Arvind Kejriwal Approaches Supreme Court Against Stay On Bail

Commissioner News Service New Delhi: Arvind Kejriwal Delhi Chief Minister has approached the Supreme Court, challenging the Delhi High Court's pause on his bail in a corruption case related to the liquor policy case till a petition by the Enforcement Directorate

The Central agency had challenged the bail granted to Mr Kejriwal hours before he was to leave Tihar jail. On Friday, the high court said till it heard the agency's petition, the trial court order for bail will not take

Mr Kejriwal was arrested by the ED on charges of money laundering. The agency has alleged that the Chief Minister got money from the liquor lobby for framing the excise policy and it was used to fund his Aam Aadmi Party's election cam-



He has been in jail since March 21 except for a brief interim bail granted by the Supreme Court ahead of the general election. In its latest petition, the ED argued that the trial court's order granting bail to Mr Kejriwal was "perverse" and had serious procedural irregularities.

New Delhi : Not being clubbed with the planned BRICS summit, expected to take place in Kazan during October —also because it comes soon after the Prime Minister took charge of the government for the third term and after Russian President Vladimir Putin was re-elected for the fifth time in March.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to launch very urgent a day-long trip to Moscow on July 8, which would be expected to underline the engagement scenario taking place over





CBI takes over 5 more cases in multiple states: NEET row

Commissioner News Service NEW DELHI: Mamata Banerjee West Bengal Chief Minister urged Minister Narendra Modi to consider abolishing NEET, the national-level medical entrance exam introduced in 2013, and reverting to the system of states conducting the exam in the wake of the

paper leak row. The CBI on Monday took over five new cases of alleged malpractices in the medical entrance exam NEET-UG that were being investigated by police in Gujarat, Rajasthan and Bihar, as the political storm intensified with the opposition gearing up to confront the government in Parliament on the paper leak

issue. The Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS) of the Maharashtra Police also arrested a Zilla Parishad schoolteacher from Latur and registered a case against four persons after it emerged that a racket was being operated to help NEET students willing to pay money to crack the exam.

Several opposition MPs said on the first day of the 18th Lok Sabha that the



government will have to answer on the issue in Parliament as it is causing hardship to lakhs of students. As Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan proceeded to take oath in Lok Sabha, members of the Opposition shouted "NEET, NEET".

Amid protests and litigation,

Amid profests and inigation, the Centre had on Saturday shunted out National Testing Agency (NTA) Director General Subodh Singh and handed over the probe into irregularities in NEET-UG to the CBI, which is now probing a total of six cases in the

matter. Pradeep Singh Kharola took the additional charge of NTA on Monday and had meetings with officials of the testing

The Education Ministry had also set up a seven-member panel headed by former ISRO chief K Radhakrishnan to review the NTA's functioning and recommend exam reforms and it was slated to meet Monday evening.

Pradhan had asserted that it was the first of a series of steps to improve the efficiency of the examination process. put an end to all possible malpractices, strengthen data security protocols and overhaul and reform the NTA. The Centre on Monday also made public the rules under the recently notified antipaper leak law, mandating the National Recruitment Agency (NRA) to prepare norms, standards and guidelines for the computer-based tests

among others.
The Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Rules, 2024 have provisions for "engagement of services of other government agencies by public examination authority", "preparations of norms, standards and guidelines" and "reporting of incidents of unfair means or offences" among others.

Except Manali, garbage from other areas would not be accepted after July 15

In a meeting with the Kullu DC and other stakeholders on March 21, the other civic bodies and panchayats were directed to make arrangements for garbage management in their respective areas within

three months. The National Green Tribunal (NGT) had imposed a penalty

MC on May 29 for polluting the Beas through discharge of untreated waste from the Rangri plant. The MC has approached the HC to seek relief in the matter. As of now, waste from many areas of Kullu was being sent to

the RDF plant at Manali by paying Re 1 per kg to the Manali MC, as many urban, semi-urban and rural areas do not have adequate waste management systems in place. The Rangri plant was also working beyond its capacity. Over the past 5 years, the Kullu MC had been looking for a site to set up a waste treatment plant after the garbage dumping at a yard at Pirdi near Kullu town was stopped from January 2, 2019, following the orders of the NGT and later protests by locals, besides directions issued by the Supreme Court, Many sites were earmarked for setting up the waste treatment plant for Kullu town and its suburbs, but local panchayats had raised






