and measurement department has recently conducted checking in commercial establishments across Chandigarh to regulate use of correct weighing and measuring instruments in trade and commerce. It was found that some firms are covering the declarations provided on the pre-packed commodities by their own MRP stickers, which is a violation of Packaged Commodities Rules, 2011. As per Rule 6 of The Packaged Commodities Rules, 2011, every pre-packaged commodity should have mandatory declarations such as complete name and address of the manufacturer/packer/importer, month and year of packing/import, common or



generic name of the commodity, net contents, unit sale price and the sale price of the package (maximum retail price, incl. of all taxes), customer care number with name, address, telephone No. of the person/office which can be contacted in case of consumer complaints and size, if applicable printed on the such packages and declaration printed on them conform to the contents of the package. Legal Metrology Wing of the UT Department Food

and Supplies and Consumer Affairs and Legal Metrology is going to start an extensive checking drive in the coming days against violations of The Packaged Commodities Rules, 2011. The department requested the business establishments to ensure that the provisions of the rules are followed in letter and in spirit. The department has been engaged in regulating use of correct weighing and measuring instruments in trade and commerce, to ensure that exact weight, measure and number of any commodity is provided to any customer as contracted for, or paid for by him. It also safeguards consumers' interest by ensuring mandatory declarations on packaged commodities.

CBI takes over 5 more cases in multiple states : NEET row

NEW DELHI : Mamata Banerjee West Bengal Chief Minister urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to consider abolishing NEET, the national-level medical entrance exam introduced in 2013, and reverting to the system of states conducting the exam in the wake of the paper leak row.
The CBI on Monday took over five new cases of alleged malpractices in the medical entrance exam NEET-UG that were being investigated by police in Gujarat, Rajasthan and Bihar, as the political storm intensified with the opposition gearing up to confront the government in Parliament on the paper leak issue.
The Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS) of the Maharashtra Police also arrested a Zilla Parishad schoolteacher from Latur and registered a case against four persons after it emerged that a racket was being operated to help NEET students willing to pay money to crack the exam.
Several opposition MPs said on the first day of the 18th Lok Sabha that the



government will have to answer on the issue in Parliament as it is causing hardship to lakhs of students.
As Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan proceeded to take oath in Lok Sabha, members of the Opposition shouted "NEET, NEET".
Amid protests and litigation, the Centre had on Saturday shunted out National Testing Agency (NTA) Director General Subodh Singh and handed over the probe into irregularities in NEET-UG to the CBI, which is now probing a total of six cases in the matter.
Pradeep Singh Kharola took the additional charge of NTA on Monday and had meetings with officials of the testing body.

Except Manali, garbage from other areas would not be accepted after July 15

KULLU : "After July 15, if need be, we will stop trucks from other areas, except from Manali and its suburbs, from dumping garbage at the Rangri site." He added it was for the government to look into solid waste management of other areas said Chaman Kapoor, president of the Manali Municipal Council.
MC has decided to accept garbage from Kullu town, its suburbs and Lahaul at the Rangri Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) plant till July 15 only.
The president said if the contractor at the Rangri facility carried out operations in a proper manner, it was sufficient to manage the garbage of Manali and surrounding panchayats. He said an ultimatum had been given to the contractor over alleged irregularities and default in payments. The MC president alleged that the contractor had failed to instal machines to generate energy from waste, as per the agreement done by the previous body of the MC in



2017. He said yesterday about 150 tonne of garbage in five trucks from other areas reached the Rangri plant.
Earlier, the Manali MC had stated that it would stop accepting waste from Kullu and Bhuntar towns, Manikaran and Banjar valleys and from Lahaul areas till Sarchu after June 21. In a meeting with the Kullu DC and other stakeholders on March 21, the other civic bodies and panchayats were directed to make arrangements for garbage management in their respective areas within three months.
The National Green Tribunal (NGT) had imposed a penalty

The Education Ministry had also set up a seven-member panel headed by former ISRO chief K Radhakrishnan to review the NTA's functioning and recommend exam reforms and it was slated to meet Monday evening.
Pradhan had asserted that it was the first of a series of steps to improve the efficiency of the examination process, put an end to all possible malpractices, strengthen data security protocols and overhaul and reform the NTA. The Centre on Monday also made public the rules under the recently notified anti-paper leak law, mandating the National Recruitment Agency (NRA) to prepare norms, standards and guidelines for the computer-based tests among others.
The Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Rules, 2024 have provisions for "engagement of services of other government agencies by public examination authority", "preparations of norms, standards and guidelines" and "reporting of incidents of unfair means or offences" among others.

Supply of Si2 circuit banned by Japan, sanctions issued over Indian Russia links

NEW DELHI : Si2 microsystems designs and assembles integrated circuits for use in commercial, military and space industries.
The Indian company that has been sanctioned by Japan for allegedly violating western sanctions on Russia is Si2 Microsystems Private Limited. The firm is based in Bengaluru.
Japan had announced its intention at the mid-June G20 meet in Italy to sanction companies from at least four countries, including India, over the Ukraine conflict issue. Two days ago the Japan Foreign Office said Tokyo was sanctioning 11 companies from five countries. Sources said most of these companies were sanctioned by the European Union in February.
Japan opted for the US line of all its allies unitedly imposing sanctions on companies that conduct



technology trade with Russia. Tokyo said the other 10 companies are from China, the UAE, Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan.
Japan had last imposed sanctions on government entities after India conducted the 1998 nuclear tests. These were gradually lifted and both sides even signed a civil-nuclear deal.
Reports said Si2 Microsystems worked for ISRO, GE and IBM. They added the firm had partnership with the Ministry of Electronics and IT and the IIT-Madras to develop high-end chips.
Japan and India are part of the Quad alliance along with the US and Australia.

GMDA draws infra roadmap for Gurugram 2041

GURUGRAM : The augmentation plan of roads in the metropolitan town has been approved by CM Manohar Lal Khattar. Based on a projection that the city's population is likely to swell to 55 lakh by 2041, the plan put together by the School of Planning and Architecture in New Delhi draws a comprehensive infrastructure augmentation roadmap.
Gurugram will be transformed into the city of future by 2041, according to the first ever Social Infrastructure Development Plan prepared by the Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA).
This roadmap shall help authority in deciding, approving and executing its projects and planning budgets. "The authority's sole purpose is the transformation of Gurugram into millennium city and achieve the target in next two decades. This can be called the blue print of the vision, which will systematically direct the development of the city," said CEO PC Meena.
The plan focuses on a roadmap for authorities to follow in five areas education, healthcare, public safety,



recreation and socio-cultural facilities. The plan underlines the need for more schools, daycare centres in residential clusters, multi-purpose campuses of institutes, government healthcare facilities within three kilometres, parks in colonies, police posts and old-age homes.
In the education sector, the assessment concluded that the five existing universities and another eight nursing and paramedical training institutes would meet the needs of the residents at the district level by 2041.
But the city would need another 750 nursery schools, 430 more primary schools, and 686 secondary and senior secondary schools over the next two decades. Currently, there are 545 nursery schools, 279 primary schools, and 412 secondary and senior secondary schools in the city.
On the health front, the city would need two more general hospitals, a civil hospital and

six veterinary hospitals. It currently has two government-run civil hospitals and five veterinary hospitals.
About 210 speciality hospitals, diagnostic centres would be needed by 2041, 250 dispensaries and clinics, 25 nursing homes and maternity centres too.
On public safety, the plan noted that there are 25 police posts in sectors, which need at least nine more, especially in Old Gurgaon and the new sectors that are now lined with housing societies.
For recreation the plan seeks four district parks, 26 community parks and 747 neighbourhood parks in addition to sports complexes and a stadium. On socio-cultural activities, the key takeaway was the need for cultural centres, old-age homes (22), orphanages (16), night shelters (5), hostels for working people (3), and cremation and burial grounds (24) over the next 18 years.

"PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in Haryana" launched by CM

AMBALA : "It is a matter of pride for us to launch the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in Haryana in which rooftop solar plants will be installed. The benefit will be given on 'first come first served' basis. It will benefit the families having annual income of less than Rs 1.80 lakh. This scheme will help those who used to face difficulty in paying bills. People should get their registration done on the portal. The solar plant will be installed at a cost of Rs 1.10 lakh. While Rs 60,000 will be contributed by the Central government, the remaining Rs 50,000 will be given by the state government," pronounced Nayab Singh Saini, the Chief Minister of Haryana.
Similarly, families with an income between Rs 1.80 lakh and Rs 3 lakh will receive a subsidy of Rs 60,000 from the Central government and Rs 20,000 from the state government," he added.
Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini launched PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in the



state. He also announced an ultra super critical thermal power unit of 800 MW at Rajiv Gandhi Thermal Plant, Khedar, Hisar. The power unit will come at a cost of Rs 7,250 crore.
The Chief Minister also announced that the government as abolished the monthly minimum charges (MMC) for the consumers having domestic connected load up to 2 KW. Earlier, the MMC was Rs 115 per KW. The consumers will have to pay their bills as per their consumption of units only. It will benefit 9.50 lakh families and will save them Rs 274 crore annually.
Taking a dig at opposition parties, the CM said, "Electricity used to be a political

issue in the state. People used to seek votes in the name of 24-hour power supply. But the double-engine BJP government worked in a systematic manner — former Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar launched 'Hamara Gaon Jagmag Gaon' in Haryana, and as a result, all villages are getting 24-hour power supply today."
The CM said, "To make Haryana self-reliant in the field of power generation, it has been decided to set up an 800 MW ultra super critical power unit at the Rajiv Gandhi Thermal Plant in Hisar to meet the future power demand at a cost of Rs 7,250 crore."
Earlier, the CM also flagged off a bus under Mukhyamantri Tirtha Yatra Yojana ferrying devotees to Ayodhya and said, "I congratulate all those who are travelling to Ayodhya." As many as 38 devotees left for Ayodhya in the bus today.

NEET-PG postponed, as panel set up for agency overhaul

New Delhi : With questions being raised about the "integrity of certain competitive examinations", the Health Ministry finally announced the postponement of the NEET-PG entrance examination "as a precautionary measure", just hours before it was due to be held on June 23 morning.

This followed on the heels of decision to remove Subodh Kumar Singh from his position as Director-General of the National Testing Agency, which has come under fire for an alleged paper leak and irregularities in the NEET-UG examination, and other examinations which it conducts. The retest is being

conducted after the National Testing Agency (NTA) cancelled the scorecards of 1,563 students who were granted compensatory marks for loss of time due to a delay in six centres in Meghalaya, Haryana, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and Chandigarh.

Investigation into the NEET paper leak case led the Bihar Police to neighbouring Jharkhand where police arrested six people from Deoghar on Friday night. A team led by officials of the Economic Offences Unit (EOU) brought the six to Patna for questioning. Deoghar Police said five Nalanda residents Paramjit Singh, Baldev Kumar, Prashant Kumar, Ajit Kumar, Rajiv Kumar,

Centsre Asks CBI To Investigate Irregularities In NEET UG Exam

The Central Govt has entrusted the matter of alleged irregularities in NEET (UG) Examination 2024 to CBI for the investigation. In an official press release, the Ministry of Education stated that "certain cases of alleged irregularities/cheating/imper sonation have been reported" as regards the NEET UG exam held on May 5. The Government of India said that after a review, it decided to entrust the matter with the CBI for "transparency on the conduct of examination process."

It may be noted that the Supreme Court has issued notice on a bunch of petitions seeking CBI investigation into the alleged malpractices in NEET UG 2024. Those petitions, which also seek a re-exam after cancelling the exam and results, are listed on July 8. The Bihar police is currently investigating a case regarding alleged paper leak at Patna. In a related development, the NEET PG exam scheduled for June 23 was postponed by Centre on Saturday night. The Government also replaced the NTA head yesterday.
