‘Sanat Realtor’ raises unapproved colony on Shamlat Land beside Nagla road

Zirakpur : The Punjab Apartment Ownership Act, no. 13 in 1995 enshrined to provide ownership of an individual apartment in all respects of a building with full architectural amenities.

The massive demolition of unapproved constructions in ‘Central Town’ would, one day, become monstrous task, if the timely action is not initiated against the on going illegitimate construction beside the Nagla road. It is pertinent to highlight here that no structure can be raised/built on the shamlat land of the gov-



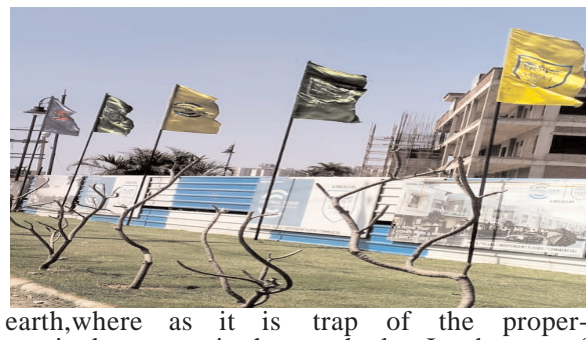
ernment/panchayat, nevertheless on the Nagla road, ‘Sanat Realtors’ owned by Sunny Garg has purportedly engaged in constructing the colony sans any valid architectural plan. The Commissioner News Service tried its best to contact the owner of the ongoing project but the owner

has reportedly instructed his deputed staff not to disclose his mobile number or whereabouts to any visitor or client. The clandestine dealing itself speaks volumes on the legality of the proposed Central Town. The sale manager of the ‘Sanat Realtors’ however said the land was ancestral and no cus-



tomer was required to worry as they were safe in the hands of the said realtors. No one, at this juncture, should forget the deeds of the former Executive Officer Girish Verma who amassed several crores of rupees by passing wrong architectural layouts and never checked the practically built up houses or the

commercial buildings. The issues were transcending its barriers and he was caught red-handed, had to face the jail imprisonment during 2022. The alleged fake architectural plan on Shamlat land is bamboozling the homeseekers and the RERA has silently been watching the phenomenon on the



earth, where as it is required to supervise the constructions in accordance with the RERA directives well in consonance with the existing rules and regulations and approved designs. No case of violations are being registered under the parliamentary laws to save the interest of the innocent home/plot seekers who fall into the

trap of the property sharks. In absence of the existing regulation, the satellite town is being metamorphosed into slum town, where due to heavy rush of property builders sewer lines are seen overflowing, grudging several scrupulous builders and property dealers. Here the ‘Sanat Realtors’ too has not manifested the

names of the officials signatories nor are these clear with bold letters name, mobile numbers incase any client wish to meet or clarify one’s doubts, he finds no way to claim his capital amount, said an home seeker on the basis of anonymity. In the ongoing fraudulent cases, now the time bound replies are being sought by the higher authorities and another Vidhan Sabha Committee comprising 13 MLAs has come into being for containing the mushrooming of illegitimate constructions, said an official of the Vidhan Sabha Committee.

Shimla: "Rahul Gandhi has started the new tradition of making a false matter an issue, and one of the best example of this is Agnipath Yojana," he added. A misconception was being spread across the country regarding the Agnipath scheme that after four years, 75% of the Agniveer would be left with no future and their lives would be ruined. "But, as per the scheme, if 100% soldier become Agniveer then 25% of them will get direct permanent posting in the Army. For the remaining 75% of the soldiers, all the BJP-ruled state governments have made 10-20% reservation in their police forces. Also, 10% reservation has been made in the paramilitary forces of the central govt," Shah said. The Union Home



minister said the Agniveer had also been given many concessions in the selection process, such as age relaxation, advantages in examination and they would not have to undergo a physical test. He said apart from this many private security agencies and companies have prioritised Agniveers, Shah said there would be no harm to the soldiers under this scheme. He said Rahul Gandhi was spreading lies among the people and misleading them, for the benefit of his party.

EDITORIAL –

Detention norms are necessitated by stringent laws

The significant problem is the monstrous nature of the laws under which these detentions are made. These are the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA), 1967, and the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002. Purkayastha, Sudha Bharadwaj, Gautam Navlakha, the late Father Stan Swamy and other Bhima Koregaon accused were held under the first, and Kejriwal, Hemant Soren, K Kavitha, Manish Sisodia and other politicians under the latter. These Acts and later amendments — and here both the BJP and Congress governments are to blame — make it virtually impossible to get bail, mandating that the judge first find that the accused is prima facie innocent; this is an inversion of the time-honoured principle of presumption of innocence. This principle is the first rule of civilised societies, and any departure from it, unless justified by extreme risk to society, is an indication that the rule of law has become a casualty to politics. There are other damaging provisions — the authorities can arrest without much cause; the normal criminal law restrictions on the police are absent; confessions obtained in custody are valid. Above all, there is the application of this draconian statute to ordinary offences. Even the dreaded Maintenance of Internal Security Act (MISA), 1976, had an advisory board of high

court judges to review detentions during the Emergency; it is noteworthy that the laws in question have no such provision in free India. The SC has upheld the validity of these laws — lock, stock and barrel — for the State and against citizens. A blot on our judicial landscape is the judgment of Justice AM Khanwilkar in the VM Choudhary case, equalling the constitutional and public damage that was done in that infamous judgment (ADM Jabalpur vs Shivkant Shukla, 1976) where it was held four to one (the great Justice HR Khanna dissented) that with the proclamation of the Emergency and suspension of fundamental rights, citizens were at the mercy of the State. The SC has admitted a review of the Choudhary judgment, but this is another priority case languishing without a hearing. Of cheer today, however, is the judgment of Justices Abhay S Oka and Ujjal Bhuyan, curbing the ED's power to arrest after the special court takes cognisance of a complaint. Purkayastha's long detention is particularly disturbing because courts worldwide are usually quick to examine cases of journalists being held in preventive custody. The judiciary and a free press are pillars of democracy, and the courts must be more vigilant in checking overbearing governments of whichever hue which threaten their members. But recent detentions have lasted long — journalist

Siddique Kappan, for example. In contrast, Arnab Goswami (albeit not arrested under these laws) got double-quick release; these are not good messages to send out. The record of the authorities in proving guilt and securing convictions under these laws is abysmal — as low as 3 per cent. This means that citizens were being held despite being innocent, and often without reasonable cause. When will our laws and courts start thinking about compensation for unjust imprisonment and deprivation of liberty? And when will we teach officers of such agencies and their political masters that they do not have immunity for mala fide and want only wrongful acts? Now this kind of non-conformity with the law is what lawyers and judges call “going to the root of the matter”; it vitiates the entire proceedings. Notice that this flaw happened on day one. Yet, and this is what should disturb us, it has taken the judicial system more than half a year to release him. We need to focus on why it is that invariably the accused has to travel all the way to the apex court to obtain release. Why aren't district courts and high courts doing their job of providing legal redress in cases of personal liberty? While the members of the former may not feel sufficiently protected, HC judges have as much constitutional protection for their independence as the judges of the Supreme Court have.

Voters may present anyone of 12 documents to vote: DEO

MOHALI : Aashika Jain District Electoral Officer said the ECI has issued directives stating that voters who do not possess an EPIC may use 12 alternative documents to establish their identity. She said voters without an EPIC can still cast their votes if they possess any of the listed alternative documents: Aadhaar card, MGNREGA job card, bank or post office passbooks with photographs, health insurance smart card issued under the scheme of the Ministry of Labour, driving license, PAN card, smart card issued by RGI under NPR, Indian passport, pension documents with photographs, service ID cards (with photographs) issued by Central or state

governments, public sector undertakings, or public limited companies, official identity card issued to MPs, MLAs, or MLCs, and Unique Disability ID (UDID) issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. To help the voters of the district during the Lok Sabha Elections-2024, the Election Commission of India has recognised 12 additional official documents as proof of identity, in addition to the Election Photo Identity Card (EPIC), for voting on June 1. District Election Officer Aashika Jain said any of these documents may be presented by the voter as proof of identity at the polling station.

Stock investor of Chandigarh duped of Rs 3.66 crore

Punjab to see single-phase polling on June 1

CHANDIGARH : With the Election Commission announcing seven-phase Lok Sabha poll schedule today, elections on 13 parliamentary seats in the state will be held on June 1. The General Election will commence on April 19 and the votes will be counted on June 4. As of March 1, the state has 2,12,71,245 voters out of which 1,19,29,959 are men, 1,07,75,543 women and as many as 744 are transgender voters. The state has a total of 24,433 polling stations. The state has nine general constituencies, including Gurdaspur, Amritsar, Khadoor Sahib, Anandpur Sahib, Ludhiana, Ferozepur, Bathinda, Sangrur and Patiala. The four reserved seats (SC) include Jalandhar, Hoshiarpur, Fatehgarh Sahib and Faridkot. In the 2019 Lok Sabha poll, the Congress recorded victory on eight seats, SAD and the BJP won two seats each and AAP one. So far, only AAP has announced

eight candidates—Ministers Gurmeet Singh Meet Hayer (Sangrur), Dr Balbir Singh (Patiala), Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal (Amritsar), Laljit Singh Bhullar (Khadoor Sahib) and Gurmeet Singh Khuddian (Bathinda). The three others include Sushil Rinku (Jalandhar), Karamjit Anmol (Faridkot) and Gurpreet Singh GP (Fatehgarh Sahib). Meanwhile, three prominent Congress leaders—Rinku, GP and Chabbewal—have switched their loyalty towards AAP. There's a buzz of more leaving shortly incase their “political aspirations were not respected by the party high command”. So far, SAD and the BJP have neither released list of their candidates nor have they announced an alliance. During the year-long farm stir in 2020-21, the Akali Dal had pulled out of the pact with the BJP. In February, Home Minister Amit Shah had mentioned about the talks between the two parties. However, the issues related to farmers and ‘Bandi Singhs’ have kept the tie-up lingering.

‘Sankalp Patra’ comprises of 68 promises including old ones : Hardeep Puri

CHANDIGARH : The BJP has highlighted its 38 achievements which were made in the past two terms of MP Kirron Kher. A majority of promises made by the ruling BJP during the 2014 and 2019 Lok Sabha elections have reappeared in their “Sankalp Patra” released by Union Minister for Housing & Urban Affairs and Petroleum & Natural Gas Hardeep Puri here. It has a total of 68 promises. The long-standing issues, which were part of the previous two manifestos, include need-based changes in Chandigarh Housing Board houses and cooperative housing societies, housing scheme for 4,000 government employees, ownership rights for colony residents, conversion



of commercial property from leasehold to freehold, construction outside lal dora, clearing Dadu Majra dump, amendments to building bylaws and a reduction in fine on account of violations, and regular service for contract and outsourced workers. The party candidate for the city Lok Sabha seat Sanjay Tandon said it was not that no efforts were made to resolve these issues, some have progressed to different levels in the said period. Tandon, who has been city BJP president, said, “Regarding

constructions outside lal dora, the way of land-pooling will be adopted or water, electricity and other facilities will be provided to them on the humanitarian ground. “Regarding need-based changes, we did five things. But every time, new issue cropped up. Now, we will come up with a one-time settlement. For the transfer of property, the BJP had brought the Apartment Act in 2001, but it was withdrawn by the Congress in 2007. We will again implement it.”

‘IT to contribute 10% in India’s GDP by 2025’

CHANDIGARH : While addressing a conference on ‘Exploring IT Frontiers’, Abhishek Gupta, chairman, CII, Punjab, is chief-strategic marketing, Trident Ltd, said, “The IT industry is a cornerstone of India’s economic growth. In the FY22, the IT sector accounted



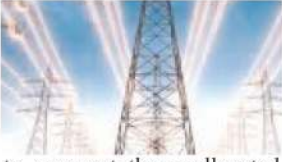
for 7.4% of India’s GDP, a figure projected to reach 10% by 2025. Gupta highlighted the importance of IT sector in Indian economy. The IT and business process management industries’ revenue was

estimated at a staggering US\$245 billion in the FY 2023.” He emphasised the immense potential of small and medium businesses and how IT could be a catalyst for their growth. He shared that automation and digitisation of repetitive tasks could save those businesses an average 10% of cost of production.

78 MW hike in power demand witnessed by electricity department in past one week

CHANDIGARH : With over 2.40 lakh power consumers, the city receives 345 MW of power from April to September. To address the rising demand, the Union Power Ministry has already approved a 5% increase in supply. The 5% hike in power approval translates to an additional 200 MW, bringing the total available power to 545 MW for the UT. With temperatures soaring to 44°C, the power demand in the city has surged from 280 MW to 358 MW over the past week. This spike in electricity usage was due to excess use of cooling appliances such as ACs and desert coolers. In a bid to ensure a smooth power supply during the summer, the UT Electricity Department had requested the Union Ministry of Power



to augment the unallocated power quota for the city from the current 9% to 14%, from April to September this year. Chandigarh receives 345 MW of power to meet the needs of its approximately 2.40 lakh consumers. The study revealed a peak demand of 280 MW around 10 am during summer, escalating to 410 MW between 2 pm and 5 pm. A senior officer said last year also they had received an additional 200 MW. The department has also secured a regular supply of 30 MW from a Gujarat-based government agency from non-renewable energy

sources. Power consumption is likely to go up by nearly 93,458 kilowatt (kW) this year as power consumers are expected to increase by nearly 10,000. As per the connected load growth projections approved by the Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission (JERC), all categories of consumers will be requiring 17,48,987 kW by 2024-25, whereas the power consumption in 2021-22 was 16,55,529 kW. The UT Electricity Department had filed a petition before the JERC for the approval of the projections for the multi-year control period from 2022-25. By keeping 2020-21 as the base year, the commission had approved a load of 16,86,035 kW for 2022-23, 17,17,183 kW for 2023-24 and 17,48,987 kW for 2024-25.

Time period extended for upgradation of Chandigarh railway station until May 31

CHANDIGARH : Initially set for April 10, 2024, the project’s timeline has been revised to May 31. The railway officers from the headquarters and Ambala division took stock of works being carried out under the Amrit Bharat Stations scheme. Local railway station’s transformative upgrade, designed as a prototype for future stations, has encountered an extension in its completion deadline. The station is being upgraded with innovative modular designs and prefabricated components. The contract has been awarded to M/s Ahluwalia Contracts (India) Limited at a cost of Rs 462 crore. Buildings (G+3) of sizes 60m x 42m each are planned on both sides of the



station. The ground floor features essential services such as ticket counters, book stalls, a souvenir shop, a retail shop, railway offices and an executive lounge. The second floor will house enquiry counters, a food court, retail shops, a cloak room and a paid waiting lounge. The third floor will have an exclusive food court. An air-concourse (72m x 80m) will connect the second floors of the two buildings. The platforms will be accessible through lifts, escalators and stairs from the

concourse. Two foot overbridges (each 12 m wide) are strategically positioned on the Kalka and Ambala ends of the station. These will be used by arriving passengers and will also be connected with the station building. A through roof, measuring 180m x 80m, covering the entire area of air-concourse and both the foot overbridges is an important feature. The present parking area on both sides of the station are being developed and is being increased from the existing 13,720 sq m to 24,515 sq m.

Aadhaar integration directives allocated to curb impersonation in bail matters by Punjab and Haryana High Court

CHANDIGARH : The entire system, was required to be made operational within four months. The National Informatics Centre was directed to provide the infrastructure for biometric verification of Aadhaar cards on the court premises with the technical assistance of UIDAI, said Justice Jain. Justice Jain also made it clear that the courts while accepting surety would insist on complete details and identity document of the surety, including Aadhaar card, once the infrastructure was in place. The surety's consent would be obtained for Aadhaar verification. Citing the adage 'bad money keeps good money out of circulation' to demonstrate the displacement of genuine sureties by professionals in bail matters, the Punjab and Haryana High Court has issued nine commandments for seamless Aadhaar integration to curb the menace of impersonation and streamline the procedure. Justice Pankaj Jain, to begin with, directed the secretaries of e-governance departments of Haryana, Punjab and Chandigarh to submit appropriate application to the



secretary, Ministry of Electronics and IT, for Aadhaar authentication services in all court premises within 30 days. The ministry, in turn, was directed to consider favourably the applications before providing necessary equipment to the courts with the State and Central government contribution. The magistrates would verify the Aadhaar card of the accused in the case of personal bond, and of sureties as well in the case of surety bonds. For first-time accused facing less than seven years' imprisonment under the IPC, the courts would adhere to Supreme Court guidelines, not insisting on sureties if specified parameters were met on inquiry/Aadhaar verification. The surety module, integrating Aadhaar and property details tendered as surety, would be fully implemented and utilised optimally. "Whenever a person is to stand as surety, the same shall be cross-checked with the

database...." Justice Jain asserted. The register of sureties would be periodically inspected by principal district judges and chief judicial magistrates. Necessary circulars and rules were directed to be issued by the high court Registrar-General to all courts in Punjab, Haryana, and Chandigarh. Justice Jain asserted professional sureties had become the norm as genuine ones were wary to encumber their property due to prolonged trials. "Delay in trials is leading to a situation where genuine surety is being pushed out by professional surety.... The other reason for mushrooming of professional sureties is the practice being adopted by the criminal courts of insisting upon the sureties and not releasing accused on personal bonds," Justice Jain asserted. The Bench asserted some of the accused in the bunch of petitions before it were facing allegation of faking Aadhaar cards. Describing the menace as widespread, Justice Jain added verification of Aadhaar cards/Aadhaar numbers was required to be seamless.

Follow the rules of handbook assigned by Election Commission of India

AMRITSAR : In para 3.3 of Chapter 3 of Returning Officers Handbook issued by ECI, the medical employees along with various other categories have been exempted from poll duties in view of the nature of their work, said Ramanjit Singh Union president. The employees have demanded from the Chief Electoral Officer to ensure that the rules of Returning Officers Handbook regarding assigning of poll duties are followed without any violations. In a letter written to the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Punjab, the Government Medical College and Hospital Nursing Association has stated that a large number of



medical employees including doctors, nurses and ANMs have been assigned election related duties in violation of the Election Commission of India (ECI) guidelines. Ramanjit Singh said with hundreds of employees from the medical college assigned these duties, the medical services are getting affected for the patients. "The employees would not only be required on the election day but are also required to attend many rehearsals and meetings as part of the preparations for elections,"

said Palwinder Kaur, a senior leader of the association. She said that due to violation of the set norms by the local administration, many employees, especially nurses, who are assigned night duty at the hospital, are forced to attend election rehearsals during the day. "This is not only affecting medical services but also the mental and physical health of the employees," she said. Among those who have been assigned election duties are the faculty members of the college who also attend to the patients in their assigned wards on a regular basis. They stated that being busy in election duty means that they would not be available for patients coming to the hospital OPD.

Fire audit at all health facilities centres becomes mandatory : Health Minister

NEW DELHI : Oxygen refilling was being carried out at the hospital and stressed that it was illegal for a hospital to have a refilling system since it could lead to fire, said Health Minister Saurabh Bharadwaj on Monday. In the wake of the Vivek Vihar hospital fire tragedy, the Delhi Government has directed all state-run and private health facilities to conduct a fire audit, even as several safety lapses have come to light at the neonatal hospital with the police also investigating why 27 oxygen cylinders were kept there. Detailing the government's response, Bharadwaj unveiled a comprehensive plan to enhance safety standards in healthcare facilities. "We have mandated water sprinklers and smoke detectors for nursing homes over nine metres tall," he announced, underscoring the importance of proactive measures in preventing fire-related tragedies. Moreover, Bharadwaj directed all Chief District Medical Officers (CDMOs) to conduct random



inspections of private hospitals to ensure compliance with safety regulations. "Our priority is to ensure that all hospitals are equipped to handle emergencies effectively," he affirmed. Addressing concerns about the circumstances surrounding the fire, he revealed plans for a thorough audit of all hospitals. "We have ordered fire audits at all hospitals, with compliance reports due by June 8," he stated, highlighting the government's proactive approach to mitigate fire risks. "In summer, the power load increases that can lead to short circuit. We have also asked hospitals to carry out an audit of their electrical system to ensure that it can withstand the load," Bharadwaj added.

Gurugram holistically aims zero emission by 2050

GURUGRAM : As Gurugram features among the top polluted cities in the country, the Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) has drawn a holistic plan to reduce emissions in the city. The authority has drafted a 'net zero 2050' document, contouring the goals for urban policy-making to make Gurugram a zero emission city. Net-zero refers to the point at which a specific area or city is able to remove from the atmosphere all green house gases (GHGs) it is emitting. Effectively, it ensures that no additional carbon or other GHGs are being added into the atmosphere.



The document elaborates on the way forward to implement sustainable development strategies like construction of green buildings, setting up of centralised cooling plants in housing societies, adoption of cleaner technologies and increasing the share of electric vehicles over the next 25 years. The plan deals in four major arenas — energy, waste, transport and greenery.

One month extension granted to Army Chief General Manoj Pande

NEW DELHI : The government on Sunday announced that a month-long extension in service for the first time has been given to Indian Army Chief General Manoj Pande, who was to superannuate on May 31. Since the Indira Gandhi-led government gave an extension to Gen SHFJ Manekshaw in the euphoria of the post 1971 India-Pak war. The Ministry of Defence on Sunday issued a statement saying "the Appointments Committee of Cabinet, met on May 26, 2024, approved the extension in service of Chief of the Army Staff General Manoj C Pande for a period of one month, beyond his normal age of superannuation (May 31, 2024), up to June 30, 2024". The MoD cited Rule 16 A (4) of the Army Rules 1954 for the extension. Chiefs of all the three services retire at age of 62. Lt General rank officers and their equivalent in the IAF



and the Navy retire at 60 years of age. The last time the rule was exercised was for General Manekshaw. And in turn his successor General GG Bewoor was also given a year's extension while Gen Manekshaw was doing his extended period of service. Gen Bewoor went on to become Army Chief. The move of the Modi government has thrown up many possibilities. A senior functionary questioned "if the Appointments committee of Cabinet can meet and extend the service of Chief, it could have very well appointed a new one, unless they fear a political controversy". The ongoing elections cannot be the excuse as the Navy Chief Admiral DK Tripathi who took over May 1, was

appointed after the model code of conduct was enforced. This one month extension means the next two seniormost --- Lt Gen Upendra Dwivedi, the Vice Chief and Lt Gen Ajai Kumar Singh, the Southern Army Commander also retire on June 30. But going by past records, Air Chief Marshal RKS Bhaduria took over as IAF Chief on the last day of service, September 30, 2019 and served for two years. Going by the case of Air Chief Marshal Bhaduria, Lt Gen Dwivedi and Lt Gen Singh cannot be ruled out. Lt General Dwivedi and Lt General Singh are batchmates but the former is senior as per the commissioning seniority, that is when they passed out from the military academy. The next in line is Lt Gen NS Raja Subramani, the present Central Army Commander.
