Why fragile attempt to assassinate Trump ??

It is apparent that Trump is missing Biden, who was like a tethered bait bleating to be killed. Instead, he now has a feisty and very credible challenger before him. November could leverage machines for Dhakoli railway underbridge work : DC

ZIRAKPUR : The construction is likely to start by November and the project would be completed in around nine months, said Deputy Commissioner Aashika Jain. The Railways opened the tenders for an underbridge at the Dhakoli level crossing and now successful bidder would be allotted the contract. The DC visited the site, after the first step of receiving tenders, the railway authorities would now take time to review the documents and allocate the work to the successful bidder. The purpose of her visit to the level crossing was to assess the conditions related to the issuance of an NOC for the project. The last date for

fulfilling all conditions to issue the NOC is September 26, said the Deputy Commissioner. As per suggestions made by residents, an alternative route will be explored from area behind Krishna Enclave to Golden Sand. Officials of the electricity wing have been instructed to shift the poles in the meantime, she added. The Punjab Government has already deposited its share of the project cost with the Railways. Interacting with the local residents regarding various issues related to the local administration, the DC assured them of early disposal of the waste dump in the mandi area and speeding up work to install CCTV cameras to curb crime.

He said the MC's sanitation wing teams were regularly monitoring dengue larvae by going from door to door in the city and the violators were being served challans.

Panchkula mayoral polls to fall on September 25 -- Haryana government

Selja to address public meeting on Sept 26 - Surjewala

CHANDIGARH : Sirsa MP Kumari Selja was learnt to be upset after the party gave a free hand to her bete noire and former Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda in ticket distribution, with most candidates who got the tickets being loyalists of the two-time former CM. Ms Selja will campaign for the Congress and address a public meeting in Narwana this week, party general secretary Randeep Surjewala said on Monday after the BJP targeted the grand old party over alleged infighting amid reports that she was sulking. Selja, 61, is a Congress general secretary and prominent Dalit face of the party. With Haryana going to poll on October 5, the ruling BJP has been targeting the Congress over the Dalit leader staying away from campaigning. Recently, Union Minister and senior BJP leader Manohar Lal Khattar had invited Selja to join the saffron party amid reports that she was staying



away from campaigning. Khattar, former Haryana Chief Minister, had also pointed towards the alleged infighting in the state unit of Congress ahead of the Assembly poll. In a post on X, Surjewala said Selja would address a public meeting in Narwana on September 26 and would campaign for the Congress. "Today, I will address 22 public meetings for Congress candidate Satbir Dablain in Narwana. We will hoist the flag of Congress' victory in the entire district and Haryana," he said. "MP and elder sister Kumari Selja will also address a public meeting in Narwana on September 26 at 12 noon and will campaign for the Congress. Under the leadership of Rahul Gandhi

and kharje ji, Congress will fight, win and make the dreams of Haryana come true," Surjewala posted on X. Surjewala's son Aditya is also contesting the poll and has been fielded by the Congress from Kaithal, a seat which he had earlier represented, but is currently held by the BJP's Leela Ram. Hooda's loyalists had also been accommodated on the majority of the 17 reserve (SC) seats. Selja, a former Union Minister, enjoys a good support base in many districts including Sirsa, Ambala and Hisar. Recently, many BJP leaders have been targeting the Congress over alleged disrespect being meted out to Selja, whose last campaign was in support of party candidates Shamsheer Singh Gogi and Shalley Chaudhary on September 11. Selja was also conspicuous by her absence at the event in Delhi where the Congress released manifesto.

Mohali to herald online challan system soon

MOHALI : The online project is aimed at curbing traffic violations, hooliganism and illegal activities by monitoring 18 busy junctions in the city with CCTV surveillance. The Rs 17.70 crore project is set to cover 18 locations on the city roads with more than 400 cameras, besides two speed detectors on the Airport Road. A Central Command And Control Room set up on the top floor of the Sohana police station would monitor the feed of four types of cameras - 63 installed for red light violation detection, 216 for



number plate recognition, 22 giving pan, tilt and zoom view, 104 bullet cameras along and two speed detectors. After the completion of installation work, online challans will be issued in Mohali. The installation of a city surveillance and traffic management system here is

in its final stages with cameras being installed at important junctions. By September 30, all cameras would be in place, said the police. This system would also have an e-challan and a virtual court. "It is a good thing that hi-tech cameras are being mounted for city surveillance but this has been done earlier also. It is the maintenance of the infrastructure that will be the key. Otherwise, everything will be junk in just one year," said a road safety and traffic management expert.

Strength of stray cattle in Panchkula city to be surveyed by MC

PANCHKULA : The issue of conducting survey of stray cattle was discussed during a meeting of Panchkula development advisory committee. The Municipal Corporation has been sending stray cows to shelters. These shelters have already exhausted their capacity and are not in position to accommodate more animals. MC officials pointed out that they had till date sent 2,721 cows to different cow shelters in and around the city. He said, "But the cow shelters have now stopped accepting more animals citing shortage of space." The local Municipal Corporation will now carry out a survey to count the number of stray cattle head in the city as well as those being kept at various cow shelters to



take a decision regarding the setting up of new cattle pounds and transportation of strays. Haryana Assembly Speaker Gian Chand Gupta said they should carry out a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters. He said, "Conduct a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters and those roaming around in the city. We will see if we have any space to keep the animals in the existing shelters else requisite land can be provided to

interested NGOs to open and run cow shelters." Officials present at the meeting also discussed the dog bite incidents and sought stringent action in this regard. They said the district had recorded registration of as many as 5,699 dog bite cases at health institutions in merely six months this year. Gupta pointed out that the district administration had spent Rs 4 crore on the development of a pound at Sukhdarshanpur village for keeping stray dogs, but remained unsuccessful in its initiative. MC Commissioner Sachin Gupta said, "The law provides provisions for sterilisation of dogs. The canines also have to be dropped back to the place from where they were picked for sterilisation."

NEW DELHI : The "success of humanity lies in our collective strength, not on the battlefield". Mr Modi was addressing the UN Summit of the Future held against the backdrop of the Russia-Ukraine war and the Israel-Gaza conflict, said Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday. Modi in Hindi said he was representing 140 crore people or one-sixth of humanity. He stressed the need for having a human-centric approach. "When we are discussing global future, we must accord the highest priority to a human-centric approach. While prioritising sustainable development, we must ensure welfare, food and health security," he said. He mentioned how India had lifted 25 crore



citizens out of poverty, saying that the country had demonstrated that sustainable development could be a success. "We are ready to share this success with the entire Global South community," said Modi. In August, India had hosted the third Global South summit in the digital format, which was attended by 129 countries. While briefing about the proceedings of the summit then, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar had said, "As we go to New York to attend the UN General Assembly summit,

we feel much more confident about seeking reforms in UN bodies. It is more like solidarity of countries (of Global South) with similar thoughts". Jaishankar will address the UNGA later this week. In New York, Modi also stressed the need for reforms in global institutions, saying "reforms were essential and the key to relevance". India has been seeking an expansion of the UN Security Council with a permanent seat for itself. The PM said while terrorism continued to be a threat to peace, new theatres of conflict were emerging in the cyber and maritime domains. The PM laid stress on global digital governance to ensure national integrity and sovereignty.

Tirumala temple to see Purification of laddu after Tirupati row

TIRUPATI : The rituals were conducted at Yagasala from 6 am to 10 am. A group of priests performed puja and associated rituals. After Purnahuti, the priests will undertake purification rituals 'Panchagavya Samprokshana' in the entire premises, including the kitchen where laddus and 'Annaprasadam' (free meals) are prepared, said J Syamala Rao TTD Executive Officer. Shanti Homam began at Sri Venkateswara Temple on Monday as purification rituals after animal fat was reportedly found in the ghee used to make Tirupati laddus. According to Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD), which manages the affairs of the famous hill shrine, the homam is being conducted to ward off the ill effects of adulteration, restore the sanctity of Laddu Prasadam along with the well-being of devotees. Syamala Rao said Shanti Homam was being performed to overcome the misconceptions about the adulterated ghee used in Srivari Naivedyams which hurt the sentiments of millions of devotees across the world. The EO said from August 15 to August 17, TTD performed



Pavitrotsavams, which is an annual three-day sin-free festival prescribed in Agama Shastra. However, since the presence of adulterated ingredients was identified in Srivari Naivedyams, the Agama Salaha Mandali decided to perform Shanti Homam. The EO said TTD has now changed the entire system of procurement of pure cow ghee. He claimed that with reforms now the taste of laddu prasadam has improved many folds and the devotees express immense satisfaction over the quality of Laddus. The issue of adulteration came to light last week when Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu alleged that ghee containing animal fat was used in making Tirumala laddus when the YSR Congress Party was in power.

No more service by private hospitals under Ayushman Bharat scheme: IMA

LUDHIANA : The decision had been forced by the state government's failure to clear outstanding dues amounting to Rs 600 crores, leaving the hospitals in a precarious financial situation, said Dr Sunil Katyal, president of IMA Punjab. Indian Medical Association's (IMA) state unit has announced that private hospitals in the state would no longer offer treatment under the Ayushman Bharat scheme. Dr Katyal said despite numerous meetings and discussions with the CEO of the State Health Agency and various



officials from the Punjab Health Ministry, no concrete action had been taken to address the issue. He emphasised the IMA had tried all possible avenues to resolve the matter through dialogue and negotiation, but the lack of any meaningful progress had left private hospitals with no choice but to opt out of the scheme. While regretting the possible hardship the decision would cause, he said the situation had become untenable for private hospitals as many of these institutions were struggling to meet their financial obligations, including loan repayments and the operational costs necessary to run their facilities.

Indigenous INS Vikrant equipped with fleet, prepared for deployment

A carrier battle group has multiple ships, including fleet supply ships, and submarines that operate together. "Inducted INS Vikrant with a multi domain exercise and twin Carrier fighter operations in the Arabian Sea," the Western Naval command

said in a post. INS Vikrant, commissioned on September 2, 2022, has now completed the integration of its in-deck fighter jets, MiG-29K, and also the installation of onboard surface-to-air missiles, Barak NG, made by public sector Bharat Dynamics Limited (BDL) and Israel Aerospace Industry (IAI). After commissioning, INS Vikrant had a minor re-fit at Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL), Kochi.

Landslide rates agonise masses in Sub division

DeraBassi : More than Mohali , the district administration has spiked the collector rate of land registry in Derabassi tehsil up to four times .While in Mohali the collector rates have been increased only by 25 to 50 percent, in the residential area of Derabassi tehsil these have been increased by up to 200 percent. The price of agricultural land have also been increased by 100 percent. In 25 out of 95 villages under Derabassi block, prices of arable land have doubled.

An increase of 108 percent has been recorded in some parts of village Chatiala of the area. Surprisingly, collector rates for agricultural land on link roads have been increased. Incredulously not only Mohali, the collector rates of Derabassi have been increased compared to Zirakpur, which is famous as a real estate hub. At one two places including Dayalpura ,



Zirakpur has witnessed the increase up to 100 percent, while other places found increase 50 percent.

Collector rates of residential plots in Derabassi city, Gulabgarh and Madhopur have increased by 100 percent. Colonies in Gulabgarh and Madhopur have lower market prices of plots but higher collector rates. The collector rate of Madhopur Mauja under Derabassi Municipal Council has been increased to Rs 2.50 crore per acre, while the collector rate of residential plots has been doubled from Rs 4500 to Rs 9000 per yard. Similarly in Madhopur itself Commercial rate have jumped twice as collector rates. This rate has now

gone up to Rs 9000 per yard and Rs 15000 per yard.

The condition of NOC removal has yet not been implemented. Nevertheless the increased prices will be implemented the very next day itself.

Property traders say that the registry of unauthorized colonies has already been closed. Registry is still closed in urban areas without map, regularization and NOC. People were waiting for relief in property purchase but the government has rubbed salt instead of ointment on their wounds. People say that the government did not issue the NOC removal notification even after 6 months.

Bhubaneswar: Among various schemes the construction of 3 crore pucca houses includes for the underprivileged. Govt has also unveiled a Rs 2 lakh crore package for youth, which includes covering the cost of their first salary in private sector jobs. Additionally, 75,000 new seats will be added in medical colleges across the country over the next five years.

Highlighted benefits for farmers and also noted that over 11 lakh "Lakhpati Didis" have been created in the past 100 days. For paddy oilseed, and onion farmers, import duties on oilseeds have been increased to ensure higher prices for domestically produced crops. The export duty on basmati rice has been lowered, and MSP of kharif crops has been raised.

The budget for the ministry of tribal affairs has nearly doubled, and a special proj-



ect for the development of 60,000 tribal villages has been announced. Pucca roads for 2,000 villages have been approved. The Unified Pension Scheme has been given the go-ahead, and income tax for professionals, business owners, and entrepreneurs has been reduced," - the PM said Tuesday in Bhubaneswar.

"Farmers will receive benefits worth Rs 2 lakh crore," Modi said.

The PM launched the Subhadra Yojana, a flagship scheme of Odisha govt, which aims to empower women by providing a cash incentive of Rs 50,000 over

five years. "Any country or state progresses only when half of its population - that is our women power has equal participation in its development," Modi said. He said it is the largest women-centric scheme, expected to cover over 1 crore women, with the first instalment of Rs 5,000 already transferred to the accounts of 25 lakh beneficiaries.

Sanju Behera, a beneficiary, expressed her gratitude: "I am really happy after I got the SMS confirming Rs 5,000 was deposited in my account. I am planning to buy a sewing machine with the money."

Chandigarh :The Union ministry of health and family welfare on Aug 23 issued an order to do away with "colonial" robes and caps and adopt the Indian dress code for convocation ceremonies instead. This was to be applied for Institutes of National Importance (INI) - PGIMER, AIIMS New Delhi, JIPMER Puducherry and National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences, Bangalore, central government medical teaching institutes and other AIIMS.

In a bid to "Indianise" the annual convocation of PGI, for the first time, there will be no traditional ceremonial gowns. Instead, doctors and degree holders shall wear ethnic attire. The dress



code is off white kurta, pyjama for men and saree for women. Soon, everyone will be asked to get the required dress ready. A total of 1,550 degrees, including around 100 medals, shall be presented in the convocation on October 6. Union minister for health and family welfare, J P Nadda will be the chief guest. This will be his first visit to PGI after resuming office for the second time.
