Commissioner News Servic NOIDA/Chandigarh: Humanity has gone on cross roads. Now what should we eat from flour to pulses, these are being adulterated all over the market places. In Chandigarh mainly

sweets are brought from neighbouring godowns where all months of the year sweets are manufactured for the seasonal sales yet traders don't bother in buying old stale sweets and old sweets are sold without displaying there manufacturing and expiry date.

In order to test the purity of the sweets, one could break a piece and add a few drops of iodine into the sweets mixture to taken as per Food Safety

see the result of adulterated sweets as its new color has surfaced blue/purple. Director Helath, Commissioner has been evading action on the adulteration in food sweets where every other shop is selling adulterated sweets On suspicion of adulter-

and Standard Athourity 2006, from many establishments including Noida, Greater Noida, Dadri, Jewar, Dankaur by the Food Safety and Department. Drugs Adulterators become more active before the festivals arrive.

People who consume flour, gram flour, mustard oil, ghee, mayonnaise, namkeen, butter, fish,

packed meat, eggs and pigeon peas and gram pulses should be careful. The samples of many items have been taken exclusively to break the back of adulterators. The maximum samples collected are of flour, namkeen and pigeon pea dal. People of societies, sectors and villages were

constantly demanding

sampling. Department has taken samples from many places as a part of surveillance.

Mr Sarvesh Mishra, Food Safety and Drugs Department Assistant Commissioner II said that samples have been taken from all over the district. After the report of the samples comes, raids will

be conducted in the establishments of failed products. Sampling is done every month. Samples have been sent to the lab in Delhi. The names of the establishments have been kept secret. Action will be taken against the establishments after the report comes.

Adulteration in pigeon pea and gram dal, Assistant Commissioner

II Sarvesh Mishra said that when pigeon pea is adulterated in the market, Khesari dal is mixed in it. This dal looks exactly like pigeon pea, so it becomes easy for the adulterators to do their work. It is very difficult to identify Khesari. By the way, this dal is vellow in color and is a little square in shape. Along mayonnaise are sold by mixing palm oil the most in the district. Therefore, adulterators exercise more alertness in using this cheap oil. Not far behind, even detergents are used to

flour, mustard oil, ghee,

make its looks crystal white and vigorously brightened. Another bamboozling addition remains "Urea" quantity that supplements protein contents and silver foils are substituted by aluminium fibre. It may be borne in mind that sweets in the markets are one of the most unchecked, contaminated food items with pandemic suppliers, sellers.



we feel much more confident about seeking reforms in UN bodies. It is more like solidarity of countries (of Global South) with similar thoughts". Jaishankar will address the UNGA later this week.

In New York, Modi also stressed the need for global reforms in institutions, saying "reforms were essential and the key to relevance". 

Landslide rates agonise masses in **Sub division**

Commissioner News Service DeraBassi : More than Mohali , the district administration has spiked the collector rate of land registry in Derabassi tehsil up to four times .While in Mohali the collector rates have been increased only by 25 to 50 percent, in the residential area of Derabassi tehsil these have been increased by up to 200

The price of agricultural land have also been increased by 100 percent. In 25 out of 95 villages under Derabassi block, prices of arable land have

An increase of 108 percent has been recorded in some parts of village Chatiala of the area. Surprisingly, collector rates for agricultural land on link roads have been increased. Incredulously not only Mohali, the collector rates of Derabassi have been increased compared to Zirakpur, which is famous as a real estate hub. At one two places including Dayalpura,



the increase up to 100 percent, while other places found increase 50 percent.

Collector rates of residen-

tial plots in Derabassi city, Gulabgarh and Madhopur have increased by 100 percent. Colonies Gulabgarh and Madhopur have lower market prices of plots but higher collector rates. The collector rate of Madhopur Mauja under Municipal Derabassi has been Council increased to Rs 2.50 crore per acre, while the collector rate of residential plots has been doubled from Rs 4500 to Rs 9000 per yard. Similarly in Madhopur itself Commercial rate have jumped twice as collector


